NABBED NOXCIIOUS GUTKA TRANSPORTING/SALES GANG -06 HELD

SEIZED NOXCIIOUS GUTKA CONTAINTS TOBACCO PACKETS

IN HUGE QUANTITY– TOTAL WORTH Rs. 10,00,000/- & 3 Transport vehicles.

On 02-05-2018, the sleuths of Commissioner's Task Force, North Zone team, Hyderabad on credible information intercepted (03) Tata Ace vehicles near Santoshi Dhaba, ShahinayathGunj, Hyderabad which containing **noxious Gutka chewing Gutka Petrol brand** material illegal transporting, delivery & sales gang apprehended **(06) accused persons** 1) Akshay Bohara (Sales & Distributor), 2) Mohammed Azim Uddin (Transporting agent), 3). Kongodige Mallikarjun (Transporting Vehicle driver Reg No.TS13UA4668), 4). Dayanand Pandurang Solunke (Transporting vehicle driver Reg.no.AP29TB1365), 5). Sanjay Pandurang Patil (Transporting vehicle Driver Reg no. AP29V7240) & 6). Murhari Shridhar Solanke (Hamali) . Seized noxious Gutka Chewing tobacco and Nicotine as ingredients of **PETROL BRAND Gutak 10,000 packets & 03 Tata Ace goods vehicles, Rs.42,000/- & 04 mobile phones** . Seized material Market Value about **Rs 10,00,000=00**

BRIEF FACTS THE CASE :-

The brief facts of the case are that, the accused person by Akshay Bohara age. 24 yrs, Occ. Gutka sales business is resident of Musheerabad, Chikkadapally, Hyderabad & Mohammed Azim Uddin, age 29 yrs, is resident of Shagunj, Bahaddurpura, Hyderabad. They are running noxious Gutka, chewing tobacco products transporting, sales distribution business in around Hyderabad City from last month. They are indulge in illegal storage , marketing **noxious Gutka products containing Tobacco contents and Nicotine as ingredients** on the name of various brands illegally to gain easy profits.

The accused person 1)Akshay Bohara & 2)Mohammed Azim Uddin are purchasing the Noxious Gutka chewing Tobacco products from dealer/distributor by name Mohd.Ashraf @ Ashwaq from Naigaon, Nanded Maharashtra State and clandestinely transporting to Hyderabad through transport vehicles & its drivers Kongodige Mallikarjun (Reg No.**TS13UA4668**), 4). Dayanand Pandurang Solunke (Reg.no.**AP29TB1365**), 5). Sanjay Pandurang Patil (Reg no. **AP29V7240**) & 6. Murhari Shridhar Solanke (loading/un-loading labour). They use to purchase the PETROL BRAND Chewing Gutka Rs. 100/- each packet and sell the same Rs. 120/- and delivery to known and needy customers, Kirana stores, Pan shop vendors in and around Hyderabad and others areas in high profits and gain easy profits illegally.

Since Telangana State has banned the sale, manufacture, distribution and storage of gutka and all its variants. After that the accused persons have planned to earning easy money by way of selling of banned Gutkha in the market as it as much demand in the market. The accused persons violated the food safety and Standards Act 2006.

Seized Noxious Gutka Packets which Contains Tobacco and Nicotine As Ingredients total 10,000 packets & 03 transport vehicle, Rs.42,000/- (sale procedure amount) & 4). Mobile phones -04. **Seized gutka market value about Rs.10.00,000/-(Ten lakh rupees only).**

The apprehended accused persons along with seized property handed over to SHO, Shahinayath Gunj PS for further investigation.

BUSTED FAKE JOB RACKET FRAUDSTER - COLLECTED RUPEES ONE CRORE - HELD ONE AND SEIZED RUPEES ONE LAKH BOND PAPERS

On 02-05-2018, on credible information the sleuths of Commissioner's Task Force, Central Zone Team busted fake job racket and apprehended One Accused person, who indulged in cheating the innocent unemployed youth with false promises of providing jobs in Income Tax Department, Aayakar Bhavan, Basheerbagh, Hyderabad for the post of Account Officer, Administrative Officer, Tax Inspector, Auditor, Junior Tax Assistants, Senior Tax Assistant, Multi Tasking Staff and attender and collected about One Crore Rupees from the individuals and seized bond papers from his possession.

