MYSTERY OF MURDER ATTEMPT ON VIKRAM GOUD SOLVED – FIVE HELD – RECOVERED (1) COUNTRY MADE PISTOL, NET CASH OF RS.5.3 LAKHS, (1) SCROPIO VEHICLE AND (8) CELL PHONES

The sleuths of Commissioner's Task Force worked out clues in co-ordination with the Banjara Hills Police and made sustained and consistent efforts and solved the mystery of murder attempt on Vikram Goud, son of Mukesh Goud, EX-Minister which occurred in the limits of Banjara Hills Police Station in the early hours of 28th July, 2017.

PARTICULARS OF ACCUSED PERSONS:-

1. Mulla Vikram Goud S/o Mukesh Goud Mulla, aged 35 yrs, Occ: Business, R/o Plot.No.459, Phase-3, Road No.86, Film Nagar, Banjara Hills, Hyderabad – **(Yet to be arrested)**
2. S.Nanda Kumar S/o Jayaramulu, aged 35 yrs, Occ: Real estate business, R/o H.No.11/A, Kattagulla(V), Kadiri(M), Ananthapur District, A.P.
3. Shaik Ahmed @ Bade Ahmed S/o Shaik Shah Ali, aged 30 yrs, Occ: Carpenter, R/o Wali Sa Road, Kadiri (Village & Mandal), Ananthapur District, A.P.,
4. Raees Khan S/o Rafiq Khan, aged about 32 yrs, Occ: Business, R/o 54, Jawahar Marg, Opp: Police Chouki Kabutar Khana, Indore, Madhya Pradesh.
5. Kokanti Babujan S/o Tajuddin, aged 35 yrs, Occ: Carpenter, R/o H.No.10-1098-60/1, Nijam vali colony, Kadiri, Ananthapur District, A.P.,

BRIEF FACTS OF THE CASE:-

On 28-07-2017 the complainant Smt Shipali Mulla lodged a complaint by stating that for the last 9 months herself & her husband Sri Vikram Goud (Son of Sri Mukesh Goud, Ex-Minister) and children have been residing at Plot.No.459, Phase-III, Road No.86, Film Nagar, Banjara Hills, Hyderabad. They decided to do Annadanam (poor feeding) at Haqim Baba darga which is close to their house. They got up early in the morning at 02.30 hrs and got ready to go to the Darga to make preparations for the proposed annadanam. Her husband, Mr Vikram, came down informing her to come behind him, but she was a minute late in following him. And within a minute she heard very loud sounds. She heard her husband calling out her name loudly seeking help. As she ran near him, he said with difficulty that a person shot at him and ran away into the darkness.

Immediately she dialled 108 to ferry her wounded husband to the hospital but to no avail. There was no response. She personally took him in the car and reached Apollo Hospital at 03.30 hrs. Her husband Vikram Goud is hurt with 2 bullets to the right hand upper arm and left hand upper arm. The doctor's of Apollo Hospital examined and told that one bullet went through the body and stuck right above the spinal cord. He is admitted in emergency at Apollo Hospital.

Considering the seriousness and sensitivity of the crime, the Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad instructed Task Force teams to assist Banjara Hills Police in the investigation to identify the accused. Having taken up the task, the Task Force teams investigated into all probable angles including the possible involvement of professional supari gangs operated in the past, the possible motives, the movements of the suspects at the scene of offence during at the time of offence. Having narrowed down on the possible involvement of some accused, the sustained efforts led to identification of the accused persons by the Task Force teams which steered to their arrest on 02-08-2017.

Brief about the accused persons:-

The accused S. Nanda Kumar is a native of Ananthapur District, A.P. He has one brother and two sisters. He studied up to SSC. His father is working as Railway Station Master, Ballari. In the year 2011 he got married to Jyothi and blessed with two children. At present he is doing Real Estate business at his native place. He involved in seven cases i.e. Theft, Dacoity, House Breaking etc. in the limits of Kadiri. He has been friend of the accused A. Govind Reddy for the past five years.

