**NOTIFICATION**

WHEREAS, reports have been received indicating that High Volume Sound Emitting Systems including DJs (High Volume Sound Mixers) are being generating noise beyond permissible limits (day time 55 db(A) and night time 45 db(A) in Residential Areas, day time 65 db(A) and night time 55 db(A) in Commercial Areas) in places of public gatherings including Processions causing inconvenience, disturbance, nuisance, annoyance and Under Section 67(c) prohibit bursting of fire crackers on public places / public roads, public meetings and marriages to the residents of locality and public in general.

WHEREAS, such acts have been causing acute inconvenience and distress among the children, old aged persons, patients and students in particular pursuing their studies in the residential localities.

WHEREAS, such High Volume sounds generated at Public Meetings, Marriages and Processions have been neutralizing Police Communication Systems deployed in relation to bandobust duties, thereby adversely affecting the function of maintenance of Public Order and Tranquillity by Law Enforcement Agencies.

AND WHEREAS, it is considered expedient to take stringent and speedy measures to control the use of High Volume Sound Emitting Systems including DJs (High Volume Sound Mixers) in place of Public gatherings including processions in the residential localities.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred under Rule 8 of Noise Pollution (Regulation & Control) Rules 2000, I, Anjani Kumar, IPS Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad City, do hereby make this written order and notify the same to the General Public Prohibiting the following within Hyderabad City, except in cases specifically permitted by the Divisional Asst. Commissioners of Police of the concerned jurisdiction:

- Use of High Volume Sound Systems including DJs (High Volume Sound Mixers) emanating sound levels beyond permissible limits in places of Public Gatherings including Processions in the Residential Localities.
- Prohibit bursting of fire crackers at public places / public roads, public meetings and marriage function halls causing inconvenience to the residents of locality and public in general.

This order shall come into force from 0600 hrs on 03-05-2018 and shall remain in force for a period of 15 days i.e., upto 0600 hrs on 17-05-2018, both days inclusive unless withdrawn earlier.

Any person violating this order shall be liable for punishment u/s 67(c), 188 of IPC and u/s 76 of the Hyderabad City Police Act, 1348 Fasli.

**NOTIFICATION**

WHEREAS, reports have been received indicating that consumption of liquor in public places has become rampant and unhindered in several areas of the City of Hyderabad, resulting in to a menace to the common members of the public, especially women and children in particular.

AND WHEREAS, such reports have been indicating that, persons consuming liquor in public places have been exhibiting abrasive unruly and indecent behavior on the streets of Hyderabad City towards law abiding citizens especially women and children in particular endangering their modesty and safety in addition to causing disturbance to public tranquility resulting in annoyance and obstruction to road users in general and women and children in particular.

WHEREAS, such unruly and indecent behavior has been instilling a sense of fear psychosis in law abiding citizens, especially women and children resulting in restriction of their free movement on the streets of Hyderabad, thereby affecting public safety at large and safety and security of women and children in particular.

AND WHEREAS, it is considered necessary to take speedy measures in this regard to prevent danger to human life and safety and security of women and children or for preventing any affray and disturbance of public tranquility.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me under Section 144 of Criminal Procedure Code 1973, I, Anjani Kumar, IPS Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad City, do hereby make this written order and notify the same to the General Public **prohibiting Consumption of liquor in public places in the City of Hyderabad.**

This order is published for the information of public through the media and through the public address system in the areas affected with drunkenness in public places.

This order shall come into force from 0600 hours on 04-05-2018 and shall remain in force for a period of one week i.e. upto 0600 hours on 10-05-2018 (both days inclusive) unless withdrawn earlier.

Any person violating this order shall be liable for punishment under Section 188 of the Indian Penal code and as per the provisions of Hyderabad City Police Act, 1348 Fasli.

**NOTIFICATION**

WHEREAS, reports have been received that in all public places like Cinema Theaters, Bus Stands, Malls, Shopping Complexes, Religious Places, Educational Institutions, Industrial Fairs and Exhibitions, Food Outlets, Wine Shops, ATMs, Business outlets, Offices, Places of Entertainment and such Other Places where public throng takes place have been leading to uninterrupted public nuisance, traffic obstructions and obstructions in smooth conducting of businesses and professions thereby adversely affecting public order, tranquility decency and smooth flow of Traffic.

