NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me under section 21 (1) (b) of the Hyderabad City Police Act, 1957, M.Mahendar Reddy, IPS., Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad, do hereby notify for the information of general public that in order to facilitate proper control and regulation of traffic in connection with **“UJJAINI MAHANKALI JATARA” at Secunderabad** following traffic regulations are made from 0400 hours on 09-07-2017 to 2200 hours on 10-07-2017.

ON 09-07-2017 FROM 0400 HOURS TO TILL CONCLUSION OF POOJA:

1. The road leading to Mahankali Temple from Tobacco Bazar Hill Street and General Bazar Secunderabad will be closed for all vehicular traffic.
2. Subash Road starting from Bata X roads up to Ramgopalpet PS Secunderabad will be closed for all vehicular traffic.
3. The road leading to Mahankali Temple from Advaiah X roads Secunderabad will be closed for all vehicular traffic.
4. The road leading to Mahankali Temple from General Bazar Secunderabad will be closed for all vehicular traffic.

DIVERSIONS:

1. 1) **Ranigunj x roads:** General Traffic and RTC Buses coming from Karbala Maidan will be diverted at Ranigunj x roads towards Minister Road – Rasoolpura x roads – R/T – CTO – SBH x roads – YMCA x roads – St.John’s Rotary – Gopalapuram Lane – Railway Station.
Note: 1) RTC Buses return from Railway Station towards Tank bund will pass through Alfa Hotel x road – Gandhi X roads- Sajjanlal street – Old Tr.P.S.Mahankali – Ghasmandi – Bible house –Karbala Maidan
2) RTC Buses return from Railway Station towards Tadban and Begumpet will pass through Clock Tower – Patny X roads/ YMCA X road – SBH x roads.
2. **Ghasmandi X roads:** General Traffic coming from Bible house will be diverted at Ghasmandi x roads towards Sajjanlal Street and Hill street.
3. **Patny x roads :**
 - (a) General Traffic coming from SBH x roads towards R.P.Road will be diverted at Patny x roads towards Clock Tower and Paradise.
 - (b) General Traffic coming from Paradise towards R.P.Road will be diverted at Patny x roads towards SBH or Clock Tower.
 - (c) General Traffic coming from Clock Tower towards R.P.Road will be diverted at Patny x roads towards SBH X roads and Paradise.

4. **Paradise X roads** : General Traffic coming from CTO Junction towards M.G.Road will be diverted at Paradise X roads towards HDFC Bank – L/T – Sindhi Colony – R/T – Minister Road – L/T- Ranigunj X roads –R/T – Karbala Maidan. Traffic coming from Patny x roads will be diverted at Paradise x roads towards CTO Junction.

ON 10-07-2017 FROM 1400 HOURS TO 2200 HOURS:

1. The Road between Secunderabad Railway Station towards St.Mary's Road will be closed for all vehicular traffic.
2. All buses proceeding towards Secunderabad Railway Station from Hakeempet, Bowenpally, Balanagar and Ameerpet will be terminated at Clock Tower and they will return to their destinations on the same route i.e., Via: Patny, SBH X Road.

PARKING PLACES:

1. For the vehicles coming from St.Johns Rotary, Sweekar Upkar, SBH side will park their vehicles at **Hari Hara Kala Bhavan / Mahboobia College.**
2. For the vehicles coming from Karbla Maidan, Bible House, Ghansmandi side will park their vehicles in **Islamia High School**

GOPALAPURAM POLICE BUSTED ONE JOB RACKET GANG AND
ARRESTED ONE SELF STYLED GODMAN

On 06.07.2017, Gopalapuram Police apprehended three cheaters namely (1) Dadubanjan Vittal, (2) Surukanti Padma Reddy and (3) Bommanaboina Niranjan Kumar who cheated the gullible people on pretext of providing jobs in government and private sectors.

