**FOUR LAB. TECHNICIANS OF GANDHI HOSPITAL, SECUNDERABAD HELD FOR HARASSING THE TRAINEES**

**Facts of the case**

The accused persons A-1 to A-4 are the employees of Gandhi Hospital, Secunderabad and working as Lab. Technicians. The Trainees deputed for the Lab. Training have submitted a representation to the Superintendent, Gandhi Hospital, Secunderabad in the month of August, 2017 leveling allegations of sexual harassment by the Lab. Technicians. On that an Enquiry Committee has been constituted with the Professors and HOD of Gandhi Hospital, Secunderabad for causing enquiry into the allegations and accordingly after causing enquiry they have submitted a report in the month of September finding the harassment being meted out to the Trainees at the hands of the Lab. Technicians to be true.

On 01.12.2017 on a specific complaint of Trainee, a case in Cr.No. 744/2017 u/s 354, 354-A, 354-D, 506, 509 r/w 34 IPC has been registered in Chilkaiguda P.S. and investigation taken up by Sri. K. Srinivasulu, Inspector of Police, Chilkaiguda P.S. with the assistance of Smt. P. Janakamma, Inspector of Police, WPS, Begumpet.

During the course of investigation the Police has examined as many as 14-witnesses and established prima facie case against the accused employees of Gandhi Hospital, Secunderabad.

All the accused persons have been arrested on 02.12.2017 and being produced in the Honourable Court for judicial remand.

The arrest was effected by Sri. K. Srinivasulu, Inspector of Police, Chilkaiguda P.S. under direct supervision of Sri. K. Srinivasa Rao, Asst. Commissioner of Police, Gopalpuram Divn. The good work done by the above officers has been rewarded suitably.