The accused S.Nanda Kumar was previously involved in the following cases:-

The accused Shaik Ahmed is a native of Kadiri of Ananthapur District, AP. He has four brothers and two sisters. He completed his SSC at his native place. About five years ago he was married to Shaheen and has two children. At present he is eking out his livelihood by working as a Carpenter. He is a friend of the accused S. Nanda Kumar.

The accused Raees Khan is native of Indore, Madhya Pradesh. His father is working as Chowkidar. He is having one brother and one sister. He studied upto 9th class. After completion of his studies he worked in different places and also worked as driver. About twelve years back he got married with Sannu and blessed with four children. At present he is doing Chicken business at his native place. About three years back he came into contact with accused Shaik Ahmed through his friend Taher.

The accused Kokanti Babujan is a native of Kadiri Town of Ananthapur District, A.P. He has one brother and four sisters. He is illiterate. His father is working as Carpenter. About fifteen years ago he got married to Shaheda and has two children. At present he is working as Carpenter at his native place. He is a friend of S.Nanda Kumar for the past ten years.

The accused A. Govind Reddy is a native of Chintala Juduru(V), Vemula(M), Pulivendula(Tq), YSR District, A.P. He has one brother and one sister. He completed his B.A. At present he is doing agriculture work in his native place. He is a friend of the accused S. Nanda Kumar for the last five years.

Motive:-

1. The A1 Vikram Goud hatched a plan of this attempt murder to gain sympathy from the people of his constituency as he is preparing to contest as MLA in the next General Elections.
2. To gain sympathy in his family and friends circle.
3. The A1 Vikram Goud thought that the Police would suspect and go after his enemies and thinking that some of his enemies attacked him (Vikram Goud).
4. He invested lot of money in Mining in Orissa state, other businesses with one Sambashiva Rao and also he was in debts. If the plan is success he will get his money back and also the persons who gave credits to him, they won't ask.
5. To get weapon license and also gun men for his protection.

Planning and Preparation:-

About two years ago, the accused A.Govind Reddy came to know about the Vikram Goud as he also produced some films Ishq and Gunday Jari Gallanthayindile Etc. About five months back one Prasad of Proddutooru who is working in the "Clap Shot" office belonging to Vikram Goud came in touch with him. As he was interested in acting his friend Prasad introduced to the said Vikram Goud. He requested him to provide him chance in his films and accordingly Vikram Goud agreed in to do so in future and he asked him to meet after some time. About four months back Vikram Goud called up the accused A. Govind Reddy to his house and informed him that he wants to be fame in Hyderabad and also to get MLA ticket in the next general elections. For this purpose, he requested A.Govind Reddy to procure a weapon and make an attempt on him so that he would gain popularity and sympathy. The attempt must be planned in such a way that the police should think that it was committed by his political rivals. Govind Reddy agreed to this plan and Vikram Goud paid him Rs.5 Lakhs as advance. Then he approached his friend Nanda Kumar and explained the plan and paid him Rs.3.5 Lakhs in different occasions to execute the plan.

In the month of first week of May-2017 he introduced Nanda to Vikram Goud in his residence. Vikram explained the task to Nanda and asked his help. For which Nanda had given assurance that he would do the needful within a month's time with an agreement of Rs.50 Lakhs. After that Nanda searched for persons who would be fit to complete the operation. In his efforts of finding a suitable person, he came into contact with Shaik Ahmed, through a friend of his Babujan. Nanda explained about the operation and agreed to pay Rs.5 Lakhs to him, if he procured a weapon and execute the task. Shaik Ahmad agreed and contacted the accused Raees Khan R/o Indore, Madya Pradesh who came into contact with his friend Taher, R/o

Kadiri, Ananthapur District about two year back, for the weapon. The accused Rayees assured him to arrange the weapon. Nanda also informed the same to his other friends Babujan and Chinna. They also agreed to participate in the task and Nanda promised to pay some amount after the completion of the task. Nanda informed the same to Vikram Goud and he had taken Rs.3.5 Lakhs for purchase of weapon.

