NOTIFICATION

WHEREAS, it has been brought to my notice that the Terrorist/ Antisocial elements may organize attacks through Para Gliders, Remote Controlled Drones, Remote Controlled Micro Light Aircraft etc., and that there is an increasing trend by events organizers to use remote controlled drones for getting aerial views for live telecasts and photography of various events.

WHEREAS, inputs have been received by Intelligence agencies about the possibility of attacks by Terrorist/Antisocial elements by the use of Para-gliders, Remote Controlled Drones, Remote Controlled Micro-Light Aircraft, etc., and there is every likelihood of breach of peace and disturbance of Public tranquility and also there is grave danger to human life, health, safety and damage to public property on that account.

AND WHEREAS, it is necessary that reasonable checks are imposed on activities of such antisocial elements in the limits of Hyderabad City Police Commissionerate to prevent the attack through Remote Controlled Drones or through Para-Gliders or through Remotely Controlled Micro-Light Aircraft.

NOW THEREFORE, I, M.Mahendar Reddy, IPS, Commissioner of Police and Executive Magistrate of Hyderabad City vide powers conferred upon me u/sec 144 of the Criminal Procedure Code 1973 (Act II of 1974), **do hereby order that no flying activities of Remotely Controlled Drones or Para-Gliders or Remotely Controlled Micro-Light Aircraft be allowed in the Jurisdiction of Hyderabad City Police Commissionerate limits without prior Police permission in writing.**

No Non-Government agency, organization or individual will be allowed to launch Unmanned Aerial Vehicle (UAV), Unmanned Aerial Survey (UAS) etc.

Government agencies and organizations should obtain appropriate clearance from local Police and Aviation authorities before launching any UAS/UAV for any purpose.

Any person contravening this order shall be punishable under section 188 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860.

This order shall remain in force from 08-09-2017 to 07-10-2017.

As the notice cannot be served individually to all concerned, the order is hereby passed ex-parte. It shall be published for the information of public, through press and by affixing copies on the Notice Boards of the Police Stations, Divisional ACsP, Zonal DCsP offices.

NOTIFICATION

WHEREAS, reports have been received indicating that High Volume Sound Emitting Systems including DJs (High Volume Sound Mixers) are being generating noise beyond permissible limits (day time 55 db(A) and night time 45 db(A) in Residential Areas, day time 65 db(A) and night time 55 db(A) in Commercial Areas) in places of public gatherings including Processions causing inconvenience, disturbance, nuisance, annoyance and Under Section 67(c) prohibit bursting of fire crackers on public places / public roads, public meetings and marriages to the residents of locality and public in general.

WHEREAS, such acts have been causing acute inconvenience and distress among the children, old aged persons, patients and students in particular pursuing their studies in the residential localities.

WHEREAS, such High Volume sounds generated at Public Meetings, Marriages and Processions have been neutralizing Police Communication Systems deployed in relation to bandobust duties, thereby adversely affecting the function of maintenance of Public Order and Tranquillity by Law Enforcement Agencies.

AND WHEREAS, it is considered expedient to take stringent and speedy measures to control the use of High Volume Sound Emitting Systems including DJs (High Volume Sound Mixers) in place of Public gatherings including processions in the residential localities.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred under Rule 8 of Noise Pollution (Regulation & Control) Rules 2000, I, M. Mahendar Reddy, IPS Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad City, do hereby make this written order and notify the same to the General Public Prohibiting the following within Hyderabad City, except in cases specifically permitted by the Divisional Asst. Commissioners of Police of the concerned jurisdiction:

- Use of High Volume Sound Systems including DJs (High Volume Sound Mixers) emanating sound levels beyond permissible limits in places of Public Gatherings including Processions in the Residential Localities.
- Prohibit bursting of fire crackers at public places / public roads, public meetings and marriage function halls causing inconvenience to the residents of locality and public in general.

This order shall come into force from 06:00 hrs on 07-09-2017 and shall remain in force for a period of 15 days i.e., upto 06:00 hrs on 21-09-2017, both days inclusive unless withdrawn earlier.