Whereas, it is considered expedient to take stringent and speedy measures to control the overcrowding of people at public places like Cinema Theaters, Bus Stands, Malls, Shopping Complexes, Religious Places, Educational Institutions, Industrial Fairs and Exhibitions, Food Outlets, Wine Shops, ATMs, Business outlets, Offices, Places of Entertainment and such Other Places where public throng takes place for maintaining public order, tranquility, decency and smooth flow of traffic in such places.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me under clause (d) of section 22 of the Hyderabad City Police Act, 1348 Fasli, I, Anjani Kumar, IPS Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad City, do hereby pass this written order and notify the same to the Managements of all the above said Establishments to take necessary measures including providing 'Q' Managers, Security Personnel, Sinages, Awareness, Enforcement etc., for mandatory formation of queue lines of the public gathered at their establishments on a sustainable basis in order to maintain order, decency and discipline and further that all the public are also duty bound to follow the queue lines at the above said places leaving a personal space of one feet between person to person standing in the queue system, without forming into a crowd.

This order shall come into force from 0600 hrs on 02-05-2018 and shall remain in force for a period of 15 days i.e., up to 06:00 hrs on 16-05-2018, both days inclusive unless withdrawn earlier.

The Managements of all the said establishments shall implement these measures strictly in letter and spirit in respect of people gathered at their establishments forming part of Public Places in the interest of public order, tranquility, decency and smooth flow of traffic.

Any Management violating this order shall be liable for punishment under Sections 188, 290 and 290 r/w 109 of the IPC and under Section 76 of the Hyderabad City Police Act, 1348 Fasli.

**NOTIFICATION**

In exercise of powers conferred upon me under section 21 clause (1) & (b) of the Hyderabad City Police Act, 1348 Fasli I, ANJANI KUMAR, I.P.S, Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad, do hereby notify for information for the public in general in order to maintain smooth flow of traffic, prevent danger and inconvenience to the public the following traffic diversions are imposed on the movement of traffic in the limits of Tr. PS. Narayanaguda in view of laying VDCC Road at Indian Bank, Himayathnagar Main Road and remodeling of storm water Drain from Satya Diagnostic Centre to Nalla in Street No. 5, Himayathnagar for removing water stagnation for **30 days** from 03-05-2018 to 01-06-2018.

**TRAFFIC DIVERSIONS**

1. Traffic coming from Narayanaguda X Roads and Flyover towards Liberty via Street No.9 Himayathnagar will be diverted at Y Junction towards Old MLA Qtrs, Café Bhar, CP Office, Basheerbagh, Liberty.
2. Traffic coming from Melkote Park or Vittal wadi intend to go towards Liberty via Telugu academy, Himayathnagar Y Junction will not be allowed, It will be diverted towards Old MLA Qtrs, Café Bhar, CP office, Bashherbagh, liberty.
3. Traffic Coming from Ambedkar statue and Basheerbagh intend to go Narayanguda via liberty, street no.1, Himayathnagar, will be diverted at Street No. 5 right turn up to Sangitha Mobile near Y Junction.
4. Commuters are advised to take alternative routes i.e.
  - a) Traffic coming from Vidyanagar with intend to go Liberty can take alternative routes at Hindi Mahavidyalaya, Azamabad, RTC X Road, Indira Park, Kattamaisamma, Liberty.
  - b) Traffic coming from Barkathpura Junction with intend to go can take alternative route via Crown Café, Sundaraiah Park, VST, RTC X Road, Indira Park, Kattamaisamma and Liberty.
5. a) RTC buses coming from Narayanaguda with intend to go Liberty will be diverted at Himayath Nagar Y-Junction via Old MLA Quarters, Café-E-Bahar Hotel, Basheerbagh.
  - b) RTC buses coming from Ambedkar Statue with intend to go Narayanaguda will be diverted at Liberty towards Basheerbagh, Café-E-Bahar, Old MLA Quarters, Himayath Nagar Y-Junction.
6. The commuters are requested not to park their vehicles on free parking areas from Y Junction- Himayathnagar to Liberty T Junction and Liberty T Junction to Y Junction- Himayathnagar both sides for free flow of traffic.
7. Public/commuters are requested not to stop their vehicles to observe the road work at Street No.5 & 6 Himayathnagar to avoid traffic congestions.

All citizens are requested to take alternate routes to reach their destinations and to avoid the above routes and co-operate with the Traffic Police during the period of traffic diversion as above.

**NOTIFICATION**

With a view to maintain public order, peace and tranquility in the twin cities of Hyderabad and Secunderabad, I, Anjani Kumar, IPS Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad City, in exercise of the powers vested in me under section 22(1) (a) to (f) and 22 (2) (a) and (b) of Hyderabad City Police Act, 1348 Fasli (No.IX), do hereby issue the following prohibitory orders.

