

SHE Teams, Hyderabad City nabs a man for stalking & harassing a Women to marry him.

A victim approached "SHE Teams" with a complaint that since two years she is working as a Teacher in a School. In that school, three children used to attend tuition with the petitioner. The father of the children who attended tuition at her residence by name Osman aged.52 yrs used to drop his children and tried to talk to her. Later he started harassing her to marry him. She was unable to bear the harassment and resigned the Teacher job and stopped giving to tuition to his children. Even after that, he continued visiting her house and troubling her. Since two years he is continuously harassing the petitioner. On 29-5-2018, without her permission, the respondent entered her house and harassed to marry him and threatened to kill her if she disobeys him.

Based on the petition filed by the victim, the SHE teams made discreet enquiry on the case and apprehended the respondent Osman Ahmed Aulaqui S/o. Ahmed Bin Abdulla Late age.52 yrs r/o.19-3-201/7/A, Jahanuma, Charminar, Falaknuma, Hyderabad. The respondent accepted his guilt for harassing the lady. A case was got filed in Falknuma Police Station U/s.354 D, 448, 506, 509 IPC and the accused Osman handed over to the Police Station by the SHE teams

SHE Teams, Hyderabad City nabs a man for harassing a Women on phone

A victim approached "SHE Teams" with a complaint that she is working as a Sales Executive in Big Bazar at Tarnaka Branch. While she was on duty, one stranger (customer) came to her and asked her phone No.. She outrightly rejected and scolded him. But he did not stop and visited her four times and repeated the same. Thereafter she scolded him in front of all and thereafter he stopped coming to Big Bazar. One day the petitioner got a call from the same unknown customer. Since she deposited the phone with security, she could see the missed calls after working hours. She thought that the calls were from her parents from unknown number and she called back. She was shocked to know that the call was from the same unknown person from Big Bazar. Since then, he started calling her and harassing her. With fear, she gave the number to her cousin and he called him. The respondent is behaving like a psycho and is telling that he is the son of a big builder and with money and power he will continue harassing her.

Based on the petition filed by the victim, the SHE teams made discreet enquiry on the case and apprehended the respondent Kumpati Kiran Babu @ Kiran S/o.K.Ramesh babu r/o.Plot No.42, Prashant Nagar, Kondapur, Madhapur, Hyderabad, Telangana. The respondent accepted his guilt for harassing the petitioner. A case was filed in Osmania University Police Station U/s.354 D, 506 IPC and the accused Kumpati Kiran Babu @ Kiran was handed over to the Police Station by the She teams.

During this year till 31st May She teams has received 310 petitions and strict action has been taken against the respondents in all these cases. Also the She teams have caught 45 red handed cases this year as compared to 12 during the same period previous year. The She teams are actively moving around in the city to provide a safe and secure environment to women in Hyderabad City.

NOTIFICATION

Whereas, it has come to my notice that some miscreants, by using Social Media like Face book, twitter and whatsapp, etc., either as administrators or members of the group are spreading rumours by sending messages of alleged child lifting or committing murders or assaults in the twin cities of Hyderabad.

Whereas such acts of spreading rumours by the aforesaid miscreants by using social media are causing a lot of disturbance to the public order of the Society and creating a serious threat to the lives of innocent persons. Recently some cases have been registered against certain persons who are allegedly responsible for attacking and causing death of innocent persons on the ground that they have come from other states and are kidnapping the children for illegal activities.

Whereas, it is considered expedient to take stringent and speedy measures to control the spreading of such rumours and alarming message on social media. In fact there are no such persons but for the rumours spread by the miscreant people who are disseminating such information through social media in the form of messages, text, etc.

Therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me under clause (e), sub-section (2) of section 22 of Hyderabad City Police Act, 1348 Fasli, I, Anjani Kumar, IPS, Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad City, do hereby make this written order and notify the same to all the public in general by means of loud speakers, news papers and social media that not to pass any such false information/ messages thereby creating panic in the society for the purpose of the maintaining order and discipline in the society. I further notify that any member of public, whoever sending such messages through any social media are hereby restrained and prohibited from doing so immediately and continuously.

This order shall come into force from 0600hrs on 15-06-2018 and shall remain in force for a period of fifteen days i.e. up to 0600hrs on 29-06-2018 both days inclusive unless withdrawn earlier.