Any person violating this order shall be liable for punishment u/s 67(c), 188 of IPC and u/s 76 of the Hyderabad City Police Act, 1348 Fasli.

NOTIFICATION

WHEREAS, reports have been received indicating that consumption of liquor in public places has become rampant and unhindered in several areas of the City of Hyderabad, resulting in to a menace to the common members of the public, especially women and children in particular.

AND WHEREAS, such reports have been indicating that, persons consuming liquor in public places have been exhibiting abrasive unruly and indecent behavior on the streets of Hyderabad City towards law abiding citizens especially women and children in particular endangering their modesty and safety in addition to causing disturbance to public tranquility resulting in annoyance and obstruction to road users in general and women and children in particular.

WHEREAS, such unruly and indecent behavior has been instilling a sense of fear psychosis in law abiding citizens, especially women and children resulting in restriction of their free movement on the streets of Hyderabad, thereby affecting public safety at large and safety and security of women and children in particular.

AND WHEREAS, it is considered necessary to take speedy measures in this regard to prevent danger to human life and safety and security of women and children or for preventing any affray and disturbance of public tranquility.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me under Section 144 of Criminal Procedure Code 1973, I, M. Mahendar Reddy, IPS, Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad City, do hereby make this written order and notify the same to the General Public **prohibiting Consumption of liquor in public places in the City of Hyderabad.**

This order is published for the information of public through the media and through the public address system in the areas affected with drunkenness in public places.

This order shall come into force from 0600 hours on 06-09-2017 and shall remain in force for a period of one week i.e. upto 0600 hours on 12-09-2017 (both days inclusive) unless withdrawn earlier.

Any person violating this order shall be liable for punishment under Section 188 of the Indian Penal code and as per the provisions of Hyderabad City Police Act, 1348 Fasli.

NOTIFICATION

With a view to maintain public order, peace and tranquility in the twin cities of Hyderabad and Secunderabad, I, M. Mahendar Reddy, IPS, Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad City, in exercise of the powers vested in me under section 22(1) (a) to (f) and 22 (2) (a) and (b) of Hyderabad City Police Act, 1348 Fasli (No.IX), do hereby issue the following prohibitory orders.

- I Prohibit to hold any kind of public meetings, and processions within the Hyderabad City, without obtaining prior permission of Zonal Dy. Commissioners of Police, Law and Order concerned, Addl. Commissioner of Police, Law and Order or Jt. Commissioner of Police, Co-ordination & Security or Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad.
 - a) Prohibit carrying of arms such as swords, spears, knives, sticks with or without flags bludgeons, guns, explosives, and other offensive weapons in the above mentioned areas.
 - b) Prohibit gathering of persons on the public roads or public places disturbing peace and order or causing inconvenience, annoyance or danger to public.
 - c) Prohibit collection, carrying of stones or other means of casting missiles.
- II Prohibit use of mikes/public address system by different Organisations around the Secretariat premises, including Burgula Rama Krishna Rao Building, Greater Hyderabad Municipal Corporation Building, Commissioner of Fisheries building, Mint Compound, Nizam College and its surroundings, Telangana / A.P. Legislative Assembly premises and surrounding roads, Public Garden Nampally, Upper Tankbund, I-MAX, Rotary and NTR Marg roads also fly-over road leading from Secretariat to Visweswarayya statue, Khairatabad.
 - a) Prohibit music, singing or speeches or broadcasting through loud speakers in the above mentioned areas.
 - b) Prohibit use of mikes/public address systems, use of horn through vehicles by any organisation, members of public etc., in the above mentioned areas.
- III The public are here by informed that any person violating the above orders shall be liable for prosecution under the Hyderabad City Police Act, 1348, Fasli (No. IX).
- IV **The following are exempted from the operation of this order**
 - (i) Police Officers on duty,
 - (ii) Military personnel on duty,
 - (iii) Home Guards on duty,
 - (iv) Bonafide funeral processions.