- I Prohibit to hold any kind of public meetings, and processions within the Hyderabad City, without obtaining prior permission of Zonal Dy. Commissioners of Police, Law and Order concerned, Addl. Commissioner of Police, Law and Order or Jt. Commissioner of Police, Co-ordination & Security or Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad.
- a) Prohibit carrying of arms such as swords, spears, knives, sticks with or without flags bludgeons, guns, explosives, and other offensive weapons in the above mentioned areas.
- b) Prohibit gathering of persons on the public roads or public places disturbing peace and order or causing inconvenience, annoyance or danger to public.
- c) Prohibit collection, carrying of stones or other means of casting missiles.
- II Prohibit use of mikes/public address system by different Organisations around the Secretariat premises, including Burgula Rama Krishna Rao Building, Greater Hyderabad Municipal Corporation Building, Commissioner of Fisheries building, Mint Compound, Nizam College and its surroundings, Telangana Legislative Assembly premises and surrounding roads, Public Garden Nampally, Upper Tankbund, I-MAX, Rotary and NTR Marg roads also fly-over road leading from Secretariat to Visweswarayya statue, Khairatabad.
- a) Prohibit music, singing or speeches or broadcasting through loud speakers in the above mentioned areas.
- b) Prohibit use of mikes/public address systems, use of horn through vehicles by any organisation, members of public etc., in the above mentioned areas.
- III The public are here by informed that any person violating the above orders shall be liable for prosecution under the Hyderabad City Police Act, 1348, Fasli (No. IX).
- IV **The following are exempted from the operation of this order**
- (i) Police Officers on duty,
- (ii) Military personnel on duty,
- (iii) Home Guards on duty,
- (iv) Bonafide funeral processions.

This order shall be in force with effect from 0600 hours on 05-05-2018 to 0600 hours on 11-05-2018.

## **NABBED ONE LSD DRUG PEDDLERS : SEIZED (37) STAMPS OF LSD DRUG**

Today i.e. on 03-05-2018, the Commissioner's Task Force, West Zone Team, Hyderabad, apprehended one accused Shishir Chauhan who is in the possession of Narcotic Drug i.e. LSD (Lysergic acid diethylamide) Stamps and selling the same to the drug users. **Seized (37) stamps of LSD Drug, (150) Grams of Ganja and (1) cell phone** from his possession.

### **Details of Accused:**

- 1) Shishir Chauhan S/o Raghunandan Chauhan @ R.N.Chauhan, aged 24 yrs, Occ: Cabs Business, R/o Flat No.105, Shubodaya Apartments, R.K.Puram, Hyderabad.

### **Modus operandi:-**

The accused Shishir Chauhan is a habit of consume LSD stamps and Ganja. He used to go to Goa and purchasing LSD drug stamps and used to consume regularly. Also he is selling the LSD drug stamps in Hyderabad for higher rates to needy students/customers. He used to purchase one LSD drug stamp for Rs.600/- to 700/- and selling the same in Hyderabad for Rs.1500/- to 1800/- per stamp depend upon customers demand.

In this process, in the month of November-2015 the accused Shishir Chauhan was apprehended by West Zone Task Force team and recovered (100) LSD drug stamps and (40) grams of Charas from his possession and handed over him to Anti Narcotic Cell, CCS, Hyderabad along with recovered property. Later the Anti Narcotic Cell, CCS, Hyderabad arrested the accused Shishir Chauhan in Cr.No.293/2015 U/s 21(b) of NDPS Act-1985 and sent him to Chanchalguda Jail. After twenty days he was released from jail and started Cabs business in Hyderabad. But his earnings are not sufficient to meet his lavish expenses. As such again he hatched a plan to sell LSD stamps in Hyderabad to earn easy money. He used to purchase for Rs.1000/- per 1 LSD stamp at Goa and used to sell to needy persons for Rs.2000/- per 1 LSD stamp. In the month of August-2017 the accused Shishir Chauhan went to Goa and purchased (100) LSD stamps. In which he sold (63) LSD stamps to the needy persons in Hyderabad and other areas. Remaining (37) LSD stamps kept with him.

Today i.e. on 03-05-2018 "Following tip off", West Zone Task Force Police laid a trap and apprehended the accused while selling the LSD Stamps at Trimulgherry X Roads, Hyderabad.