ACCUSED

- (A-1) Dadubanjan Vittal S/o D. Satyanarayana, age; 37 years, Occ; Poojari, Caste: Patkara (Kshathriya) Presently r/o beside Toli Masjid, Karwan, Hyderabad, N/o Alladurgam (V) & (M), Medak district
(A-2) Surukanti Padma Reddy S/o Narayana Reddy, age; 46 years, Occ; Ayurvedic Doctor, r/o 1-1-1260, Vanastalipuram, Hyderabad
(A-3) Bommana Boina Niranjan Kumar S/o B. Satyanarayana, age; 42 years, Occ; Business, r/o 1-6-113, Boyawada, Karimnagar town
(A-4) Ramesh r/o Kothapet, Dilsukh Nagar, Hyderabad (**Absconding**)

HISTORY

A-1) is native of Alladurgam (V) & (M), Medak district. He studied upto 5th class and in the year 2001, he with one Dhanunjaya and learnt tactics and manthras from him. After learning all works from him, A-1 murdered him in the year 2005, upon which a case in Crime No. 23/2005 U/s 302, 201 IPC was registered at Mididoddi PS, Medak district. The A-1 was arrested in that case and sent to jail. After releasing from jail, the A-1 started acting as Pujari/Baba and used to make the gullible public to believe that he can cure all types of diseases and provide luck to them etc. So far, he was arrested in the following cases,

- 1) Cr. No. 23/2005 U/s 302, 201 IPC was registered at Mididoddi PS, Medak
- 2) Cr No. 269/2008 U/s 302 IPC (Double murder) of Toopran PS, Medak
- 3) Cr No. 71/2012 U/s 364-A, 342, 324, 387, 511, 202 r/w 149 IPC & 25 (a) (f) Arms Act of PS Pitlam, Medak
- 4) Cr No. 186/2015 U/s 25 (I) (b) Arms Act of Dubbaka PS.

After releasing from jail, he started deceiving the innocent people by acting as Baba/Pujari. As the A-1 unable to get sufficient amounts from puja work, the A-1 decided to earn easy money by printing fake Indian currency notes and the A-1 along with his friend Venu purchased one currency printing machine at Hyderabad and took it to Siddipet. Though they purchased the printing machine, they unable to print currency notes, due to fear of police they threw away the printing machine in a well at Errukodu village, Medak district. The A-1 shifted residence to Siddipet and in the year 2016, the A-1 got introduction with A-2 to A-4. During the time, they all formed as a gang and decided to cheat the innocent people on pretext of providing jobs in government and private sectors. In that process, they have cheated several gullible people. The A-1 induced some electronic media people that he is having black magic


powers and can provide luck with poojas. The A-1 have collected some amounts from them and spent the same for expenditures. On 06-07-2017 at about 1130 hours, A-1 to A-3 were gathered at Christian grave yard, Alugaddabavi x roads and discussing about future plans, police apprehended them.

In that process, in the month of January 2016, the accused A-1 to A-4 cheated one Mallikarjun on pretext of providing job in AP Genco and took Rs. 4 Lakhs. (Cr. No. 155/2017 u/s 420, 468, 471 IPC of PS Gopalapuram)

In the month of March, 2016, the accused A-1 to A-4 cheated one N. Bal Chandram on pretext of providing government job in Income Tax Department and collected Rs. 30 Lakhs. (Crime No. 173/2017 U/s 468, 471, 420, 506 R/w 34 IPC of Ramgopalpet PS)

Recovery: Rs. 16,81,000/- (Sixteen Lakhs eighteen thousand rupees), Bank passbook pertains to A-1 account A/c No. 122400101005505 of Corporation Bank, Two Samsung J7 cell phones, Two Samsung DUOs cell phones VIVO cell phone and black colour CEELKON cell phone.

The good is work done by Sri P. Gangadhar Reddy, SI of Police, Sri Rakesh Yadav (PC 3211), Sri Manoj Kumar (PC 4772), Sri R. Raju (PC 5143), Sri JBK Raju (PC 4073) & Sri Rama Krishna (HG 8343) under the supervision of Sri Ch. Sridhar, Inspector of Police and able guidance of Sri K. Srinivasa Rao, ACP, Gopalapuram division. The staff will be rewarded suitably.

PRESS NOTE

The Cyber Crime Police, CCS, DD, Hyderabad City apprehended four notorious offenders Mr.Kiran Kumar of Hyderabad, Aboobacker of Kerala, Haneef Hamza of Kerala and Ram Kumar of Hyderabad on 06-07-2017 who are committing online cheating through POS machines.

