NOTIFICATION

WHEREAS, it has been brought to my notice that the Terrorist/ Antisocial elements may organize attacks through Para Gliders, Remote Controlled Drones, Remote Controlled Micro Light Aircraft etc., and that there is an increasing trend by events organizers to use remote controlled drones for getting aerial views for live telecasts and photography of various events.

WHEREAS, inputs have been received by Intelligence agencies about the possibility of attacks by Terrorist/Antisocial elements by the use of Para-gliders, Remote Controlled Drones, Remote Controlled Micro-Light Aircraft, etc., and there is every likelihood of breach of peace and disturbance of Public tranquility and also there is grave danger to human life, health, safety and damage to public property on that account.

AND WHEREAS, it is necessary that reasonable checks are imposed on activities of such antisocial elements in the limits of Hyderabad City Police Commissionerate to prevent the attack through Remote Controlled Drones or through Para-Gliders or through Remotely Controlled Micro-Light Aircraft.

NOW THEREFORE, I, V.V. Srinivasa Rao, IPS, Commissioner of Police and Executive Magistrate of Hyderabad City vide powers conferred upon me u/sec 144 of the Criminal Procedure Code 1973 (Act II of 1974), **do hereby order that no flying activities of Remotely Controlled Drones or Para-Gliders or Remotely Controlled Micro-Light Aircraft be allowed in the Jurisdiction of Hyderabad City Police Commissionerate limits without prior Police permission in writing.**

No Non-Government agency, organization or individual will be allowed to launch Unmanned Aerial Vehicle (UAV), Unmanned Aerial Survey (UAS) etc.

Government agencies and organizations should obtain appropriate clearance from local Police and Aviation authorities before launching any UAS/UAV for any purpose.

Any person contravening this order shall be punishable under section 188 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860.

This order shall remain in force from 08-03-2018 to 07-04-2018.

As the notice cannot be served individually to all concerned, the order is hereby passed ex-parte. It shall be published for the information of public, through press and by affixing copies on the Notice Boards of the Police Stations, Divisional ACsP, Zonal DCsP offices.

NOTIFICATION

WHEREAS, reports have been received indicating that High Volume Sound Emitting Systems including DJs (High Volume Sound Mixers) are being generating noise beyond permissible limits (day time 55 db(A) and night time 45 db(A) in Residential Areas, day time 65 db(A) and night time 55 db(A) in Commercial Areas) in places of public gatherings including Processions causing inconvenience, disturbance, nuisance, annoyance and Under Section 67(c) prohibit bursting of fire crackers on public places / public roads, public meetings and marriages to the residents of locality and public in general.

WHEREAS, such acts have been causing acute inconvenience and distress among the children, old aged persons, patients and students in particular pursuing their studies in the residential localities.

WHEREAS, such High Volume sounds generated at Public Meetings, Marriages and Processions have been neutralizing Police Communication Systems deployed in relation to bandobust duties, thereby adversely affecting the function of maintenance of Public Order and Tranquillity by Law Enforcement Agencies.

AND WHEREAS, it is considered expedient to take stringent and speedy measures to control the use of High Volume Sound Emitting Systems including DJs (High Volume Sound Mixers) in place of Public gatherings including processions in the residential localities.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred under Rule 8 of Noise Pollution (Regulation & Control) Rules 2000, I, V.V. Srinivasa Rao, IPS Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad City, do hereby make this written order and notify the same to the General Public Prohibiting the following within Hyderabad City, except in cases specifically permitted by the Divisional Asst. Commissioners of Police of the concerned jurisdiction:

- Use of High Volume Sound Systems including DJs (High Volume Sound Mixers) emanating sound levels beyond permissible limits in places of Public Gatherings including Processions in the Residential Localities.
- Prohibit bursting of fire crackers at public places / public roads, public meetings and marriage function halls causing inconvenience to the residents of locality and public in general.

This order shall come into force from 0600 hrs on 08-03-2018 and shall remain in force for a period of 15 days i.e., upto 0600 hrs on 22-03-2018, both days inclusive unless withdrawn earlier.

Any person violating this order shall be liable for punishment u/s 67(c), 188 of IPC and u/s 76 of the Hyderabad City Police Act, 1348 Fasli.

SEIZURE OF 15.239 KGs UN-ACCOUNTED GOLD ORNAMENTS (WORTH ABOUT RS 5 CRORES) 3 HELD

On 06-03-2018 the sleuths of Chandrayangutta & Shahalibanda Police Stations Hyderabad apprehended following three respondents and seized unaccounted Gold ornaments (without any tax receipts) **Wg. 15.239 KGs worth about Rs.5 Crores and 2 cell phones** from their possession.

Details of the respondents:-

- 1) **Vaishnav Manoj Kumar Employee**, S/o Gopaldas, Age:42Yrs, Occ: **Worker in RAJA RAM Jewels**, Office No.# 21-2-684 to 693,/111 & 112, first Floor Veer Hanuman Complex, Urdu Shareef Charkaman, R/o H. No 3-4-63/19/D/A, Sriramanapuram, Ramanthapur, Amberpet.
- 2) **Pradeep Agarwal, Employee** S/o Rajesh Agarwal, Age:23Yrs, Occ: **Worker in RAJA RAM Jewels**, Office No.# 21-2-684 to 693,/111 & 112, first Floor Veer Hanuman Complex, Urdu Shareef Charkaman, Hyderabad. R/o H. No. Opposite Bahadurpura PS, Bahadurpura Colony, Bahadurpura.
- 3) **Yashaswi Agarwal (OWNER)** S/O Suresh Kumar Agarwal, Age: 30Yrs, Occ: **Owner of RAJA RAM Jewels**, Office No.# 21-2-684 to 693,/111 & 112, first Floor Veer Hanuman Complex, Urdu Shareef Charkaman.

Details of the case:

Respondents 1 & 2 were employees at RAJARAM Jewels, Veer Hanuman Complex, Urdu Shareef Charkaman, Charminar, Hyderabad. Respondent-3 is the owner of Raja Ram Jewellers.

On 05-03-2018 at about 8 PM **Yashaswi Agarwal** owner RAJA RAM Jewels, handed over the Gold ornaments Wg. 15.239 Kilo grams (without any tax receipts) and valid records to **Vaishnav Manoj Kumar and Pradeep Agarwal** to sell the same in the familiar Jewelry Shops Joy Alukas in the Mysore and Malabar Joy Alukas in Bangalore. **Vaishnav Manoj Kumar and Pradeep Agarwal** left along with Gold Ornaments to go to Mysore, in the meanwhile, when they reached near Aliyabad, Sri N. Lingaiah Inspector of Police PS Shahalibanda who was conducting vehicle checking at Aliyabad Road, tried to stop the Passenger Auto, but they did not stop and fled from there in rash driving, Immediately Inspector of PS Shalibanda passed the information to Chandrayangutta PS about the happened incident.

Sri. Y. Prakash Reddy along with the staff of PS Chandrayangutta, stopped the fast moving Auto at MBNR X Roads at about 10 PM in which there were two passengers were sitting inside, on enquiry, they refused to reveal their identity, on thoroughly checking the Auto found Gold ornaments in huge quantity, On questioning they revealed their identity, and confessed that they are going to sell these gold Ornaments to Jewels shops in Mysore and Bangalore. They are also failed to show the valid receipts of gold ornaments.

Police Chandrayangutta, South Zone seized 15.239 KGs of Gold ornaments. The Respondents R3 Yashahwi Agarwal was also taken into custody from his house on the information of R1 & R2.

The apprehended respondents along with seized property are being handed over to Income Tax department Hyderabad for Further action
