**NOTIFICATION**

General Elections to Telangana State. Legislative Assembly are scheduled to be held in the twin cities of Hyderabad and Secunderabad on 07-12-2018 i.e., Friday.

After reviewing the situation carefully and with a view of maintain public order, peace and tranquility in the twin cities of Hyderabad and Secunderabad on **07-12-2018**, I, Anjani Kumar, IPS Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad in exercise of the powers conferred on me under section 22 (1) (d) to (f) and 22 (2) (a) to (e) and 22 (3) of Hyderabad City Police, Act do hereby issued the following prohibitory orders:-

1. Prohibit Assembly of persons and any kind of processions.
2. Prohibit carrying of sticks either with or without flags, lathies, fire arms, or any other weapons which can be used as weapons for offence or defence by persons in processions, big gathering or meetings within a radius of one K.M. from the polling stations.
3. Prohibit erection of temporary structures like Shamianas, pandals, Khannath etc., on thoroughfares, public places and all other places where public throng.
4. Prohibit use of mikes/public address system by anybody or parties in the entire twin cities of Hyderabad and Secunderabad.
5. Prohibit music, singing or speeches or broadcasting through speakers or any other instruments.
6. Prohibit making a speech, gesture or mimetic representation, exhibition or dissemination of pictures, symbols, placards or any other thing which is likely to create religious animosity or hatred between different communities or individuals or is likely to bring about commission of an offence of disturbance to or contempt of the law or of a lawful authority.

**The following are exempted from the operation of this order:-**

- a. Police Officers on duty.
- b. Military/Para Military personnel on duty.
- c. Home Guards on duty.
- d. Election Officers on duty.

The public are hereby informed that any person violating the above orders shall be liable for prosecution.

This order shall be in force with effect from 1600 hours on 05-12-2018 to 0600 hours on 08-12-2018.

Sri Anjani Kumar, IPS, Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad City issued P.D. Orders against Govula Janaki @ Mulla Janaki W/o Govula Ramesh, Property Offender of Lallaguda Police Station on 26.11.2018.

Govula Janaki @ Mulla Janaki W/o Govula Ramesh, aged about 38 years, R/o H.No.44-15-162, Lenin Nagar, Gunadala, Vijayawada, Andhra Pradesh State and previously resided at H.No.3-5-231/1/NR, Road No.5, Krishna Nagar, NFC Road, Housing Board Colony, Moulali, Ranga Reddy District has committed **offences of theft of gold ornaments, cash, etc., from the passengers travelling in RTC buses in the limits of Hyderabad Police Commissionerate** to make easy money and lead a lavish life.

The accused/detenu has committed 7 offences of theft of gold ornaments, cash, etc., from the passengers travelling in RTC buses in the limits of Hyderabad Police Commissionerate and has been creating large scale fear and panic among the general public, thereby adversely affecting the public order, apart from disturbing the peace, tranquillity and social harmony in the society.

Lallaguda Police made sincere efforts and arrested the accused/detenu Govula Janaki @ Mulla Janaki W/o Govula Ramesh on 26.7.2018 in Cr.No.84/2018 U/s 379 IPC of Lallaguda PS and remanded him to judicial custody. The Preventive Detention Order was executed on him on 30.11.2018 and he was lodged in Special Prison for Women, Chanchalguda, Hyderabad.