Any person violating this order shall be liable for punishment under Sections 188, 290, 505(1)(b) & (c) and 506 read with Section 109 IPC and Section 76 of Hyderabad City Police Act-1348 Fasli.

NOTIFICATION

WHEREAS, reports have been received indicating that High Volume Sound Emitting Systems including DJs (High Volume Sound Mixers) are being generating noise beyond permissible limits (day time 55 db(A) and night time 45 db(A) in Residential Areas, day time 65 db(A) and night time 55 db(A) in Commercial Areas) in places of public gatherings including Processions causing inconvenience, disturbance, nuisance, annoyance and Under Section 67(c) prohibit bursting of fire crackers on public places / public roads, public meetings and marriages to the residents of locality and public in general.

WHEREAS, such acts have been causing acute inconvenience and distress among the children, old aged persons, patients and students in particular pursuing their studies in the residential localities.

WHEREAS, such High Volume sounds generated at Public Meetings, Marriages and Processions have been neutralizing Police Communication Systems deployed in relation to bandobust duties, thereby adversely affecting the function of maintenance of Public Order and Tranquillity by Law Enforcement Agencies.

AND WHEREAS, it is considered expedient to take stringent and speedy measures to control the use of High Volume Sound Emitting Systems including DJs (High Volume Sound Mixers) in place of Public gatherings including processions in the residential localities.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred under Rule 8 of Noise Pollution (Regulation & Control) Rules 2000, I, Anjani Kumar, IPS Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad City, do hereby make this written order and notify the same to the General Public Prohibiting the following within Hyderabad City, except in cases specifically permitted by the Divisional Asst. Commissioners of Police of the concerned jurisdiction:

- Use of High Volume Sound Systems including DJs (High Volume Sound Mixers) emanating sound levels beyond permissible limits in places of Public Gatherings including Processions in the Residential Localities.
- Prohibit bursting of fire crackers at public places / public roads, public meetings and marriage function halls causing inconvenience to the residents of locality and public in general.

This order shall come into force from 0600 hrs on 14-06-2018 and shall remain in force for a period of 15 days i.e., upto 0600 hrs on 28-06-2018, both days inclusive unless withdrawn earlier.

Any person violating this order shall be liable for punishment u/s 67(c), 188 of IPC and u/s 76 of the Hyderabad City Police Act, 1348 Fasli.

NOTIFICATION

WHEREAS, reports have been received that in all public places like Cinema Theaters, Bus Stands, Malls, Shopping Complexes, Religious Places, Educational Institutions, Industrial Fairs and Exhibitions, Food Outlets, Wine Shops, ATMs, Business outlets, Offices, Places of Entertainment and such Other Places where public throng takes place have been leading to uninterrupted public nuisance, traffic obstructions and obstructions in smooth conducting of businesses and professions thereby adversely affecting public order, tranquility decency and smooth flow of Traffic.

Whereas, it is considered expedient to take stringent and speedy measures to control the overcrowding of people at public places like Cinema Theaters, Bus Stands, Malls, Shopping Complexes, Religious Places, Educational Institutions, Industrial Fairs and Exhibitions, Food Outlets, Wine Shops, ATMs, Business outlets, Offices, Places of Entertainment and such Other Places where public throng takes place for maintaining public order, tranquility, decency and smooth flow of traffic in such places.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me under clause (d) of section 22 of the Hyderabad City Police Act, 1348 Fasli, I, Anjani Kumar, IPS Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad City, do hereby pass this written order and notify the same to the Managements of all the above said Establishments to take necessary measures including providing 'Q' Managers, Security Personnel, Sinages, Awareness, Enforcement etc., for mandatory formation of queue lines of the public gathered at their establishments on a sustainable basis in order to maintain order, decency and discipline and further that all the public are also duty bound to follow the queue lines at the above said places leaving a personal space of one feet between person to person standing in the queue system, without forming into a crowd.

This order shall come into force from 0600 hrs on 13-06-2018 and shall remain in force for a period of 15 days i.e., up to 06:00 hrs on 27-06-2018, both days inclusive unless withdrawn earlier.

The Managements of all the said establishments shall implement these measures strictly in letter and spirit in respect of people gathered at their establishments forming part of Public Places in the interest of public order, tranquility, decency and smooth flow of traffic.

Any Management violating this order shall be liable for punishment under Sections 188, 290 and 290 r/w 109 of the IPC and under Section 76 of the Hyderabad City Police Act, 1348 Fasli.
