PRESS NOTE

“It’s a victory for the people of Hyderabad and Telangana Police”, said the CP Hyderabad Sri M. Mahendar Reddy, who arrived at Vishakhapatnam to receive the 20th National E-Governance Gold Award for the Citizen Empowering Mobile App – HawkEye, which has become immensely popular and has won several national and international awards ever since its launch on 31st December, 2014. HawkEye has become successful in empowering the community to become Citizen Police. The Ministry of Administrative Reforms and Public Grievances of the Government of India has recognised the impact and outreach of this app in the community. At a 2 day National Convention titled “Transforming India” held at Vishakhapatnam, the Ministry conferred the National Gold Award for Hyderabad Police Mobile IT Application HawkEye.

It is the only Police IT Initiative in the country, that was recognised by the Government of India from among the 261 contenders in 12 different categories in its latest round of Awards for the year 2016 under the category “Innovative Use of Mobile Technology in e-governance”. The Award comprises of a Citation, a Memento and cash of Rs 2 lakh.

The Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad City received the Gold Award from Sri P.P.Chowdary, Hon’ble Minister of State for Electronics and Information Technology and Law and Justice, Govt. of India.

The Citation of the Gold Award reads thus - “ *This Award seeks to recognise the exemplary projects that have used mobile technology in e-governance in an innovative and effective way which resulted in delivering enhanced value to its beneficiaries*”.

By integrating the various communication tools of the police department, HawkEye application served as a master tool for improving the operational efficiency of the police and in enhancing the collaboration between public and police, particularly for establishing a safe and smart Hyderabad City.

Hyderabad City Police has been using a lot of IT enabled technologies, as a force multiplier, in crime prevention, crime detection, public order management, traffic management, women and child safety, surveillance over criminals, work force management etc., This has led to considerable reduction in serious crimes affecting public safety and security. The Hyderabad City Police has been working in partnership with the members of the public in popularising technologies in enhancing the standards of safety and security in Hyderabad City.

The Commissioner of Police congratulated the Technology Team behind the App. The CP said that the Award is dedicated to the people of Hyderabad City for their significant contribution towards a safer society.

The DGP Telangana Sri Anurag Sharma congratulated the Technology Team of the Hyderabad City Police for winning the coveted award and bringing laurels to the State Police at the national level.

NOTIFICATION

In order to maintain Law & Order, peace and tranquility and to prevent incidents of breach of peace and accidents that are likely to occur unless kite flying is regulated during the celebration of Sankranthi Festival in Hyderabad City from 14-01-2017 to 15-01-2017. I, M. Mahendar Reddy, IPS, Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad, in exercise of the powers vested in me Under Section 22 (1), (2) and (3) of Hyderabad City Police Act, 1348 Fasli (No. IX) do hereby order that kite flying on all thoroughfares and in and around places of worship be prohibited, in the interest of maintenance of public order.

Parents and Citizens of Hyderabad City have to advise their children for not to fly kites from the terraces, which do not have parapet walls, to avoid any untoward incident. They should also advise their children not to run on the roads or vulnerable places while flying kites or trying to collect stays kites. Children should be made aware of their vulnerability as regards electrocution, if they try to collect stay kites from electric poles.

The revelers shall not collect wood forcibly for bonfires and they should use wood only with the consent of owners.

Public are hereby informed that any person violating the above Orders shall be liable for Prosecution under the Hyderabad City Police Act, 1348 Fasli (No. IX).

This Order shall be in force with effect from 0600 hrs on 13-01-2017 upto 0600 hrs on 16-01-2017.

ARREST OF A CHEATER WHO EXTRACT MONEY FROM A DOCTOR BY THREATENING
HIM ON PHONE

Details of the accused

Mohd Sajid @ Sadiq @ Abdullah s/o Late. Mohd Noor, age 39 years, Lorry Driver r/o H.No. 12-1-486/ A/136. Kishan Nagar, Jhirra, Asif Nagar, Karwan, Hyderabad.

On a complaint of Dr. N. Lakshmi Kanth Reddy S/o N. Janardhan Reddy, age 66 yrs, Occ: Doctor R/o H.No. 1-9-18/1/A/1, Sairam Clinic, Ram Nagar X Road, Tahera Plaza, Hyderabad, a case in Cr.No. **343/2016 U/S 420 IPC** has been registered at Musheerabad P.S. and investigation taken up.

HISTORY

The accused Mohd. Sadiq @ Sajid @ Abdullah is a Lorry driver by profession and his earnings were insufficient to fulfill his family requirements. He planned to earn money by adopting easy means and in furtherance of his plan he started cheating the Doctors practicing in Hyderabad City. His M.O. is to observe Hospitals/clinics in Hyderabad and noting down the Contact Nos. of the Doctors daily and he used to consult and take treatment by posing some illness. Thereafter contacting them on the plea of prescribing wrong treatment and thereby demanding money by posing himself as Sub-Inspector of Police and thereby negotiating with them for settlement and extract money. Initially he was arrested in the year 2013 by the Tapachabutra Police in Cr.No. 205/2013 U/S 417, 420 IPC and recovered 85 Cell phones from his possession.

On 09.01.2017 in the evening he was arrested by Musheerabad Police and one Cell Phone and an amount of Rs, 3,800/- has been recovered from his possession and he is being produced before the Hon'ble court.
