NOTIFICATION

WHEREAS, reports have been received indicating that consumption of liquor in public places has become rampant and unhindered in several areas of the City of Hyderabad, resulting in to a menace to the common members of the public, especially women and children in particular.

AND WHEREAS, such reports have been indicating that, persons consuming liquor in public places have been exhibiting abrasive unruly and indecent behavior on the streets of Hyderabad City towards law abiding citizens especially women and children in particular endangering their modesty and safety in addition to causing disturbance to public tranquility resulting in annoyance and obstruction to road users in general and women and children in particular.

WHEREAS, such unruly and indecent behavior has been instilling a sense of fear psychosis in law abiding citizens, especially women and children resulting in restriction of their free movement on the streets of Hyderabad, thereby affecting public safety at large and safety and security of women and children in particular.

AND WHEREAS, it is considered necessary to take speedy measures in this regard to prevent danger to human life and safety and security of women and children or for preventing any affray and disturbance of public tranquility.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me under Section 144 of Criminal Procedure Code 1973, I, Anjani Kumar, IPS Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad City, do hereby make this written order and notify the same to the General Public **prohibiting Consumption of liquor in public places in the City of Hyderabad.**

This order is published for the information of public through the media and through the public address system in the areas affected with drunkenness in public places.

This order shall come into force from 0600 hours on 09-06-2018 and shall remain in force for a period of one week i.e. upto 0600 hours on 15-06-2018 (both days inclusive) unless withdrawn earlier.

Any person violating this order shall be liable for punishment under Section 188 of the Indian Penal code and as per the provisions of Hyderabad City Police Act, 1348 Fasli.

NOTIFICATION

With a view to maintain public order, peace and tranquility in the twin cities of Hyderabad and Secunderabad, I, Anjani Kumar, IPS Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad City, in exercise of the powers vested in me under section 22(1) (a) to (f) and 22 (2) (a) and (b) of Hyderabad City Police Act, 1348 Fasli (No.IX), do hereby issue the following prohibitory orders.

- I Prohibit to hold any kind of public meetings, and processions within the Hyderabad City, without obtaining prior permission of Zonal Dy. Commissioners of Police, Law and Order concerned, Addl. Commissioner of Police, Law and Order or Jt. Commissioner of Police, Co-ordination & Security or Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad.
- a) Prohibit carrying of arms such as swords, spears, knives, sticks with or without flags bludgeons, guns, explosives, and other offensive weapons in the above mentioned areas.
- b) Prohibit gathering of persons on the public roads or public places disturbing peace and order or causing inconvenience, annoyance or danger to public.
- c) Prohibit collection, carrying of stones or other means of casting missiles.
- II Prohibit use of mikes/public address system by different Organisations around the Secretariat premises, including Burgula Rama Krishna Rao Building, Greater Hyderabad Municipal Corporation Building, Commissioner of Fisheries building, Mint Compound, Nizam College and its surroundings, Telangana Legislative Assembly premises and surrounding roads, Public Garden Nampally, Upper Tankbund, I-MAX, Rotary and NTR Marg roads also fly-over road leading from Secretariat to Visweswarayya statue, Khairatabad.
- a) Prohibit music, singing or speeches or broadcasting through loud speakers in the above mentioned areas.
- b) Prohibit use of mikes/public address systems, use of horn through vehicles by any organisation, members of public etc., in the above mentioned areas.
- III The public are here by informed that any person violating the above orders shall be liable for prosecution under the Hyderabad City Police Act, 1348, Fasli (No. IX).
- IV **The following are exempted from the operation of this order**
- (i) Police Officers on duty,
(ii) Military personnel on duty,
(iii) Home Guards on duty,
(iv) Bonafide funeral processions.

This order shall be in force with effect from 0600 hours on 10-06-2018 to 0600 hours on 16-06-2018.

**ARREST OF ACCUSED PERSON IN MURDER CASE OF PS.REIN BAZAR,
SOUTH ZONE, HYDERABAD.**

Cr.No. 119/2018 U/s 302 IPC

Complaint Details:-

Sri. Aslam Bin Khaled, S/o Kaled Bin Saad, age: 45 yrs, Occ: Business, R/o. H.No:- 17-2-1195/A/1, Near Indian Function Hall, yakathpura Hyderabad.

Deceased Details:

Mirza Muneer Baig @ Muneer Shah, S/o Mirza Afzal Baig, Age : 35 Yrs, Occ: Bawarchi, R/o 17-8-402/2/6, Near Mashallah building, Yakutpura, Hyderabad.

Accused Details :-

Syed Suleman S/o Syed Ahmed, Age: 34 Yrs Occ: Helper to Cook, R/o Vattepally, Falaknuma, Hyderabad.

