

## PRESS RELEASE

**BHAROSA** an integrated Support Center for Women and Children was inaugurated on May 7<sup>th</sup> 2016, with an aim to reduce the trauma and re-victimization of clients affected by sexual abuse and severe domestic violence.

Bharosa provides Police, Prosecution, Medial, Legal, Psycho therapeutic counselling and rehabilitation services all under one roof.

Other Facilities include:

- Video conference facility connecting to the District Court, Nampally, Hyd to record statement of victim under section 164 of Cr. P.C.
- Unique child friendly room for statement recording and counselling for victims of child sexual abuse.
- Counselling rooms to maintain privacy and confidentiality of clients.
- Sophisticated software to register and follow the case to its logical end.
- **Help line**, through Dial 100 to provide information and counselling to clients over the phone.
- A team of well qualified and trained staff to provide information, guidance, support to victims and facilitate end to end procedures for justice, redressal and rehabilitation of victims.
- **Medical facilities.**
- An initiative supported by Department of Women and Child Welfare, NGOs and Corporate Houses for rehabilitation and various other activities beneficial to clients.

Since its inception a total number of **1931 victims** approached Bharosa with a range of problems to seek help. The cases include:

- 1432 Domestic Violence cases
- 162 POCSO cases

### 161 Cr. P.C and 164 Cr Pc Statements:

- **213** - "161 Statements" have been recorded by a Women Inspector or Women Sub- Inspector of Police
- **31** statements of POCSO and Rape case victims were recorded through video-conference by the Magistrate under sec 164 Cr Pc.
- In a few cases the Magistrate has recorded the statements by coming to Bharosa Center.

### Awareness Campaigns:

Apart from dealing with DV cases and supporting victims of sexual abuse, Bharosa also creates awareness in communities in collaboration with NGOs such as Save the Children and World Vision. Till now **22** communities, **43** schools, a total of **9700** people were reached through these awareness programs.

**Workshops:**

- ✓ **22** De-addiction workshops were conducted at Bharosa to tackle domestic violence induced by alcoholism. Out of the **108** Alcoholic husbands **72** have successfully developed abstinence from alcohol and are leading a harmonious family life.
- ✓ **21** group counselling for couples and victims as well as parents of POCSO cases and awareness for Skills development were conducted.

**Rehabilitation:**

One of the objectives of Bharosa is to provide rehabilitation services to Victims of abuse. Out of the **106** clients referred to employment related training programs **15** have already been placed in employment and the others are enrolled or waiting to be enrolled in training programs leading to employment.

**Visitors:**

Visits from many prominent people and organizations like Ms Preeti Sudan, IAS, Special Secretary Ministry of Women & Child Welfare, UN Women Members, Sisters for Change, NGO- UK, American United States Polo Association Women's team, MPs from UK, Police departments officials from Bangladesh & various states of India like Rajasthan, Maharashtra, A.P., Delhi, Karnataka, J&K, etc.

## **PRESS NOTE**

On 08-05-2017 at 18:00 hours WCO Team IV, Central Crime Station, Hyderabad arrested the accused person A-1: Md. Jahangir @ Wajid Khan, S/o Late Md. Rasool, Age 35 years, Occ Business, R/o H. No. 19-2-180/146/A, Tadbun, Hyderabad, who is the managing Director of M/s Green Globe Financial Services. He attracted the gullible public for investments/deposits on the pretext of offering high returns to the tune of 10% to 20% and collected to the tune of about Rs. 60 lakhs from several victims.

### **Cr. No. 158/2014 u/sec 406, 420 IPC & Sec 5 of APPDFE Act of CCS, DD, Hyderabad.**

The brief facts of the case are that, on the complaint of Mohammed Najamuddin and 13 other victims a case vide Cr. No. 158/2014 u/sec 406, 420 IPC and Sec 5 of APPDFE Act was registered at CCS, DD, Hyderabad against (1) Mohammed Jahangir and (2) Syed Firasath Ali. The accused Mohammed Jahangir (MD), in connivance with Syed Firasath Ali (Marketing Head) as established a firm in the name and style of M/s Green Globe Financial Services with an intention to cheat the gullible public. Initially established the firm at Santhosh nagar in the year 2010 and subsequently in the year 2012 he shifted his office to Hyderguda, Hyderabad and collected an amount to the tune of Rs. 60 lakhs from the gullible public on the pretext of high returns to the tune of 10% to 20% by investing in the share market and closed the office in the year 2014 and cheated the general public and absconded.

The accused Md. Jahangir obtained Voter ID Card in the name of Wajid Khan and established another firm in the name and style of M/s Excel Digital Software solutions at Amarchand Complex, SD Road, Secunderabad. The accused gave advertisement in Deccan Chronicle that he is going to start Super Rhymes Project and requested the investors to deposit in the project to get good profits. Some of the gullible public attracted and deposited amounts. There also the accused cheated the gullible public on which a case was registered at PS Gopalapuram vide Cr. No. 34/2017 u/sec 420 IPC and Sec 5 of APPDFE Act.

Further it is also revealed that, the accused Md. Jahangir @ Wajid Khan also involved in (1) Cr. No. 377/2013 u/sec 420, 406, 448, 506 IPC of PS Medipally, Cyberabad and (2) Cr. No. 204/2017 u/sec 406, 420 IPC of PS Panjagutta, Hyderabad.

The case is being investigated by the Sri. NLN Raju, Inspector of Police, WCO Team IV, CCS, DD, Hyderabad under the guidance of Sri. N. Sanjeeva Rao, ACP, B Division, CCS, DD, Hyderabad and also under the direct supervision of Sri. G. Jogaiah, I/c Addl. DCP, CCS & EOW, DD, Hyderabad.
