NOTIFICATION

With a view to maintaining public order and tranquillity I, V.V. Srinivasa Rao, IPS, Commissioner of Police Hyderabad City, in exercise of the powers vested in me, Under Section 22(1) (a) to (f) and 22 (2) (a) and (b) of Hyderabad City Police Act, 1348 Fasli (No.IX), do hereby prohibit every kind of assembly or public meeting or procession that has potential to cause disturbance to the public peace and safety within a radius of four kilometres of the Telangana State Legislative Assembly / Council Building. In connection with Telangana State Legislative Assembly / Council Budget Sessions scheduled to commence from 12-03-2018.

This order shall come into force with effect from 0600 hours on 12-03-2018 to 0600 hrs on 18-03-2018.

THE POLICE MIRCHOWK ARRESTED THREE ACCUSED PERSONS IN CRIME NO. 37/2018, U/S 420, 506 IPC & SEC. 28 OF INDIAN ARMS ACT AND SEC. 7 OF DRUGS AND MAGIC REMEDIES (OBJECTIONABLE ADVERTISEMENTS) ACT 1954 OF MIRCHOWK PS, HYDERABAD, WHO THEY ARE IN HABIT OF CHANT TO HEAL THE PEOPLE WHO VISIT HIM ON BELIEF AND THEY PRETEND TO PERFORM WORSHIP DOINGS TO RELINQUISH THE POWERS AND TO RICE PULLING (RP) AND CHEATED COMPLAINANT AND OTHERS FOR AN AMOUNT APPROXIMATELY RS. 5 CRORES

BRIEF FACTS OF THE CASE: On 24-02-2018 at 2300 hrs received complaint from Rustum Patel stating that accused Mehtab Hussain @ Adil has cheated by inducing complainant that they are well known conjurer and has unearthed several wealth, which were concealed by the respective ancestors. In order to relinquish the power which are holding the wealth, they has to perform some adore activities by doing black magic activities and also induced complainant to give Rice Puller and collected huge amounts from him.

MODUS OPERANDI

The accused A-1 is born and brought up in Hyderabad and running furniture business on the name of SMH Furniture's (Syed Mehtab Hussain). The accused A-2 is third wife of A-1. They addicted to live lavish needs and in habit of chant to heal the people who visits them on belief. The accused persons came in contact with complainant through one Azam, N/o. Bidar District, Karnataka State and developed friendship with him. In order to cheat complainant the accused persons provoked him that his ancestors who are emperors concealed wealth and asked him to pay money in order to relinquish the power which is holding the wealth. The accused persons excavated some earth at Bidar and when nothing was found he informed complainant that he has given less amounts and has to pay more money to perform adore activities so that they can gain control over the evil powers which are concealing the wealth. The accused person A-1 pretended that complainant ancestors i.e., Great Grand Fathers souls were talking with him and the wealth will be unearthed only when he gratify them. The accused persons used to say Rustum Patel that he used to be king in his past life i.e., 4000 years back and having palaces in Mysore of Karnataka State. If they perform adore activities, Rustum Patel can get one ring which gives him some supernatural powers and by using the same he can able to get the wealth. The accused also given one photograph of unknown lady, some letters written in Hindi stating that the same were given by lady who is to be wife of Rustum Patel in his past life, presently she is also re-born and passionate to marry him. The accused informed Rustum Patel that he is possession of Rice Pulling item, which is used in satellite technology and its worth Crores of rupees in international market. When the

complainant asked him to repay the amounts the accused threatened him by showing imitation arms (Air Pistol) and also threatened him with the help of Junglee Yousuf, who is rowdy sheeter of Habeeb Nagar Police Station.

As Rustom Patel believed accused in all manner, he didn't let him off and whenever he questions him or get distrust on him, accused used to create panic in his mind by saying mercilessly that if he stop doing worship activity or else any activity which was instructed by him, he and his family members will die.

The complainant, who is victim visited the exorcist i.e., A-1 & A-2 he get so hooked to the session that he kept on visiting him until his money is drained out. The accused persons A-1 & A-2 are exploiting innocent people by taking advantage of the bad times in their life. They loot money, gold ornaments and other kinds of property giving the victims a hard life ahead.

The accused totally collected an amount approximately Rs. 5 Crores from Rustom Patel and others in order to fulfil accused money demands he sold out his properties, collected money from known persons and paid to accused persons.

With the collected amounts the accused lived lavishly needs like he along with his family members visited to Hongkong and others places in India. He also invested the money in order to expand his furniture business. The accused persons purchased 2000 sq.yds land in Chinna Golconda, Shamshabad and started construction work in order to erect water plant in the said land and also constructed the building as Ground + Three floors at chintalmet by the help of complainant.

The accused person A-3 Junglee Yousuf has threatened complainant with dire consequences and kept an amount of Rs. 8,50,000/- which was given the accused persons A-1 & A-2 for handing over the same to complainant.

