**ONE NIGERIAN DRUG PEDDLER HELD –SEIZED 15 GRAMS
COCAINE**

On 06-03-2017, on credible information the Commissioner's Task force, East Zone Team, Hyderabad City, with the assistance of Jubilee Hills Police nabbed **One Nigerian National** by name **Patrick Williams Uzonna**, near Post Brew Pub, road no.45, Jubilee Hills, Hyderabad. Seized **15 grams Cocaine, One Maestro Bike B.No.AP13AE7431** and **03-Cell phones**, from the possession of accused.

The details of accused person arrested:-

Patrick Williams Uzonna s/o Williams, R/o Suncity, R.R.Dist, N/o Nigeria Nationalist.

Property seized :-

- 1) 15 grams of Cocaine,
- 2) One two wheeler Bearing No. AP-13-AE-7431,
- 3) 3-Cell phones

The brief facts of the case :-

The brief facts of the case are that the accused person by name **Patrick Williams Uzonna** a Nigerian National came to India on visit VISA in the month of September 2016 and staying in Hyderabad. He met with Mr. Davis Chris Richard Mueller @ Collins belongs to a Kenya Nationalist in a pub, who is drug peddler. Then he hatched a plan to earn money for his lavish life by supplying drugs to needy customers. Patrick Williams used to procure 1 gram of Cocaine per Rs.2,000/- from Mr. Davis Chris Richard Mueller and sells the same for Rs.5,000/- to Rs.6,000/- per 1 gram. He used to supply the contraband to the needy customers by moving on two wheeler Maestro Bike and earning easy money illegally.

Today i.e. on 06-03-2017 in the evening hours, while the accused person is present near Post Brew Pub, road no.45, Jubilee Hills, Hyderabad on his two wheeler along with contraband drug i.e. Cocaine for selling the same to the needy customers, police apprehended him and seized **15 grams of Cocaine, One Maestro Bike B.No.AP13AE7431, and 03-Cell phones** at the instance of the accused person.

Efforts are on to apprehend the other accused involved in this trade.

The arrested accused along with seized property was handed over to SHO, Jubilee Hills PS, for judicial remand.

A-1) Bakkavari Vinod is a previous offender and arrested by Jeedimetla police in 2014 in a house theft case. He made friendship with A-2) Gundu Prabhakar (auto driver), A-3) Konde Arun Rao (private job) and A-4) Gali Anjil Reddy (Mason). They all planned to earn easy money by committing thefts in the house. A-1) Vinod and A-3) Konde Arun Rao goes for committing theft and Vinod enters into the room/house and commit theft of Cellphones/ Laptops/ Net cash while A-3) Arun Rao observes the outside of the targeted room/ house. A-2) G Prabhakar provided shelter and food to the A-1 and encouraged him to commit thefts and A-4) Gali Anjil Reddy took the stolen property for disposal.
