**(309) JAILED AND 21 DRIVING LICENCES WERE SUSPENDED FOR DRUNKEN DRIVE**

During the month of August (2184) charge sheets were filed against the Drunken Drivers and produced in the Hon'ble 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Metropolitan Magistrate Court, Erramanzil, Hyderabad. In this regard 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Metropolitan Magistrate Court has awarded imprisonment to the ( 309 ) respondents, **Suspended (21) driving License** for a period of 2 years, 1 year and 6 Months apart from imposing fine up to Rs. 46,86,300/- All the candidates sentenced for imprisonment are sent to Chanchalguda Jail.

**HYDERABAD CITY CYBER CRIMES POLICE STATION would like to advise all parents, schools/education institutions and children on Blue Whale Challenge ....**

### **What is the Blue Whale Challenge?**

The Blue Whale phenomenon is not a game but a challenge where usually teenagers are targeted and invited to take up the challenge by certain administrators on social media. The people taking up the invitation are given different tasks over a period of 50 days.

- The game starts from trivial things like watching a horror movie, listening to a music etc.
- Slowly as the step progresses, the tasks became gruesome where players are instructed to self-mutilation and self-harm.
- This includes pricking needles into arms, cutting veins, mutilating body parts and the last being suicide or death.

**Blue Whale is not a freely downloadable game, application or software. Children cannot access it on their smartphones through app stores or on social media platforms like Facebook. It is shared among secretive groups on social media networks. The creators seek out their players/victims and send them an invitation to join.**

### What Precautions Should Parents/Elders Take?

- Parents should look at the matter with utmost seriousness. The only thing that can protect them from being attracted to such life-threatening phenomenon is your **bonding, conversations and time spent together**.
- Always ensure that your child accesses internet from a computer placed in the family space.
- Maintain access to your children's accounts and ensure that there are no secrets.
- Download parent control apps to monitor internet usage and track their activity- Like Kids place parent control app, Parental control, Parental control light etc
- Check your children's Facebook, WhatsApp and snapchat accounts and see their activity for any trace of discussion about the Blue whale challenge.
- Check their search history to understand what they are browsing to understand their state of mind.
- Teach kids not to share their personal information on the Internet.
- Help them understand that strangers in real life are no different from strangers on the Internet. In fact it is easier to camouflage one's identity on the net.
- Pay attention when children are playing online games and report immediately when any suspicious activity is observed.
- Ask them casually if they know about this game and from where did they know about the game, if it's from the school- inform the school authorities, if friends talk to his/ her parents.
- Caution them against joining any groups that ask them to perform undesirable tasks.
- Have regular conversations with your children about the risks they may be exposed to and how to deal with them, such as cyberbullying and cyber stalking. Create an environment where they can come and talk to you if they see anything upsetting or are disturbed by anything.

- Observe any change in your child's behavior indicating sadness, avoiding communication, lack of interest in studies and falling grades or depression. Try to talk to them about issues they are facing personally.
- Teachers must pay attention to what kids are usually discussing and make them awareness of Cyber bullying, how to report it etc. Regular counselling sessions must be conducted in the schools.
- Be conscious of your own online activities as children often learn from them.

If you find out that your child is already taking up the Blue Whale Challenge, immediately stop him/her from using the internet from any devices and report to the CYBER CRIMES POLICE UNIT immediately and seek our advice on the next safety measures.

**PANJAGUTTA POLICE NABBED FOUR MEMBERS OF AN ATTENTION  
DIVERSION INTERSTATE TAMIL NADU GANG & RECOVERED GOLD  
ORNAMENTS Wg. ABOUT 50 TULAS, NET CASH OF Rs. 30,000/-, TWO BIKES  
AND FOUR MOBILE PHONES, ALL WORTH OF ABOUT Rs. 15 LAKHS.**

Today i.e. on 08.09.2017 the crime team Panjagutta Police apprehended four members of interstate Tamil Nadu attention diversion gang, who had committed thefts in the limits of Hyderabad and Vijayawada Cities by diverting attention of the old aged inmates by posing themselves as GHMC employees on the pretext of old drainage pipe lines removal and new drainage pipe lines has to be laid down.

**Recovered Property:**

- 1) Gold ornaments weighing about 50 tulas.
- 2) Net Cash of Rs. 30,000/-.
- 3) Two motor bikes with fake number plates.
- 4) Four mobile phones of accused persons.
- 5) Two measurement tapes.
- 6) Two electronic weighing machines.
- 7) One Long Note Book Register.

**Modus Operandi:**

The accused persons A1 to A5 hatched a plan to divert the attention of the old aged inmates of the houses and commits thefts of the valuable items from their houses. In this process, they move on two bikes with fake number plates and select independent houses in the locality to find the old inmates. The A1 and A2 goes to the houses posing themselves as a GHMC employees in the guise of sanctioning of new drainage pipe lines, if they find any young persons in the house they just act as noting the details of drainage pipe lines and go to the next house to find old inmates. If they find old inmates in the houses the A1 & A2 introduce themselves as GHMC Employees and divert the attention of the old inmates saying that new drainage line has been sanctioned to their houses and they came for taking measurements and also check whether they have paid property tax and ask for their aadhaar card details and property tax details. Meanwhile the A1 takes the measurements for drainage pipe connection and A2 write down the figures in the register readily available with them and diverts the attention of the old inmates. Upon receipt of the signals from the A1, the accused A3 enters into the house, while A4 & A5 keeps guard over the

surroundings outside of the house and A3 commits theft of cash, gold ornaments and other valuables from the almarihs and leaves from there after giving signals to A1. Later A1 & A2 join the remaining accused persons with the stolen booty.

**Present case involved in Cr.No.559/2017 U/s. 420, 380 IPC of PS Panjagutta:**

**Brief Facts:** On 11-08-2017 at 1830 hrs, Sri Atluri Venkateshwara Rao R/o Nagarjuna Nagar Colony, Yellareddyguda, Hyderabad reported that, on 07-08-2017 two people came to their house saying that they are GHMC employees and informed that the drainage line was sanctioned by GHMC to their house and it should be replaced, for that they asked his Aadhaar card, trusting their words, his wife brought the Aadhaar card from Almirah and left the keys to the almirah itself. One of the suspects took the Aadhaar card from his wife and acted as a noting the card particulars in a register and diverted his wife's attention by going here and there in the compound of the house. After much persuasion by his wife he handed over the Aadhaar card to his wife after about 15 minutes who then took the card and kept it back in the almirah. There was no suspicion at that point of time as everything appeared normal near the almirah. After some time his wife opened the almirah to take cash for household purposes, it was noticed that cash and gold ornaments were missed from the Almirah. He strongly suspects that the theft was committed by the two individuals who came to their house on the pretext of GHMC employees, likewise the gang committed the following cases.

Always keep the doors or almarihs lock, if any persons come in to your houses from outside if you have any suspicious keep them into your house and lock the door and inform the Police through dial 100 or surrounding persons.