This order shall be in force with effect from 0600 hours on 07-09-2017 to 0600 hours on 13-09-2017.

- This year the Final **Ganesh Idol Immersion Procession will start on 05-09-2017 (Tuesday)** from various places of Hyderabad and Secunderabad to Hussain Sagar lake and other places. On that day thousands of Ganesh Idols from Hyderabad, Cyberabad, Rachakonda, Medak, Nalgonda and Mahboob Nagar Districts are expected to be Immersed in Hussain Sagar Lake.

Ganesh Idols Places of Immersion

- Tail end water body of Hussain Sagar Lake Opposite Deccan Continental Hotel
- Rajanna Bowli
- Miralam Tank
- Errakunta
- Shaikpet Tank
- Saroornagar Tank
- Safilguda / Malkajgiri Tank
- Hashmathpet Tank

- About 10 to 15 Lakh people are expected to participate in the final procession.

12262 Idols that have been installed after giving information to Police and several others will be immersed this Year. Out of these 50 – 60 % of Ganesh Idols have been immersed till now and more than 6,000 have to be taken out during the last 2 days of Immersion.

In addition to the above Force 6 Units of Greyhounds and 3 Units of Octopus kept as Stand-to for any emergency.

- Forces of all the Units of Hyderabad City Police viz., Law and Order, Traffic, Special Branch, Task Force, City Security Wing, City Armed Reserve have been pressed into service in making security and bandobust arrangements.
- Emergency response teams are being stationed at strategic locations in the route
- **They are deployed** for bandobust for Ganesh Pandals, Mosques, important junctions, immersion points and other places of requirement.
- The Force and Officers deployed have been chosen in such that they had previous experience of Ganesh bandobust and knowledge of sensitive and hypersensitive areas.
- **310 Hypersensitive and 605 Sensitive places** have been identified for which pickets have been posted. Total **410 Mobile Parties** are moving in the area for smooth conduct of the Ganesh Festival.
- Last year-2016, 11074 Ganesh Idols were permitted to be installed in various public places.
- This year-2017, 10232 Ganesh Idols were permitted to be installed in various public places.

The City Security Wing of Hyderabad City Police is deploying **16 Bomb Disposal Teams, 2 Access Control Teams** at important Ganesh Pandal and Ganesh Temples. They are equipped with **DFMDs, HFMDs**, Prodder, Deep Search mine detector, under carriage mirror, explosive detector etc. The Anti-Sabotage Teams will be using the services of **22 Sniffer Dogs**.

Anti-Sabotage measures like Vehicle checking and frisking at entry points to the City and at important junctions and checking at important crowded places viz., Railway Stations, Bus Stations, Shopping malls, Cinema Halls, Hotels, Restaurants etc., are being undertaken.