The accused along with seized material was handed over to SHO, Trimulgherry PS, Hyderabad, for further action.

### **LSD (Lysergic acid diethylamide) Drug:**

It is also known as lysergide and colloquially as acid, is a psychedelic drug of the ergoline family, well known for its psychological effects—which can include altered thinking processes, closed and open-eye visuals, synesthesia, an altered sense of time, and spiritual experiences. It is used mainly as an entheogen and recreational drug and mainly used in psychedelic parties. However, acute adverse psychiatric reactions such as anxiety, paranoia, and delusions are possible. The selling price will be ranged between Rs.1700/- to 2,000/- per stamp depending upon customers and their urgency.

The arrests were made under the supervision of **Sri P.Radha Kishan Rao**, Dy.Commissioner of Police, Commissioner's Task Force, **Sri B.Gattu Mallu**, Inspector of Police, Commissioner's Task Force, West Zone team, and SIs Sri V.Kishore, Sri P.Mallikarjun, Sri M.Prabhakar Reddy, Sri L.Bhaskar Reddy and staff of West Zone Team, Commissioner's Task Force, Hyderabad.

## PRESS NOTE

Cyber Crime Police of CCS, Detective Department, Hyderabad, apprehended (3) three offenders namely 1) Bidyut Ghosh, age 28 yrs, R/o Jamuria, West Bengal, 2) Binod Patra, age 32 yrs, R/o Durgapur, West Bengal, 3) Sahabaz Khan, age 21 yrs, R/o Asansol, West Bengal, who are assisting inter-state fraudsters by providing their bank accounts on commission basis. The gang are indulging in obtaining debit/credit card details from bank customers by posing themselves as executives/officials of banks, call the customers, lure them informing that their ATM cards and bank accounts are blocked/to be linked with Aadhaar card, and for unblocking ATM cards/bank accounts, they require details of debit/credit cards and collect card number, cvv number, expiry date and OTP numbers and fraudulently transfer the money in to e-commerce wallets and from there they will transfer the fraudulent amount in to various bank accounts. Police seized net cash Rs. 11,000/-, (9) debit cards, (4) bank account pass books, (5) cheque books, mobile phone and one small executive note book containing details of bank account numbers, debit card numbers of various account holders with the PIN numbers, from the possession of accused.

### FACTS OF THE CASE:

Basing on the complaint received from Sri Balaji, age 52 yrs, R/o Chandanwadi, Gosha Mahal, Hyderabad, regarding receiving call from unknown person posing as Bank Official who obtained his SBI debit card details and OTP numbers fraudulently and made on line transactions for Rs.3,79,470/- for the period from 8-2-2018 to 16-2-2018, a case was registered vide Cr.No.54/2018, U/Sec. 66 (C) (D) I.T.A Act 2008, Sec.419, 420 IPC at Cyber Crime PS, CCS, Hyderabad and investigated into.

During the course of investigation, basing on the information provided by banks and e-commerce wallets and clues on hand, police teams lead by Sri D. Prashanth and Sri P. Suresh, Sub-Inspectors of Police, Cyber Crime PS, CCS, Hyderabad, proceeded to West Bengal and Jharkhand states and apprehended the accused persons. They were brought to Hyderabad on transit remand and are being remanded to Judicial custody.

### Details of the arrested persons :-

A1) Bidyut Ghosh S/o Karthi Ghosh, age 28 yrs, Occ: Labour, R/o Lal Bazar (vill. Jamuria, West Bardhaman, West Bengal.

A2) Binod Patra S/o late Lakshmidhar Patra, age 32 yrs, R/o Maithri Villa, Roy Danga, Durgapur-1, Bardhaman, West Bengal.

A3) Sahabaz Khan @ Saju S/o Jamal Khan, age 21 yrs, R/o near Dr.p.R. Mukarji Nursing Home Lower Chelidanga, Asansol, West Bengal.

### M.O. OF THE OFFENDER:-

The Accused persons and their associates hailing from West Bengal and Jharkhand states are assisting inter-state fraudsters indulging in obtaining debit/credit card details including OTP numbers from bank customers posing themselves as bank officials by providing them bank accounts on commission basis.

The teams headed by Sri D. Prashanth and Sri P. Suresh, Sub-Inspectors of Police along with staff under the guidance of Sri V.P. Tiwari, Inspector and supervision of Sri KCS Raghu Vir, Addl. Dy. Commissioner of Police, Cyber Crime PS, Hyderabad, apprehended the accused persons.
