

**CRICKET BETTING BUSTED – APPREHENDED TWO PERSONS
& SEIZED (1) T.V, (1) LAPTOP, (8) CELL PHONES AND NET
CASH OF RS.2,00,000/-.**

On 02-02-2018 the sleuths of Commissioner's Task Force, West Zone Team, Hyderabad, generated actionable information after making sustained efforts and apprehended two cricket betting organizers by name 1) Rajesh Singh & 2) Lal Chand Agarwal, while they were accepting cricket betting in the limits of Asif Nagar Police Station from the known and unknown punters directly and indirectly i.e., over cell phones. **Seized (1) T.V., (1) Set up box, (1) Remote, (1) Laptop, (1) Calculator (1) Book which was used to write Cricket betting amounts, (2) Pens, (1) Calculator, (1) Line phone, (7) Cell Phones and net cash of Rs.2,00,000/-.**

Details of the Accused:

1. Rajesh Singh S/o Late Jag Mohan, aged 53 yrs, Occ: Cricket betting organizer, R/o H.No.12-1-347, Dattu nagar, Asif nagar, Hyderabad.
2. Lal Chand Agarwal S/o Shambu Dayal, aged 58yrs, Occ: Cricket betting sub-organizer, R/o H.No.4-6-90/6/3, Tejaswi colony, Attapur, Mehdiapatnam, Hyderabad.

The accused persons Rajesh Singh and Lal Chand Agarwal hatched a plan to organize Cricket betting and to collect the betting amounts directly and indirectly i.e. through cell phones from the punters in Hyderabad. Since one year they are organizing Cricket betting. They are collecting and distributing the amounts of betting from nearly 25 to 30 punters in twin cities. On 02-02-2018 the said accused persons are running Cricket betting in an organized manner at **premises No.12-1-347, Dattu Nagar, Asif Nagar, Hyderabad** and accepting Cricket betting amount directly and indirectly i.e. over cell phones from them by watching in T.V. and Laptop on ongoing Big Bash League Cricket Match in between Adelaide Strikers Vs Melbourne Renegades teams playing in playing at Adelaide, Australia on 02-02-2018.

The apprehended accused persons along with seized property were handed over to the SHO, Asif Nagar PS, Hyderabad for further action.

As per the instructions of SHO Trimulgherry, while conducting vehicle checking, Police Trimulgherry apprehended a group of House burglary offenders who were involved in three House burglary offences in and around Trimulgherry border localities, near Nagmandir, Lalbazar on 02-02-2018.

A school dropout, he involved in a murder case in the year 2013, subsequently he involved in several property offences in Trimulgherry and its bordering Police Stations. **In Cr.No. 77/2016 U/s. 457,380 IPC of PS Trimulgherry PS, sentenced Jail for a period of one and half year w.e.f. 24-06-2016 to 08-01-2018,** he was released from Chachalguda Central Prison on 09-01-2018. He again started similar offences by forming a gang with his cousins said above.

Somesh (Name Changed) is a relative of Gajula Yogender who motivated him to earn easy money by committing burglaries. He is young and potential. He had involved in 1 case earlier in Cr.No. 603/2017 U/s. 457,380 IPC of PS Jawahar Nagar. He was kept in a Juvenile home for his good behavior in the year 2017 and released from Juvenile home.

History of BJ-2 Ramesh (Name Changed) aged about 16 years:

Ramesh (Name Changed) is a brother of Gajula Yogender. He is young and potential previously involved in petty offences. He is a close associate of A-1& BJ-1

Modus Operandi:

The accused persons are addicted to bad vices like consuming alcohol, toddy and smoking cigarettes etc. As their earning was not sufficient to meet their lavish expenses, they first rekey the locked houses by Juveniles, and commits house burglaries by break opening the locks and commit theft of Gold and Silver ornaments. Then they sped on Honda Activa Vehicle. By selling them at a thrown away price in the market, they used to spend the sales proceeds for their lavish expenditure.

Investigation carried out with them detected one grave case and two non grave cases and recovered stolen property **all worth Rs. 7,00,000/- (Seven Lakhs)**

The above arrests are effected by Trimulgherry Police led by Inspector Sri. R. Rajeshwar Rao, SI P. Rama Raju and his Crime team under direct supervision of Sri S. Ranga Rao, Asst. Commissioner of Police, Begumpet Division, and they will be rewarded suitably.

PRESS NOTE

The Bowenpally Police arrested the accused persons 1.Smt Jonnagari Aruna Reddy 2. Srinivas, 3. Chenna madhavuni Karunakar 4. N.J. Seetharam and 5 M.Surender who are involved in cheating and forgery, the documents and tried to grab the house bearing No. 12-11-152/1/A, situated at Namalgundu, Secunderabad which belongs to the complainant Smt Swarajya laxmi.

On 08.07.2017 at 18:00 hours received a complaint from Sri Abdul Saleem, Sub-Registrar, Marredpally in which he stated that one Smt. Annam Swarajya Lakshmi W/o Late Kondaragunta Koteswara Rao R/o Thumkunta, Ranga reddy District has complained that a fake transaction on her house property bearing H.No. 12-11-152/1 and 12-11-152/1/A, situated at Namalgundu, Secunderabad was taken place through a registered Document No. 2669 of 2014, in his office and requested to stop any further transaction informing that she is very much alive and she has (3) children and her husband K. Koteswara Rao has expired on 11-10-2004 and produced copies of her Aadhar card and death certificate of her husband Kondragunta Koteswara Rao S/o Yellamanda issued by the Registrar of the Births and deaths, MCH Dated: 13.10.2004 on 28-03-2017 with a request to take necessary action against the false personating with another person. On the strength of the above complaint registered a case in Cr.No. 214/2017 U/s 419, 420, 467, 468, 471 r/w 34 IPC and taken up the investigation.

