**RAID ON GAMING HOUSE UNDER THE LIMITS OF PANJAGUTTA – (8) PERSONS HELD –
SEIZED AN AMOUNT OF Rs.1,57,630/- AND PLAYING CARDS**

On the 05-12-2017 the sleuths of Commissioner's Task force, West Zone Team, Hyderabad received credible information that some persons are playing 3 cards gambling at Premises No.8-3-720/1, Koteshwar Rao Building, Yellareddyguda, Panjagutta, Hyderabad and using the premises as common gaming house.

The West Zone Task Force team raided the said premises and found the following persons are playing 3 Cards gambling which is a game of chance.

1. K.V.Ramana Reddy S/o Sridhar Reddy, aged 61 yrs, Occ: Movie producer, R/o Flat No.503, Challa cresenta, Panchavati colony, Manikonda, Hyderabad **and (7) Others.**

During the enquiry it came to light that, the organizer K.V.Ramana Reddy is organizing gaming house in the above premises by taking commission for each game from the players at Premises No.8-3-720/1, Koteshwar Rao Building, Yellareddyguda, Panjagutta, Hyderabad and collecting commission for each game from the players and earning money. In this case **seized net cash of Rs.1,57,630/-, Playing cards and (8) cell phones** from the possession of accused persons.

The arrested accused persons along with seized material were handed over to the SHO, Panjagutta Police Station for necessary action.

The raid was made under the supervision of **Sri P.Radha Kishan Rao**, Dy.Commissioner of Police, Commissioner's Task Force, by **Sri B.Gattu Mallu**, Inspector of Police with the assistance of SIs Sri V.Kishore, Sri M.Prabhakar Reddy, Sri P.Mallikarjun, Sri L.Bhaskar Reddy and the Staff of West Zone Team, Commissioner's Task Force, Hyderabad.

TWO PERSONS HELD - WHO WERE CHEATED INNOCENT PERSONS ON THE GUISE OF SELLING GOLD ON LOWEST PRICE TO THEM

On 06-12-2017 the sleuths of Commissioner's Task Force, West Zone Team, Hyderabad, apprehended two accused persons who were cheating the innocent people on the guise of selling Gold on lowest price to them. Recovered **net Cash of Rs.5,000/- and (4) Cell phones** from their possession.

DETAILS OF THE ACCUSED:

- 1) Reddymalla Uday Kumar S/o Reddy Malla Badraiah, aged 47 yrs, Occ: Real Estate business, R/o Flat No.401, Bansilall Apartment, Raghavendra Rao Colony, Suchitra, Qutbullapur, Hyderabad, N/o Bajana Mandiram, Ellandu Taluka, Khammam District.
- 2) T.Ravi Kumar S/o T.Narsimha Chary, aged 31 yrs, Occ: Real Estate business, R/o H.No.16-4-461, Shiva Nagar, Warangal.

Brief history of accused persons:-

The accused Reddymalla Uday Kumar is native of Khammam District. He studied upto 7th class. In the year 2008 he came to Hyderabad and started readymade cloths business at Suchitra, Hyderabad. In the year 2012 due to loss he closed his business. In the year 2013 he along with his friend opened a film distribution office styled as "UK Entertainments" at Yousufuguda checkpost. At present he is doing Real Estate business in Hyderabad and also he introduced himself to public as he is Producer of the film "O MANASA EAVERI KOSAM".

The accused T.Ravi Kumar is native of Warangal District. He completed his MCA studies in the year 2011. After completion of his studies he came to Hyderabad and worked as private employee in Hyderabad for four years. Later he went to his native place. At present he is doing Real Estate business in Warangal district. About one year back he came into contact with Uday Kumar in his real estate business.

Modus operandi:-

The accused Reddymalla Uday Kumar hatched a plan to cheat the innocent people on the guise of selling gold on lowest price by taking huge money from them. The accused used to attract the innocent people that he will arrange gold on lowest price compare to the market price. To believe him the accused Reddymalla Uday Kumar used to take less money from the innocent people and go to any Gold shop and purchase the gold by adding his money. Later he will hand over the gold to the innocent people by informing them that he purchased gold on lowest price and hand over to them. After believing him he used to take huge money from them by promising them that he will arrange gold. After taking money he used to cheat them. In the year 2014 a case was registered against him in Market Police Station, Hyderabad vide Cr.No.138/2014 U/s 406, 420 IPC.

About one year back he came into contact with the accused T.Ravi Kumar and he informed him that he is cheating the innocent people on the guise of selling gold on lowest price and also asked him to get customers to him on commission basis. For which the accused T.Ravi Kumar agreed with him and started getting customers to him.

About one month back both the accused persons cheated one person by name Mahesh who is a Gold Smith. On 29-11-2017 the accused persons got introduced with Mahesh and informed him that they will arrange gold on lowest price. On which the victim asked gold about 5 tulas to them. On which the accused Uday Kumar purchased 5 tulas gold to victim by adding his money of Rs.20,000/- and hand over to victim and informed him that he had purchased gold for Rs.26,000/- per 1 tula. At that time the gold price is Rs.30,000/- per 1 tula.

Later the accused persons informed the victim that, 300 grams gold biscuits (100 grams X 3 Biscuits) available with them and also informed him that be ready with money to purchase. On 01-11-2017 at about 5 PM as per the instructions of accused Uday Kumar the victim Mahesh came near Panna Jewelers, Pot Market, Secunderabad. Where the accused Uday Kumar took Rs.7,80,000/- (Seven Lakhs and Eighty thousand rupees) from him and informed him that wait outside of the shop he will go inside the shop and purchase the gold and hand over to him. By

saying this he went inside the Panna Jewelers shop. But he did not return back and escaped from there by taking money.

On complaint of Victim a case has been registered against the accused persons vide Cr.No.136/2017 U/s 420 IPC of Market PS, Hyderabad City.

On credible information, apprehended the above accused persons and recovered Rs.5,000/- and (4) Cell phones from their possession.

The arrested accused persons along with seized property were handed over to SHO, Market PS, Hyderabad, for taking necessary action.
