**NOTIFICATION**

With a view to maintain public order, peace and tranquility in the twin cities of Hyderabad and Secunderabad, I, V.V. Srinivasa Rao, IPS, Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad City, in exercise of the powers vested in me under section 22(1) (a) to (f) and 22 (2) (a) and (b) of Hyderabad City Police Act, 1348 Fasli (No.IX), do hereby issue the following prohibitory orders.

- I Prohibit to hold any kind of public meetings, and processions within the Hyderabad City, without obtaining prior permission of Zonal Dy. Commissioners of Police, Law and Order concerned, Addl. Commissioner of Police, Law and Order or Jt. Commissioner of Police, Co-ordination & Security or Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad.
  - a) Prohibit carrying of arms such as swords, spears, knives, sticks with or without flags bludgeons, guns, explosives, and other offensive weapons in the above mentioned areas.
  - b) Prohibit gathering of persons on the public roads or public places disturbing peace and order or causing inconvenience, annoyance or danger to public.
  - c) Prohibit collection, carrying of stones or other means of casting missiles.
- II Prohibit use of mikes/public address system by different Organisations around the Secretariat premises, including Burgula Rama Krishna Rao Building, Greater Hyderabad Municipal Corporation Building, Commissioner of Fisheries building, Mint Compound, Nizam College and its surroundings, Telangana Legislative Assembly premises and surrounding roads, Public Garden Nampally, Upper Tankbund, I-MAX, Rotary and NTR Marg roads also fly-over road leading from Secretariat to Visweswarayya statue, Khairatabad.
  - a) Prohibit music, singing or speeches or broadcasting through loud speakers in the above mentioned areas.
  - b) Prohibit use of mikes/public address systems, use of horn through vehicles by any organisation, members of public etc., in the above mentioned areas.
- III The public are here by informed that any person violating the above orders shall be liable for prosecution under the Hyderabad City Police Act, 1348, Fasli (No. IX).
- IV **The following are exempted from the operation of this order**
  - (i) Police Officers on duty,
  - (ii) Military personnel on duty,
  - (iii) Home Guards on duty,
  - (iv) Bonafide funeral processions.

This order shall be in force with effect from 0600 hours on 05-01-2018 to 0600 hours on 11-01-2018.

**NOTIFICATION**

WHEREAS, reports have been received indicating that consumption of liquor in public places has become rampant and unhindered in several areas of the City of Hyderabad, resulting in to a menace to the common members of the public, especially women and children in particular.

AND WHEREAS, such reports have been indicating that, persons consuming liquor in public places have been exhibiting abrasive unruly and indecent behavior on the streets of Hyderabad City towards law abiding citizens especially women and children in particular endangering their modesty and safety in addition to causing disturbance to public tranquility resulting in annoyance and obstruction to road users in general and women and children in particular.

WHEREAS, such unruly and indecent behavior has been instilling a sense of fear psychosis in law abiding citizens, especially women and children resulting in restriction of their free movement on the streets of Hyderabad, thereby affecting public safety at large and safety and security of women and children in particular.

AND WHEREAS, it is considered necessary to take speedy measures in this regard to prevent danger to human life and safety and security of women and children or for preventing any affray and disturbance of public tranquility.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me under Section 144 of Criminal Procedure Code 1973, I, V.V. Srinivasa Rao, IPS Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad City, do hereby make this written order and notify the same to the General Public **prohibiting Consumption of liquor in public places in the City of Hyderabad.**

This order is published for the information of public through the media and through the public address system in the areas affected with drunkenness in public places.

This order shall come into force from 0600 hours on 04-01-2018 and shall remain in force for a period of one week i.e. upto 0600 hours on 10-01-2018 (both days inclusive) unless withdrawn earlier.

Any person violating this order shall be liable for punishment under Section 188 of the Indian Penal code and as per the provisions of Hyderabad City Police Act, 1348 Fasli.

