NOTIFICATION

WHEREAS, reports have been received indicating that High Volume Sound Emitting Systems including DJs (High Volume Sound Mixers) are being generating noise beyond permissible limits (day time 55 db(A) and night time 45 db(A) in Residential Areas, day time 65 db(A) and night time 55 db(A) in Commercial Areas) in places of public gatherings including Processions causing inconvenience, disturbance, nuisance, annoyance and Under Section 67(c) prohibit bursting of fire crackers on public places / public roads, public meetings and marriages to the residents of locality and public in general.

WHEREAS, such acts have been causing acute inconvenience and distress among the children, old aged persons, patients and students in particular pursuing their studies in the residential localities.

WHEREAS, such High Volume sounds generated at Public Meetings, Marriages and Processions have been neutralizing Police Communication Systems deployed in relation to bandobust duties, thereby adversely affecting the function of maintenance of Public Order and Tranquillity by Law Enforcement Agencies.

AND WHEREAS, it is considered expedient to take stringent and speedy measures to control the use of High Volume Sound Emitting Systems including DJs (High Volume Sound Mixers) in place of Public gatherings including processions in the residential localities.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred under Rule 8 of Noise Pollution (Regulation & Control) Rules 2000, I, M. Mahendar Reddy, IPS., Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad City, do hereby make this written order and notify the same to the General Public Prohibiting the following within Hyderabad City, except in cases specifically permitted by the Divisional Asst. Commissioners of Police of the concerned jurisdiction:

- Use of High Volume Sound Systems including DJs (High Volume Sound Mixers) emanating sound levels beyond permissible limits in places of Public Gatherings including Processions in the Residential Localities.
- Prohibit bursting of fire crackers at public places / public roads, public meetings and marriage function halls causing inconvenience to the residents of locality and public in general.

This order shall come into force from 06:00 hrs on 09-03-2017 and shall remain in force for a period of 15 days i.e., upto 06:00 hrs on 23-03-2017, both days inclusive unless withdrawn earlier.

Any person violating this order shall be liable for punishment u/s 67(c), 188 of IPC and u/s 76 of the Hyderabad City Police Act, 1348 Fasli.

NOTIFICATION

WHEREAS, it has been brought to my notice that the Terrorist/ Antisocial elements may organize attacks through Para Gliders, Remote Controlled Drones, Remote Controlled Micro Light Aircraft etc., and that there is an increasing trend by events organizers to use remote controlled drones for getting aerial views for live telecasts and photography of various events.

WHEREAS, inputs have been received by Intelligence agencies about the possibility of attacks by Terrorist/Antisocial elements by the use of Para-gliders, Remote Controlled Drones, Remote Controlled Micro-Light Aircraft, etc., and there is every likelihood of breach of peace and disturbance of Public tranquility and also there is grave danger to human life, health, safety and damage to public property on that account.

AND WHEREAS, it is necessary that reasonable checks are imposed on activities of such antisocial elements in the limits of Hyderabad City Police Commissionerate to prevent the attack through Remote Controlled Drones or through Para-Gliders or through Remotely Controlled Micro-Light Aircraft.

NOW THEREFORE, I, M.Mahendar Reddy, IPS, Commissioner of Police and Executive Magistrate of Hyderabad City vide powers conferred upon me u/sec 144 of the Criminal Procedure Code 1973 (Act II of 1974), **do hereby order that no flying activities of Remotely Controlled Drones or Para-Gliders or Remotely Controlled Micro-Light Aircraft be allowed in the Jurisdiction of Hyderabad City Police Commissionerate limits without prior Police permission in writing.**

No Non-Government agency, organization or individual will be allowed to launch Unmanned Aerial Vehicle (UAV), Unmanned Aerial Survey (UAS) etc.

Government agencies and organizations should obtain appropriate clearance from local Police and Aviation authorities before launching any UAS/UAV for any purpose.

Any person contravening this order shall be punishable under section 188 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860.

This order shall remain in force from 08-03-2017 to 07-04-2017.

As the notice cannot be served individually to all concerned, the order is hereby passed ex-parte. It shall be published for the information of public, through press and by affixing copies on the Notice Boards of the Police Stations, Divisional ACsP, Zonal DCsP offices.

NOTIFICATION

Elections to the Telangana Legislative Council in respect of Teacher's Constituencies are scheduled to be held in the Twin Cities of Hyderabad and Secunderabad on 09-03-2017 i.e., on Wednesday.

After reviewing the situation carefully and with a view to maintain public order, peace and tranquility in the Twin Cities of Hyderabad and Secunderabad on 09-03-2017, I, M. Mahendar Reddy, IPS, Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad in exercise of the powers conferred on me Under Section 22 (1) (d) to (f) and 22 (2) (a) to (e) and 22 (3) of Hyderabad City Police, Act do hereby issue the following prohibitory orders:-

1. Prohibit Assembly of persons and any kind of processions
2. Prohibit carrying of sticks either with or without flags, lathies, fire arms, or any other weapons which can be used as weapons for offence or defence by persons in processions, big gathering or meetings within a radius of one K.M. from the Polling Stations
3. Prohibit erection of temporary structures like Shamianas, Pandals, Khannath etc., on thoroughfares, public places and all other places where public throng
4. Prohibit use of mikes/public address system by anybody or parties in the entire Twin Cities of Hyderabad and Secunderabad
5. Prohibit music, singing or speeches or broadcasting through or speakers of any other instruments
6. Prohibit making a speech, gesture or mimetic representation, exhibition or dissemination of pictures, symbols, placards or any other thing which is likely to create religious animosity or hatred between different communities or individuals or is likely to bring about commission of an offence or disturbance or contempt of the law or of a lawful authority

The following are exempted from the operation of this order

- a. Police Officers on duty
- b. Military/Para Military personnel on duty
- c. Home Guards on duty
- d. Election Officers on duty

The public are hereby informed that any person violating the above order shall be liable for prosecution.

