APPRECIATION IN CONVICTION CASE

The Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad city appreciated the, Assistant public prosecutor 2nd ACMM Court Smt.Rajani, Inspector of Police Sultan Bazar PS. Sri.P. Shiva Shanker, SI-Sri.K.Rami Reddy (IO)) presently working in Banjara Hills PS, CDO Sri.Y.Raghavendra for successfully securing conviction in a case of theft by diverting attention.

The accused Bathula Ravi Kiran s/o B. Venkatesh, age 28 years occ. Electrician R/o Kachiguda, Hyderabad was convicted and sentence to undergo 6 years Imprisonment and to pay Rs. 2000/- fine, in a **attention diversion** (He diverted the Baby girls attention by officering pens, pencils and scholarships) case in cr. No. 292/2015 u/s 420,379 IPS of PS Sultan Bazar.

The accused Bathula Ravikiran is involved in 25 cases in Hyderabad and Rachakonda Commissionerrates. This is the 1st case in which the trial was conducted. The DCP East Zone Sri. Ramesh,IPS was also present in the occasion.

CONVICTION FOR MISBEHAVE

The Child friendly Court at HACA Bhavan, Saifabad today sentenced an accused, Someswara Rao, age 42 yrs and a private employee to 3 yrs rigorous imprisonment and a fine of Rs.1000/-. The accused had followed an 11 year old girl when she went to a shop and misbehaved with her by touching her inappropriately. The accused was booked U/s.354 of IPC and Sec.7 r/w 8 of POCSO Act in Kharkhana PS.

The victim girl was sent to Bharosa for recording of the statement and for medical examination and was later produced before the child friendly court.

RAID ON ILLEGAL GODOWN OF P.D.S RICE - HELD TWO ACCUSED AND SEIZED 06 QUINTALS OF PDS RICE AND ONE GOODS CARRIER AUTO

On 06-09-2018, on credible information sleuths of Commissioner's Task Force Central Zone Team along with Civil Supply officials raided on illegal PDS Rice Godown situated at H.No. 1-7-135/A/2, Risala, Zamistanpur, Hyderabad and apprehended Two accused person and seized (06) Quintals of PDS Rice and One Goods Carrier Auto.

Names of the accused:

1. Ahmed Ali @ Ahmed S/o Late. Masthan Ali, age: 47 years, Occ: Leather Business C/o Bholakpur, Ranganagar R/o H.No. 1-4-60/3, near Community Hall, Ranganagar, Bholakpur, Musheerabad, Hyderabad.
2. Sarfaraz Ali @ Sarfaraz S/o Ahmed Ali @ Ahmed, age: 19 years, Occ: Auto Driver, R/o H.No. 1-4-60/3, near Community Hall, Ranganagar, Bholakpur, Musheerabad, Hyderabad.

Brief Facts of the case:

The accused persons Ahmed Ali @ Ahmed and Sarfaraz Ali are Father and Son who are Residing in Bholakpur, Musheerabad Hyderabad who were doing Leather business, due to loss in the said business, they started PDS Rice business by collecting PDS rice from the known and unknown card holders in Bholakpur, Musheerabad and Gandhinagar, Warasiguda areas for Rs.8/- per Kg and diverting the same to Zaheerabad and selling the same at Zaheerabad Market for Rs.15/- per Kg to needy customers and earning illegal profit from last one year.

Today morning while the above persons are at illegal PDS rice godown situated at at H.No. 1-7-135/A/2, Risala, Zamistanpur, Hyderabad on credible information Central Zone Task Force Team along with Civil Supply Officials raided the above godown and apprehended the accused persons Ahmed Ali @ Ahmed and Sarfaraz Ali @ Sarfaraz and seized **(06) Quintal of PDS Rice and One Goods Carrier Auto**. The accused persons illegally possessing and transporting the PDS rice and cheating the Government and gaining illegal money.

In this case total (06) Quintals of PDS Rice and one goods carrier auto vide Reg. No. AP9V6030 were seized and apprehended two accused persons. The accused persons along with seized property were handed over to Civil Supply officials for further necessary action.

Previously the accused persons were arrested by Musheerabad and Gandhinagar Police Stations for illegal possession and transport of the PDS Rice.

