**PRESS NOTE**

**Penalty Point System Came in to Existence**

**In order to discipline the violators, ensure the free flow of traffic and safety of commuters on roads Government of Telangana has issued a G.O.Ms. No.26, Dt.24-04-2017 of Transport, Roads and Buildings (Tr-1) Department which introduced the system of penalty points for the Traffic Violations under the M.V Act.**

From today i.e on 01-08-2017, Hyderabad Traffic Police Started conducting a Special drive on Penalty Point system on Traffic violations under the M.V Act in order to discipline the violators, ensure free flow of traffic and also to curb the violators. The main objective of the special drive is to educate and also to ensure safety of the commuters apart from enforcement.

The following are the cases booked and points were imposed on the violators are as follows :-

It is to inform that, if the cumulative tally of penalty points exceed the limit of 12 during the block period, his driving license shall be placed under suspension for a period of one year. If repeated after revoking by the same individual and accrues more than 12 points, his DL will be placed under suspension for 2 years and similarly for Third time- 3 years suspension. These penalty points are in addition to fine imposed for respective violation. The individual whose license is cancelled drives vehicle, then the vehicle is seized, on charge sheet likely to get imprisonment up to 3 months

If a Person holding Learners License accrues 5 points during the validity of his Learners License, it shall be cancelled

Therefore all the commuters shall be aware of penalty point system to avoid suspension of Driving License and lets us make the Hyderabad city as a safe place for commuting.

### **SERVANT THEFT ACCUSED ARRESTED AND RECOVERED STOLEN PROPERTY BY BOWENPALLY POLICE.**

#### **Brief Facts:-**

On 18.05.2017 received an complaint from Sri Sandesh Soni S/o Late Brij Gopal Soni, aged: 39 years, Occ: Business, R/o Plot No.24, Airhant Enclave, Bunglow No.205, Manovikas Nagar, Bowenpally, Secunderabad and he stated that on 13-05-2017 he along with his family members went to Puri Jagannath temple for pilgrimage after duly locking his house and instructed his maid servant Dipak bera to look after the house and he is staying in servant room and after returning from the Puri jagannath temple on 18-05-2017 he found his house doors was broken and window grill was removed and Gold and silver ornaments and cash, LED T.V and other house hold items were stolen total **worth Rs. 25,00000/-** and his servant Dipak bera was found missing from servant room and He requested to take necessary action.

On receipt of the above complaint registered a case in Crime No. 157/2017 U/sec 457, 381 IPC of Bowenpally Police station and took up the investigation.

On 16-05-2017 GRP Police, Kharagpur, West Bengal found the unclaimed property luggage bags and same was seized by GRP from the East coast express train and later the same was recovered by Bowenpally Police sleuth. **Stolen property worth about Rs. 20,00,000/- is recovered.**

**On 31-07-2017 the Accused A-1) Dipak Bera S/o Late Subhendu Behra, age: 29yrs, Occ: House keeping, R/o Roankinipur village, Nandigram Mandal Medhanapur Dist, West Bengal State** was arrested and recovered the stolen artificial jewellery and silver spoons from his Possession and he also confessed that he along with his associate Guru Mondal has committed this offence and in this case **A-2) Guru Mondal is absconding.**

This case is being investigated and detected by Inspector of Police, Bowenpally PS. with the help of crime staff, under the supervision of Smt. Sumathi Dy. Commissioner of Police, North Zone, Secunderabad and Sri S. Ranga Rao, Asst. Commissioner of Police, Begumpet Division, Hyderabad.
