

**THE INTERSTATE GANG OF JOB FRAUDSTERS RACKET BUSTED,
COLLECTED CRORES OF RUPEES FROM UN-EMPLOYED YOUTH FOR
PROVIDING JOBS IN RAILWAY DEPARTMENT, REVENUE DEPARTMENT
AND OTHER DEPARTMENTS - HELD (08) PERSONS AND SEIZED NET CASH
OF RUPEES (24.1) LAKHS & FAKE APPOINTMENT ORDERS ETC.,**

On credible information, on 02-08-2018 Commissioner's Task Force, Central and West Zone Teams, apprehended two gangs consisted (08) persons (in which two Vardhanapu Gangadhar and Pitla Dathadri belongs to other states) who indulged in cheating the innocent unemployed youth, acting as Job providers in various departments of Central and State Government sectors such as Railway, Revenue, Education Departments etc. and cheated about 100 to 150 youths by collecting huge amounts from them for providing jobs in Railway Department as "Ticket Collector", "Commercial Clerk" & "Point Men" Revenue Department as "Junior Assistant", Education Department as "Junior Assistant" & "Attender" and issued fake appointment orders, training letters, emails and seized net cash of Rs.(24.1) Lakhs, Fake Appointment orders & Fake Identity cards etc.

MODUS OPERANDI:-

The Modus Operandi of the job fraudsters is that they all formed into a gang and started cheating the unemployed youth through their known friends and relatives with a promise to provide jobs as “Ticket Collector, Commercial Clerk, Point Men and Attender” in Railway Department, “Junior Assistant, clerks and Attenders” in Revenue, Education, Secretariat, High Court, TSTRANSCO, GHMC and various other Government sectors and demands Rs.10 Lakhs to Rs.25 Lakhs and taken advance Rs.1 to 10 Lakhs from each candidate. After taking the amount from the candidates they will send fake SMS’s, email and call letters to the candidates on their phones, e-mails and ask the candidates to come to their respective departments and show them that they are going to be working in the same office and collect the amount in the same premises. After issuing appointment letters to drag the time they conduct training classes at Durgapur, Asansol of West Bengal State and Khurda of Orissa State. After that they issue TC dress to the selected Candidates and keep them at Railway Station Secunderabad and paid one month salary to them.

The main head of the Gang Pitla Dathadri @ Badri formed a gang with sub brokers Y.Veeresham, M.Kranthi Kumar, M.Srikanth and Aerukonda Swamy @ Swamy and M.Shiva Reddy @ Venkat formed a gang with sub broker K.Rajesh. The sub brokers bring the Jobless aspirants to main brokers and used to get their commission over each candidate. All the accused persons hatched a plan to cheat the Jobless candidates on huge amounts on false promise to provide Jobs in Government Sectors. Once the candidates approach, they introduces and possess themselves as a Local political leaders with high influence in various Government departments and assure them that they will provide Jobs to the candidates even without appearing any examinations under Special Departmental Quota/Ministers Quota/Deceased Quota etc and used to collect their resume and original certificates and used to take an advance of Rs.1 to 10 Lakhs from each candidate.

After collecting their certificates the main brokers sends the candidates details to accused Vardhanapu Gangadhar, who is hardware engineer for creating fake appointment letters, ID cards and fake Certificates etc. After preparing the same the accused Gangadhar used to send fake emails by creating fake Gmail accounts on the names of respective Departments and send the appointment letters, offer letters, Training Letters and ID Cards etc. to main brokers. After collecting fake ID cards and other relevant documents the main brokers used to send the same to the candidates through sub brokers. Later the accused persons bring the candidates for conducting medical tests and done the same to them though one Shyam, R/o Balaji Nagar, Kapra, Hyderabad and also he given fitness certificates to them. Later the accused persons bring the candidates to Vijayawada for conducting interviews through one Shankar, R/o Vijayawada. After conducting medical tests and interview the accused persons to drag the process they send the innocent persons to Calcutta, Delhi and Orissa for training purpose.

The accused M.Shiva Reddy @ Venkat also created one fake website "RRC (Railway Recruitment Cell) with the help of accused P.Padma Reddy, R/o Vanasthalipuram, Hyderabad for candidates and informed them that within 15 to 20 days the permanent offer letters come to their permanent addresses. Later the accused persons used to change their phone numbers to avoid calls of candidates.

Like this the accused persons will cheat the unemployed youth by taking Rupees Rs.1 to 10 Lakhs from each candidate. So far, they cheated about 100-150 candidates in the name of providing jobs to them in Railways, Revenue, Education, Secretariat, High Court, TSTRANSCO, GHMC and various other Government Departments as Ticket Collector, Commercial Clerk, Point Men, Junior Assistant, and Attenders. The accused spend the amount lavishly.

Nabbing the above gang by Commissioner's Task Force, Central Zone and West Zone Team in time has saved so many other unemployed youth, otherwise these gang will cheat, some more youth in the guise of providing jobs in Railways, Revenue, Education, Secretariat, High Court, TSTRANSCO, GHMC.

So far, (10) cases were registered against the accused persons in various Police Stations of Hyderabad City in which (01) case in SR Nagar PS, (01) case in Market PS, (01) case in Chilkalguda PS, (01) case in Panjagutta PS, (02) cases in Saifabad P.S, (01) case in Chikkadapally, (01) case in Gopalapuram PS, (01) case in Gachibowli P.S, of Cyberabad and (01) case in Pendurthy PS of Visakapatnam City, AP.

The apprehended (08) accused persons along with seized property being handed over to SHO, SR Nagar PS and SHO, Saifabad PS for taking necessary action.

APPEAL TO THE PUBLIC:

Please do not believe the version of any mediator/agents who make false promises of providing employment for money through backdoor in Indian Railways, State Bank of India, Income Tax Department, Road and Building Department and in Software Jobs in Multi National Companies and you have to confirm from the concerned Competent Authorities or head of the department, while giving any amount to the cheaters. You may please inform the same to Police to take stringent action against those deceivers. The names of the people giving information about the cheaters/deceivers will be kept confidential.

Mohammed Saleem @ Sunil Shetty @ Ibrahim @ Setty Saleem S/o Mohammed Jahangir, aged about 44 years, Occ: Auto Driver, R/o H.No.7-171/14/3, Errakunta, Balapur, Ranga Reddy district, has been committing burglaries by targeting the locked houses in the limits of Hyderabad and Rachakonda Police Commissionerates to make easy money to lead lavish life, thereby adversely affecting the public order.

He was earlier involved in **14** offences **of Burglaries** in limits of Hyderabad and Rachakonda Police Commissionerates and has been creating fear and panic among the general public by committing such offences in public places and thus he has been acting in a manner prejudicial to the maintenance of public order apart from disturbing the peace, tranquillity and social harmony in the society.

Police made efforts and arrested Mohammed Saleem @ Sunil Shetty @ Ibrahim @ Setty Saleem on 27.04.2018 in Cr.No.20/2018 U/s 454, 380 IPC of Kanchanbagh PS and remanded to Judicial Custody. The Detention Order was executed on him on 29.7.2018, and lodged in Central Prison, Chanchalguda, Hyderabad