### ARREST OF ACCUSED PERSONS INVOLVED IN ATTEMPT TO MURDER CASE OF CHILKALGUDA POLICE STATION

#### Details of the accused

- A-1 G. Vinay Goud s/o G. Veera Swamy, 23-years, Unemployee r/o H.No. 11-2-500, Upper Basti, Namalagundu, Secunderabad (**Body builder**)
- A-2 G. Vikranth Goud s/o Veera Swamy, 24-years, Pvt. Employee r/o H.No. 11-2-500, Upper Basti, Namalagundu, Secunderabad
- A-3 A. Vinay Kumar s/o A. Ramakrishna, 25-years, Pvt. Employee r/o H.No. 12-11-218/A, Warasiguda, Secunderabad

On 14.03.2017 on a specific complaint of Sri. G. Naresh s/o G. Yellaiah, 28-years, Private Employee r/o H.No. 11-1-312, Datar Colony, Seetaphalmandi, Secunderabad, a case in Cr.No. 172/2017 u/s 324 IPC r/w 34 IPC has been registered in Chilkaiguda P.S. and investigation taken up by Sri. K. Rajesh, Sub-Inspector of Police, Chilkaiguda P.S. Initially, the case has been registered u/s 324 IPC r/w 34 IPC and subsequent on receipt of the medical certificate, the section of law has been altered to 307, 109 IPC r/w 34 IPC.

Facts of the case are that on 19.02.2017 at about 2330 hrs. while the complainant Sri. G. Naresh was going on his two wheeler bearing No. AP 10 AM 8572 (Activa) to H.P. Petrol Bunk situated at Chilkaiguda for getting fuel, on approaching near Famous Pan Shop accidentally he slightly dashed the two wheeler of an unknown person who was standing there, on that the complainant stopped his two wheeler and apologized with him. Even though the unknown person demanded him to pay an amount of Rs. 1,000/- on the plea of damaging his vehicle and when the complainant expressed his inability to pay the cash, he picked up quarrel with him and in the meantime two more unknown persons came there and they all assaulted the complainant with first blows causing internal injuries on his jaws and ribs.

The complainant sustained fracture injuries on his lower jaw and severe blunt injuries on his ribs and was hospitalized for a period of 15-days as in-patient and after his discharge he reported to the Chilkaiguda Police which delayed the registration of case.

- During the course of investigation based on the descriptive particulars furnished by the complainant, as many as 32-persons were brought to the Police Station and their complicity has been verified.
- Based on the vehicles used, about 12-two wheelers with their owners were brought to the Police Stations and their complicity has been verified.
- Local Nenu Saitham cameras could not be caught the unknown offenders,
- Decoy parties were sent and the identity of the accused persons has been established.
- The I.O. has established the identity of the accused persons by adopting techniques and the accused persons A-1 to A-3 have been arrested on 03.01.2018 at 0800 hrs. at their residence and they are being produced in the Court for judicial remand.
- At the instance and from the possession of the accused persons the I.O. has seized Hero Honda Splendor Plus bearing No. AP 29 AH 9538 and Hero Honda Passion Pro bearing No. AP 09 BU 8526 including two Cell Phones.

#### Background of the arrested accused

A-1 and A-2 are own brothers while A-3 is the friend of A-2. They all are residing in the locality of Namalagundu, Seethaphalmandi, Secunderabad. A-1 is a chain smoker and used to loiter at Famous Pan Shop, Chilkaiguda which is identified as a Hotspot of Chilkaiguda Police Station. On the fateful night of 19.02.2017 A-1 was standing at the Famous Pan Shop and smoking cigarette by keeping his two wheeler on the road and in the meantime the complainant happened to pass through that way and accidentally his two wheeler hit the two wheeler of the accused, on that he picked up quarrel and called A-2 and A-3 on phone and they all assaulted the complainant

causing severe internal injuries on his face and ribs as a result of which his lower jaw was fractured and blunt injuries on his ribs and caused panic and terror in the area.

Any disturbance in law and order or creating panic, resorting to create brawl, fighting, rowdism will not be tolerated in the Hyderabad City (North Zone).

The arrest was effected by Sri. K. Rajesh, Sub-Inspector of Police, under the direct supervision of Sri. K. Srinivasulu, Inspector of Police, Chilkaiguda P.S. and Sri. K. Srinivasa Rao, Asst. Commissioner of Police, Gopalpuram Divn. The good work done by the above officers has been rewarded suitably.

### **ARREST OF ACCUSED PERSONS INVOLVED IN TSRTC BUS BURNING CASE OF CHILKALGUDA POLICE STATION**

#### **Details of the accused**

- A-1 Govinda Naresh s/o Babu (Late), 29-years, SC-Madiga, Ph.D. Student at Osmania University c/o Room No. 77, NRS Hostel, Osmania University, Hyderabad Native of H.No. 1-9-1583, Deendayal Nagar, Hunger Road, Hanumakonda, Warangal
- A-2 Bejjanki Anil s/o Bejjanki Yellaiah, 29-years, LLB Final year Student, MSSS College, Chaderghat X Roads, Kachiguda, Hyderabad c/o Room No. 14, SC Boys Hostel, Kachiguda, Hyderabad Native of H.No. 1-87, Ryalapally village, Gangadhar Mandal, Karim Nagar

