The New Year Celebrations throughout the city of Hyderabad have passed off incident free, while the citizens participated in large numbers in various Celebrations/Events, bidding farewell to 2016 and welcoming 2017. It was heartening to note that the youth of Hyderabad City have exhibited a very high standard of maturity in conducting themselves with great responsibility, while moving on the streets/participating in the events showing great concern to the safety, security and convenience of fellow citizens.

The maintenance of public order & peace and upholding of public safety and security is a shared responsibility of all stakeholders in the community. The Hyderabad City police in coordination with and the support of various Government departments, community groups, Businesses establishments, Event Managements and all other stakeholders have taken several measures to facilitate the New Year celebrations in a peaceful and joyous manner. Women's safety has been on the top of Hyderabad City Police priority in achieving incident free New Year celebrations. The entire 15000 strong police force of Hyderabad City Police supported by the RAF and Telangana State Special Police had been deployed throughout the night. 100 SHE Teams had been sprawling in the city throughout the night

taking care of women safety. Another 50 teams of Traffic Police were involved in “drunk and drive checking” in order to ensure accident free celebrations. In all about 927 cases of “Drunk and drive” have been booked during this night. Armed Interceptor Teams have been deployed in all sensitive areas in Hyderabad City to prevent any incidents of violence. The entire credit for incident free New Year Celebrations goes to the People of Hyderabad City.

The Hyderabad City Police take this opportunity to convey its gratitude to all citizens of Hyderabad City, various Business Establishments and Event Managements for being active partners in ensuring incident free New Year celebrations and maintenance of public order and peace throughout the city.

CELEBRATION WITH SAFETY

Hyderabad traffic police has been working with community to promote safety of commuters on roads of Hyderabad. During the entire year 2016 several drives against drunk driving, racing , over speeding etc have been taken up. During 2016, Hyderabad Traffic Police (HTP) has enforced the drunken drive and booked **(17051)** cases including **(13)**-Women respondents (upto 30th Dec-2016).

In the year 2016, **(7505)** drunken drivers were imprisoned (ranging from 1-20 days), **(9546)** drunken drivers imposed fine and collected total **fine amount of Rs.3,15,81,700-00.**

For safety of people on roads and have celebrations with safety on 31-12-16, **Hyderabad City Traffic Police** during the intervening night of 31/01-01-2017 took up special drive and extensive checks to curb **(i)** Drunken driving with Breath Analyzers **(ii)** Rash and Negligent driving **(iii)** Over speeding & **(iv)** Triple riding on two-wheelers and other traffic violations in the interest of public order and safety from 10.00 PM to 5.00 AM (31-12-2016 / 01-01-2017). More than 100 static / mobile /decoy teams conducted the Special DD tests and entire enforcement was video recorded. **(957)** persons were found in drunken drive including one women and **(957)** vehicles were seized on the spot. As well as **(27)**-without/irregular No. plate, **(16)**-Dangerous driving, **(31)**-Over speeding and **(37)**-Triple riding violators were found.

We thank all citizens of Hyderabad for support and because of same we had incident free celebrations during night. No fatal road accident involving loss of life is reported.

We will continue to work with community to promote safety on Hyderabad roads.
