NOTIFICATION

With a view to maintain public order, peace and tranquility in the twin cities of Hyderabad and Secunderabad, I, V.V. Srinivasa Rao, IPS, Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad City, in exercise of the powers vested in me under section 22(1) (a) to (f) and 22 (2) (a) and (b) of Hyderabad City Police Act, 1348 Fasli (No.IX), do hereby issue the following prohibitory orders.

- I Prohibit to hold any kind of public meetings, and processions within the Hyderabad City, without obtaining prior permission of Zonal Dy. Commissioners of Police, Law and Order concerned, Addl. Commissioner of Police, Law and Order or Jt. Commissioner of Police, Co-ordination & Security or Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad.
- a) Prohibit carrying of arms such as swords, spears, knives, sticks with or without flags bludgeons, guns, explosives, and other offensive weapons in the above mentioned areas.
- b) Prohibit gathering of persons on the public roads or public places disturbing peace and order or causing inconvenience, annoyance or danger to public.
- c) Prohibit collection, carrying of stones or other means of casting missiles.
- II Prohibit use of mikes/public address system by different Organisations around the Secretariat premises, including Burgula Rama Krishna Rao Building, Greater Hyderabad Municipal Corporation Building, Commissioner of Fisheries building, Mint Compound, Nizam College and its surroundings, Telangana Legislative Assembly premises and surrounding roads, Public Garden Nampally, Upper Tankbund, I-MAX, Rotary and NTR Marg roads also fly-over road leading from Secretariat to Visweswarayya statue, Khairatabad.
- a) Prohibit music, singing or speeches or broadcasting through loud speakers in the above mentioned areas.
- b) Prohibit use of mikes/public address systems, use of horn through vehicles by any organisation, members of public etc., in the above mentioned areas.
- III The public are here by informed that any person violating the above orders shall be liable for prosecution under the Hyderabad City Police Act, 1348, Fasli (No. IX).
- IV **The following are exempted from the operation of this order**
- (i) Police Officers on duty,
(ii) Military personnel on duty,
(iii) Home Guards on duty,
(iv) Bonafide funeral processions.

This order shall be in force with effect from 0600 hours on 10-02-2018 to 0600 hours on 16-02-2018.

NOTIFICATION

WHEREAS, reports have been received indicating that High Volume Sound Emitting Systems including DJs (High Volume Sound Mixers) are being generating noise beyond permissible limits (day time 55 db(A) and night time 45 db(A) in Residential Areas, day time 65 db(A) and night time 55 db(A) in Commercial Areas) in places of public gatherings including Processions causing inconvenience, disturbance, nuisance, annoyance and Under Section 67(c) prohibit bursting of fire crackers on public places / public roads, public meetings and marriages to the residents of locality and public in general.

WHEREAS, such acts have been causing acute inconvenience and distress among the children, old aged persons, patients and students in particular pursuing their studies in the residential localities.

WHEREAS, such High Volume sounds generated at Public Meetings, Marriages and Processions have been neutralizing Police Communication Systems deployed in relation to bandobust duties, thereby adversely affecting the function of maintenance of Public Order and Tranquillity by Law Enforcement Agencies.

AND WHEREAS, it is considered expedient to take stringent and speedy measures to control the use of High Volume Sound Emitting Systems including DJs (High Volume Sound Mixers) in place of Public gatherings including processions in the residential localities.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred under Rule 8 of Noise Pollution (Regulation & Control) Rules 2000, I, V.V. Srinivasa Rao, IPS Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad City, do hereby make this written order and notify the same to the General Public Prohibiting the following within Hyderabad City, except in cases specifically permitted by the Divisional Asst. Commissioners of Police of the concerned jurisdiction:

- Use of High Volume Sound Systems including DJs (High Volume Sound Mixers) emanating sound levels beyond permissible limits in places of Public Gatherings including Processions in the Residential Localities.
- Prohibit bursting of fire crackers at public places / public roads, public meetings and marriage function halls causing inconvenience to the residents of locality and public in general.

This order shall come into force from 0600 hrs on 08-02-2018 and shall remain in force for a period of 15 days i.e., upto 0600 hrs on 22-02-2018, both days inclusive unless withdrawn earlier.

Any person violating this order shall be liable for punishment u/s 67(c), 188 of IPC and u/s 76 of the Hyderabad City Police Act, 1348 Fasli.

NOTIFICATION

WHEREAS, reports have been received indicating that consumption of liquor in public places has become rampant and unhindered in several areas of the City of Hyderabad, resulting in to a menace to the common members of the public, especially women and children in particular.