- Meetings were conducted by the Government, Telangana State, Hyderabad with Ganesh Utsav Samithi Members apart from number of meetings with DCsP and above and with all Inspectors and ACsP of City Police.
- All bandobust arrangements are being made taking police Station as basic unit.
- We identified need for 51 Static Cranes as follows.
 1. NTR Marg – 12 + 4 Reserve = 16
 2. Tankbund – 23 + 2 Reserve = 25
 3. Ministers Road - 3 = 03
 4. Rajanna Bowli – 3 = 03
 5. Miralam Tank and Errakunta Tank – 2 each
 6. Further need for 108 Mobile Cranes has been identified for the Final day.
 7. Mobile generators, Mobile Cranes, Ambulances, Medical Teams, Fire Tenders, Spare Vehicles, Mechanic Teams, Public Address Systems are being stationed at all the important and strategic Junctions.
 8. Requested for teams of repairers/mechanics apart from shift duty drivers from TSRTC.
- Constant liaison has been established with GHMC, Irrigation Department, R&B, Transport Department, TSRTC, Metro Water and TSSPDCL.
- Main Joint Control Room has been established at Sardar Mahal, GHMC, Hyderabad which started functioning from 25-08-2017. It will function till conclusion of final immersion on 06-09-2017. Apart from that, three more Joint Control Rooms will function from 07:00 am on 04-09-2017 to 12.00 Noon on 06-09-2017 at 1. Main Police Control Room, Basheerbagh, 2. NTR Marg and 3. Gandhi Nagar, Outpost Tankbund.
- Stern action will be taken against those who make provocative speeches or circulate CDs etc. Such material i.e., CDs, pamphlets will be seized and legal action will be taken.
- SHE teams and Crime teams are being deployed to prevent eve teasing and to proceed safety to the people
- Roof tops with communication sets and sophisticated Binoculars are stationed in the route
- 600 Additional Wireless sets have been deployed in addition to the existing 4000 no. of sets.
- The event is being covered by more than 800 Video Cameras, some of which will be monitored on a real time basis from Control Room.
- All steps are being taken to ensure that rumors of any kind are nipped at the bud.
- We are enlisting the cooperation of the Peace Committee members and Bhagyanagar Ganesh Utsav Samithi for maintaining peace and harmony in the City.
- We appeal to citizens of Hyderabad all for harmony and brotherhood among Hindus and Muslims to uphold the great traditions of this City.

ROUTE OF THE MAIN PROCESSION

The Main Procession on 04-09-2017 and 05-09-2017 will start at Keshavagiri and proceed towards Hussain Sagar via Chandrayangutta, Chatrinaka, Lal Darwaza , Nagulchintha, Shahalibanda, Moghalpura, Charminar, Gulzar Houz & Pathergatti (South zone) Afzalgunj, Siddiamber Bazar, M.J.Market (East Zone), Abids and Basheerbagh (Central Zone). The other processions coming from Balapur, Pahadi

Sharif, Maheswaram, Mahankali etc. of R.R. District will join the main procession at Keshavagiri. The procession, which starts at Aliabad will pass through Syed Ali Chabutra and join the main procession at Shahalibanda. Small processions from the neighbouring areas like Engine Bowli, Falaknuma will join the procession at Aliabad. Tributary processions coming from Gowlipura, Chandulal Bela, Hari Bowli will join the main procession at Nagulchinta.

The Processions coming from old Kabutara Khana, Shahgunj, Chelapura and Alijah Kotla which pass through sensitive areas like Hussain Alam, Chowk Mosque, Ladbazar, Etiibar Chowk will join the main procession at Charminar. The procession which starts at Indira Seva Sadan (Santosh Nagar Cross Roads) will pass through Saidabad, Govt. Printing Press, Police Hospital (Malakpet), Nalgonda x road, Chaderghat, Victoria Play Grounds, Puthlibowli x roads, Jambagh and join the main procession at M.J.Market. Small processions of neighbouring areas like Santosh Nagar, Saroor Nagar, Dilsuk Nagar, Karman ghat etc. will join the procession at Saidabad x Roads and Nalgonda x roads.

Some Tributary Processions which start from various localities also join the main procession at different points i.e. at Lal Darwaza, Nagulchinta, Charminar, Afzalgunj, M.J. Market, Liberty x roads etc. Some small processions will directly go to Hussain Sagar for immersion.

The Procession from West Zone areas of Mehdipatnam, Langer House, Tappachabutra, Karwan, Puranapul, Jummerat Bazar and Begum Bazar also join the main procession at M.J.Market. Another procession from Mehdipatnam passes through Mallepally X roads and Bazarghat and joins at M.J.Market. Yet another procession starts from S.R.Nagar and passes through Panjagutta, Somajiguda, Khairtabad, Iqbal Minor, Secretariat and reaches NTR Marg. Similarly, there will be smaller processions from Secunderabad and Hyderabad reaching the Hussain Sagar Lake.

