**NOTIFICATION**

WHEREAS, it has been brought to my notice that the Terrorist/Antisocial elements may organize attacks through Para Gliders, Remote Controlled Drones, Remote Controlled Micro Light Aircraft etc., and that there is an increasing trend by events organizers to use remote controlled drones for getting aerial views for live telecasts and photography of various events.

WHEREAS, inputs have been received by Intelligence agencies about the possibility of attacks by Terrorist/Antisocial elements by the use of Para-gliders, Remote Controlled Drones, Remote Controlled Micro-Light Aircraft, etc., and there is every likelihood of breach of peace and disturbance of Public tranquility and also there is grave danger to human life, health, safety and damage to public property on that account.

AND WHEREAS, it is necessary that reasonable checks are imposed on activities of such antisocial elements in the limits of Hyderabad City Police Commissionerate to prevent the attack through Remote Controlled Drones or through Para-Gliders or through Remotely Controlled Micro-Light Aircraft.

NOW THEREFORE, I, M.Mahendar Reddy, IPS, Commissioner of Police and Executive Magistrate of Hyderabad City vide powers conferred upon me u/sec 144 of the Criminal Procedure Code 1973 (Act II of 1974), **do hereby order that no flying activities of Remotely Controlled Drones or Para-Gliders or Remotely Controlled Micro-Light Aircraft be allowed in the Jurisdiction of Hyderabad City Police Commissionerate limits without prior Police permission in writing.**

No Non-Government agency, organization or individual will be allowed to launch Unmanned Aerial Vehicle (UAV), Unmanned Aerial Survey (UAS) etc.

Government agencies and organizations should obtain appropriate clearance from local Police and Aviation authorities before launching any UAS/UAV for any purpose.

Any person contravening this order shall be punishable under section 188 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860.

This order shall remain in force from 08-04-2017 to 07-05-2017.

As the notice cannot be served individually to all concerned, the order is hereby passed ex-parte. It shall be published for the information of public, through press and by affixing copies on the Notice Boards of the Police Stations, Divisional ACsP, Zonal DCsP offices.

**NOTIFICATION**

WHEREAS, reports have been received indicating that High Volume Sound Emitting Systems including DJs (High Volume Sound Mixers) are being generating noise beyond permissible limits (day time 55 db(A) and night time 45 db(A) in Residential Areas, day time 65 db(A) and night time 55 db(A) in Commercial Areas) in places of public gatherings including Processions causing inconvenience, disturbance, nuisance, annoyance and Under Section 67(c) prohibit bursting of fire crackers on public places / public roads, public meetings and marriages to the residents of locality and public in general.

WHEREAS, such acts have been causing acute inconvenience and distress among the children, old aged persons, patients and students in particular pursuing their studies in the residential localities.

WHEREAS, such High Volume sounds generated at Public Meetings, Marriages and Processions have been neutralizing Police Communication Systems deployed in relation to bandobust duties, thereby adversely affecting the function of maintenance of Public Order and Tranquillity by Law Enforcement Agencies.

AND WHEREAS, it is considered expedient to take stringent and speedy measures to control the use of High Volume Sound Emitting Systems including DJs (High Volume Sound Mixers) in place of Public gatherings including processions in the residential localities.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred under Rule 8 of Noise Pollution (Regulation & Control) Rules 2000, I, M. Mahendar Reddy, IPS., Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad City, do hereby make this written order and notify the same to the General Public Prohibiting the following within Hyderabad City, except in cases specifically permitted by the Divisional Asst. Commissioners of Police of the concerned jurisdiction:

- Use of High Volume Sound Systems including DJs (High Volume Sound Mixers) emanating sound levels beyond permissible limits in places of Public Gatherings including Processions in the Residential Localities.
- Prohibit bursting of fire crackers at public places / public roads, public meetings and marriage function halls causing inconvenience to the residents of locality and public in general.

This order shall come into force from 06:00 hrs on 06-04-2017 and shall remain in force for a period of 15 days i.e., upto 06:00 hrs on 20-04-2017, both days inclusive unless withdrawn earlier.

Any person violating this order shall be liable for punishment u/s 67(c), 188 of IPC and u/s 76 of the Hyderabad City Police Act, 1348 Fasli.

## **P R E S S   N O T E**

On 5-04-2017 Sri Harishwar Reddy, PC 6529 of Charminar Police Station on credible information apprehended the accused persons A1). Syed Farhan @ Farhan, @ Baba, S/o Syed Asad, age 24 yrs occ auto driver, r/o H.No. 19-2-10/14, Misrigunj Hyderabad and A2 Syed Aslam @ Ashu, s/o Syed Ibrahim age 20 yrs, occ: auto driver r/o H.No. 19-3-294/113 Fatima nagar, Jahanuma, Hyderabad while they were moving under suspicious circumstances on Bajaj Chetak motor cycle bearing No.AP11D-9250 to commit theft of cycles and produced them before the DSI Sri I. Chandra Sheker of Charminar PS. On interrogation they confessed to have committed theft of 5 cycles from PS Charminar, 2 cycles from Kalapathar, 2 cycles from Kamatipura 2 cycles from Hussainialam, 2 cycles from Bahadurpura, 1 cycle from Bhavani nagar PS limits. At the instance of the accused persons A1 and A2 seized Bajaj Chetak motor cycle bearing No.AP11D-9250 and two keys which were used in the commission of offence. **The recovered property worth of Rs. 51,500/-.**

**Modus operandi** : A1). Syed Farhan @ Farhan, @ Baba and A2 Syed Aslam @ Ashu are that they were selected the Mosques, play grounds, when the victims are in busy in playing games and also offering their prayers, the accused persons used to commit theft of cycles by using the false keys. The habit of the offenders selected the places on their Chetak scooter. Later they committed theft of cycles. They are the habitual offenders and were arrested by Police Mirchowk and Moghalpura Police Station in cycle thefts cases during the year 2010 and remanded them to judicial custody.