**APPREHENDED FIVE PERSONS WHO ARE IN POSSESSION OF
TOBACCO/GUTKA ITEMS SEZIED TWO LAKHS WORTH MATERIAL &
TRANSPORTING VEHICLE BY CENTRAL ZONE TASK FORCE TEAM,
HYDERABAD**

On 06-09-2018, on credible information the sleuths of Commissioner's Task Force, Central Zone team, Hyderabad raid at Ambica Stores, # 1-7-390, Shop No. 14, Arora Complex, Opp. Guru Nanak Care Hospital, Metro Pillar No. 8, Musheerabad, bakaram Road, Hyderabad apprehended (5) accused persons and seized (34) bags of Tobacco products worth about Rupees Two Lakhs, one passenger Auto, (06) cell Phones and Net cash of Rs. 65,000/-.

Brief facts of the case:

The brief facts of the case are that Devuni Mohan Kumar @ Mohan who is running the General store Business M/s Ambica Stores at Arora Complex, Musheerabad hatched a plan to sell the Gutka/Tobacco products to the needy customers secretly in his stores as there is huge demand for Tobacco products which were banned by the Government of Telangana. He is selling the Tobacco products with the help of his two employees Marapalli Mahesh @ Mahesh and Bonkuri Sridhar @ Sridhar. Mohan Kumar accordingly to his plan he dumped the Gutka/Tobacco products in his stores and selling them to the needy customers and Pan Shop vendors secretly for huge amount and gaining illegal profits as sale of Tobacco Products is prohibited in Hyderabad. Mohan Kumar place the order for the Tobacco Products to Mohmmmed Sahul @ Hafeez who supplies Tobacco products in Passenger Auto with the help of Mohammed Farooq @ Farooq who is running passenger auto in Hyderabad city has his earning are not sufficient to meet the necessities of his family, he decided to transport the Tobacco products to get huge amount, accordingly he started working with Mohmmmed Sahul @ Hafeez and used to supply the products to the shops of Hyderabad and earning easy money.

Mohmmmed Sahul @ Hafeez purchase the Gutka/Tobacco products from one Mohammed Khaleed @ Ather Syed resident of Hyderabad who is main supplier who brought Tobacco products from Karnataka State and transport them in auto to other shops with the help of Mohammed Farooq @ Farooq and sell them to gain easy money.

Today while Mohmmmed Sahul @ Hafeez and Mohammed Farooq @ Farooq while they were delivering the Gutka/ Tobacco products to Devuni Mohan Kumar @ Mohan the Central Zone Team raided the Shop of Devuni Mohan Kumar @ Mohan and seized (34) bags of Tobacco Products from their possession. In this case the main stockist of the Tobacco Products namely Mohammed Khaleed @ Ather Syed is absconding.

The apprehended five accused persons along with seized properties were handed over to S.H.O. Musheerabad Police Station for further necessary action.

The above apprehension were made under the supervision of **Sri. P. LAKE POLICE RESCUED TWO PERSONS FROM COMMITTING SUICIDE

On 06th of September 2018, P S Lake officials has rescued **Two persons** in two different timing and situation i.e., One man & one woman. Were all rescued, while they were about to commit suicide by jumping into the Hussain Sagar Lake. The Details of the victims are as follows:-

First incident: Occurred on 05-06/09/2018 at 2330 hours tried to jump into water at upper tankbund lepakshi immediately patrolling Lake Police noticed her and saved her life and brought to Lake P.S.

Details of Victim: one lady, age:- 27 yrs, r/o:- IDA, uppal.

Reason: On enquiry it came to know that she is suffering with suicidal tendency since few years, due to which she went into depression and decided to end her life and came. I counselled her promptly and handed over to her parents and send them to Roshini centre for further counselling.

Second incident: It occurred on 06/09/2018 at around 0105 hours upper tankbund at old LOVE HYD.

Details of Victim:- one man, age:- 32 yrs, occ:- pvt employee, r/o:- lothkunta, alwal.

Reason: On enquiry victim revealed that he is a married person and leading conjugal life happily. Since few days they are facing with some family problems with some family problems. Yesterday in the evening hour's victim and his wife quarrelled with each other on a petty family issue. Due to which he went into depression and decided to end his life and came. I counselled him promptly, after that send to Barosa centre for further action.

As such Lake Police played a vital role in saving them spontaneously without giving any scope for untoward incidents for which they could save the lives of people. These three incidents were occurred on 06-09-2018. I counselled them promptly and they were safely handed over to their relatives and concerned by taking their assurances that they will not repeat such things in near & future.

Thus, the patrolling Blue Colts of Lake PS viz., PC 8303, R. Sandeep, PC 4295, C. Sai kiran, HG 8155 – N.M. Kumar, HG 2039, B. Krishna yadav, have tactfully identified the above persons in a suspicious manner and rescued them from committing suicide.
