

CRICKET BETTING ORGANIZER NABBED

On 02-05-2017, the sleuths of Commissioner's Task Force, North Zone Team, Hyderabad on credible information near Sanchar Palace Apartments, East Marredpally, Secunderabad apprehended one **cricket betting organizer** K.Sudheer @ Raja S/o. late.K.Chandrashekar, age. 46 yrs who is accepting cricket betting amount from punters directly & in-directly for ongoing IPL Cricket matches in the limits of Thukaramgate, Secunderabad to gain easy money. **Seized net cash Rs. Rs. 36,100/-, Cricket betting punters receipts, 02 Cell phones** from the possession of accused.

The accused Karnati Sudheer @ Raja along with seized material was produced before the SHO, Thukaramagate PS for taking necessary action. In this case the SHO, Tukaramgate PS registered a case vide e.petty case no.HYD31PC17100453 and produced him before the Hon'ble XVI Spl.MM Court, Secunderabad along with charge sheet U/s. 9(i) of A.P.Gaming Act.

CONVICTION PARTICULARS:-

The Hon'ble XVI Spl. MM Court sentenced Karnati Sudheer @ Raja (05) days imprisonment vide STC No. 1069/2017, of Hon'ble XVI Spl.,MM Court, Secunderabad, dt. 03-05-2017 after the accused pled guilty of offence.

BRIEF FACTS OF THE CASE :-

K. Sudheer @ Raja S/o. late.K.Chandrashekar, age. 46 yrs, Occ. Business, R/o. Sanchar Palace Apartments, East Marredpally, Secunderabad, N/o. Miryalaguda, Suryapet Dist, (Cricket betting organizer).

Seized material:-

- 1.Rs. 36,100/-
- 2.Betting punters receipts -02
3. 03 Cell phones

The accused Karnati Sudheer @ Raja S/o. late.K.Chandrashekar, age. 46 yrs is residing at East Marredpally, Secunderabad. He is doing as Film distributor, but he got huge loss in the film distribution filed and facing financial problems, and his income through this business is not sufficient for his lavish expenditure. He is habit of betting money On IPL Cricket matches. Later he started accepting cricket betting amount over cell phone & directly from the interested punters for the ongoing IPL cricket matches and mentioning the customers/punters names in the note book for the ongoing matches. On 02-05-2017 on tip of the Commissioners Task Force, North Zone Police apprehended him and seized above material.

The apprehended accused persons along with the seized material handed over to SHO, Thukaramgate PS for taking necessary action.

ARREST OF A PROFESSIONAL HOUSE BURGLAR AND RECOVERY OF GOLD
ORNAMENTS WEIGHING ABOUT 55-TOLAS ALL WORTH RS. 15,00,000/- BY MARKET
POLICE

Details of the accused

Mohammed Iqbal Jeelani @ Saleem Shaik s/o Abdul Gaffar Jeelani (Late), 45-years, vulcanizing worker r/o # 21-1, Danilimda, Ahmadabad, State of Gujarat-Native of # 22/2, Kharadi Oni Nagar, Kamaripeth (PS), P.B. Road, Hubli, Darwad Dist, Karnataka State. (Arrested on 02.05.2017 and being produced in the Honourable Court for judicial remand)

HISTORY

The accused Mohammed Iqbal Jeelani is a native of Hubli of State of Karnataka. He is studied up to 5th Class. Professionally he is puncture shop worker. He is married and having two kids. When he was Juvenile, he was arrested in the year 1986 by the Karnataka Police for committing offences like theft of Electronic items from the dwelling houses. He is a habitual and a notorious house burglar, involved and arrested in as many as (35) property as well as bodily offences related to the Police Stations of Hubli District, State of Karnataka. A history sheet is also being maintained against him at Kamaripeth Police Station of Hubli District, State of Karnataka. 7-Non-Bailable Warrants related to the property offences of Hubli District are pending against him. He is being shown as Out of Vigil by the concern Police of Hubli District since 2000 and moved to Ahmadabad, State of Gujarat and was also indulging in property offences and other petty offences.

Recently, he has committed House Burglary in the daylight in the limits of Market Police Station of Hyderabad City; wherein on 19.02.2017 he entered into a dwelling house situated in the locality of Bandimet by breaking open the locks of the grill and the main door and committed theft of gold ornaments weighing about 55-tolas by breaking open the locks of the almirah and decamped with the booty in the temporary absence of the inmates.

On a complaint of Sri. R.S. Dayanand, a case in Cr.No. 26/2017 u/s 454, 380 IPC has been registered at Market P.S. and investigation taken up.

During the course of investigation, the CC footages from the vicinity of the crime scene have been collected and the complicity of the person found in the footage has been verified and while the efforts were in progress, the same person happened to visit the area for targeting other houses. On 02.05.2017 at 5 P.M. near Clock Tower he has been identified and taken into custody. On meticulous interrogation by the Market Police, he confessed to have committed this offence. At the instance and from his possession part of stolen articles have been recovered and remaining stolen property has been recovered from a room of Indian Lodge situated at Nampally, Hyderabad, which he checked in 02.05.2017 in the early hours. He has been arrested and being produced in the Court for judicial remand.

**SURPRISE CHECKING ON ILLEGAL STAYING FOREIGN NATIONALS IN THE
LIMITS OF HYDERABAD CITY BY TASK FORCE TEAMS**

Today i.e. on 03-05-2017 as per the instructions issued by Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad City the Task Force teams conducted surprise check on illegal staying foreign Nationals at Golconda, Humayun Nagar, Asif Nagar, Langer House, Banjara Hills, Jubilee Hills, OU Sity, Malkpet in the limits of Hyderabad City even after expiry of their Visa. The above mentioned (14) foreign nationals in which five are Sudan Nationals, four are Yemen Nationals, two are Soomaliyan Nationals, two are Kenya Nationals and one is Tanzania National. Most of them came to India on Student Visa.

On our check we found that the most of the house owners who are giving accommodation on let out the house/flats on rent to the foreigners are not informing the foreign nationals staying details through C-Form to the FRRO. Accommodators viz., Hotels, Lodges, Corporate Guest houses, Individual Houses, Dharmasala, Hostels and Hospitals etc., should register in the online C-Form module by creating a login account in the website of FRRO. It is a statutory procedure under Sec.7(3) and 7(4) of the Foreigners Act-1946. Contravening the provisions of the act would invite punishment with imprisonment for a term which may be extended to 5 years.

The same was intimated to the FRRO for taking further action.
