**NOTIFICATION**

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me under section 21(1) (b) of the Hyderabad City Police Act, I, M.Mahendar Reddy, IPS., Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad, do hereby notify, for information of the general public, that, In order to make arrangements for the early commencement of commercial operations of Hyderabad Metro Rail and for the speedy completion of preparatory works, the OLIPHENTA RAILWAY BRIDGE Secunderabad will be closed, and to avoid inconvenience to the general public the following traffic diversions are made and will be in force for a period of **(15) days from 7-08-2017 midnight.**

**:-TRAFFIC DIVERSION:-**

- 1) The Vehicular traffic coming from Musheerabad and Seethafalmandi towards Secunderabad and Begumpet will be diverted at Chilkalguda X roads towards, Alugaddabavi – Rail Nilayam – Sangeeth X roads – left turn and proceed towards, Rethifile Bus station, Secunderabad and right turn at Sangeeth X roads towards Begumpet. All the TSRTC Buses coming from Sitafalmandi and Musheerabad will be terminated at Chilkalguda Rotary.
- 2) All the RTC Buses coming from Sangeeth to Uppal Bus Stop will take U turn at Delight Hotel only.
- 3) The Railway passenger traffic coming from Mettuguda, Sitafalmandi and Musheerabad towards Secunderabad Railway Station are requested to board train from Platform No. 10 side at Chilkalguda X roads.

- 4) The vehicular traffic coming from Begumpet towards Musheerabad and Chilkalguda will be diverted at Sangeeth Cross road- left turn – Alugaddabavi – left turn – should take U turn at Hyderabad Tent House – towards Chilkalguda X roads.
- 5) The vehicular traffic coming from Patny & YMCA towards Musheerabad and Chilkalguda will be diverted at Sangeeth Cross road- straight to Alugaddabavi – left turn – should take U turn at Hyderabad Tent House – towards Chilkalguda X roads and Musheerabad.
- 6) All the traffic coming from Secunderbad Railway Station ( front side ) towards Musheerabad – Tarnaka and Chilkalguda will be diverted at Delight Hotel- Left turn- towards Sangeeth X roads- right turn- Alugaddabavi – should take U turn at Hyderabad Tent House – towards Chilkalguda X roads.
- 7) There will be no change in the flow of traffic which comes from YMCA and Garden Hotel towards Mettuguda and Tarnaka side.

The above traffic restrictions will be in force for a period of **(15)** days from the date of the issue of this Notification and the people are requested to take alternate routes and co-operate with the Traffic Police to ensure smooth flow of traffic.

**FROM CHEYUTHA TO PRE-RECRUITMENT PROGRAMME WITH TECHNOLOGY AND  
INTERFACE**

To-day, Cheyutha’s 7,000 unemployed have been further filtered at backend to undergo free pre training for Police constable recruitment of Hyderabad, Telangana State. 1875 (1153 Male and 722 Female) are found eligible to join free coaching classes for Police Constable in the forthcoming recruitment of Hyderabad City Police.

The programme is aimed at training the weaker section youth to clear the upcoming exams in Armed Forces and Police Department. How Cheyutha rolled out into action plan for pre-recruitment for SIs/PCs.

- i. From Backend data base of Cheyutha website of 6690, 1875 youths were found eligible as per online information already available,
- ii. Received 2230 applications on line in 3-weeks Police Station-wise
- iii. Candidates as they applied, were physically checked by BCs/Patrol Officers in each Police Station,
- iv. All applied candidates were called to respective Police Station for cross verification of information provided online (both physical and documentary). They were interviewed, given firsthand experience of how Police Station is and duties of a Constable officer,
- v. They were binded before elders of locality in each Police Station before SHO for taking Free coaching seriously
- vi. They are provided facility to see their application and informed their performances/doubts/on website model papers itself, Website is going to be an open interaction forum for each candidates selected for pre-recruitment (free) coaching Camp
- vii. details of institute/time table is also displayed on website

### **ADVANTAGES**

1. All SHOs have owned up candidates up to BC/Patrol officer of their limits, have their e-Bio Data with them of every candidate for follow-up and motivation,
2. Website is going to be open forum for all kinds of information in future,
3. Decentralized/coaching in each division is announced and inaugurated

### **TRAINING CENTERS**

For the purpose of training 3-Centers at YMCA, Secunderabad (Gopalpuram Division), Tivoli Gardens (Begumpet Division) and D.A.D. (Mahankali Division) under the charge of Divisional ACsP at each center have been arranged. In this regard the following procedure is adapted to impart coaching for the 1245 Candidates in three batches each batch consists of 415-candidates.

