Sri Anjani Kumar, IPS, Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad City invoked P.D.Act against Bommala Dilip Kumar, S/o Anjaiah of Osmania University Police Station on 30.7.2018.

Bommala Dilip Kumar, S/o Anjaiah, aged about 40 years, R/o Anand Nagar, Bandlaguda, Nagole, Medchal District, N/o Shadnagar, Ranga Reddy District, has been committing offences of theft of two wheeler vehicles parked in front of residential houses and other places by using duplicate key in the limits of Hyderabad and Rachakonda Police Commissionerates to make easy money and to lead a lavish life.

He Committed **18 such offences** in the limits of Hyderabad and Raachakonda Police Commissionerates and has been creating fear and panic among the general public by committing such offences in public places and thus he has been acting in a manner prejudicial to the maintenance of public order apart from disturbing the peace, tranquillity and social harmony in the society.

Osmania University Police made efforts to arrest the accused Bommala Dilip Kumar, S/o Anjaiah, on 24.4.2018 in Cr. No 124/2018 U/s 379 IPC of Osmania University PS and remanded to judicial custody. The Detention Order was executed on him on 31.7.2018 and lodged him in Central Prison, Chanchalguda, Hyderabad.

**ARREST OF NOTORIOUS AND DESPERATE GANG OF WHITE COLLAR OFFENDERS INVOLVED IN SERIES OF CHEATINGS IN THE LIMITS OF HYDERABAD, CYBERABAD AND RACHAKONDA COMMISSIONARATES AND RECOVERY OF NET CASH RS. 1,25,000/-**

- A-1 Syed Shabbir Ali, 38-years, Marketing (Involved in 17-cases)
  - A-2 Mir Mehdi Ali Razvi, 55-years, (Involved in 13-cases)
  - A-3 Mohammed Shahid Ali Khan, 38-years, (Involved in 3-cases)
  - A-4 Zia Abbas, 25-years, Student (Involved in 1-case)

**HISTORY**

A-1 Syed Shabbir Ali is a resident of Qayam Nagar Pahadi, Rajender Nagar. A-2 to A-4 are his associates. A-1 hatched a plan to earn money by adopting easy means by cheating the gullible Petty vendors in Rural areas and newly opened shops in bordering areas of Hyderabad. A-1 started approaching the Vendors by posing himself as Marketing Executive. He has collected some Battery Cells and also a printed Bill Book of his name. A-1 Syed Shabbir Ali along with A-2 Mir Mehdi Ali Razvi used to approach the newly opened shopkeepers and introduced themselves as Sales Representatives/Agents of reputed firms i.e. Sree Sai Agency and Coca Cola and offered them to provide Refrigerators, Snack Stud and LED lighting Board for their shops on cheaper rates and also offered 24-crates of Coke and by saying so they used to collect some amount from the shopkeepers as token advance and to believe their version they used to give 12-Packets of Max Cells as complimentary and used to issue a cash receipt acknowledging the token advance and giving their false name as Saleem with their false Contact No. and promising the delivery of their consignment shortly and say so they used to leave the place along with A-3 and A-4.

All the accused are associates of accused A-1 Syed Shabbir Ali and they become a group to receive the business locality and select innocent shopkeepers and posing them as true Sales Representatives of reputed firms and thereby used to cheat them fraudulently for their wrongful gains.

As on today they have cheated altogether 17-members in the following cases to an extent of RS. 2,09,000/- where as 2-cases have been reported from Karim Nagar, 1-case from Siddipet, 1-case from Nizamabad, 3-cases from Cyberabad and 8-cases from Rachakonda and 1-case from Bowenpally and 1-case from Trimulgherry.

**ON LINE SATTA BETTING RACKET BUSTED – 12 HELD  
SEIZED RS. 7,100/- (11) CELL PHONES,(06)-SATTA CHITS .**

On 02-08-2018, The sleuths of Commissioner's Task Force, North Zone Team, in joint operation with PS Lalaguda Police, Secunderabad, conducted special drive against Satta Betting organizers and nabbed (2) Satta betting groups and apprehended **(12) accused persons** in which **Organizers-2, Punters-10** by name- 1)Vipparla Shraavan Kumar(Organizer), 2)Simhadri Sudhakar (Organizer) & punters by name:- 3)Mohd. Buran, 4)Abdul Razak, 5)Syed Anwar, 6)Mohd. Abdul Nayeem, 7)Mohd. Jamir, 8)Shaik Ghouse, 9)Mohd. Hayath @ Anwar, 10)Mohd. Anwar @ Annu, 11)Mohd Ghouse Khan & 12)Mudigonda Prabhudass. The organizers are running the satta betting through on line by collecting satta betting amount through Paytm from punters, habitual customers, which is a game of chance. **Seized Rs. 7100/- (06) Satta charts, (11) Cell phones, from the possession of accused persons.**

➤ **BRIEF FACTS OF THE CASE:**

In continuation of curbing on Organized Satta betting game in Hyderabad City, the Commissioner's Task Force, North Zone team conducted a special drive on "**organized Satta betting**" and apprehended 12 ACCUSED PERSONS.

The organizer Vipparla Shraavan Kumar is organizing On line satta betting under main organizer Kumar Sanjay, who is organizing Satta betting in around Secunderabad and Hyderabad and he is admin of On line Satta betting "KS ONLINE PLAY WHATS'P" and the sub-organizers, punters are use to follow the Satta betting app Sattamatka.mobi, Sattamatkano7.com, Satta Matka 143 apps and paying amount through on line PAYTM app and gain easy money illegally.

The accused Simhadri Sudhakar is organizing Satta betting under main organizer Ankesh Kumar Jaiswal. The accused have engaged (15) punters who are habit of betting on satta through the punters the organizer is use to collect Satta betting amount & Satta chits from the punters directly, indirectly & over cell phone communication clandestinely and the punters remit the collection amount to the organizer. The organizer have been paid commission Rs. 200/- to 400/- per day to the sub-organizer and the organizers are sharing the profits.

On tip of information, to day i.e on 02-08-2018, the sleuths of Commissioner's Task Force North Zone team in joint operation with Police Lalaguda PS apprehended (12) accused persons consisting of (02) Organizers & (10) Punters in the limits of Lalaguda, Secunderabad.

The accused persons along with seized material hand over to SHO, Lalaguda PS for taking necessary legal action against them as per law.

The arrest were made under the supervision of **Sri. P Radhakishan Rao Dy.Commissioner of Police**, Commissioners Task Force, Hyderabad, assisted by Sri K Nageswar Rao, Inspector of Police, North Zone Task Force & SIs Sri.
