TRAFFIC ADVISORY

The following traffic restrictions are likely to be imposed on 05-03-2017, 5 AM to 8 AM, in connection with 2K, 5k RUN organized by She Teams, Hyderabad City, between People Plaza to middle of the upper Tankbund (Kshetrayya Statue) and back to People Plaza, in case of necessity:-

Traffic diversions:

1. Traffic coming from VV statue towards Khairtabad flyover and Necklace Rotary will be diverted at V.V statue towards Shadan and Nirankari Bhavan.
2. Traffic coming from Abedker Statue and I.T will be diverted at Telugu Talli towards Iqbal Minar.
3. Traffic coming from Iqbal Minar intending to go towards Upper tankbund will be diverted on Telugu Tally flyover at Old gate Secretariat
4. Traffic coming from Liberty intending to go towards Upper tank bund will be diverted at GHMC office towards BRKR Bhavan, Telugu Tally, Iqbal Minar "U" Turn and on to Telugu Tally flyover.
5. Traffic coming from Karbala to Ambedkar Statue via Tankbund will be diverted at Children Park towards DBR Mills – Lower Tankbund.
6. Traffic coming from Nallagutta to Sanjeevaiah Park will be diverted at Nallgutta Junction towards Ranigunj x road.
7. At DBR Mills traffic will not be allowed towards Children Park.

Parking places: 1) Maktha, 2) Imax parking and 3) Doctor's Car Parking

General public are requested to avoid Tank Bund road, Necklace Road, NTR Marg road and take alternate routes to reach their destination and cooperate with the Traffic Police.

ONE HOUSE BURGLER APPREHENDED BY POLICE PANJAGUTTA CRIME TEAM.

On 03-03-2017 the Crime Team of Panjagutta Police apprehended one notorious accused person and detected a case and recovered the **Gold Ornaments Wg. about 105grams, all worth of Rs. 3 Lakhs.**

Details of Arrested Accused person:

Abed Hussain S/o Late. Gulam Mustafa, age: 62 yrs, Occ: Auto Driver, R/o. H. No. 1-67, Motilala Nahru Nagar, behind DBR Mill, Lower Tankbund, Hyderabad.

(The accused person was arrested on 04.03.2017 and being produced before the Hon'ble Court for judicial remand)

Detected Case details:

1) Cr.No. 05/2014, U/Sec. 454, 380 IPC of P.S. Panjagutta, Hyderabad

On 02-01-2014 in the early morning the accused *moved in Naveen Nagar, Eramanzil colony, Panjagutta* and found one house entrance gate was opened, by taking advantage he entered into the house and went to 1st floor and noticed that the main door was locked and in the absence of inmates he break opened the main door lock with the help of stone, then he entered into the house and committed theft of Gold ornaments from the almirah and fled away from the spot. *The accused was addicted for his bad habits and started the commission of theft for fulfill his needs with the money and spent the sold away gold ornaments money for playing Satta, consuming alcohol and spent money lavishly.*

During the course of investigation, the fingerprints were taken from the scene of offence with the help of finger print bureau and the same were sent to CCRB for comparison with the MO criminal fingerprints. The CCRB Finger print bureau tallied the finger prints by using new IT technology and found that the chance prints taken from the scene was tallied with one criminal offender namely **Abed Hussain S/o late Gulam Mustafa R/o Borabanda** who was previously bind over in case **vide Cr.No.174/1987 U/s.41(a), 110 Cr.PC of PS Asifnagar, Hyderabad**, wherein his address details are incomplete. On that the crime team made efforts to apprehend the accused and traced and apprehended him and on interrogation he voluntarily confessed this offence.

The above case was detected under the supervision of **Sri M.Venkateshwarlu, Asst.Commissioner of Police, Panjagutta Division, Hyderabad** and **Sri S.Mohan Kumar, Inspector of Police, PS Panjagutta, Hyderabad** by **Sri B.Lakshmi Narayana Reddy, Detective Inspector of Police, Sri P. Srinivasulu, DSI and Crime Staff of Panjagutta Police Station, Hyderabad** detected this case.

The efforts of the above officers and staff are highly appreciated and proposals are being forwarded to the C.P., Hyderabad for suitably rewarding them.

POLICE SLEUTHS NABBED MURDERERS OF HOME GUARD WITHIN A DAY

(Cr. No. 45/2017 U/s 120 (B), 302, 201, 109 IPC of Kulsumpura PS)

On 03-03-2017 at 1245 hours, dead body of Mr.L.Ravindra Chary, HG 4226 of Kalapathar PS was found lying in the midst of bushes at Imampura Graveyard, Jiyaguda, Hyderabad, in fully burnt state. On that a case vide Cr. No. 45/2017 U/s 302, 201 IPC has been registered.

