In this regard 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Metropolitan Magistrate Court has awarded the following imprisonments to ( 98 ) respondents apart from imposing fine amount to (64) respondents of Rs. 13,44,000 /- and total fine amount imposed is Rs. 3,16,800 /-

## **PRESS NOTE**

The Marketing Intelligence Team of Cyber Crimes PS, CCS, DD, Hyderabad have apprehended an accused by name Katta Sridevi who has cheated many persons on the pretext of marriage bureau with fake profiles by publishing advertisements in Telugu News Papers in Cr. No. 107/2017, U/s 420 IPC & Sec 66(D) of ITA Act of PS Cyber Crimes. The Police have seized 1) One Cellkon 4G Mobile phone, 2) Copy of Registration Certificate of marriage bureau from the possession of the accused.

### **FACTS OF THE CASE:**

Facts of the case are that on 26-04-2017 at 1200 hrs received a complaint from Sri G. Mohd Nazeer S/o Abdul Khader, age 64 yrs, Occ: Retd Employee, R/o Shaikpet, Hyderabad in which he stated that he is single and intended to remarry again. So on seeing an add in Eenadu Classifieds, dt: 08-01-2017, he has contacted Mobile No. 9052025886. One lady by name Sridevi had spoke with him and sent him 2 female photos through Whatsapp. She promised him to set a match definitely. She asked him to remit an amount Rs. 5,500/-, Immediately towards registration fees. He has remitted an amount of Rs. 3,000/- through online to her Bank Acc. No. 35401293504, SBI Branch Mandadam on 16-01-2017 IFSC SBIN3175. Thereafter, she gave him fake profiles. Later on, When he was contacting her, she was not answering his phone calls several times. There is no response from her. Thus, she cheated him. He requested to take necessary action as per law.

### **MO. OF THE OFFENDER**

The accused has been running a marriage bureau styled as Sai Sravani Marriage Bureau at Flat No. 39, Sriram Nagar Colony, Kapra, Hyderabad. She publishes advertisements in Eenadu, Sakshi Telugu News Papers about her marriage bureau by providing her phone number 9052025886. Then, when the customers contacts her for matches, she would collect Rs. 2,000/- to Rs. 3,000/- as registration fees and make promise them that she would arrange the matches. But, thereafter, she downloads the beautiful women's photos through Internet and makes fake profiles with those photos. Then, she sends the same fake profiles to the customers and the accused herself & sometimes by her employees would speak with the customers over phone posing as bride and rejects the match on one or other pretext. When the customers force her, she would not respond to their calls. Thereby, she fails to fulfill her promise.

The team headed by Inspector of Police Sri. G. Shanker Raju consisting of team members S.I. Sri B. Lachi Reddy, Sri SI Ramesh, HC Sri K. Thakur, Chandra Shekar, PC Sunil under the direct supervision of ACP Cyber Crimes Sri. K. C. S. Raghu Vir has cracked the said case.