The facts of the case are that on 22-06-2017 at 15.30 hours received a complaint from Mr.Mohammad Altaf Wani Branch Head, J&K Bank, Abids stating that Mr.Mamidi Mahesh of Vanasthalipuram opened four current accounts with their bank and requested for EDC machines (POS machines) to do his business. Hence their bank issued four EDC Machines (POS Machines) to Mr.M.Mahesh of Vanasthalipuram for each current account to utilise the same in the business of the customer Mr.Mahesh in the month of February-2017. In the month of May-2017 the J&K bank received charge back requests from various banks all over India reporting fraud against the transactions made through the EDC machines issued to the customer Mr.Mahesh. Hence the complainant Mr.Mohammad Altaf Wani Branch Head, J&K Bank requested to take action against the customer Mr.Mamidi Mahesh. Aproximately Rs.1,10,000,00/- transactions were occurred in the four current accounts.

During the course of investigation it is revealed that the customer Mr.Mahesh was convicted for life in a dacoity case committed by him in the limits of Asifnagar Police Station previously. So he handed over the EDC machines to his associate Kiran Kumar. Kiran Kumar inturn handed over the machines to Mr.Chand Pasha under conspiracy for utilisation of the same in doing illegal transactions. Chand Pasha agreed to give a commission of 10% to Mr.Kiran Kumar over the amounts received into the accounts of Mahesh. Chandpasha handed over the machines to Aboobacker. Aboobacker got links with Mr.Yousuf of Kasarakode, Kerala who supplies cloned debit/credit cards as well as data pertaining to credit/debit cards along with pin numbers. Utilising the same Aboobacker makes the illegal transactions and the amount will be credited into the four accounts connected with the EDC machines. The money received in the current accounts was transferred to different accounts by Mr.Kiran Kumar as requested by Mr.Chand Basha. Mr.Ram Prasad is an associate of Kiran Kumar assisting him in doing the fraud. In the same way Mr.Haneefa Hamza is a translator to Aboobacker. Aboobacker doesn't know Hindi. The money sent by Mr.Kiran Kumar will be withdrawn by Chand Pasha and deducting his commission of 40%, he will handover rest of the money to Aboobacker. Aboobacker will in turn take his commission and handover the rest of the money to Yousuf.

ARREST OF NOTORIOUS PICK POCKETERS ETTA ANJANEYULU @ ANJI @ ANIL KUMAR & DEVARAKONDA DURGA RAO @ SRINU BY MARREDPALLY POLICE AND RECOVERY OF GOLD ORNAMENTS AND NET CASH RS. 35,000/- ALL WORTH RS. 3,00,000/-

Details of the case

On 27.05.2016 while the complainant Smt. D. Rajitha, Housewife r/o Chappal Bazar, Kachiguda, Hyderabad got down from a Bus at Jubilee Bus Stand, unknown offenders committed theft of a mini purse containing a gold necklace and one pair of ear rings and decamped with the booty. She lodged a complaint at Marredpally and basing on her compliant, a case in Cr.No.172/2017 u/s 379 IPC has been registered and investigation taken up by Sri. B. Aravind Goud, DSI, Marredpally P.S.

While the efforts were in progress to detect the case and during surprise checking to-day i.e., on 07.07.2017 at 1300 hours two persons in the age group of 35-40 years were found moving under suspicious circumstances in the vicinity of Jubilee Bus Stand. **Immediately they were taken into custody and on meticulous interrogation, they revealed their identity as Etta Anjaneyulu @ Anji @ Anil Kumar and A-2 Devarakonda Durga Rao @ Srinu** and confessed to have committed pick pocketing offences in the limits of Marredpally, Bowenpally, Mahankali, Market and Tukaramgate Police Stations of North Zone. They were arrested and the following property has been recovered and they are being produced in the Court for judicial remand.

MODUS OPERANDI:

The accused A-1 and A-2 commit Pick pocketing offences in heavy crowded places i.e. shopping mall opening, Political Public meetings, Marriage function halls, Rallys, Dharnas, RTC Bus Stands, Railway Stations and Important festivals i.e., Bonalu, Ganesh, Dassara etc., from innocent public.

So far they have committed 7 theft cases, out of which 3 cases are in the limits of Marredpally, 4 cases in the limits of PS Tukaramgate, Market, Mahankali and Bowenpally respectively.

Coming to the details;

In the limits of PS Santoshnagar two units namely Bhavani Agencies, Chakram brand Garam Masala in Rakshapuram, MKR products, Royal Rose brand ginger-garlic paste in Moinbagh, Riyasathnagar were raided.

