NOTIFICATION

WHEREAS, reports have been received indicating that High Volume Sound Emitting Systems including DJs (High Volume Sound Mixers) are being generating noise beyond permissible limits (day time 55 db(A) and night time 45 db(A) in Residential Areas, day time 65 db(A) and night time 55 db(A) in Commercial Areas) in places of public gatherings including Processions causing inconvenience, disturbance, nuisance, annoyance and Under Section 67(c) prohibit bursting of fire crackers on public places / public roads, public meetings and marriages to the residents of locality and public in general.

WHEREAS, such acts have been causing acute inconvenience and distress among the children, old aged persons, patients and students in particular pursuing their studies in the residential localities.

WHEREAS, such High Volume sounds generated at Public Meetings, Marriages and Processions have been neutralizing Police Communication Systems deployed in relation to bandobust duties, thereby adversely affecting the function of maintenance of Public Order and Tranquillity by Law Enforcement Agencies.

AND WHEREAS, it is considered expedient to take stringent and speedy measures to control the use of High Volume Sound Emitting Systems including DJs (High Volume Sound Mixers) in place of Public gatherings including processions in the residential localities.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred under Rule 8 of Noise Pollution (Regulation & Control) Rules 2000, I, Anjani Kumar, IPS Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad City, do hereby make this written order and notify the same to the General Public Prohibiting the following within Hyderabad City, except in cases specifically permitted by the Divisional Asst. Commissioners of Police of the concerned jurisdiction:

- Use of High Volume Sound Systems including DJs (High Volume Sound Mixers) emanating sound levels beyond permissible limits in places of Public Gatherings including Processions in the Residential Localities.
- Prohibit bursting of fire crackers at public places / public roads, public meetings and marriage function halls causing inconvenience to the residents of locality and public in general.

This order shall come into force from 0600 hrs on 05-04-2018 and shall remain in force for a period of 15 days i.e., upto 0600 hrs on 19-04-2018, both days inclusive unless withdrawn earlier.

Any person violating this order shall be liable for punishment u/s 67(c), 188 of IPC and u/s 76 of the Hyderabad City Police Act, 1348 Fasli.

NOTIFICATION

WHEREAS, reports have been received indicating that consumption of liquor in public places has become rampant and unhindered in several areas of the City of Hyderabad, resulting in to a menace to the common members of the public, especially women and children in particular.

AND WHEREAS, such reports have been indicating that, persons consuming liquor in public places have been exhibiting abrasive unruly and indecent behavior on the streets of Hyderabad City towards law abiding citizens especially women and children in particular endangering their modesty and safety in addition to causing disturbance to public tranquility resulting in annoyance and obstruction to road users in general and women and children in particular.

WHEREAS, such unruly and indecent behavior has been instilling a sense of fear psychosis in law abiding citizens, especially women and children resulting in restriction of their free movement on the streets of Hyderabad, thereby affecting public safety at large and safety and security of women and children in particular.

AND WHEREAS, it is considered necessary to take speedy measures in this regard to prevent danger to human life and safety and security of women and children or for preventing any affray and disturbance of public tranquility.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me under Section 144 of Criminal Procedure Code 1973, I, Anjani Kumar, IPS Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad City, do hereby make this written order and notify the same to the General Public **prohibiting Consumption of liquor in public places in the City of Hyderabad.**

This order is published for the information of public through the media and through the public address system in the areas affected with drunkenness in public places.

This order shall come into force from 0600 hours on 04-04-2018 and shall remain in force for a period of one week i.e. upto 0600 hours on 10-04-2018 (both days inclusive) unless withdrawn earlier.

Any person violating this order shall be liable for punishment under Section 188 of the Indian Penal code and as per the provisions of Hyderabad City Police Act, 1348 Fasli.

NOTIFICATION

WHEREAS, it has been brought to my notice that the Terrorist/Antisocial elements may organize attacks through Para Gliders, Remote Controlled Drones, Remote Controlled Micro Light Aircraft etc., and that there is an increasing trend by events organizers to use remote controlled drones for getting aerial views for live telecasts and photography of various events.

WHEREAS, inputs have been received by Intelligence agencies about the possibility of attacks by Terrorist/Antisocial elements by the use of Para-gliders, Remote Controlled Drones, Remote Controlled Micro-Light Aircraft, etc., and there is every likelihood of breach of peace and disturbance of Public tranquility and also there is grave danger to human life, health, safety and damage to public property on that account.