Special Teams formed by Inspector Kulsumpura PS, have apprehended the accused woman Smt. A. Shoba w/o. Late A. Yadagiri, aged 45 yrs, Occ: Flower Vendor, r/o. Near Grave Yard, Imampura, Ziaguda, Hyderabad and interrogated, wherein, she admitted that, she is eking livelihood by selling flowers. The deceased L.Ravindra Chary, is her brother in law (Sister's husband) as well as paramour and he is drunkard. He is working as Home Guard at Kalapathar PS. Her husband expired about 7 years ago. Since then the deceased L.Ravindra Chary developed intimacy with her. She provided financial assistance to Ravindra Chary many a times and he owes her an amount of Rs.2.8 lakhs. In the year 2014, her daughter Rama Devi expired due to ill health. Due to financial problems, she started insisting Ravindra Chary to return the amount of Rs.2.8 lakhs, but he is dodging the matter on one or other pretext. As she is insisting for the money, he stopped visiting to her house since few weeks. She vexed with the behavior of Ravindra Chary and decided to take revenge by eliminating him. She expressed the same with her son Naresh, who inturn shared his views with his friends Anup Darvesh (Rowdy sheeter of Kulsumpura PS) and Sandeep (Suspect of Kulsumpura PS) and sought their help. The accused persons Anup Darvesh, Sandeep along with their friends Ravi and Lokesh have hatched a plan. According to their plan, on 02-03-2017 evening hours, Anup Darvesh, Sandeep and Lokesh went to Toddy shop, Puranapool, wherein they met with the deceased and all consumed toddy/liquor. After that, they along with their friend Lokesh took the deceased to the graveyard of Imampura in a rented auto and they also followed the auto on the Yamaha Fz motorcycle of Sandeep and informed the same to A1 Smt.Shoba and beat him with hands and stick indiscriminately at 1730 hours, due to which he fell down and became unconscious. After that, the accused Smt.Shobha, brought kerosene from her house in a can, poured on the body of the deceased and set him to fire. Due to which his body was completely burnt. After committing the offence, all the accused except A1 fled away from there.

In pursuance of the confession of A1 Smt.Shobha, apprehended the other accused persons A2: Anoop Darvesh s/o. Suresh Darvesh, aged 24 yrs, Occ: Salesman, r/o. K.S. Nagar, Ziaguda, Hyderabad, A3: Sandeep Kamle s/o. Babu Rao Kamle, aged 26 yrs, Occ: Band worker, r/o. H.No: 13-3-506/379, MCH Quarters, Ziaguda, Hyderabad, A4: Panuganti Lokesh s/o. Late P. Narsimha, aged 22 yrs, Occ: Mixie Repairing, r/o. Near Scholar School, Venkateshwar Nagar, Puranapul, Hyderabad, A5: Myatari Ravi Kumar s/o. M. Anjaiah, aged 20 yrs, Occ: Salesman, r/o. Saidurga Nagar, Ziaguda, Hyderabad and A6: Ambati Naresh s/o. Late A. Yadagiri, aged 24 yrs, Occ: Worker in Scrap shop, r/o. Saidurga Nagar, Ziaguda, Hyderabad at Kashibugga Temple.

DETAILS OF THE ACCUSED

- A-1 Tummy Sai Nanda Kishore @ Satyanarayana @ Satya @ Akhshay @ Rajesh Kumar @ Sheshadri Kumar @ Sanjay Kumar @ Chinna s/o Eshwar, 31-years, Munnuru Kapu, Rice Business r/o H.No. 16-9-380/77, Old Malakpet, Hyderabad
- A-2 Mohammed Abdul Raheem @ Feroze s/o Mohammed Yousuf, 29-years, Muslim, Broker r/o H.No. 16-9-377/2, Housing Board Colony, Old Malakpet, Hyderabad

A-1 Tummy Sai Kishore used to identify the premises where the To-let Boards are displayed and introduce the Watchman expressing his willingness to take the premises on rent and by saying so he collects his Contact No. Then he contacts the Dealers/Distributors of Cosmetics and Confectionary products and place an order amounting to Rs. 1,00,000/- by giving the consignment delivery address as the To-Let address. After the receipt/delivery of the consignment at the said address he collects the contact number of the delivery person from the watchman and contacts the delivery person asking him to come to a nearby place on the plea of collecting the bill amount.

As soon as the Delivery persons leave the place for collecting the cash from A-1, A-2 Mohammed Abdul Raheem @ Feroze collects the delivered consignment and decamped with the booty.

A-1 is addicted to play Horse race betting and other all bad vices while A-2 is addicted to alcohol and other bad vices. For which they adopted these means to earn easy money.

On 04.03.2017 at about 1100 hrs. the accused persons A-1 and A-2 were arrested while they were moving in the locality of Padmashali Colony near the house of and 9-cartoons of Fogg Deodorant (Each cartoon contains 72-bottles) and 3-cartoons of Garnier Hair Dye (Each Cartoon contains 36-pieces), 4-boxes of Dairy Milk Chocolate (Each Box contains 36-bars), 12-Boxes of Snickers (each box contains 32-Bars), 240-Bottles of Nivea Deodorant, 420-Loreal Majirel Hair dye tubes, 25-Bags Silver Hot pack weighing about 15-Kgs. all worth Rs. 4,50,000/- and net cash Rs.1,10,000/- and a motor cycle bearing No. AP 29 F 3630 have been recovered.

The above accused persons were arrested on 04.03.2017 and being produced in the Court for judicial remand.
