NOTIFICATION

WHEREAS, it has been brought to my notice that the Terrorist/ Antisocial elements may organize attacks through Para Gliders, Remote Controlled Drones, Remote Controlled Micro Light Aircraft etc., and that there is an increasing trend by events organizers to use remote controlled drones for getting aerial views for live telecasts and photography of various events.

WHEREAS, inputs have been received by Intelligence agencies about the possibility of attacks by Terrorist/Antisocial elements by the use of Para-gliders, Remote Controlled Drones, Remote Controlled Micro-Light Aircraft, etc., and there is every likelihood of breach of peace and disturbance of Public tranquility and also there is grave danger to human life, health, safety and damage to public property on that account.

AND WHEREAS, it is necessary that reasonable checks are imposed on activities of such antisocial elements in the limits of Hyderabad City Police Commissionerate to prevent the attack through Remote Controlled Drones or through Para-Gliders or through Remotely Controlled Micro-Light Aircraft.

NOW THEREFORE, I, M.Mahendar Reddy, IPS, Commissioner of Police and Executive Magistrate of Hyderabad City vide powers conferred upon me u/sec 144 of the Criminal Procedure Code 1973 (Act II of 1974), **do hereby order that no flying activities of Remotely Controlled Drones or Para-Gliders or Remotely Controlled Micro-Light Aircraft be allowed in the Jurisdiction of Hyderabad City Police Commissionerate limits without prior Police permission in writing.**

No Non-Government agency, organization or individual will be allowed to launch Unmanned Aerial Vehicle (UAV), Unmanned Aerial Survey (UAS) etc.

Government agencies and organizations should obtain appropriate clearance from local Police and Aviation authorities before launching any UAS/UAV for any purpose.

Any person contravening this order shall be punishable under section 188 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860.

This order shall remain in force from 08-05-2017 to 07-06-2017.

As the notice cannot be served individually to all concerned, the order is hereby passed ex-parte. It shall be published for the information of public, through press and by affixing copies on the Notice Boards of the Police Stations, Divisional ACsP, Zonal DCsP offices.

NOTIFICATION

WHEREAS, reports have been received indicating that consumption of liquor in public places has become rampant and unhindered in several areas of the City of Hyderabad, resulting in to a menace to the common members of the public, especially women and children in particular.

AND WHEREAS, such reports have been indicating that, persons consuming liquor in public places have been exhibiting abrasive unruly and indecent behavior on the streets of Hyderabad City towards law abiding citizens especially women and children in particular endangering their modesty and safety in addition to causing disturbance to public tranquility resulting in annoyance and obstruction to road users in general and women and children in particular.

WHEREAS, such unruly and indecent behavior has been instilling a sense of fear psychosis in law abiding citizens, especially women and children resulting in restriction of their free movement on the streets of Hyderabad, thereby affecting public safety at large and safety and security of women and children in particular.

AND WHEREAS, it is considered necessary to take speedy measures in this regard to prevent danger to human life and safety and security of women and children or for preventing any affray and disturbance of public tranquility.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me under Section 144 of Criminal Procedure Code 1973, I, M. Mahendar Reddy, IPS, Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad City, do hereby make this written order and notify the same to the General Public **prohibiting Consumption of liquor in public places in the City of Hyderabad.**

This order is published for the information of public through the media and through the public address system in the areas affected with drunkenness in public places.

This order shall come into force from 0600 hours on 09-05-2017 and shall remain in force for a period of one week i.e. upto 0600 hours on 15-05-2017 (both days inclusive) unless withdrawn earlier.

Any person violating this order shall be liable for punishment under Section 188 of the Indian Penal code and as per the provisions of Hyderabad City Police Act, 1348 Fasli.

NOTIFICATION

With a view to maintain public order, peace and tranquility in the twin cities of Hyderabad and Secunderabad, I, M. Mahendar Reddy, IPS Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad City, in exercise of the powers vested in me under section 22(1) (a) to (f) and 22 (2) (a) and (b) of Hyderabad City Police Act, 1348 Fasli (No.IX), do hereby issue the following prohibitory orders.

