SEX RACKET BUSTED – APPREHENDED TWO BROTHEL HOUSE ORGANIZERS AND RESCUED TWO VICTIMS (MINOR GIRLS) OF BANGLADESH NATIONAL

On 08/09-08-2017, on credible information the sleuths of Commissioner's Task Force, West Zone Team, Hyderabad, raided on brothel house in the limits of Langer House Police Station, Hyderabad and apprehended (2) persons and seized **net cash of Rs.8,800/-, (3) Cell phones and Un used condoms** from their possession and also rescued (2) Minor Girls of Bangladesh Country.

Details of accused persons:

- 1 Abdul Bariq Shaik @ Raju S/o Zakir Ali Shaik, aged 44 yrs, Occ: **Organizer of Brothel House**, R/o H.No.9-1-34/26, 3rd Floor, Near Mayuri Sweet House, Bapu Nagar, Langer House, Hyderabad, N/o Siripalli(V), Aramdharma(Tq), Bhupal Nagar (Thana), West Bengal State.
2. Sherajul Islam S/o Rahul Amin, aged 19 yrs, Occ: **Sub-Organizer of Brothel house**, R/o H.No.9-1-34/26, 3rd Floor, Near Mayuri Sweet House, Bapu Nagar, Langer House, Hyderabad, N/o Panchupota, Shonakrubakra, Manirampoor, Jessore, Bangladesh.

Modus operandi:-

About three years back the accused Abdul Bariq Shaik @ Raju, N/o Siripalli(V), Aramdharma (Tq), Bhupal Nagar (Thana), West Bengal State came to Hyderabad for livelihood and worked in construction company in Hyderabad. About five months back the accused Sherajul Islam who is friend of accused Abdul Bariq Shaik @ Raju has informed him that he will supply minor girls from Bangladesh to run prostitution in Hyderabad.

On which the accused Abdul Bariq Shaik @ Raju hatched a plan to organize brothel house in Hyderabad with minor girls of Bangladesh with the help of accused Sherajul Islam. About four months back he took the premises No.9-1-34/26, 3rd Floor, Near Mayuri Sweet House, Bapu Nagar, Langer House, Hyderabad on rent for Rs.6,000/- per month and running the brothel house at the above said premises with minor girls of Bangladesh who were sending by the accused Sherajul Islam. Also about one month back the accused Sherajul Islam came to Hyderabad and living with the accused Abdul Bariq Shaik @ Raju in the above said premises and both were running the brothel house in the above said premises. They used to bring minor girls from Bangladesh to Hyderabad on agreement for payment of Rs.15,000/- per 15 days and running brothel House with them. About one week back the accused Sherajul Islam brought two minor girls from Bangladesh and running the brothel house at the above said premises.

On credible information the West Zone Task Force team raided the above said premises and apprehended the accused persons Abdul Bariq Shaik @ Raju and Sherajul Islam and rescued (2) Victims of Bangladesh Country.

The arrested accused persons along with seized property and rescued victims were handed over to SHO, Langer House PS, for taking necessary action.

LAKE POLICE RESCUED FIVE PERSONS FROM COMMITTING SUICIDE

On 08th of August 2017, P S Lake officials has rescued **five persons** i.e., three female and two children, their particulars are 1) Smt. G. Jaya laxmi 2) R. Arundathi, 3) S. Lavanya & **her two children i.e., 4) Sri. S. Harsha wardhan, 5) Kum. S. Hasvitha** were all rescued, while they were about to commit suicide by jumping into the Hussain Sagar Lake. The Details of the victims are as follows:-

First incident: Occurred on 07/08/2017 at 19.10 hours tried to Jump into water at upper tank bund near "LOVE HYD".

Details of Victim: Smt. G. Jaya laxmi w/o G. Santosh, age:- 30 years, Occ:- labour, r/o:- beside chittalamma gudi, anna nagar, rasool pura, sec-bad, hyd.

