- 15 Assembly Constituencies are falling in Hyderabad city.
- 4 ACs are falling in neighboring Commissionerate i.e., Cyberabad and Rachakonda.
- 15 Nodal Officers are identified for 15 Assembly Constituencies at the rank of ACP.
- All the Nodal Officers and concerned Police Officers have visited each Polling Station, made their observations with regard to the accessibility, condition of building, sensitivity of the areas and made analyzed criticality of polling Station
- Total **3911** Polling Stations in 1574 polling locations.
- **161** are **S1** polling stations **334** are **S2** and **S3** locations
- **21 Vulnerable Hamlets** / Areas in which **17 polling stations** are identified
- Total **426 Police Routes** are planned
- **3 Static Surveillance Teams and 3 Flying Squads will be working round the clock** in each Assembly Constituency to address MCC violations and for expenditure monitoring.
- These SST and FS will be covering all the political parties rallies, programmes, road shows and they videographer major political party meetings.
- **60 QRT teams** and **17 SSF** teams are formed.
- **12 inter boarder check** posts were functioning.
- **51 Check posts** will be working on the day of poll at different places.
- **302 law and order Pickets** are placed.
- **93 interception teams** were formed
- Formed **60 Shadow Teams** in each constituency.

- **On the day of Election, a total of 518 check posts / Pickets will be functioning.**
- Necessary communication systems like **UHF 3300** are arranged.
- Utilized CAPF optimally in Hyderabad city conducted **126 flag march, 98 route march, 146 vehicle checkings** and **confidence building, Cordon and search** operated.
- We have completed **2 rounds** of training camps with regard to election related subjects like MCC violations and poll day arrangements, utilization of CAPF and state police, etc., upto a rank of PC at SHO, Divisional and zonal level and CP office.
- Security arrangements were made at **(15) Distribution, Reception and counting centres** with CAPF