AND WHEREAS, it is necessary that reasonable checks are imposed on activities of such antisocial elements in the limits of Hyderabad City Police Commissionerate to prevent the attack through Remote Controlled Drones or through Para-Gliders or through Remotely Controlled Micro-Light Aircraft.

NOW THEREFORE, I, Anjani Kumar, IPS, Commissioner of Police and Executive Magistrate of Hyderabad City vide powers conferred upon me u/sec 144 of the Criminal Procedure Code 1973 (Act II of 1974), **do hereby order that no flying activities of Remotely Controlled Drones or Para-Gliders or Remotely Controlled Micro-Light Aircraft be allowed in the Jurisdiction of Hyderabad City Police Commissionerate limits without prior Police permission in writing.**

No Non-Government agency, organization or individual will be allowed to launch Unmanned Aerial Vehicle (UAV), Unmanned Aerial Survey (UAS) etc.

Government agencies and organizations should obtain appropriate clearance from local Police and Aviation authorities before launching any UAS/UAV for any purpose.

Any person contravening this order shall be punishable under section 188 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860.

This order shall remain in force from 08-04-2018 to 07-05-2018.

As the notice cannot be served individually to all concerned, the order is hereby passed ex-parte. It shall be published for the information of public, through press and by affixing copies on the Notice Boards of the Police Stations, Divisional ACsP, Zonal DCsP offices.

**CCS POLICE NABBED THE PRIME ACCUSED ANDOL
JAGADISWHWAR IN A CHEATING CASE WHO HAD RUN
UNREGISTERED CHITFUND BUSINESS AND DUPED MANY
PEOPLE.**

The complainant Mr. Bandari Ramachandraiah approached CCS police and lodged a complaint that he was duped by the accused Andol Jagadiswar who had run Private Chit business and siphoned the huge amount. The complainant used to subscribe various chits in the chits business of the accused but after completion of chits period, the accused has not paid the chit amounts to the tune of 2.7 crores by citing various personal and business exigencies and assured that he would definitely repay the same. On several requests, the accused with intention to cheat the complainant issued Bank cheques without having sufficient funds in his bank account and also issued cheques of closed accounts. All the cheques issued by the accused were dishonoured. Thus the accused cheated the complainant and others. Upon which a case is registered in Crime No. 01/2018 of CCS, Hyd.

On 02.04.18, the CCS Police arrested the prime accused Andol Jagadiswar and he confessed that he had worked as a collection boy in a private chits and observed that huge profits in chit business, so he hatched a plan to run unregistered chits for getting easy money in short time. Thus the accused has started his illegal/unregistered chit business in the year 1995 and cheated the complainant and others by way collecting the crores of rupees from complainant and others and did not repay the chit amounts to them.

This case is being investigated by Assistant Commissioner of Police Sri. T.M.N.Babji under the supervision of Sri. G. Jogaiah, Addl. DCP, EOW & SIT, Detective Department, Hyderabad.

NOTIFICATION

With a view to maintain public order, peace and tranquility in the twin cities of Hyderabad and Secunderabad, I, Anjani Kumar, IPS, Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad City, in exercise of the powers vested in me under section 22(1) (a) to (f) and 22 (2) (a) and (b) of Hyderabad City Police Act, 1348 Fasli (No.IX), do hereby issue the following prohibitory orders.

- I Prohibit to hold any kind of public meetings, and processions within the Hyderabad City, without obtaining prior permission of Zonal Dy. Commissioners of Police, Law and Order concerned, Addl. Commissioner of Police, Law and Order or Jt. Commissioner of Police, Co-ordination & Security or Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad.
 - a) Prohibit carrying of arms such as swords, spears, knives, sticks with or without flags bludgeons, guns, explosives, and other offensive weapons in the above mentioned areas.
 - b) Prohibit gathering of persons on the public roads or public places disturbing peace and order or causing inconvenience, annoyance or danger to public.
 - c) Prohibit collection, carrying of stones or other means of casting missiles.
- II Prohibit use of mikes/public address system by different Organisations around the Secretariat premises, including Burgula Rama Krishna Rao Building, Greater Hyderabad Municipal Corporation Building, Commissioner of Fisheries building, Mint Compound, Nizam College and its surroundings, Telangana Legislative Assembly premises and surrounding roads, Public Garden Nampally, Upper Tankbund, I-MAX, Rotary and NTR Marg roads also fly-over road leading from Secretariat to Visweswarayya statue, Khairatabad.
 - a) Prohibit music, singing or speeches or broadcasting through loud speakers in the above mentioned areas.
 - b) Prohibit use of mikes/public address systems, use of horn through vehicles by any organisation, members of public etc., in the above mentioned areas.
- III The public are here by informed that any person violating the above orders shall be liable for prosecution under the Hyderabad City Police Act, 1348, Fasli (No. IX).
- IV **The following are exempted from the operation of this order**
 - (i) Police Officers on duty,
 - (ii) Military personnel on duty,
 - (iii) Home Guards on duty,
 - (iv) Bonafide funeral processions.