AND WHEREAS, such reports have been indicating that, persons consuming liquor in public places have been exhibiting abrasive unruly and indecent behavior on the streets of Hyderabad City towards law abiding citizens especially women and children in particular endangering their modesty and safety in addition to causing disturbance to public tranquility resulting in annoyance and obstruction to road users in general and women and children in particular.

WHEREAS, such unruly and indecent behavior has been instilling a sense of fear psychosis in law abiding citizens, especially women and children resulting in restriction of their free movement on the streets of Hyderabad, thereby affecting public safety at large and safety and security of women and children in particular.

AND WHEREAS, it is considered necessary to take speedy measures in this regard to prevent danger to human life and safety and security of women and children or for preventing any affray and disturbance of public tranquility.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me under Section 144 of Criminal Procedure Code 1973, I, V.V. Srinivasa Rao, IPS Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad City, do hereby make this written order and notify the same to the General Public **prohibiting Consumption of liquor in public places in the City of Hyderabad.**

This order is published for the information of public through the media and through the public address system in the areas affected with drunkenness in public places.

This order shall come into force from 0600 hours on 09-02-2018 and shall remain in force for a period of one week i.e. upto 0600 hours on 15-02-2018 (both days inclusive) unless withdrawn earlier.

Any person violating this order shall be liable for punishment under Section 188 of the Indian Penal code and as per the provisions of Hyderabad City Police Act, 1348 Fasli.

NOTIFICATION

WHEREAS, it has been brought to my notice that the Terrorist/Antisocial elements may organize attacks through Para Gliders, Remote Controlled Drones, Remote Controlled Micro Light Aircraft etc., and that there is an increasing trend by events organizers to use remote controlled drones for getting aerial views for live telecasts and photography of various events.

WHEREAS, inputs have been received by Intelligence agencies about the possibility of attacks by Terrorist/Antisocial elements by the use of Para-gliders, Remote Controlled Drones, Remote Controlled Micro-Light Aircraft, etc., and there is every likelihood of breach of peace and disturbance of Public tranquility and also there is grave danger to human life, health, safety and damage to public property on that account.

AND WHEREAS, it is necessary that reasonable checks are imposed on activities of such antisocial elements in the limits of Hyderabad City Police Commissionerate to prevent the attack through Remote Controlled Drones or through Para-Gliders or through Remotely Controlled Micro-Light Aircraft.

NOW THEREFORE, I, V.V. Srinivasa Rao, IPS, Commissioner of Police and Executive Magistrate of Hyderabad City vide powers conferred upon me u/sec 144 of the Criminal Procedure Code 1973 (Act II of 1974), **do hereby order that no flying activities of Remotely Controlled Drones or Para-Gliders or Remotely Controlled Micro-Light Aircraft be allowed in the Jurisdiction of Hyderabad City Police Commissionerate limits without prior Police permission in writing.**

No Non-Government agency, organization or individual will be allowed to launch Unmanned Aerial Vehicle (UAV), Unmanned Aerial Survey (UAS) etc.

Government agencies and organizations should obtain appropriate clearance from local Police and Aviation authorities before launching any UAS/UAV for any purpose.

Any person contravening this order shall be punishable under section 188 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860.

This order shall remain in force from 08-02-2018 to 07-03-2018.

As the notice cannot be served individually to all concerned, the order is hereby passed ex-parte. It shall be published for the information of public, through press and by affixing copies on the Notice Boards of the Police Stations, Divisional ACsP, Zonal DCsP offices.

**SLEUTHS OF SULTAN BAZAAR POLICE BLASTED RACKET OF
FRAUDULENT PRODUCTION OF DEATH CERTIFICATES GANG DURING
LIFE TIME - RECOVERED DEATH CERTIFICATES IN CRIME NO. 04/2018
OF P.S SULTAN BAZAR.**

On 12-01-2018 at 1830 hours received a complaint from Sri P.P. Rama Rao, occ: Branch Manager, LIC of India, Branch office, CB-19, Putlibowli, Koti, Sultan Bazar, Hyderabad against the accused persons i.e., Smt. Ushasri and Ravi Sankar Sarma for discharging of death claims during their life time by submitting fraudulent death certificate.

During the course of investigation, the sleuths of Sultan Bazar Police nabbed the following accused persons subsequently one after other i.e., Aripirala Ravi Sankar Sarma, s/o Kumara Swamy, aged 38 yrs, occ: Business, Caste: Brahmin, r/o Flat No. 202, Sanjana Lake View Apartment, Gangastan, Dhollapally, Hyderabad., N/o Tripuranthakam (V), Prakashan District of Andhra Pradesh State., Mohammed Mujeeb-ulla-Khan, s/o Mohammed Azmath-ulla-Khan, aged 42 yrs, occ: Mechanic in RTC., r/o H. No. 5-8-214, MLG Road, Shamsh Nagar, BTS, Nalgonda District of Telangana State and Khaja Arifuddin, s/o Md. Khaja Moinuddin, aged 40 yrs, occ: Revenue Officer at Municipal at Nalgonda District, r/o H. No. 6-1-176, Municipal Quarters, Nalgonda District of Telangana State and seized (DEATH CERTIFICATES IN RESPECT OF A-1: ARIPIRALA RAVI SANKAR SARMA WHICH WERE FRAUDULENTLY PROCURED DURING LIFE TIME) from the possession of accused.