## CORDON AND SEARCH OPERATION IN THE LIMITS OF BAHADURPURA POLICE STATION

O/o the Dy. Commissioner of Police,

DATE: 05/08/2017.

South Zone Police altogether 325 Police Officers & men and women force with TSSP, City Armed Force Task Force and Staff of Special Branch conducted Cordon and Search Operation at Asad Baba Nagar, Kishanbagh in the limits of PS Bahadurpura between 05:30 hrs to 09:00 hrs on 05/07/2017 which is sensitive location boarding to Cyberabad; Hyderabad and situated on the bank of Musi River in order to curtail the criminal activities and to create sense of security in the minds of the public.

Locality People of Asad Baba Nagar, Kishanbagh were also requested to conduct the operations in their locality. People are coming forward and requesting the police to conduct the similar search operations.

### "E- FINGER PRINTS RECOGNITION DEVICE" & "HYDCOPS"

E-Finger Prints Recognition Device and " HYDCOPS APP" were used in this search operation. With the help of this device police verified the finger prints of the persons moving in suspicious circumstance in the cordoned locality without causing the disturbance to the locality people. Nearly 250 persons were tested with this E-finger Print Equipment. 84 Suspects, 23 Old Criminals involved in property offences, 20 Rowdy sheeters were taken into custody for verification of their complicity; 1 vehicle lifter-Salman who is wanted for Kanchanbagh and Chandrayangutta Police was arrested and one cell phone offender Syed Sajeed S/o Syed Ali r/o Dhoud Bwoli who is wanted for Bahadurpura Police in Cr.no.12/17 U/sec 379 IPC and involved in 7 theft other cases of Rachakonda Commissionrate limits was also apprehended.

### **CAUGHT OLD AUTO MOBILE OFFENDER - SALMAN**

With the help of "E- FINGER PRINTS RECOGNITION DEVICE" & "HYDCOPS" application, one Auto mobile offender Salman wanted in one three wheeler theft case and one two wheeler case of Kanchanbagh PS and also wanted in three wheeler case of Chandrayangutta PS was caught under suspicious circumstances and arrested. He is resident of Chandrayangutta.

### **CAUGHT CELL OFFENDER – SYED SAJEED.**

Syed Sajeed s/o Syed Ali r/o Dhoud Bowli, Hussaini Alam wanted by Pahadi Shareef PS, Meerpet and other police stations of Rachakonda and involved in Cr.no.12/17 U/sec 379 IPC of Bahadurpura PS was apprehended under the suspicious circumstances and effected the arrest and remanded to judicial custody.

### **56 TWO WHEELERS & 17 THREE WHEELER:**

Police have also verified the documents of vehicles in which 56 two wheelers & 17 three wheelers were taken into custody to verify the documents which were found in suspicious condition without Number Plates and documents.

On verification two, two wheelers viz TVS VICTOR ; AP-28-AJ-1943 AND BAJAJ PULSUR – BLACK CLOUR – AP 09 EC 9075 were found without documents. Look out circulars is being circulated to all police stations of Hyderabad / Cyberabad / Rachakonda to know any cases theft reported at their respective police stations. On 15 two wheelers, E-challans were also pending and the same were handed over to Traffic PS Bahadurpura.

### **FOUND A ILLEGAL MANUFACTURING OF MEHANDI AND OTHER BEAUTY PRODUCTS:**

While searching in the houses, police found one person Md. Javeed preparing various Mehandi / beauty products at his house situated at Asad Baba Nagar without proper license from concerned competent authority and police Bahadurpura seized the company for public safety purpose and registered a case under section 420 IPC. Sample of the Mehandi and other beauty products are being sent to FSL for chemical analysis to know the harmful chemicals which are using in preparation of Mehandi and other beauty products which is dangerous lives of the public.

### **ADULTERATED COOKING OIL:**

Search parties located one Md. Rasheed s/o Md. Younus seller of adulterated cooking oil and seized 4 tins of oil, each tin consist of 15 liters of oil.

He collects cooking oil of various brands from various vendors like to clean the oil tins. After collecting the tins he used to collect last remaining oil in the tins at one place and sell it to the public.

A case in cr. No. 164/17 U/sec 420, 272 IPC has been registered and effected the arrest and being sent to judicial remand.