On 06-07-2017 Nanda handed over Rs.1.9 Lakh to Shaik Ahmed to purchase the weapon. On the same day the accused Shaik Ahmed, his friend Babujan and Nanda's friend Chinna went to Indore of Madhya Pradesh by connected Indigo flight from Hyderabad to Indore via Mumbai and collected a country made Fire Arm and three rounds of bullets by paying Rs.30,000/- to Raees Khan. After that Shaik Ahmed and Babujan came to Hyderabad by flight and stayed in a lodge at Panjagutta. On the next day i.e. 08-07-2017 Chinna and Rayees's friend came to Hyderabad by bus with the weapon. On the same day the accused Chinna handed over the weapon to Nanda at Bala Nagar and the same was handed over to Vikram Goud at Bala Nagar, Hyderabad by Nanda. Later Rayees's friends went back to Madhya Pradesh by bus and Shaik Ahmed, Babujan, Chinna travelled to Kadiri in Andhra Pradesh.

Later Vikram Goud is pressuring to Nanda to complete the work. On 17-07-2017 he went to Puttaparthi and met with Nanda and pressurised him and sending abusing messages to him. On 21-07-2017 Nanda, Chinna, Babujan and Shaik Ahmed came to Hyderabad. On the same day Nanda met Vikram Goud at his residence and explained how they planned to execute the task i.e., Vikram Goud's plan. On 23-07-2017 Nanda and Shaik Ahmed went to Kadiri and collected a bajaj pulsar motor bike from A. Govind Reddy at Pulivendula which was purchased for this operation for Rs.30,000/- about one week back and Shaik Ahmed came to Hyderabad on the same bike on 24th July. After reaching Hyderabad, one Ghouse who is a friend of Babujan picked him up and went to Royal Lodge at Secunderabad and stayed there. In the evening hours on 25-07-2017 Shaik Ahmed along with Ghouse went to Chandrayangutta area and erased the engine and Chasis numbers of the motor bike (Bajaj Pulsar).

On 26-07-2017 in the early mornings hours Nanda came to Ameerpet, Hyderabad where he picked up by one driver of Swift Car which was arranged by Vikram Goud to him and he went to Secunderabad and met with Shaik Ahmed near Royal Lodge, Secunderabad. At about 03.30 hrs Nanda, Ghouse and Babujan went to Vikram Goud's residence and met with Vikram Goud and all planned to execute this simulated murder attempt on Vikram Goud and as per their plan "Ghouse and Chinna would enter the house of Vikram to attack with the weapon brought from Madhya Pradesh, Shaik Ahmed would wait outside on the motor bike (Pulsar) to ferry them out after the attempt, Nanda and Babujan who would wait further away from Vikram Goud's house in a four wheeler would collect these three persons and escape. That was the plan. But at present non availability of Shaik Ahmed and as there was some miscommunications, the plan could not be executed and was postponed to the following day. As per the instructions of Vikram Goud at around 07.00 hrs Nanda called Shaik Ahmed to come to Vikram Goud's residence by the motor bike. Around 10.30 hrs Shaik Ahmed came and parked the motor bike (black colour Bajaj Pulsar) at Vikram Goud's residence and had tea with Nanda and Babujan. On the same day they shifted their place of stay from Secunderabad to a guest house namely "Teja

Nivas", 4th Floor, Sri Sai Susheel Building, Plot No.B-55, Near Apollo Hospital, Banjara Hills, Hyderabad which was arranged by Vikram Goud.