The accused person i.e., **Aripirala Ravi Sankar Sarma** in cahoot with Smt. **Aripirala Ushasri** (Wife of Ravi Sankar Sarma), **Mohammed Mujeeb-ulla-Khan.**, and **Khaja Arifuddin** fraudulently procured death certificate in respect of A-1: Aripirala Ravi Sankar Sarma during his life time and submitted the same at the office of LIC, Putlibowli & Chaitanyapura Branch through LIC Agent i.e., **Pulla Reddy** (Acted as LIC Agent on behalf of his wife by name Smt. Vinitha Gogi Reddy) and discharged death claim amount of Rs. 14,15,736/- by deceiving officials.

Apart from this case, the accused i.e, Aripirala Ravi Sankar Sarma is also involved in Crime No. 794/2017 U/s 420, 468 and 471 IPC of P.S Chaitanyapuri, Cyberabad and the same is under investigation.

Under the supervision of Sri C. Shashidhar Raju, Dy. Commissioner of Police, East Zone, Hyderabad, Sri G. Chakravarthy, Asst. Commissioner of Police, Sultan Bazar Division, Hyderabad, Sri P. Siva Shankar Rao, Inspector of Police, P.S Sultan Bazar, Hyderabad, Sri K. Madhusudhan, S.I and his team were instrumental in arresting the accused persons who were indulged in discharging death claims during life time by submitting death certificate which was fraudulently procured from the office of Muncipal, Nalgonda District and deceiving officials of LIC department.

**CHEYUTA ROLLED INTO PRE-RECRUITMENT TRAINING PROGRAMME –
INAUGURATION OF OUT-DOOR TRAINING ON 07.02.2018 IN THE EVENING
AT GHMC GROUNDS, LALAPET, SECUNDERABAD**

On 04.12.2016 “Cheyutha” (Skill/Job Mela) was conceived and conducted by Hyderabad City Police (North Zone) which was seen as meaningful step towards concept of “Community Policing” adopted by Telangana State Police/Hyderabad City Police in a way where different kinds of stakeholders were brought on to one platform by Police with a slogan **“We Pledge not only for your safety, but also for your well being”**. As a part of Cheyutha 6966 unemployed youngsters/women who got registered online <http://www.tscheyuthapolicejobmela.com> were interviewed by 70+companies/organizations. **It was done at the behest of TMI which opened a new chapter for Civic-Police partnership for community good.**

INAUGURATION OF PRE-RECRUITMENT TRAINING PROGRAMME

It was done on 05.08.2017 at 1600 hrs. at Hari Hara Kala Bhavan, Secunderabad by Sri. M. Mahender Reddy, IPS, Director General of Police, Telangana State (Erstwhile Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad) in the presence of Smt. Neetu Kumari Prasad, IAS, Projector Director, TSSDM and Sri. Muralidharan, Founder and Chairman, TMI and the function was attended by Sri. Vijay Pratap Maharaj of Art of Living and Sri. B.S.N. Murthy respectively.

ACTION PLAN

In North Zone, action plan has been prepared for Pre-Police Recruitment Training for about 1875 youth. In this regard in all the Police Stations of North Zone, Secunderabad applications were received from the aspirants and completed the physical fitness (Height) and certificate verification. Finally, a total of 1875 candidates are selected for the training, among them 722 are girls and 1153 are boys.

IN-DOOR TRAINING

All the selected candidates are given training for preliminary written examination at the various training centers.

TRAINING CENTERS

For the purpose of training 3-Centers at YMCA, Secunderabad (Gopalpuram Division), Tivoli Gardens (Begumpet Division) and D.A.D. (Mahankali Division) under the charge of Divisional ACsP at each Center have been arranged.

In this regard the following procedure is adapted to impart coaching for the 1875 Candidates in three batches each batch consists of 625-Candidates.

- The services of the Faculties of M/s Bhagya Kiran Institute, Hyderabad for the indoor classes in all the subjects of syllabus has provided,
- The training period has been scheduled for a period of 4-months daily from 1600 hrs. to 2000 hrs.
- All the 3-Batches have been accommodated at the Centers for indoor and outdoor training,
- Weekly exams have been conducted for the candidates to review the standards and improvements,
- Study material covering all the subjects and prescribed syllabus has been supplied to all the candidates,

UNIFORM

A Blue colour printed T-Shirt for Boys and Girls candidates has been provided during the training.

