SHE TEAMS NAB 2 PERSONS FOR STALKING GIRL

'SHE' Teams, Hyderabad City Police caught 2 persons for following, stalking and harassing a college student. A complaint was lodged by the father of the victim girl through whats app to SHE teams on 02-01-2017. He stated that, his daughter is studying in a Private Degree college in Abids, Hyderabad. She goes to college and comes back in the college bus.

Since two weeks, two unknown persons were following her on bike or in a red car, while going to college. Frightened over their behaviour, she stopped going to college.

Sri Shoban Babu, Sub Inspector of Police, 'SHE' Teams under the guidance of Smt.D.Kavitha ACP 'SHE' Teams caught the respondents based on the bike number given by the father of the victim, and after confirming the identity of the respondents with the victim. Resp. 1) Ahmed Bin Ali S/o Ali Bin Sayee, , 23 yrs, Occ: Student R/o H No. 12-2-26/A/10/N, Phoolbagh, Hyderabad and 2) Mir Saifali Abedi, S/o Mir Mustafa Ali Abedi, 23 yrs. Occ: Student R/o H No. 16-4-733, Chanchalguda, Hyderabad also confessed their guilt.

As the father of the victim refused to come forward to give a complaint for booking a case, a suo moto case was registered. They were arrested and produced before the Magistrate.

Anyone who stalks or harasses girls will be caught and suo moto cases will be registered, if the victim is not ready to give a complaint. Students creating nuisance near the colleges using bikes and 4 wheelers also will be caught and punished under relevant sections of law.

People are advised to inform the SHE teams, Hyderabad City Police in case they notice any one harassing or causing inconvenience to the women and the general public.

South Zone Police and CCS, Cyber Crime Team Today i.e. 04.01.2017 about 12:00 PM at Minar Function Hall, Salarjung museum, Naya Phool conducted meeting with the owners of **CYBER CAFE** regarding the implementation of rules framed by the Government for functioning of their respective cafes and sufficient precautionary measures.

- All Cyber cafes should and must install CCTV cameras of superior **THERMAL IR IMAGE** quality of recording inside and outside the cafe.
- The Users cabin should be removed so that their view should be visible from any corner of the cyber café.
- Visitor details of should be entered in the register the time of log in and log out and user should also provide his Identity proof.
- The Owners of cyber café should register their cafes Account by producing their required documents and applications at the O/o Commissionerate of Police, Hyderabad City, Basheerbagh as per the **GOI., G.S.R.No. 315 (E) dt.11.04.2011** issued.
- As per rule (3) (1) of Information Technology (Guidelines for Cyber Café) Rules, 2011 All Cyber Cafes should be registered with a unique number.
- All Cyber cafes Registered Name of the cafes should be displayed outside which should be visible to all.
- All Cyber cafes should display the do's & don't's on the wall visible to the visitors.

Sri Ravi Kumar, Inspector of Police, CCS, Hyderabad had informed the owners to change their **PROXY settings** and block the porn sites or any unsocial elements which may lead to illegal/unlawful activities to be occurred. Cyber Crimes happening in our city most of them are traced by the use of IP addresses but the time of reaching the particular cyber café we are unable to the identify the person because they are not maintaining the appropriate register entries and no CCTV Cameras have been installed in all cafes. INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY ACT 2000 rules and regulations Pertaining in that and sections in which the owners are liable for the illegal/unlawful activities of irrespective. Police Authorities may inspect any of the cafes at reasonable timings to ensure the compliance of the cafes in view of Increasing of Cyber Crimes in Hyderabad City they is a dire need for regulating the cyber cafes in the city.