This order shall be in force with effect from 0600 hours on 05-04-2018 to 0600 hours on 11-04-2018.

PRESS NOTE IN CRIME No: 34/2018 & 30/2018 U/S 406, 420, 467, 468, 471 R/w 34 IPC

This is a case of cheating, creating of fake and fabricated property documents and using as genuine document and submitted the same and obtained Cash Credit Loan on the name of M/s SMG Electronics from State Bank of India, Yellareddyguda Branch, Hyderabad and in the name of M/s Cromo Automotive Private Limited.

Facts of the case are that on 26-02-2018 received a complaint from Smt. Usha Shanker, Asst.General Manager, SBI, Yellareddyguda Branch, Hyderabad, in which she stated that, the accused persons 1. Sri Ravula Venkatesh and 2. Smt Ravula Sri Latha, partners of SMG Electronics availed Cash Credit Loan of Rs: 2 Crores on 25-06-2012 for expansion of their Electronic goods business, by submitting 4 property documents i.e., 1) Three Plots bearing Nos. 74, 76 and 77, Saraswathi Nagar Colony, Uppal 2) Three Plot bearing Nos. 78, 79 and 105, Saraswathi Nagar Colony, Uppal 3) H.No. 2-3-215/3/A/1, Plot No: 5, Survey No: 228, Uppal Hills, Uppal, Hyderabad and 4) H.No. 2-1-390 in Sy. Nos 26,28 and 29, situated at Baghlingampally. Subsequently the accused persons are paid interest for the Cash Credit Loan up to 07-09-2012. Thereafter the accused persons are failed to pay the interest amount or principal amount and become as NPA on 28-05-2013.

Later the Stressed Account Recovery Branch (SARB) on verification of the loan property documents which are offered to security to the bank the accused persons, are said to be found false. They are created fake and fabricated documents in respect of above mortgaged properties whose identity is not traced within the given boundaries. Later on, it turned out that the property 1 and 2 above were already sold by Sri G Jagannath Goud, the earlier owner. Taking advantage of the EC that did not reflect the sale deed executed by Sri G Jagannath Goud. The accused persons have suppressed the earlier transactions and misrepresented to the Bank for having wrongful gain.

Further on 22-02-2018 received a complaint from Sri Daparti Dorababu, Regional Manager, State Bank of India, Regional Business Office – V, R.P. Road, Secunderabad in which he stated that Mr. Ravula Venkatesh, M.D., & Smt. Ravula Sri Latha, Director, M/s Cromo Automotive Private Limited, Secunderabad have approached SBI Bible House Branch and availed cash credit loan of Rs.2.50 Crores for procuring four wheelers from Hindustan Motors Ltd., in between 22-02-2010 to 26-05-2012 by mortgaging non existing properties i.e. Plot No.2 admeasuring 520 Sq. Yards, Plot No. 3 admeasuring 506 Sq. yards, Plot No.4 admeasuring 522 Sq. yards situated in Sy. No. 239 & 243 situated at Uppal Village, Ranga Reddy Dist. They showed different properties with the help of created mortgages by impersonation and defaulted by not repaying the outstanding loan amount Rs.2.81 Crores to the bank and become NPA.

Subsequently the accused Ravula Venkatesh surrendered before the Hon'ble Court on 02-04-2017 in above two cases and remanded to judicial custody up to 16-04-2018, in both the cases CCS has filed for custody before the Hon'ble Court. The cases are being investigating by ACP-C Div Sri. M.Srinivasulu and ACP- E, Div Sri. Srinivas Reddy under the supervision of Sri. G. Jogaiah Addl. DCP, EOW, CCS.