LOGISTICS AT THE TRAINING CENTER

Public addressing system, huge screen with projector, chairs, mineral water, I.D. Cards and Biometric attendance system have been provided at the Training Center.

BUDGET SANCTIONED BY THE GOVT. UNDER TSSDM

An amount of Rs. **29,04,000-00** has been sanctioned by the Mission Director, Telangana State Skill Development Mission, Hyderabad for taking up Pre Police Recruitment Training Programme for 1200 youths in North Zone, Secunderabad as proposed by the Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad on the request of the Dy. Commissioner of Police, North Zone, Secunderabad.

Out of the above sanctioned budget an amount of **Rs. 10,00,000-00 (Rupees Ten Lakhs only)** has been released towards the 1st installment and credited in the Head Office.

On 21.07.2017, an amount of **Rs. 2,00,000/- (Rupees Two Lakhs only)** have been withdrawn and paid to the Trader for **1,000 T-shirts** ordered for the use of candidates during the Pre Police Recruitment Training Programme and each T-shirt cost Rs. 200/-.

On 04.08.2017, an amount of Rs. **1,00,000/- (Rupees One Lakh only)** has been drawn for the expenditure towards the miscellaneous work

On 22.09.2017, an amount of **Rs. 5,00,000/- (Rupees Five Lakhs only)** and on 30.12.2017, an amount of **Rs. 2,00,000/- (Rupees Two Lakhs only)** has been withdrawn and paid to M/s Bhagya Kiran Coaching Center, Hyderabad towards the remuneration for free teaching staff, who rendered their services from the commencement of pre-recruitment training commenced from 05.08.2017 in North Zone.

Remaining amount of Rs. 19,04,000/- (Rupees Nineteen lakhs four thousand only) has to be released by the Mission Director, Telangana State Skill Development Mission, Hyderabad.

During the indoor training the candidates were given training in the subjects of History, Biology, Arithmetic, Reasoning, Economy, English, Geography, Polity and Telangana History for a period of 4-months and 21-days by utilizing the best services of Faculties from M/s Bhagya Kiran Coaching Institute, Hyderabad. During the indoor training 45-motivation classes have been given to the candidates by the Expertise Motivators.

Now, the North Zone Police has taking up Pre Police Recruitment Training Programme for 1197 youths in North Zone, Secunderabad as proposed by the Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad on the request of the Dy. Commissioner of Police, North Zone, and Secunderabad and out of which 700-800 members have attended for the indoor classes regularly.

- For the proposed outdoor training they have been divided into 2-groups and for the outdoor training in 2-grounds i.e. GHMC Stadium, Lalapet (in the limits of Lalaguda P.S.) and Hockey Grounds, Sikh village, (in the limits of Karkhana P.S.).
- Outdoor training will be imparted to all the candidates by the assistance of 12-PET's/Expert and Trained Coaches, with the assistance of 3-Mentor Sub-Inspectors, 8-Asst. Reserve Sub-Inspectors of Police and 13-Mentor Constable Officer who are expertise in the events of 100-meters running, 800-meters running, Shot put throwing, long and High Jumps etc. The training scheduled will be as 0600 hrs. to 0800 hrs. in the morning. They will be supplied with energy supplements.

- In this connection on 07.02.2018 in the evening the outdoor training events will be inaugurated by the Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad at the GHMC Stadium, Lalapet (Under the limits of Lalaguda P.S.) It will be attended by Sri. V.V. Srinivasa Rao, IPS, Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad as Chief Guest, Sri. M. Shiva Prasad, IPS, Addl. Commissioner of Police, CAR Head Quarters, Sri. J. Shankaraiah, Zonal Commissioner, GHMC and Sri. T. Kiran Kumar, Director, M/s Bhagyakiran coaching Institution as Other guests.
- Introduction about the training and programme will be given by Inspector, Lalaguda P.S., followed by the speeches by Sri. Srinatha Chary, Motivator, 2-candidates from Begumpet and Chilkalguda PSs, one Parent from Karkhana P.S., Mentors from Gopalpuram, Market and Begumpet PSs, Mentor SI Sri. Ch. Ganesh, Tukaramgate P.S., Inspector, Karkhana P.S. on upcoming outdoor training, ACP Gopalpuram, Briefing by the Dy. Commissioner of Police, North Zone, Sri. T. Kiran Kumar, Director, M/s Bhagya Kiran Coaching Institute, Addl. Commissioner of Police, CAR Head Quarters and the Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad City.
- During the inauguration, rewards will be given to the 9-candidates who secured top marks in the 2-Grand Tests during the Indoor training.
