

NABBED NOXIOUS ZARDA TRANSPORTING & SALES GANG-4 HELD

Seized noxious zarda contains Tobacco in huge quantity total worth of Rs.4,50,000/- & (2) transport vehicles.

On 02-07-2018, the sleuths of Commissioner's Task Force, North Zone team, Hyderabad on credible information intercepted (02) transports vehicles bearing Reg No. **AP09Y8130 (Tata Ace), TS07UB-2141 (Omni Cargo)** H.No. 8-2-97, Badaguda, Old Bowenpally, Secunderabad, which containing **noxious Zarda & chewing Gutka of various brands** which are illegal transporting, delivery & sales gang. Apprehended **(04) accused persons** 1)Mohd Javeeduddin (Main dealer), 2)Kulal Ramesh (Transporting agent & Driver) 3) Mohd Raheem (Sales agent) & 4). Bure Devendar (Driver). Seized noxious Zarda, Chewing tobacco and Nicotine as ingredients of various brands i.e **1.V-1 brand Zarda – 1580 packets, 2.SR-1 brand Zarda- 1200 packets, 3.Swagath Gold Zarda- 1045 packets 4.Premium Raja Tobacco-780 box and two transport vehicles. Seized material Market Value about Rs 4,50,000/-.**

➤ **BRIEF FACTS THE CASE :-**

The brief facts of the case are that, the accused Mohd.Javeduddin is resident of Moosapet, Maruthi Nagar, Kukatpally. He is doing business of Gutka and pan masala products sales and marketing in the areas of Ameerpet, Fathe Nagar, Baba Nagar, Jagadgiri gutta, Borabanda, Bowenpally and other areas. He is habitual offender. Previous he was arrested by SR Nagar PS & Jubilee Hills PS. After released from jail he started running the business. The accused engaged Kulal Ramesh **and** Bure Devendar as transport drivers and used to deliver the material to agent Mohd Raheem who is sale the Gutka products. They are indulge in illegal storage , marketing **noxious Zara, Gutka products containing Tobacco contents and Nicotine as ingredients** on the name of various brands illegally to gain easy profits.

The main accused Mohd Javeduddin is purchasing the Noxious Zarda, Gutak chewing Tobacco products from dealer/distributor by name Purushotam, M/s.Balaji Traders,

Begum Bazar, Hyderabad and Saleem C/o. City college, Old City (absconding) clandestinely transporting & storage in godown and deliver to sub dealers and other known and needy customers, Kirana stores, Pan shop vendors in and around Hyderabad and others areas in high profits and gain easy profits illegally.

Since, the Telangana State Government has banned the sale, manufacture, distribution and storage of Zarda, Gutka contains Tobacco and all its variants. After that the accused persons have planned to earning easy money by way of selling of banned Zarda, Gutkha in the market as it as much demand in the market. The accused persons violated the food safety and Standards Act 2006.

➤ **Arrest:-**

To day i.e on 02/07/2018 the main accused along with his agent while deliver the Zarda material to the accused Mohd Raheem at H.No. 8-2-97, Badaguda, Old Bowenpally, Secunderabad meanwhile on credible information intercepted (02) transports vehicles bearing Reg No. **AP09Y8130 (Tata Ace), TS07UB-2141 (Omni Cargo)** near New Bowenpally, Secunderabad and apprehended the above accused persons and seized noxious Zarda packets 1).**V-1 brand Zarda – 1580 packets, 2).SR-1 brand Zarda-1200 packets, 3.Swagath Gold Zarda-1045 packets 4.Premium Raja Tobacco-780 boxes.** Seized material Market Value about **Rs 4,50,000/-**.

The apprehended accused persons along with seized property handed over to SHO, Bowenpally PS for further investigation.

The arrest was made under the supervision of Sri. **P.Radhakishan Rao, Dy.Commissioner of Police, Commissioner's Task Force**, Hyderabad by Sri K.Nageswar Rao, Inspector of Police, Commissioner's Task Force, North Zone, and SIs Sri. Panjagutta Police arrested a gang of six persons (including a lady) who impersonated as ACB Officials and tried to extort Rs. 4 Lakhs from Smt. Renuka who is working as a Junior Assistant in RTA, Central Zone, Hyderabad.

Facts: The brief facts of the case are that on 30-06-2018, Smt. K. Renuka, working as a Junior Assistant in RTA, Central Zone, Hyderabad, has given a complaint stating that three persons including a lady have come to her office at about 11.30 am and threatened her by saying that they have a video (which they didn't show to her) and demanded Rs. 4 Lakhs from her by saying that if she doesn't fulfill their demands they will post the video on social network sites. Even before she had time to think, they forcibly took her outside the RTA Office and took her to a hotel at Lakadikapul and took her signatures on Non-Judicial Stamp papers as if she is to give Rs. 4 Lakhs on Monday i.e., on 02-07-2018. On the receipt of her complaint a case in Cr.No. 292/2018 U/s. 384, 388, 419, 365 r/w 34 IPC has been registered and further investigated into.

Modus Operandi: The accused lady A3 has been running an NGO Organization in the name of **Parivartan Women's Educational Welfare & Charitable Society** having her office at Attapur and have been organizing the training programs for various schools. The accused A1 is working as an informer to **Crime Today** and other web channels and A2 is Director of **Voice Today** web channel and A2 is also Media Spokesperson for **National Anti-Crime & Human Rights Council of India** having office at Road No. 12, Banjara Hills. As the income that they are getting was not sufficient for their expenses, they hatched a plan to extort money from unauthorized schools.

About one week back, they visited a school at Uppal and introduced themselves as NGO and Media persons by showing their ID Cards and extorted Rs. 30,000/- by threatening the school correspondent that they will post a video in social media stating that their school is not having government recognition.

Similarly A1 to A3 has visited the office of RTA at Central Zone, Hyderabad on 30-06-2018 at about 1130 hrs and even though they didn't have any video, they threatened complainant Smt. K. Renuka that they have her video in which it is clearly seen that she is accepting bribe and forcibly took her from her office to Dwaraka Hotel at Lakadikapul and sat in the restaurant and took her signatures on two Rs. 50 Non Judicial Stamp papers as if she has taken Rs. 4 Lakhs from them for the medical expenses of her mother and will return the same on 02-07-2018. They demanded her to give Rs. 1 Lakh on Sunday i.e., on 01-07-2018 as they have urgent need of money and A1 to A3 came near RTA Office at about 1900 hrs in a Maruti Omni Van of A5 and A4 & A6 came there to assist them and were apprehended.
