NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me under section 21(1) (b) of the Hyderabad City Police Act, I, ANJANI KUMAR, IPS., Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad, do hereby notify, for information of the general public, that, in order to facilitate proper regulation of traffic in connection with the **TRS PARTY ELECTION MEETING** at Parade Grounds, Secunderabad on 02-12-2018 from 1500 Hrs to 2100 Hrs the following traffic diversions and parking arrangements will be in enforce.

DIVERSION POINTS:

1. Traffic coming from Sangeeth X roads towards Begumpet will be diverted at YMCA towards clock tower – Patny - Paradise – CTO – Rasoolpura – Begumet.
2. Traffic coming from Begumpet towards Sangeeth x roads will be diverted at CTO X Roads towards Balamrai – Brooke Bond - Tivoli –Sweekar Upkar – YMCA - St. Johns Rotary – Sangeeth X roads.
3. Traffic coming from Tivoli X roads towards Plaza will be diverted towards Brook Bond-Balamrai – CTO or towards Sweekar Upkar-YMCA , Sangeeth Junction.
4. Traffic coming from Sweekar – Upkar X Roads towards SBH- Patney will be diverted towards YMCA – Clock Tower – Patny or towards Tivoli-Brook bond - Balamrai-CTO
5. Traffic coming from Patny, vehicles with not be allowed towards SBH-Sweekar Upkar, The same will be diverted towards Clock Tower-YMCA or Paradise-CTO.

PARKING PLACES & ALIGHTING POINTS:

1. Vehicles coming from Trimulgherry and Bowenpally side should park at Dhobi Ghat and Balamrai Edga after dropping the passengers at Brook Bond.
2. Vehicles coming from Tarnaka side should park at RRC grounds, Railway Degree college, Tarnaka, after dropping the passengers at YMCA.
3. Vehicles coming from Begumpet side should park at Cargo office at Begumpet, PG College and Wesley College at Begumpet, after dropping the passengers at CTO.
4. Vehicles coming from Tank bund side should park at Wesley College at Begumpet, after dropping the passengers at CTO.

All Citizens are requested to take alternate routes to reach their destinations and to avoid the above routes during the specified timings and cooperate with the Traffic Police. Further citizens are requested to use Metro Rail conveyance to reach their destinations.

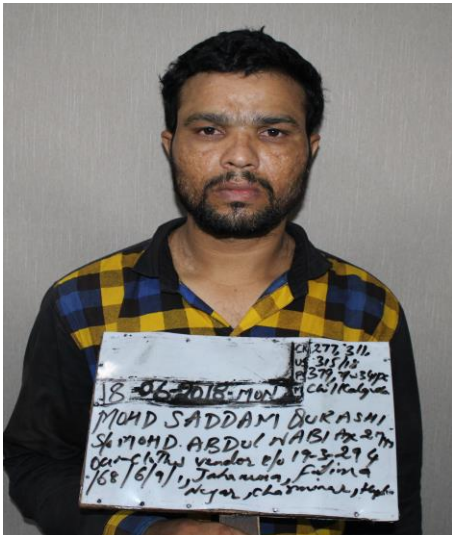

Whereas detention order was issued on 9.10.2018 against Mohd. Saddam Qurashi S/o Mohd. Abdul Nabi, aged about 27 years, Occ: Clothes Vendor, R/o H.No.19-3-294/68/6/9/1, Jahanuma, Fatima Nagar, Charminar, Hyderabad, cattle theft offender of Chilalguda Police Station, under the provision of Act No. 1 of 1986 and it has been returned un-served stating that the said detention order could not be executed as the offender could not be traced despite all possible efforts. Whereas, I am satisfied that the said Mohd. Saddam Qurashi S/o Mohd. Abdul Nabi, has been wilfully absconding and concealing himself to evade the detention order, thereby obstructing the process of law.

Therefore, by invoking the provisions of Sec.7 of the said Act, the proclamation is hereby made that Mohd. Saddam Qurashi S/o Mohd. Abdul Nabi, is required to appear before me at the Office of the Commissioner of Police, Basheerbagh, Hyderabad within 30 days from the date of publication of proclamation to answer/execute the said orders.