On the same day A.Govind Reddy also joined them at Guest house "Teja Nivas", 4th Floor, Sri Sai Susheel Building, Plot No.B-55, Near Apollo Hospital, Banjara Hills, Hyderabad. Later Nanda changed the plan and told Shaik Ahmed to call up Raees Khan to execute the plan and also instructed him to bring 20 more live rounds. Nanda along with Babujan, Chinna and A.Govind Reddy went to Kadiri on the same day. On 27-07-2017 on the instructions given by the accused Shaik Ahmed, the accused Raees Khan came to Hyderabad at 11.45 hrs by bus and got down at the bus at Imlibun bus stand. Shaik Ahmed picked him up and brought him to a lodge "Hotel Sanman", Room No.107, near Gokul Theatre, Erragadda, Hyderabad. Then Shaik Ahmed informed Nanda about the arrival of Raees Khan to Hyderabad and both consumed liquor in Room No.107.

At about 22.30 hrs Nanda came in a Scorpio vehicle from Kadiri and called up Shaik Ahmed and Raees Khan to a guest house "Teja Nivas", 4th Floor, Sri Sai Susheel Building, Plot No.B-55, Near Apollo Hospital, Banjara Hills, Hyderabad. After few minutes Vikram Goud joined with them and explained them how to execute the plan and paid Rs.2 Lakhs to Raees Khan and Rs.2 Lakhs to Shaik Ahmed and promised to give them another Rs.10 Lakhs after the execution of the plan.

Execution:-

On the intervening night of 27/28-07-2017 around 01.45 hrs Vikram Goud took Nanda, Shaik Ahmed and Raees Khan in his car and showed the escaping routes twice to them and also instructed them to throw the weapon in a pond at Hakeempet, abandon the vehicle and leave. Around 02.30 hrs Vikram Goud along with the accused persons Nanda, Shaik Ahmed and Raees Khan reached the house. Vikram Goud dropped them nearby his house and parked his vehicle in his house and after 10 to 15 minutes he called them into his house. After entering into the hall Vikram Goud made them to sit and went into the upstairs and brought weapon along with rounds and handed over the same to Raees Khan and instructed him to fire 3 rounds on him as it is his lucky number. And also informed him that to fire one round on his right shoulder, one round on his left shoulder and one round will go outside by touching of his right side of the stomach. The Accused Raees Khan loaded the gun with rounds, at the same time Vikram Goud instructed them that Shaik Ahmed will wait outside with Pulsar vehicle with the engine on, Raees Khan will fire on him with weapon on his both hands while entering into the hall and also Nanda will wait outside in a four wheeler vehicle to escape from there after commission of offence. And Vikram Goud had given Rs.4 Lakhs to Nanda. After taking Rs.4 Lakhs the accused Nanda went from there by walk.

After that Nanda instructed Shaik Ahmed and Raees Khan to wait outside of the hall in a compound for fifteen minutes. After fifteen to twenty minutes Vikram Goud opened the door and called Raees Khan inside and while standing near sofa. On the instructions of Vikram Goud, Raees Khan fired one round on left hand and one round on right hand of Vikram Goud and while firing the third round Vikram Goud informed him to fled away from there. As per his instructions the accused Raees Khan fled away from there

and came out of Vikram Goud's house and he along with Shaik Ahmed fled away on the pulsar vehicle.

After Execution:-

After the execution of their plan Shaik Ahmed and Raees Khan went to one unknown pond as shown by the Vikram Goud where Raees Khan threw the weapon into Hakeempet pond and also left the pulsar vehicle nearby on the road. Then Raees Khan told Shaik Ahmed that he did not know the route they came by and both got separated. Later Nanda informed Shaik Ahmed not to go to his village for two days.

The Task Force teams and Banjara Hills Police have taken up the case as a challenge and detected the case successfully by travelling from place to place and chasing the accused. Police could finally track the accused down and arrested of all the accused.

PRESS NOTE

87 persons, 72 majors and 15 minors were caught by SHE teams for harassing women in different ways at different places in the city during the last one month.

2 persons were booked under Nirbhya Act, 2 others under different sections of IPC, 10 of them under petty cases and others were counselled and monitored.