DETAILS OF THE ACCUSED:

Gangadhar Satish Kumar s/o G.Narsing Rao aged 29 years r/o H.No.18-7-607/8/29/1,
Danaiah Nagar, Uppuguda, Hyderabad

SEIZED MATERIAL :-

1. Bonds written by the accused - (06)
2. Cell Phone (01)
3. Net cash of Rs.1,00,000/- (Rupees One Lakh only)

BRIEF FACTS THE CASE:

The accused born and brought-up in Hyderabad and studied up to S.S.C. due to dis-interest in studies further not studied, thereafter he started working as salesman in Cloth showroom situated at Pathergatti, Hyderabad for two years till 2008, then he quit the job of salesman in cloth shop and joined in Pappu Bread Company and worked as supplier of Breads till 2012 as he was getting commission Rs.3000/- per month and not fulfilling his expenses. Then in the year 2012 starting working in the office of C.A. Sri Sundaram on a daily wages of Rs.120/- per day, this income also is fulfilling his expenses then in the month of June 2014 he quit the job of C.A. While working in the office of the C.A. he got acquainted posts of Income Tax Department, Hyderabad. He frequently used to visit Pan-Card Section of Income Tax Office, Basheerbagh, Hyderabad.

MODUS OPERANDI

The accused G.Satish Kumar hatched a plan to cheat the public on the name of providing jobs to the youth in Income Tax Department Hyderabad and firstly he inform his friends and other relatives that there are vacancies of Account Officer, Administrative Officer, Tax Inspector, Auditor, Junior Tax Assistant, Senior Tax Assistant, Multi Tasking Staff and attender in Income Tax Department and he has good rapport in Income Tax Department and he demands Rupees One Lakh to Two Lakhs, depending upon the post as an advance. He has taken Rs 1 Lakh to 2 Lakhs, from nearly about 80 persons around the city since 2014. After collecting the amount he send 6 digit numerical fake number as "697507" to the prospective candidates by showing the said number is allotment number for the applied post from Income Tax Department, Basheerbagh, Hyderabad City.

If any person, who paid amount and did not get job pressurize to return the amount, then he cheat another person and give the account number of the new candidate and asked him to transfer the amount in the account, saying them, that this account number belongs to Income Tax Officer who providing jobs, like this he is continuing his fake job racket and cheating unemployed youth continuously since 2014.

The accused has given the following rates:- For the post such as 1) Accounts Officer Rs. 10 Lakhs, 2) Administrative Officer Rs.10 Lakhs, 3) Tax Inspector Rs.10 Lakhs, 4) Senior Tax Assistant 9 Lakhs, 5) Tax Assistant 6 Lakhs, 6) Multi-Tasking Staff Rs.4 Lakhs and 7) Attender 3 Lakhs, like this he collected approximately an amount of Rupees One Crore from the innocent unemployed youths and cheated them.

So far, (07) cases were registered against him in various Police Stations of Hyderabad City in which one case in Cyberabad Commissionerate of Sanathnagar P.S, (01) Saifabad P.S., (01) Chaderghat P.S, (01) Shalibanda PS, (01) Chatrinaka P.S (01) Falaknuma P.S and (01) Mangalhat PS.

The accused Gangadhar Satish Kumar along with seized property being handed over to S.H.O. Saifabad Police Station for further investigation.

APPEAL TO THE PUBLIC:

Please do not believe the version of any mediator/agents who make false promises of providing employment for money through backdoor in Income Tax Department, Aayarkar Bhavan, Basheerbagh Hyderabad or any other Government Departments and you have to confirm from the concerned Income Tax Competent Authorities or head of the department, while giving any amount to the cheaters. You may please inform the same to police to take stringent action against those deceivers. The names of the people giving information about the cheaters/deceivers will be kept confidential.

She used to give change for high denomination Indian Currency notes to the needful customers in front of RBI. On 01-05-2018 at about 1600 hrs, the offender Sameer Kumar s/o Sukdev Rao, age 28 yrs Occ. Carpenter r/o Road.No.12, Banjara Hills N/o Bapuji Nagar, Bhuvaneshwar of Odisha snatched Rs.10,000/- from the complainant and run towards Ravindrabharathi. On hearing the hue and cry of Smt K.Padma, The snatcher he was caught by Sri K. Naresh PC 6084 of Traffic PS Saifabad who is on point duty at Ravindra Bharathi. The offender and cash was handed over to PS Saifabad L & O.Vide Cr.No.204/2018 U/S 382 r/w 511 of IPC.

3) On 01-05-2018 while Home Guards Officer bearing No. HG 1888 Sri Tummala Ramesh, performing his legitimate duty at Shivaji Bridge, he found a Samsung Android Cell Phone worth Rs. 15000/- which belongs to Sri Dhanunjay of Medical and Health Dept. Later Samsung Mobile was handed over to the Sri Dhanunjaya by Insp.Tr.PS Sulan Bazar. Good work done by H.G Officer appreciated by one and all.