The accused A. Sarjaiah @ Shekar S/o A. Pentaiah age 43 years R/o Nadergul, Rangareddy District is running the unit at Rakshapuram in the name and style as Bhavani Agencies wherein Chakram brand chilli powder, coriander powder, Garam Masala and other food products were being manufactured and packed. A Case in Cr.No.168/2017 U/SEC 272, 273, 336 and 420 IPC OF SANTOSHNAGAR PS has been registered

Chilly powder-

The chilly powder is made of poor and inferior quality chillies by grinding in an unhygienic way by mixing red colour, saw dust and other waste material .

Turmeric powder-

Turmeric powder is made of using low quality, sub standard finger turmeric and other waste material are being used and manufacturing in an unhygienic way using poor inferior quality finger turmeric and rice flour powder.

Garam Masala-

Garam Masala “Chakram brand” is being prepared using shells of Ilachy, shells of coriander, salt and poor quality chilly powder, saw dust and other waste material by grinding in an unhygienic way and it is packed and unpacked are being sold to customers and to the nearby Kirana shopkeepers, particularly in thickly populated localities in Hyderabad, supplying to the function halls during functions etc., and also selling in the districts.

AAMCHOUR;

He used to bring the rotted mangos from the market, bagged and stored in the unhygienic area. Due to the rains, all the mangos were spoiled with fungus. The same was used in preparation of AAMCHOUR and used to supply in the market.

The accused Mohammed Mujeeb-Ur-Rahaman S/o late Khaleel-Ur-Rahaman age 45 years, R/oRiyasat Nagar is running MKR products unit at MoinBagh, Riyasathnagar wherein “Royal Rose brand” ginger-garlic paste is manufactured and packed. He is involved in manufacturing of unhygienic, un-cleaned, poor and inferior quality ginger-garlic paste by mixing food color powder potatoes and onions and locally made acids

They are being sold in the name of “Royal Rose brand” garlic and ginger paste to the nearby Kirana shop located at Miralammandi, Madannapet areas particularly in thickly populated localities in Hyderabad, supplying to the function halls during functions etc., and also selling in the districts.

“The accused did not have valid licenses. This unhygienic stuff would effects on the consumer’s health. It also causes chronic abdomen disorders, food poisoning and sometimes it may lead to cancer and other diseases.

Cr.No. 217/2017 U/sec 272, 420 IPC OF CHATRINAKA PS

Sleuths of Chatrinaka PS raided one shop styled as Sri Sai Stores, Bhayalal Nagar, Chatrinaka, and apprehended the proprietor of the shop by name B. Purna Chander who was indulging in selling Oil and Dalda to the customers and shop keepers loosely after boiling the oil and dalda at his shop even though he was authorized to sell the oil and Dalda without tampering the seal of the reputed brands to the customers and earning easy money.

In turn the shop keepers who are purchasing loose Oil and dalda from the accused are preparing Ghee from the Oil and Dalda and selling the same to the innocent public on the name of pure Ghee endangering the public health.

The accused was previously arrested for the same offence in the year 2004 by Chatrinaka Police.

The arrested accused is being produced before the Honourble court.

The said house consist of G+2 floors. In the ground floor of said house he made a mulgi and running a slaughter house/beef shop. Daily he used to purchase the buffalos meat from Doodhbowli Kamela (Slaughter house), Fathedarwaza (Slaughter house) and sell the meat of buffalo to needy customers.

Besides he used to bring buffalos from cattle holding points i.e. Mallepally, kodada and various places from all over Telangana State through brokers and slaughtering them in his house in an un hygienic condition and the same meat has been supplying to butcher shops in and around Talabkatta, Yakuthpura, Santoshnagar areas.

Further he is illegally extracting the wastages, bones and cattle fat and used to preserves them at his slaughter house and further he used to prepare oil from the above said wastages and fat by heating them in aluminium bowls, filling them tins and selling the same to accused A2. Mohd. Amjad and inturn he is selling the same to A3. Khaja Moinuddin for higher price.

The accused person Mohd. Ghouse Qureshi is preparing adulterated oil by melting cattle fat and other wastages and selling the same and gaining illegal profits. If the common public consume this type of oil, which cause diseases like cancer, gastric problems, failure of kidneys and other viral fevers and makes the environment noxious which is endangerous to human life.

Further the accused person is running slaughter house at his house and illegally slaughtering the cattles in un hygienic condition and so many complaints received against the accused person from the locality people.