Some of the case details are as follows:

Nirbhaya Act booked for social media harassment

A victim approached "SHE Teams" with a complaint of social media harassment. One unknown person made friendship with her on face book. Later he also became friends with her sister. He has taken photograph of the victim and created a fake face book account and started harassing and blackmailing the family members. He started posting the photos of her sisters, cousins and family members in the fake account and threatened and blackmailed her. He also shared the photos of the victim with his friend who is a minor of 17 yrs age. The minor has sent the photos to the victim's aunt telling that he is receiving the inappropriate photos of her daughters and relatives on whats app through somebody. On coming to know this, they came to know that there is a fake account created on victim's name and many photos were posted on the page. The victim approached "She Teams" for help. SHE teams collected the entire evidence of the crime, traced out and caught Mirza Mohammad Ali Baig, S/o Mirza Zaaffar Ali Baig, 23 yrs, Occp : Pvt employee, R/o Talabkatta, and the minor boy who received the photos, caught and handed over to Chandrayangutta PS. A case U/s 354(D) (II) and 509 IPC was registered and investigated into.

IT Act case booked for harassing Ex colleague through social media

A lady working in a reputed soft ware company as a researcher approached SHE teams with a complaint of ex colleague harassing, stalking, using foul language and torturing her for the past one and half years. He tried to contact her foster personal interaction. The victim expressed her disinterest and kept ignoring and avoiding him politely.

He kept operating several fake accounts on Cyber Space, impersonating people and wrote hateful/immodest thing about her on public forums. He was also stalking her electronically. The victim approached the local PS, where the respondent was warned over phone by the concerned SI, to stop harassment and keep good behaviour.

For some time he was silent. But he again started harassing her, defaming her in her friends group and posted abusive comments about her. The victim then approached "She Teams" for help. The "She Teams" collected the entire evidence of the crime, caught the accused Abhishek Peddibhotla and was handed over to Cyber Crimes PS. A case U/s.67 A IT Act, 2008 of Cyber Crimes, is registered and investigated into.

Person harassing ladies through phone calls was booked under IPC.

A lady studying at Osmania University was getting phone calls from unknown numbers speaking in very abusive and vulgar language. They were even making blank calls at odd hours in the night and harassing her. Vexed over such calls, she approached SHE teams. She teams after investigation, nabbed the accused **Avula Janaiah,S/o.Lingaiah,27 yrs, Occ:Un-employee, r/o.Nakrekal, Nalgonda Dist.**, handed over to Osmania University PS. **A case u/s 507,509 IPC was registered and the person was arrested.**

NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me under section 21(1) (b) of the Hyderabad City Police Act, I, M.Mahendar Reddy, IPS., Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad, do hereby notify, for information of the general public, that, In order to make arrangements for the early commencement of commercial operations of Hyderabad Metro Rail and for the speedy completion of preparatory works and to avoid inconvenience to the general public the following traffic diversions are made and will be in force for a period of 45 days from 3 -08-2017 midnight.

:-TRAFFIC DIVERSION:-

- 1) Vehicular traffic coming from Erragadda towards Ameerpet and Secunderabad will be diverted at Umesh Chandra Statue, SR Nagar towards, SR Nagar Law and Order P.S., SR Nagar T Junction, take right turn and proceed towards, Satyam Theatre and Durgamata Temple where traffic intending to go towards Begumpet and Secunderabad will take left turn and traffic intending to go towards Panjagutta and Maitrivanam will take right turn and merge with regular traffic at Ameerpet junction.
- 2) The entire stretch of road from Umesh Chandra Statue to Ameerpet Junction via, SR Nagar T Junction, Satyam Theatre, Durga Maatha Temple is made one way and no vehicular

traffic shall be allowed in the opposite direction. i.e., No entry for vehicles from Durga Matha Temple towards SR Nagar T Junction and from there to Umesh Chandra Statue.

3) Vehicular traffic coming from Fatehnagar towards Ameerpet will not be allowed towards Satyam Theatre and will be diverted at R&B Office, Balkampet Road via DK Road, GHMC playground.