TECHNOLOGICAL INNOVATIONS TO ENRICH THE QUALITY OF BANDOBUST

- This year each Idol that is registered with Hyderabad City Police is allotted a QR Code which will be helpful in monitoring the coverage by patrolling and visits / surprise visits of Senior Officers.
- There has been a major technological breakthrough as regards the holding – hooks used in immersion of the Idols which will reduced the time of immersion considerably i.e. by 30 – 40 %.
- Hyderabad City Police installed more than 15000 cameras to cover each and every corner of the procession in the City and all cameras are connected to the network and viewing the facility is provided to the all Officers with the help of the Mobile Applications. With this feature Hyderabad City Police can access all cameras through mobile on their fingertips.
- Considering the importance and sensitivity of the Balapur Ganesh Idol Nimajjanam Procession route City Police are established 1500 CCTVs along the route.
- Hyderabad City Police are focusing on the surveillance in the crime perspective and towards this end installed 10 Megapixel Cameras which are having the range of covering 500 Mts distance and having Facial Recognition facility also.
- By establishing separate Command Control Centre with CCTVs Surveillance at Charminar the City Police can now monitor now the entire procession in the old city area. Command Control Centre has been established at Tank Band to look after the entire immersion.
- By having network connectivity at CP Office, DGP Office and CM camp office the senior officers can monitor the entire Procession and Nimajjanam closely and they have been going instructions and guidelines accordingly.

- The City Police have been covering entire procession process with help of Camera Mounted vehicles which are having the capability of PTZ (Pan-Tilt-Zoom) and wireless connectivity to the Command Control Centre.
- The City Police are monitoring all the Idol Immersion cranes by installing a special Long Range Camera at boat club, Hussain sagar. The Long Range Camera is having the feature of wireless connectivity with a Range of 5 KM distance and has been extremely helpful in closely monitoring each and every corner of the immersion at the Tank Band.

INTER STATE PERSON STALKING THE WOMEN ON PHONE WAS HELD

The sleuths of DD, CCS, Hyderabad City Police **Special Team** apprehended accused Durgesh Kumar Agarwal at Morena in Madhya Pradesh state and seized one Mobile Phone from his possession.

Details of Accused:

Durgesh Kumar Agarwal, S/o B.D. Agarwal, r/o H.No.218, Purana Sabji Mandi, Dattapura, Morena, M.P. state.

Brief Facts:

The complainant Smt. G. Laxmi Madhavi, aged 36 yrs, Inspector of Police of Women Police Station, South Zone, Hyderabad complained that on the intervening night of 12/13-08-2017 at 00.30 hours onwards she receiving phone calls to her official Govt. mobile phone number **9490616508** from mobile number **7974078839** more than five times, and used utmost filthy language. He also threatened her with dire-consequences and warned to punish her. She disconnected his phone calls, even though he repeatedly called and abused her. She also found that the person also called in her Police Station (WPS, South Zone, Hyderabad) land line number 040-27854852 on the same day night. The unknown person calling her to cause harm with an intention of harass, humiliate and disturb her mentally. On her complaint a case was registered in CCS, Hyderabad.

The Special Team went to Morena District, M,P state and apprehended the accused Durgesh Kumar Agarwal. On interrogation he confessed that he took a Reliance Mobile phone No.7974078839 through which he randomly select women numbers on browsing internet and calls them in the midnight. After hearing the voice of women he starts talking in abusive language and harass them. Earlier he was also caught by Kothwali PS of Morena District for the similar offence. Further he revealed that he made such calls and harassed about (20) women in and around Hyderabad, Warangal, Nizamabad in Telangana state and West Godavari, Guntur, Chittoor districts in A.P. He also harassed by making number of such calls in other states i.e. Assam, Bihar, Delhi, Goa, Haryana, J&K, Karnataka, Kerala, Maharashtra, M.P, Orissa, Punjab, Rajasthan, Tamilnadu, West Bengal and Gujrath. He has also called several senior Police Officers in different states in the past.

The accused was produced in the Hon'ble Chief Judicial Magistrate at Morena and obtained Transit Warrant and will be produced before the concerned Court in Hyderabad.

The arrest was made by Special Team, CCS, DD, Hyderabad.