PRESS NOTE

Hyderabad Traffic Police continuing its drive against the drunken drivers to ensure road safety. In the Month of **November-2018** caught **(2690)** drivers who were driving the vehicle in drunken condition. Charge sheets were filed against them and were produced in the Hon'ble **3rd and 4th** Metropolitan Magistrate Courts, Nampally, Hyderabad. In this regard **3rd** and **4th** Metropolitan Magistrate Courts awarded imprisonment to the **(612)** respondents and Permanently Cancelled / Suspended Driving licenses of **(124)** Persons for a period as mentioned below. The Hon'ble Courts imposed fine amount of Rs. **58,29,900/-** on the remaining **(2078)** Traffic violators. All the candidates sentenced for imprisonment were sent to Chanchalguda Jail.

PRESS NOTE

The Cyber Crime Police, Detective Department of Hyderabad City arrested an accused by name Prabhat Roy, R/o Delhi who cheated un-employed persons with a fake promise of providing job in multinational companies in Cr. No. 384/2018 & 340/2018, U/s 419, 420 IPC & Sec 66(D) of ITA Act on 28-11-2018 and brought to Hyderabad on transit warrant. Police seized laptop, mobile phones, Bank ATM cards and Cheque books.

Names of the accused persons:

Prabhat Roy S/o Deepak Roy, age: 25 yrs, R/o Dabri, Palam, Delhi

Facts of the case:

On 20-11-2018 & 15-10-2018 received reports from two persons R/o Hyderabad stating that they were cheated by unknown persons on the pretext of providing job in multinational companies by contacting through emails & mobile phones. Believing their versions, they have transferred amounts Rs. 1,02,000/- & Rs. 1,79,000/- respectively to their PAYTM accounts. Later, the accused had cheated them by not responding to their calls. They requested to register case.

M.O. of the accused:

The accused would collect the resumes of unemployed persons from job portals and would make calls to them saying they can provide jobs to them in multinational companies. Later, they would send emails and make them believe that they are genuine. Then, they would collect the money through online transfer to their PAYTM account numbers on the pretext of registration fees, certificate verification, e-filing, medical etc. They continue collecting money until the victim questioned them. Likewise, the accused have cheated many un-employed persons across the country.

The general public are warned to not believe such job offers which come through online/mobile phones.

The team headed by Inspector of Police Sri Bhadramraju Ramesh and SI Venkatesham, ASI Venkat Reddy & PC Feroz under the direct supervision of Addl. DCP Sri K.C.S. Raghuvir cracked the case at Delhi.

PRESS RELEASE

The Cyber Crime Police, Hyderabad City apprehended accused persons by namely 1) Ashutosh kanwal @ ashu kumar and 2) Amith Kumar who make calls and cheat the existing/new insurance policy holders by contacting through emails & mobile phones on the pretext of providing huge returns to existing/new insurance policies in short period in Cr. No. 331/2018. Police seized 12 lakhs cash, 3 mobiles and other material objects which are pertaining to this case.

Details of the accused:

- 1) Ashutosh kanwal @ ashu kumar S/o Sri Rajesh, age 28 yrs, Occ: Pvt.Employee, R/o Mayur Vihar Phase-I, Delhi.

- 2) Amith Kumar S/o Virender Kumar, age 23 yrs, Occ: Pvt.Employee, R/o Nawada, New Delhi.

Facts of the case:

On 06-10-2018, received a complaint by a person R/o Hyderabad stating he was cheated by unknown accused who promised him to provide/get huge returns in short period on his existing insurance policies to contacting through emails & mobile phones and lured him to the tune of Rs. 22,00,000/-. He requested to register a case.

M.O. Of the offender:

The accused contact the existing/new insurance policy holders through emails & mobile phones, on noticing their previous insurance policy numbers through IRDA Insurance Broker companies and would lure them by saying they can provide/get huge returns from insurance companies on their previous insurance policies. The arrested accused persons make calls to customers who are having existing insurance policies by luring and collect money from them. Likewise, the accused persons had cheated many victims who had insurance policies on the pretext of providing huge returns to existing insurance policies.

The general public are warned not to entertain such huge returns to on their insurance policies, which come through online or mobile phones.

The above operation was carried out by Inspector Sri G. Venkat Ramreddy along with SIs Sri Krishna, Madhusudhan Rao and team members under the direct supervision of Addl. DCP Sri K.C.S. Raghuvir.