**APPREHENDED TWO PERSONS WHO ARE IN POSSESSION OF "CHARAS"
BY CENTRAL ZONE TASK FORCE TEAM, HYDERABAD AND SEIZED ABOUT
01 KG CHARAS, ONE HONDA ACTIVA AND 02 MOBILE PHONES WORTH
RS.4,00,000/-**

On 07-03-2018, on credible information the sleuths of Commissioner's Task Force, Central Zone team, Hyderabad and Police Tappachabutra apprehended two persons at 'T' Junction, near old Police Station Tappachabutra, Hyderabad who are in possession of "**CHARAS**" a Narcotic substance and **Seized about 1 Kg of CHARAS, One Honda Activa and two mobile phones** from them.

Details of the Accused:

1. Mohammed Arshad s/o Mohammed Akhlaaq aged 28 years Occ:Carpenter r/o H.No.12-1-489/9, Beside Shanker Kirana Shop, near Ganje Shahi Dargah, Shanker Nagar, Tappachabutra, Hyderabad District, Native of Near Sabzimandi, Chand Colony, Saharanpur District U.P State
2. Mohammed Aleem s/o Mohammed Naseer aged 28 years Occ:Carpenter r/o Opp.Kanaka Durga Wines beside Pond, Bheeramguda (V) Patancheru Dist Native of Near Sabzimandi, Chand Colony, Saharanpur District U.P. State

SEIZED PROPERTY:

- 1) Charas - about 1 Kg
- 2) Honda Activa vehicle - 1
- 3) Cell Phone - 2

Brief facts of the case:

Both the accused namely Mohammed Arshad and Mohammed Aleem are native of Saharanpur of Utter Pradesh State. About Ten Years back they migrated to Hyderabad for eking their livelihood and started working as a Carpenter and worked in various furniture workshops, thereafter they started their own workshops of furniture at Jirra, Tappachabutra, Hyderabad and Bheeramguda, Patancheru, Sangareddy District. Both suffered loss in their business and to meet their financial losses, they hatched a plan to sell Charas to earn cash money. As per their plan Mohammad Arshad taken assurance from Mohammed Aleem that, he will arrange to sell Charas to his known and needy customers, for which Arshad will give good commission to Mohammed Aleem. Mohammed Arshad used to bring Charas from his native place i.e., Saharanpur of Utter Pradesh State. On 22-2-2018 he informed his mother namely Shamshad Begum, that he is facing financial problems in Hyderabad and requested his mother to bring Charas from Saharanpur, as there is demand of Charas in Hyderabad. As per the request of Mohd Arshad his mother 25-02-2018 brought about 1 Kg of charas and handed over to his son Mohd Arshad and again left to his native place Saharanpur of U.P. After taking the Charas Mohd Arshad initially gave a sample to Aleem in order to sell the same. But the Aleem who is addict of consuming narcotic drugs i.e., Charas consumed the sample given by Arshad instead of sale. As such today while Mohammed Arshad and Mohammed Aleem both came to 'T' Junction, Old Police Station Tappachabutra to deliver the Charas to needy customers keeping the drug Charas packed in plastic cover in their Honda Active vehicle, meanwhile on the tip of information Task Force, Central Zone Team and police Tappachabutra apprehended them along with Charas.

The accused Mohammed Arshad and Mohammed Aleem along with the seized material handed over to Tappachabutra Police, Hyderabad for further investigation.

The above accused persons were apprehended by **Sri Sayini Srinivasa Rao, Inspector of Police, Central Zone Task Force**, and SIs S/Sri G.Thimmappa, B.Kantha Reddy, and Central Zone Task Force Team and Sri G.Chandrashekar Addl.Inspector of Police, Tappachabutra PS under the supervision of **Sri P Radhakishan Rao, Dy. Commissioner of Police, Commissioner's Task Force, Hyderabad.**

In pursuance of his confession statement, stolen property i.e., "10" Honda Activa's, "4" Yamaha FZ, "3" TVS Apache, "1" Bajaj Pulsar, "1" Twister all worth Rs.10 Lakhs were recovered at the instance of boy juvenile and from purchasers. One person who purchased three vehicles knowingly on stolen is also arrested. The Boy juvenile and receiver are being sent to judicial custody.

The Modus Operandi of boy juvenile is that he will moves in the late nights in isolated places and commit theft of two wheelers by breaking the locks and the same were disposed to needy customers for nominal price by saying that the seized vehicles of finance defaulters in his finance work place.

In the year 2015 boy juvenile apprehended by Abid Road police in cell phone theft case and remanded to judicial custody. Later during the year 2016 he was again arrested by Asif Nagar Police in cell phone and vehicle theft case and sent to judicial remand. After releasing from juvenile home he did private job at different places and his earnings not sufficient for his lavish expenditures and he decided to commit theft of two wheelers and the same were disposed to needy customers for nominal price by saying that the seized vehicles of finance defaulters in his finance work place.

The case is being investigated by SI Sri.S.Sampath with the assistance of and team, under the supervision of DI Sri.N.Mohan Rao, Sri A.Gangaram, Inspector of Police and Sri.Biksham Reddy, Asst.