Reason: On causing enquiry it came to know that the victim is a married person and blessed with two children and leading conjugal life happily. Her husband is a alcoholic and quarrels regularly with the victim. As usually last night he went to home in a fully drunken condition and started quarrelled with the victim, there he abused victim in a most filthy language. She unable the torture and decided to end her life by jumping into the Hussain sagar lake water and came to upper tankbund near LOVE HYD and tried. Immediately our patrolling Lake police noticed victim and saved her life. SHO Lake police station, Sri. T. Ch. Babu counselled both the wife and husband. After counselling handed over to her husband.

Second incident: Occurred on 02/08/2017 at 16.20 hours tried to Jump into water at upper tank bund near Lepakshi.

Details of Victim: Smt. R. Arundathi w/o Sri. R. Nagender, age:- 40 years, Occ:- Beautician, r/o:- 1-2-136, kasali bazar, bowenpally, hyderabad.

Reason: On causing enquiry it came to know that the victim is a married person and blessed with two children. Yesterday in the evening hours her elder son started quarrelling with her in a petty matter due to which she went into depression and planned to end her life by jumping into water. Immediately our patrolling Lake police noticed her and saved her life. SHO Lake police station, Sri. T. Ch. Babu counselled victim and handed over to her husband.

Third incident: Occurred on 08/08/2017 at 21.45 hours tried to Jump into water at upper tank bund near Children's park.

Details of Victim: Smt. S. Lavanya w/o Sri. S. Nageshwar rao, age:- 32 years, Occ:- Housewife, r/o:- 1-10-680/1, indira nagar colony, warasi guda, sec-bad.

Reason: On causing enquiry it came to know that the victim is a married person and blessed with two children. Yesterday in the evening hours she quarrelled with her husband in a petty matter due to which she went into depression and planned to end her life by jumping into water. Immediately our patrolling Lake police noticed her and saved her life. SHO Lake police station, Sri. T. Ch. Babu counselled victim and handed over to her husband.

As such Lake Police played a vital role in saving them spontaneously without giving any scope for untoward incidents for which they could saved the lives of people viz., 1) Smt. G. Jaya laxmi 2) R.

Arundathi, 3) S. Lavanya & her **two children i.e., 4) Sri. S. Harsha wardhan, 5) Kum. S. Hasvitha** these five incidents were occurred on 08-08-2017 SHO Lake police station, Sri. T. Ch. Babu, had counselled them promptly and they were safely handed over to their concerned by taking assurance that they will not repeat such thing in nearby future.

Thus, the patrolling Blue Colts of Lake PS viz., Sri. U. Sai kiran, PC 1797, Sri. R. Sandeep, PC 8303, Sri. C. Sai kiran, PS 4295, Sri. Jaganath bhai, HG 6849, Sri. T. Raju, HG 5658 and Sri. Subba reddy, HG 5348 have tactfully identified the above persons in a suspicious manner and rescued them from committing suicide which was done under the supervision of SHO Lake police station, Sri. T. Ch. Babu.

ARRESTED TWO CHAIN SNATCHERS AND RECOVERED (9) TULAS GOLD ORNAMENTS. ALL WORTH ABOUT RS. 2,40,000/- INCLUDING BAJAJ PLATINUM BIKE WHICH WAS USED IN COMMISSION OF OFFENCE WHICH IS COVERED WITH BLACK TAPE AND ALSO BEING HANDED OVER (20) NO.S OF HIGH-END SMART CELL PHONES BELONGS TO VARIOUS COMPLAINANTS/VICTIMS WHO LOST THEIR MOBILES UNDER S.R. NAGAR P.S. LIMITS, TRACED THROUGH IMEI NUMBERS AND RECOVERED BY D.I.S.R.NAGAR TEAMS, ALL W/RS. 3,00,000/-

On 09.08.2017 the Crime team of SR Nagar P.S. under the leadership of Mr. P. Sateesh, Detective Inspr. of Police, Mr. G. Srinivas, Sub-Inspr. of Police(Crimes), Mr. N. Sanjay Kumar, Sub-Inspr. of Police(Crimes) of SR Nagar P.S with the help of N. Kiran Kumar, PC-4058, B. Hareesh Kumar, PC-5456, B. Srinivasulu and Krishnareddy has apprehended below persons through the Vengalrao Nagar community CCTV Camera's and got identified.