This order shall be in force with effect from 1700 hours on 08-03-2017 to 0600 hours on 10-03-2017.

It is noticed that, some of Commuters / Traffic Violators are not paying the e-Challan pending amount, ignoring the Legal Notices / e-Challan. A special drive will be organized w.e.f. **13-03-2017 to 07-04-2017** to curb the repeated violators of e-Challans. Therefore it is requested to general public especially e-Challan Violators to pay their e-Challan immediately to avoid embarrassment.

1. e-Challan violators are given option to pay their fine amounts at **e-Seva/Mee Seva, AP Online Centers as well as Net banking Debit/Credit card facility through “State Bank of Hyderabad” and “ICICI Bank”**. They can also pay fine amounts at the **Traffic Compounding Booth, Traffic Complex, Opp: Public Garden, Nampally, Hyd.**
2. e-Challan violators can pay their fine amounts through **Net Banking** through our website www.htp.gov.in and click **Challan status** or www.echallan.org enter your vehicle Registration Number, if any Challans are pending they can go through and click **Net Banking icon** and pay the Challans through Debit/Credit cards and Net Banking in the easy and simple procedure.
3. **Hyderabad Traffic Police has also developed the Android mobile application for easy payment gateway for paying the Challans. Users can download the Android APK “e-Challan Telangana” through “Play Store”**.
4. If a commuter have Challans pending against him the violator should invariably pay their pending Challan fine amounts immediately at any of above said centers and then only their vehicles /documents will be released.
5. For any clarification the Traffic Help Line center staff will help commuters in guiding payment of pending Challans. Contact Number of helpline is **9010203626**.
6. **This effort is initiated by the Hyderabad Traffic Police to clear the pendency and improve the Traffic enforcement in Hyderabad City and also to improve Traffic Police Citizens interface.**

LAKE POLICE RESCUED THREE PERSONS FROM COMMITTING SUICIDE

On 05/06 of March 2017, P S Lake officials has rescued **Three persons** i.e., two female & one male and their particulars are 1) Smt. Zareena begum, 2) Smt. D. Maheshwari and 3) Sri. Chintala. Raju Were all rescued, while they were about to commit suicide by jumping into the Hussain Sagar Lake. The Details of the victims are as follows:-

First incident: Occurred on 05/03/2017 at 22.50 hours tried to jump into Hussain sagar lake at tank bund near rotary.

Details of Victim: Smt. Zareena begum w/o Sri. MD Aziz pasha, age:- 36 years, Occ:- housewife, r/o:- 24-1243/101, opp Raj bhavan road. MS maqtha, Hyderabad.

Reason: On 05-02-2017 at about 22.50 hrs the victim came to tank bund near Rotary and tried to jump into Hussain sagar lake water, immediately the patrolling police noticed her stopped her by jumping into the Lake water and saved her life. On causing enquiry it came to know that the victim got marriage and blessed with three children and leading conjugal life happily. Last night the victim and her husband quarrelled with each other in a petty family issues due to which she went into depression and decided to end her life. After counselling both ther wife and husband were sent to Barosa counselling centre for further action.

Second incident: Occurred on 06/03/2017 at 01.30 hours tried to Jump into water at upper tank bund near Lepakshi.

Details of Victim: Smt. D. Maheshwari w/o Sri. D. Satish, age:- 40 years, Occ:- housewife, r/o:- 1-10-287, comsary bazaar, new bowenpally, Sec-bad.

Reason: On causing enquiry it came to know that the victim got married with Sri. D. Satish and leading conjugal life happily. In the evening hours on 05-03-2017 the victim quarrelled with her in-laws in a petty family matter. Due to which he went into depression and tried to jump into water. Immediately our patrolling Lake police noticed her and saved her life. Inspector lake Smt. K. Sreedevi counselled her and handed over to her husband.

Third INCIDENT: It occurred on 06.03.2017 at around 13.00 hour's upper tankbund near Love Hyd.

Details of Victim:- Sri. Chitala. Raju s/o Sri. Ch. Yadagiri, age:- 27 years, occ:- vegetables vendor, r/o:- 7-2-249, takkar basthi, near city light hotel, secunderabad, hyderabad.

Reason: On causing enquiry we got to know that the victim is a married person and blessed with two female children. The victim got to know that his wife maintaining illegal affair with others since few months. The victim warned her many times to stop her affairs and to look at their children, but she never heed to him. Due to which he went into depression and came to upper tankbund and tried to jump into the Hussain Sagar Lake water immediately available Lake Police noticed him and stopped him. Inspector Lake Smt. K. Sreedevi counselled the victim handed over to his elder brother.

As such Lake Police played a vital role in saving them spontaneously without giving any scope for untoward incidents for which they could saved the lives of people viz., 1) Smt. Zareena begum, 2) Smt. D. Maheshwari and 3) Sri. Chintala. Raju These three incidents were occurred on 05/06-03-2017. Smt. K. Sreedevi, Inspector of Police, Lake Police Station had counselled them promptly and they were safely handed over to their relatives and concerned by taking their assurances that they will not repeat such things in near & future.

Thus, the patrolling Blue Colts of Lake PS viz., Sri. C. Sai kiran, PC 4295, Sri. Fazal Ahmed, PC 5280, Sri. T. Raju, HG 5658, Sri. Ismail bin salam, HG 6616, Sri. S. Koteswar rao, HG 5861 have tactfully identified the above persons in a suspicious manner and rescued them from committing suicide which was done under the supervision of Smt. Sreedevi Inspector lake P.S.