- I Prohibit to hold any kind of public meetings, and processions within the Hyderabad City, without obtaining prior permission of Zonal Dy. Commissioners of Police, Law and Order concerned, Addl. Commissioner of Police, Law and Order or Jt. Commissioner of Police, Co-ordination & Security or Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad.
- a) Prohibit carrying of arms such as swords, spears, knives, sticks with or without flags bludgeons, guns, explosives, and other offensive weapons in the above mentioned areas.
- b) Prohibit gathering of persons on the public roads or public places disturbing peace and order or causing inconvenience, annoyance or danger to public.
- c) Prohibit collection, carrying of stones or other means of casting missiles.
- II Prohibit use of mikes/public address system by different Organisations around the Secretariat premises, including Burgula Rama Krishna Rao Building, Greater Hyderabad Municipal Corporation Building, Commissioner of Fisheries building, Mint Compound, Nizam College and its surroundings, Telangana / A.P. Legislative Assembly premises and surrounding roads, Public Garden Nampally, Upper Tankbund, I-MAX, Rotary and NTR Marg roads also fly-over road leading from Secretariat to Visweswarayya statue, Khairatabad.
- a) Prohibit music, singing or speeches or broadcasting through loud speakers in the above mentioned areas.
- b) Prohibit use of mikes/public address systems, use of horn through vehicles by any organisation, members of public etc., in the above mentioned areas.
- III The public are here by informed that any person violating the above orders shall be liable for prosecution under the Hyderabad City Police Act, 1348, Fasli (No. IX).
- IV **The following are exempted from the operation of this order**
- (i) Police Officers on duty,
(ii) Military personnel on duty,
(iii) Home Guards on duty,
(iv) Bonafide funeral processions.

This order shall be in force with effect from 0600 hours on 10-05-2017 to 0600 hours on 16-05-2017.

PRESS NOTE

The Cyber Crime Police, CCS, DD, Hyderabad City apprehended Four Cyber offenders 1.Mr.Himanshu Sharma, 2.Sumit Kumar, 3.Jackson Paul and 4.Mazhar Alam all are from Delhi who cheated the complainant Mr.Aleemuddin in the pretext of delivering Honda Amaze car which is alleged to be won by him.

Facts are that on 08-03-2017 at 16.30 hrs received a complaint from Mr.Aleemuddin R/O Falaknuma, Hyderabad, stating that in 2016, one Mr. Vijay Chauhan from Crusebeen Enterprises Delhi, contacted him over phone and informed him that he was selected for a Honda Amaze Car Contest and eligible for awards and other benefits. In the pretext of delivering Honda Amaze Car and other gift items the complainant was lured and confused with their tactful words and squeezed an amount of Rs.17,00,000/-. The complainant deposited amounts as per the directions of Mr.Vijay Chauhan and his associates in the current account No. 135705001184 of ICICI and A/C No. 35747873013 of SBI. Some of the money was transferred through Paytm and western money transfer. Approximately Rs.17 lakhs were paid by the complainant being attracted to the words of Mr.Vijay Chauhan and his associates. Even after making such huge amount, he did not get the Honda Amaze car. Hence he got suspicion and complained the matter with Cyber Crime P.S., The complaint was registered as a case in Cr.No.58/2017, U/s. 66 C, D, I.T.A Act 2008 and Sec.419, 420, 120-B IPC and Inspector Sri.K.V.M.Prasad took up investigation.

Basing on the tower locations of the accused, Cyber Crime team under the leadership of Inspector Sri.K.V.M.Prasad and the team members S.I.s Sri.M.Krishna Sri.Madhusudhan, Pcs Satish, Vijay Murari, Feroz, Saleem and Rajender under the supervision of Sri.Raghuvir ACP, Cyber Crime PS proceeded to Delhi and arrested the accused persons 1.Himanshu Sharma, 2. Sumit Kumar, 3.Jackson Paul and 4.Mazhar Alam. On interrogation of the accused it came to light that all the accused along with another accused Mr.Ravinder (absconding) established a company (Call Centre) at Okhla, New Delhi in the name of shopon4u.com. Mr.Himanshu Sharma and Sumit Kumar under conspiracy opened current accounts with SBI, ICICI and HDFC banks in the name of Crusebeen Enterprises Pvt Ltd and supplied the account particulars to the telecallers working with their company. The telecallers were trained to lure the customers in the pretext of prizes and gifts. After that they instruct the customers to deposit the money in the current accounts opened by Himanshu Sharma and Sumit Kumar. The deposited money will be transferred into the current account of shopon4u which was opened by Mr.Jackson Paul, Mazhar Alam and Ravinder. The money will be shared among Jackson Paul, Mazhar Alam and Ravinder. For supplying the currents accounts, the salary of Mr.Himanshu Sharma and Sumit Kumar was increased to Rs.35,000/-. Recently the accused persons Himanshu Sharma, Sumit Kumar became a group and departed from Jackson Paul, Mazhar Alam and Ravinder. Himanshu Sharma and Sumit Kumar are aged about 25 years and unmarried. Mr.Jackson Paul, Mazhar Alam and Ravinder opened a new company in the name of JMR and opened current accounts in ICICI, HDFC and SBI banks. The JMR and CRUSEBEEN are being run at D-14, Okhla Industrial Area, Phase-1, New Delhi.

Hence the general public are advised not to incline for the phone calls of strangers and should not make online shopping on such websites. Those who were already cheated by the website shopon4u.com can approach Cyber Crime Police for their redressal.