DETAILS OF THE ACCUSED PERSONS:

1. Syed Abrar s/o late Syed Khaja, age about 29-years, Flower Vendor, r/o H.No. 8-4-544/74/92, Sultan Nagar, Erragadda, Hyderabad.
2. B. Dasarath Ram s/o late B. Tuljaram, age about 31-years, Tea Powder vendor, r/o H.No. 8-4-369/270, Banjara Nagar, Borabanda, Hyderabad.

MODUS OPERAND:

The accused A-1 is habitual offender by commits snatching of gold chains including Mangal Sutrams using force from the women folk in public places and streets, creating panic and in security in the minds of general public especially women folk. He along with A-2 were moving in public places and identified the old/isolated women/ walking women where he has a chance to commit chain snatchings and fled away, while committing snatchings, they covered their bike number with black colour tapes for un identification by police.

HISTORY OF THE ACCUSED PERSONS:

A-1 Native of Sultan Nagar, Erragadda areas and used to sale the flowers at Vengal Rao Nagar main road. A-2 Residence of Borabanda and used to sale the Tea powders. They both are childhood friends and addicted bad vices. They both are suffering financial problems and decided to commit snatching offences. Earlier A-1 involved in one snatching case from S.R. Nagar in the year of 2008 vide Cr.No.20/2008 and released on bail. Due to this experience, he again planned to commit snatching offender with the help of A-2 Mr. Dasarath Ram who knows driving and the A1) Syed Abrar act as pillion rider and snatch the chains from the neck of the old/isolated women while walking.

FACTS OF THIS CASE : Smt.Kilaru Jyothi w/o K. Ramarao, age about 65-years residing in Madhura Nagar and she used to make walking around D-Block Park. On 06.08.2017 at about 1630 hours while she walking the accused persons came one Bajaj Platina Bike from her opposite direction and snatched away her (09) tulas gold Mangal Sutram chain, they were chased by one road Passer, but he failed to catch him. After that, crime team S.R. Nagar P.S. collected the CCTV footage from Madhura Nagar and Vengal Rao Nagar Communities. The same was get published in localities of Vengal Rao Nagar and Madhura Nagar. Further A-1 Syed Abrar was identified by Mr. A. Balakotaiah who is working as a Watchman at one of the Apartment in Vengal Rao Nagar. As per his information the crime team S.R. Nagar was raided on A-1 house at Sultan Nagar and apprehended the accused A-1 and recovered intact gold property from his house and as per the confession of A-1, the A-2 was apprehended at his home Borabanda and recovered his Bajaj Palatina bike which is used in the commission of offence covered with black tape covered the number plate of the said bike.

In this context we congratulate and convey our appreciation to the community of Vengalrao nagar welfare association and Mr.A.Balakotaiah, Watchman who take their initiation for fitting of CCTV cameras around Vengal Rao Nagar colony to ensure the safety and security of the localities and the watch man A.Bala Kotaiah Identified the A1) Syed Abrar.

DETAILS ABOUT CELL PHONES RECOVERY OF (20) SMART PHONES.

S.R. Nagar crime police also traced (20) cell phones belongs to various complainants who lost their phones under the S.R. Nagar Police Station. The Police collected the IMEI numbers from the said complaints and made efforts through technical efforts and recovered (20) high-end smart phones and being handed over to the concerned complainants/victims.

Srinivas, Sub-Inspr. of Police(Crimes), Mr. N. Sanjay Kumar, Sub-Inspr. of Police(Crimes) of SR Nagar P.S with the help of N. Kiran Kumar, PC-4058 and B. Hareesh Kumar, PC-5456, B. Srinivasulu and Krishnareddy of S.R. Nagar P.S, Hyderabad.