On 21.12.2017 at 1430 hrs. on receipt of a specific complaint from Sri. Akantha Krishna (57), RTC Bus Driver Staff No. 203731 r/o H.No. 9-1-6, Champapet, Hyderabad, a case in Cr.No. 772/2017 u/s 143, 147, 435 IPC r/w 149 IPC and Sec. 3 and 4 of PDPP Act and Sec. 7 of Criminal Law Amendment Act, 1932 has been registered at Chilkaiguda P.S. and investigation taken up by Sri. T. Sudhakar, Sub-Inspector of Police, Chilkaiguda P.S.

Facts of the case are that on 21.12.2017 at about 1330 hrs. after completion of duty, the complainant Sri. Akantha Krishna, Driver of TSRTC Bus bearing No. AP 28 Z 130 of Musheerabad Depot Route No. 86-J (From Secunderabad to Jiyaguda) parked the vehicle on the road opposite to Jamia Osmania Railway Station for change over and went to have a cup of tea. In the meanwhile two unknown offenders having college bag wearing Jeans pant and casual shirts boarded the stationed bus and got down within few minutes after settling ablaze the seats in the bus by pouring kerosene and absconded.

- During the course of investigation based on the descriptive particulars furnished by the complainant, as many as 06-suspected persons were brought to the Police Station and their complicity has been verified.
- Local Nenu Saitham cameras could not be caught the unknown offenders,
- Decoy parties were sent to all probable places to locate and establish the identity of the accused persons.
- The I.O. has established the identity of the accused persons by adopting techniques and the accused persons A-1 and A-2 have been arrested on 03.01.2018 at 0800 hrs. at Seethaphalmandi Cross Roads and they are being produced in the Court for judicial remand.
- Interrogation of the accused revealed that they did the mischief in protest of the arrest of their Leader Sri. Manda Krishna Madiga and others by the Police and demanding their release.

#### **Background of the arrested accused**

A-1 and A-2 are the students of Osmania University. A-1 is the State President of Madiga Students Federation while A-2 is the State Committee Member of Madiga Students Federation.

**INAUGURATION OF TECHNOLOGY FUSION CENTER AT  
HYDERABAD CITY POLICE COMMISSIONERATE**

Hyderabad City Police launches its first-of-its-kind Technology Fusion Center at Hyderabad Police Commissionerate, an access to a wide variety of structured and unstructured data from various sources such as

- merging information from detection of crime and criminal data,
- incidents from Dial-100 & Hawk-eye,
- road accidents,
- city-wide surveillance cameras,
- patrol vehicles tracking data,
- investigation analysis,
- traffic enforcement data, and
- social media platforms

to improve response times through aggregation, analysis, and dissemination of actionable information to the field officers. It is a collaborative effort of multiple agencies that provide resources, expertise, and information with the goal of maximizing their ability to detect, prevent, investigate and respond to any crime incidents and threat activities.

The Technology Fusion Center consists of several functional blocks that provide essential technology solutions towards protecting communities and enhancing public safety, including:

- Video Surveillance Security Command Center
- Traffic Command Center
- Facial Recognition Analytics and Video Enhancement Unit
- Emergency Response Unit (Dial-100/112)
- Social Monitoring Unit
- Traffic Signal Management Unit
- Traffic Enforcement Unit

The Analysts at Fusion Center use the necessary and available analytics tools to identify patterns, relationships, and correlations in large volumes of information from multiple sources such as crime incidents, road accidents, social media etc. The Analysts collate meaningful information and actionable intelligence to assist with accurate and timely analysis to feed the field officers. This actionable information and intelligence enables police officers and other multi-agency officers to make sound decisions on the spot regarding incident situations, emerging threats, traffic congestions etc., and they can more effectively and efficiently carry out their duties and responsibilities. It provides not just intelligence, but also technology that proffers quicker access to information, shared with one another and it can be utilized to streamline the operations and efficiencies to contribute towards building safer communities.

A video surveillance command center receives video camera signals from multiple systems implemented across the city. It helps the operators at the command center in being oriented to the situation and evaluates any threats, crime incidents, or road accidents that need immediate attention. The operator continuously monitors alarms and events for any critical incidents and ensures that the system initiates the alarms to the patrol officers who are nearest to the incident locations for immediate action. The objective of video enhancement is to sharpen the video images, remove video noise by preserving the video evidence integrity and enriching pixel quality for identification and enhancement of the video images.

