

## **BUSTED "COCAINE" DRUG PEDDLING RACKET - (02) HELD**

### **SEIZED (180) GRAMS OF COCAINE,(04) CELL PHONES & (01)M/CYCLE,**

On 06-08-2017 in the joint operation, the Commissioner's Task Force, North Zone Team and Police S.R Nagar PS, busted "COCAINE" drug peddling racket and apprehended (02) accused persons including one **Nigerian** National near Madhura Nagar Park, Yousufguda, Hyderabad who are in possession of Narcotic substance Drug i.e. Cocaine, in order to delivery to needy customers at Hyderabad. **Seized (180) grams of Cocaine, (04) Cell phones, (01) Honda Activa** from their possession.

#### **Details of Accused persons :**

#### **➤ Modus operandi:-**

The Drug peddler Ogugua John Basco , age. 37 yrs is a **Citizen of Nigeria Country**. He is habit of Consume Cocaine, he use one of their local dialects to communicate with one another and deliver drug to the agents from Mumbai to Hyderabad and other metropolitan Cities. The accused developed contacts with potential drug agent by name Mohammed. Jaharullah @ Sanni @ Aijaj, age. 33 yrs, R/o. Madhura Nagar, Yousuguda N/o. Kakinada. AP State and supplying cocaine drug. They also built chain system in-between Drug customers, seller to hide their identity.

#### **➤ Brief facts of the case:-**

The prime accused Ogugua John Basco , age. 37 yrs is a **Citizen of Lagos, Nigeria Country**. He is kingpin of Drug peddling racket at Mumbai. He came to India on **business VISA** in the month of June-2016 and staying at Diva Junction, Vasi, Mumbai, Maharashtra State and doing Garments export business. He is habit of Consume Cocaine, he use one of their local dialects to communicate with one another and deliver drug to the agents, from Mumbai to Hyderabad and other metropolitan Cities. The drug peddler supplying Cocaine Drug for Rs. 2000/- to 2,500/- per grams to the Drugs agents at Hyderabad and the agents sell the same to consumers for Rs. 5000/- to 6000/- per gram and gain easy profit.

The accused Mohammed. Jaharullah @ Sanni @ Aijaj is native of Kakinada, East Godavari Dist, A.P. State. In the year 2014 he came to Hyderabad and doing pvt job presently residing at Madhura Nagar, Yousufguda. He is habit of Consuming Cocaine. He use to Visit events in Hyderabad . While searching about Drug peddlers at the event he came into contact with the above Drug peddlers John Basco. Since then he use to purchase Cocaine Drug from him and sell the same to consumers at Hyderabad. The Nigerian drug peddler is selling the Cocaine Drug Rs 2000/- to 2500/- per gram to the accused Mohammed. Jaharullah @ Sanni @ Aijaj and the same drug sell to consumers for Rs. 5000/- to 6000/- per gram and gain easy profits. Sometimes the Nigerian national is come to Hyderabad and deliver Cocaine Drug to him at Tolichowki area.

Four days back the consumer Mohammed. Jaharullah @ Sanni @ Aijaj, came into contact with Drug peddler John Basco told him to supply 80 grams of Cocaine on that he agree for delivery the same at Hyderabad. As per their plan to day i.e on 06-08-2017 the drug peddler reached at Madhura Nagar Park, Yousufguda delivered 80 grams of Cocaine to the agent Mohammed. Jaharullah @ Sanni @ Aijaj and 100 grams of cocaine kept with John Basco in order to deliver to other agent , meanwhile on tip off apprehended

them along with the narcotic drug "Cocaine". Seized 100 grams of Cocaine drug from the possession of John Basco and 80 grams of cocaine seized from the possession Mohammed. Jaharullah @ Sanni @ Aijaj.

**Total seized (180) grams of Cocaine, (01) Motor cycle, (04) Cell phones from their possession.**

The accused persons along with seized material being handed over to SHO, S.R Nagar PS for further necessary action. Further investigation is on to find out the others involved in the drug peddling racket and consumers.

**ILLEGAL POSSESSION OF OLD INDIAN CURRENCY GANG NABBED-**  
**05 HELD - SEIZED DEMONITIZE INDIAN CURRENCY Rs. 99,00,000/- and 06 CELL**  
**PHONES**

On 05-08-2017, the sleuths of Commissioner's Task Force, **Central Zone team**, Hyderabad, apprehended **(05) accused** who were procured and possession of the old currency notes of Rs.1000 and 500 denominations illegally after the demonetization they were illegally trying to exchange the demonetized old currency notes of Rs. 1000 & 500 in to valid currency on commission basis with agents in front of Sanjeeviah Park parking, Necklace Road, Ramgopalpet, Hyderabad and Seized old currency **Rs.99,00,000/-(Ninety Nine Lakhs Rupees)** and **(06) Cell phones** from their possession.

**Modus Operandi: -**

The accused V.Sai Kumar Reddy is a B.Tech student at Sri Indu Engineering College at Ibrahim Patnam,RR Dist . The said Saikumar Reddy along with his friend Sai hatched a plan to getting easy money for exchanging of old Indian Currency with new Currency due to financial crisis. As per their plan two days before they collected old Indian currency with one known person Praveen an amount of Rs. 99,00,000/- (Ninety Nine Lakhs Rupees). Since then they were trying to exchange the old currency. They informed to one of his agent by name prasad resident of Narsaraopet Town for exchanging old Indian currency with new currency, in which they would give some commission to him. Then a deal was made between them with a commission of 05%. Then Prasad also informed the same to another mediators Nagender and Rambabu for exchanging the money. After that, as per their plan yesterday evening hours, the all accused persons came to Sanjeeviah Park along with Rs. 99,00,000/- (Ninety Nine Lakhs Rupees) and waiting at in front of Sanjeeviah Park parking, Necklace Road, Ramgopalpet, Hyderabad for party to exchange old Indian currency with new Indian currency, mean time Central Zone Task Force Police apprehended them along with the demonetize notes of **Rs.99,00,000/-(Ninety Nine Lakhs Rupees)** and **(06) Cell phones** from their possession with denomination of 500 and 1000 notes.

The accused persons along with the seized property was handed over to SHO, Ramgopalpet PS for further investigation.

**BRIEF FACTS:**

The accused Tonuguntla Mallikarjun Rao is native of Guntur Town and two months back he came to Hyderabad and took rent of one flat at Gandhinagar for running the brothel at Flat No.103, St No.15, Santhi apartment, Gandhi Nagar, Hyderabad and paid rent Rs 10,000/- per month. The accused collected sex workers from Kolkata, Mumbai etc.. and keeping them in the above said premises, for known customers and collecting an amount of Rs 1,000/- to Rs 1,500/- from each customer by giving commission to sex workers. On reliable information, Central Zone Task Force team conducted raid on the brothel house situated at Flat No.103, Street No.15, Santhi Apartment, Gandhinagar, Hyderabad and apprehended one brothel organizer and rescued one victim women and seized (01) cell phone,20 No's SKORE un used Condoms and net cash Rs 1050/- from the possession of organizer.

The accused person along with seized material was handed over to the **SHO, Gandhinagar PS** for further investigation.