4) Vehicular Traffic (Light Motor Vehicles, Autos and two wheelers only) coming from Erragadda intending to go to Madhura Nagar and Kalyan Nagar can take right turn at Umesh Chandra Statue and Heavy vehicles will have to take the route via., SR Nagar T Junction, Durga Matha Temple and Ameerpet Junction.

5) The stretch between GHMC playground, Ameerpet to Sonabai temple, being a narrow road, made one way and no vehicle shall be allowed towards Sonabai Temple to avoid obstruction to Begumpet and Secunderabad bound traffic.

6) Vehicular traffic coming from Begumpet for SR Nagar, Yousufguda etc will not allowed towards Satyam Theatre and will be diverted at Durga Matha Temple, Ameerpet towards Ameerpet Junction and merge with the regular traffic towards Maitrivanam Junction.

7) All the by lanes joining to the road from Umesh Chandra Statue to SR Nagar T Junction will be closed except at SR Nagar Community Hall Junction to facilitate free movement of vehicles.

8) There will be no change in the flow of traffic which comes from Ameerpet Junction towards Maitrivanam and SR Nagar and runs as usual.

The above traffic restrictions will be in force for a period of 45 days from the date of the issue of this Notification and the people are requested to take alternate routes and cooperate with the Traffic Police to ensure smooth flow of traffic.

LAKE POLICE RESCUED TWO PERSONS FROM COMMITTING SUICIDE

On 02 of August 2017, P S Lake officials has rescued **two persons** i.e., two female, their particulars are 1) Smt. U. Vijaya and 2) Kum. J. Shirisha were all rescued, while they were about to commit suicide by jumping into the Hussain Sagar Lake. The Details of the victims are as follows:-

First incident: Occurred on 02/08/2017 at 05.10 hours tried to Jump into water at upper tank bund near LOVE HYD.

Details of Victim: Smt. U. Vijaya w/o U. Rama krishna, age:- 35 years, Occ:- Maid servant, r/o:- near officers quarters, tirumalgi, hyd.

Reason: On causing enquiry it came to know that the victim is a married person and blessed with three children and leading conjugal life happily. her husband is a alcoholic and quarrels regularly with the victim. As usually last night he went to home in a fully drunken condition and started quarrelled with the victim, there he abused victim in a most filthy language. She unable the torture and decided to end her life by jumping into the Hussain sagar lake water and came to upper tankbund near LOVE HYD and tried. Immediately our patrolling Lake police noticed victim and saved her life. SHO Lake police station, Sri. T. Ch. Babu counselled both the wife and husband. After counselling handed over to her husband.

Second incident: Occurred on 02/08/2017 at 16.20 hours tried to Jump into water at upper tank bund near Lepakshi.

Details of Victim: Kum. J. Sirisha d/o Sri. J. Satyanarayana, age:- 20 years, Occ:- pvt employee, r/o:- near bomalamma temple, bakarm, musheerabad, hyderabad.

Reason: On causing enquiry it came to know that the victim quarrelled with her elder brother in a petty matter due to which she went into depression and planned to end her life by jumping into water. Immediately our patrolling Lake police noticed her and saved her life. SHO Lake police station, Sri. T. Ch. babu counselled victim and handed over to her family.

As such Lake Police played a vital role in saving them spontaneously without giving any scope for untoward incidents for which they could saved the lives of people viz.,. 1) Smt. U. Vijaya and 2) Kum. J. Shirisha these two incidents were occurred on 02-08-2017 SHO Lake police station, Sri. T. Ch. Babu, had counselled them promptly and they were safely handed over to their concerned by taking assurance that they will not repeat such thing in nearby future.

Thus, the patrolling Blue Colts of Lake PS viz., Sri. U. Sai kiran, PC 1797, Sri. Md. Shareef, PC 7867 and Sri. Subba reddy, HG 5348 have tactfully identified the above persons in a suspicious manner and rescued them from committing suicide which was done under the supervision of SHO Lake police station, Sri. T. Ch. Babu.