The function of traffic command center is to real-time monitoring and control of traffic flows, traffic signals, traffic video surveillance, and traffic violation detection; alarm reception and handling; analysis of traffic conditions based on the traffic flow information; and aid decision-making for various traffic violations and accidents.

The objective of video enhancement is to sharpen the video images, remove video noise by preserving the video evidence integrity and pixel quality for identification and enrichment of the video images.

The emergency response management is a systematic, proactive approach to disaster and incident preparation, prevention, response, recovery and mitigation to assist the field officers who respond to incidents or events and it also serves as the coordination hub for an incident response. It consists of initial incident dispatch, incident analysis, assessment of risk and vulnerabilities, and dissemination of meaningful information and an actionable intelligence for decision makers and first responders to respond to an incident for quick resolution.

Social media has grown exponentially in the last few years to become an integral part of the community and it is incredibly influential and has the power to radically impact the public perception. The social media tools help in analyzing information from publically available social media posts, tweets, and social media conversations that could be a threat. These tools have the ability to provide an early warning of possible problematic situations, sentiment analysis using taxonomy, geo-location pattern analysis etc., and disseminate the critical information to the field officers for timely responsiveness.

The Technology Fusion Centre is inaugurated by Sri M.Mahendar Reddy, IPS, Director General of Police, Telangana State in the presence of Sri V.V.Srinivasa Rao IPS, Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad City, Sri T.Murali Krishna IPS, Addl.Commissioner of Police (Admn.), Smt Swathi Lakra IPS, Addl.Commissioner (Crimes), Sri M.Shiva Prasad IPS, Addl.Commissioner (Hqrs) & Sri V.Ravinder, Jt.CP (Traffic) Hyderabad. **APPREHENDED (03) OFFENDERS FOR ASSUALT & EXTORTION OF CASH FROM THE CONDUCTOR OF RTC BUS, BY THE CRIME TEAM OF ABID ROAD P.S, HYDERABAD.**

The crime team of Abid Road Police Station apprehended the three accused persons who were assaulted the RTC Bus Driver and conductor and extorted cash of Rs 9,496/- from the RTC bus conductor, on 28-12-2017 at 0515hrs at Law College, Basheer Bagh, on verifying the C.C. footage, the three accused persons were arrested.

**ACCUSED DETAILS:**

**A-1:** Mohd Sarfaraz Uddin Khan @ Doctor S/o Late Mohd Siddiq Uddin Khan, Age: 32 years, Occ: Second Hand two wheeler vehicles business at Ramkote in front of Grand Motors R/o 3-5-782/52/1/E/1, Niyath Khana, Pardha Gate, King Kothi, Abids, Hyderabad.

**A-2:** Mohammed Muqtadar @ Muttu S/o Mohammed Moinuddin, Age: 28 years, Occ: Carpenter and Furniture work at Zirra C/o Near Kameli Ki Masjid, Yakuthpura, Rein Bazar P.S.R/o H.No. 11-1-1115, back side of Ghatala Mosque, Mallepally, Hyderabad.

**A-3:** Shabbar Hussain @ Syed Shabbar S/o Mohammed Asghar Hussain , Age: 23 years, Occ: Un Employee and presently learning CCNA Computer Net working course R/o 13-6-434/A/213/A, Sardhar Bagh, Lungar House, Mehdiapatnam Ring Road, Hyderabad.

**Brief Facts**

This is case of obstruction of duties of the RTC Bus Driver & Conductor, by three accused persons who came in Verna Car and by keeping them in fear of threat, extorted an amount of Rs. 9496/- of tickets fare from the conductor and also bet the driver with hands on his face and body, which occurred on 28-12-2017 at 05.15 hours near Nizam Law College, Basheerbagh, Hyderabad.

The above three accused persons were arrested on 02-01-2018 at 1930 hrs and recovered the stolen cash and seized the Verna Car AP 26P9359 which was used in the commission of offence.

The Abids police installed more than 122 CC Cameras in the limits of Abids P.S under Community CCTV Project and by verifying the sequels of the CC cameras more than 200 CC Cameras from Abid Road P.S. to Jubilee Hills P.S and also in Cyberabad limits, the registration number of the Verna Car AP 26P9359 which was used in the commission was identified, through which the accused persons were caught at King Koti, Hyderabad and the car which was used in the commission of offence is recovered.

The superior officers appreciated the good work done by Abids Police.

The above case was investigated and the accused was apprehended by Sri. N. Mohan Rao, Detective. Inspector of Police, Sri. K.Laxmaiah, SI along with the Crime staff of P.S.