In this case the Bowenpally police make sincere efforts and arrested the A-1 Smt Jonnagari Aruna Reddy on 16-12-2017, A-3 and A-4 Karunakar and N.J. Seetharam on 7-12-2017 and A-2 Srinivas and A-7 Surender on 1-2-2018 and remanded to judicial custody. The prime accused J. Aruna Reddy is involved in 9 cheating cases of Hyderabad city and other districts, the A-3 Karunakar is involved in 3 cheating cases and A-4 Seetharam is involved in one cheating case of Chilkaiguda PS.

The accused persons are the real estate brokers and used to collect the Xerox copies of the properties and creates same fake documents by forging the signatures and writings and used to get a prosperous party, shown the documents and believe them as genuine and sell the property by cheating. In the same passion the accused persons collected the certified copies of document No. 1421 of 1976 from SRO Marredpally with regard to the complainant's house and created fake death certificate of her where she is very much alive, and also prepared fake legal heir certificate of her

husband who is already demised, produced him in Sub Registrar office by impersonation and got registered sale deed in favour of one Aruna w/o Praveen Bank manager for Rs 1.25 crores and duped them with the connivance of Sub Registrar.

In this case some of the accused persons are still absconding. Efforts are being continued to arrest them.

The case are being investigated by Sri E.Raghuveer Reddy, Sub. Inspector of Police, Bowenpally P.S. under the supervision of Sri P.Vijaykumar, Inspector of Police, Bowenpally and able guidance of Sri Ranga Rao, ACP Begumpet Divn.

ACTIVE SERVANT THEFT OFFENDER APPREHENDED BY BEGUMPET POLICE

FACTS OF THE CASE:

The accused started working as Cook at Complainant house at Welkin Apartment, Prakash Nagar, Begumpet through his friend Sudhir paswan. On 29.01.2018 at morning hour's complainant and his wife went outside. In the mean time A1 entered into the complainant's father's dressing room and committed theft of Gold Ornaments from the almarah cupboard and fled away. At that time the A2 Parshuram Uddav Taksande was watching the movement of complainant's father and mother. The A2 knowing with an intention gave false information to the owner about disappearance of A1: Shivanath Mukhiya. Later registered a case in Cr.No. 34/2018 u/s 381 IPC of Begumpet and took up the investigation.

MODUS OPERANDI:

The accused A1 joined as a maid servant in the house owners through the known persons and after few days commits offences and fled away.

PREVIOUS HISTORY:

The accused person A1 had worked as cook at Banjara Hills area and was arrested by Banjara Hills PS on 01.07.2014 and released on Bail. Later he worked as cook at Balkampet area and was arrested by Sanjeeva Reddy Nagar PS on 25.04.2016 and Released on Bail on 3.06.2016 and Since 2014 he is being Committing Offences.

Shivanath Mukhiya has been habitually committing offences, against properties and his activities are prejudicial to the maintenance of public order. He commits unlawful acts and cause insecurity among the general public in areas of Hyderabad City and creating alarm by his activities. A1 was involved in the following cases.

BROTHEL HOUSE BUSTED AT WEST MARREDPALLY - 06 HELD

Konda Ramesh Reddy, 2)Shamanna Chidananda, 3)Mohd.Faizal Khan, one pimp Addapaka Kalayani, two customers and also rescued one victim. **Seized net cash of Rs. 32,330/-, 05 Condoms packets, 06 mobile phone**, from the possession of brothel organizers.

➤ **BRIEF FACTS OF THE CASE:**

The accused Konda Ramesh Reddy @ Ramesh is native of Kurnool, AP State and prime accused of the brothel case. He is running Garments sales business at Kurnool town and cause huge loss of money in this business. To gain easy money in illegal way to overcome his financial problems planed to organize a brothel house at Hyderabad by procure female sex workers for sexual exploitation through traffickers.

Accordingly the accused came into ontact with brothel sub-organizers by name Shamanna Chidananda N/o. Kenkerepalya (village), Ram nagar Dist, Karnataka State, & Mohd.Faizal Khan N/o. near Manga Nagar, UP School, Kasarkode Dist, Kerala State and also engaged one pimp by name Addapaka Kalayani N/o. West Godavari Dist, A.P. Few months back the accused Konda Ramesh Reddy @ Ramesh took a portion on rental for Rs. 15,000/- per month in the residential are # Flat no.502, Gayatri Arcade Apartment, Street No.3, West Marredpally, Secunderabad and used the premises as brothel house. The organizers are use to engage sex workers through their known sources and pay an amount of Rs. 30,000/- per a week to each sex workers. The pimp is controls the prostitutes and arranges clients for them on commission basis. The organizers are collect an amount of Rs. 3,000/- to 4,0000/- from each client and gain easy profits illegally.

Last day the organizers have procured a lady from Pune, Maharashtra State and organizing prostitution with the lady in the said Flat no.502, Gayatri Arcade Apartment, Street No.3, West Marredpally, Secunderabad.

On 02-02-2018 in the night hours on tipoff information along with women PCs of Marredpally PS conducted raid at the brothel house # Flat no.502, Gayatri Arcade Apartment, Street No.3, West Marredpally, Secunderabad. and apprehended (03) Brothel organizers (01) Pimp (02) Customers & rescued one victim.

Seized amount of Rs. 32,330/-, 05 Condoms packets, 06 mobile phones from the possession of brothel organizers. The apprehended Brothel organizers, customers and rescued woman along with seized material handed over to SHO, Marredpally PS for further necessary legal action against them as per law. Vide Cr.No.22/2018, U/Sec. 370(A),(2) IPC and Sec. 3,4,5&7 of Immoral Traffic (Prevention) Act-1956.