This is a case of Brutal murder of a man, which occurred on intervening night of 6/7-06-2018 at about 0300 hrs at P.No. 17-2-3/A, inside Kitchen of Rasheediya Function Hall, Yakuthpura, Hyderabad, wherein the accused Syed Suleman committed murder of deceased Mirza Muneer Baig @ Muneer Shah by keeping grudge, as the deceased is frequently quarreling with accused and using filthy language.

Basing on the complaint of Sri. Aslam Bin Khaled a case was registered in Cr. No. 119/2018, U/s 302 IPC and took up the investigation.

The investigation revealed that, during the Ramzan period Sri. Aslam bin Khaled used to prepare Haleem and supplies to various hotels at Hyderabad City. As such this year complainant Aslam preparing the Haleem of Chicken, Beef at Rasheediya Function Hall in the kitchen, as such the accused along with other deceased and workers joined Aslam for preparing the Haleem. On 06-06-2018 at about 1800 hrs the deceased came to function hall in drunken condition and took up argument with accused and one co-worker Mukther, used filthy language to accused. On that complainant Aslam shouted on deceased and asked him to leave the function hall, In order to calm down the situation. At midnight 0130 hrs on 07-06-2018 deceased return to function hall and worked with complainant for some time for preparation of Haleem and slept beside Mukther. During that time the accused was very much angry, as deceased again came to kitchen and deceased frequently used to abused him in most filthy language and used to insult him during the work, on that the accused hatched a plan to eliminate deceased and noticed that he is in deep sleep, the accused took one damaged iron Kabgir (big ladle) and forcibly hit on his forehead, due to which he died on the spot.

Past Criminal record of accused:-

Earlier in the year 2012 the accused committed the same M.O. by killing one Md. Ateeq (Beggar), when he is in deep sleep, the accused forcibly beat on his head with boulder, as such a case in Cr.No. 223/2012 U/s 302 IPC was registered against accused Syed Suleman at PS Moghalpura, Hyderabad.

Under the supervising of Sri. B. Anand, Asst., Commissioner of Police, Mirchowk Division, the investigation officer Sri. M. A. Javeed, Inspector of Police, PS. Rein Bazar, formed a special team with Sri. S. Naveen Reddy SI, and staff of PS Rein Bazar, apprehended the accused Syed Suleman on the same day on 07-08-2018 at 1700 hrs and on interrogation he confessed his guilt to have committed this offence and seized iron Kabgir, **he is being produced before the Hon'ble Court for judicial remand.**

Sri. M. A. Javeed, Inspector of Police (I.O), Sri. S. Naveen Reddy SI, and staff of PS Rein Bazar, who was actively apprehended accused person, within short span of time, are appreciated and will be rewarded suitably.

NOTIFICATION

WHEREAS, it has been brought to my notice that the Terrorist/Antisocial elements may organize attacks through Para Gliders, Remote Controlled Drones, Remote Controlled Micro Light Aircraft etc., and that there is an increasing trend by events organizers to use remote controlled drones for getting aerial views for live telecasts and photography of various events.

WHEREAS, inputs have been received by Intelligence agencies about the possibility of attacks by Terrorist/Antisocial elements by the use of Para-gliders, Remote Controlled Drones, Remote Controlled Micro-Light Aircraft, etc., and there is every likelihood of breach of peace and disturbance of Public tranquility and also there is grave danger to human life, health, safety and damage to public property on that account.

AND WHEREAS, it is necessary that reasonable checks are imposed on activities of such antisocial elements in the limits of Hyderabad City Police Commissionerate to prevent the attack through Remote Controlled Drones or through Para-Gliders or through Remotely Controlled Micro-Light Aircraft.

NOW THEREFORE, I, Anjani Kumar, IPS, Commissioner of Police and Executive Magistrate of Hyderabad City vide powers conferred upon me u/sec 144 of the Criminal Procedure Code 1973 (Act II of 1974), **do hereby order that no flying activities of Remotely Controlled Drones or Para-Gliders or Remotely Controlled Micro-Light Aircraft be allowed in the Jurisdiction of Hyderabad City Police Commissionerate limits without prior Police permission in writing.**

No Non-Government agency, organization or individual will be allowed to launch Unmanned Aerial Vehicle (UAV), Unmanned Aerial Survey (UAS) etc.

Government agencies and organizations should obtain appropriate clearance from local Police and Aviation authorities before launching any UAS/UAV for any purpose.

Any person contravening this order shall be punishable under section 188 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860.

This order shall remain in force from 08-06-2018 to 07-07-2018.

As the notice cannot be served individually to all concerned, the order is hereby passed ex-parte. It shall be published for the information of public, through press and by affixing copies on the Notice Boards of the Police Stations, Divisional ACsP, Zonal DCsP offices.