#### ILLEGAL STORAGE OF LIQOUR ON THE BANKS OF MUSI RIVER.

Police also seized 40 beer bottles belongs to Knock out and KF Strong beers, two cartoons of Mc Whisky quarter bottles which were kept by unknown persons on the bank of Musi River. Police is keeping the surveillance in on the banks of Musi River in order to curtail such nuisance issues.

#### Checked the houses of Refugees families of Burman nationals:

During the search operations police checked the houses of refugee families of Burman Nationals. There are 22 families taking shelter in the rented houses at Asad Baba Nagar. Search parties under the supervision of the rank of Inspector checked the Refuge cards. The refuge cards of six members were expired are over stayed. On verification they have applied for extension of their stay to United Nations High Commission for Refugees.

They were informed that they should inform their current doings, place of working and occupation to the local police.

The house owners are requested to inform the tenancy particulars of the refugees to the local police.

In the course of this Cordon & Search operation we used Geo- tagging in keeping view of the innocent public and not to disturb or create any inconvenience to the common public. In future we are going to conduct more Cordon searches to create the sense of security in the minds of public and stop the unsocial and bad elements in the society.

## PRESS NOTE

### FAKE EDUCATIONAL CERTIFICATE RACKET BUSTED- ONE HELD - SEIZED FAKE EDUCATIONAL CERTIFICATES OF KARNATAKA STATE OPEN UNIVERSITY

The sleuths of Commissioner's Task Force, West Zone team on 04-08-2017 apprehended one person by name B.Laxmi Narayana, who indulging in preparing fake Educational certificates of Degree & P.G. on the name of Karnataka State Open University and providing them to the needy customers by collecting huge money from them at his Computer Training Institute "TISHT" #12-13-1260, 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor, Above Meera Medical Hall, Beside Andhra bank, Street No.7, Tarnaka, Hyderabad. **Seized (20) Fake Educational certificates of Karnataka State Open University and (1) Cell phone** from his possession.

#### ACCUSED:

1. B.Laxmi Narayana @ Raj Kumar S/o B.Nageshwar Rao, aged 40 yrs, Occ: Running Computer Training Institute on the name of "TISHT" #12-13-1260, 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor, Above Meera Medical Hall, Beside Andhra bank, Street No.7, Tarnaka, Hyderabad, R/o H.No.12-1-193/A, Kummur wadi, Asif Nagar, Hyderabad.

#### MODUS OPERNIDI:

The accused B.Laxmi Narayana is native of Hyderabad. In the year 1998 he completed his B.A. In the year 2001 he opened a computer training institute on the name of "TISHT", (Tara Institute of Software and Hardware Technology), #12-13-1260, Beside Andhra bank, Tarnaka, Hyderabad. But from past three years he did not get any profits and he is facing financial problems. At the same time in the year 2015 he came into contact with one person by name M.Satyanarayana, Chairman of "HIWORTH EDUCATIONS", #12-13-677/65, 1<sup>st</sup> Floor, Road No.1, Plot No.188, Kimtee Colony, Tarnaka, Hyderabad, who is issuing Fake Educational Certificates of Degree & Post Graduation to the needy customers on the name of "Karnataka State Open University" within 45 days by charging huge money from them. As such he hatched a plan to supply Fake Educational Certificates on the name Karnataka State Open University to the needy customers with the help of M.Satyanarayana. He informed the same to M.Satyanarayan. He agreed with him on commission basis to supply fake educational certificates to him.

He used to collect the data of the students who needs Educational certificates and used to give the candidate details i.e. SSC & Intermediate Memo Xerox copies, Photos etc to M.Satyanarayana by hand. After preparation of Fake certificates i.e. Degree & Post Graduation he used to send the same to him. Later he will give the fake certificates to needy customers by charging of Rs.30,000/- for Degree i.e. B.Com, B.Tech Certificates and Rs.40,000/- for Post Graduation i.e. M.B.A., M.A. certificates etc. So far he sold fake educational certificates nearly 50-80 persons. In this case the accused M.Satyanarayana is at large.

The accused along with seized property was handed over to SHO, OU Sity PS, for taking further necessary action.

The arrest was made under the supervision of Sri B.Limba Reddy, Dy.Commissioner of Police, Commissioner's Task Force, by Sri L.Raja Venkat Reddy, Inspector of Police with the assistance of SI's Sri M.Prabhakar Reddy, Sri P.Mallikarjun, Sri L.Bhaskar Reddy and the staff of West Zone Team, Commissioner's Task Force, Hyderabad.
