

Hyderabad City Police, Through 'Bharosa' Partners with UNDP the Disha project to Skill Telangana's Women in Need

The Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad City signed an agreement with the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) under the Disha project to build capacities and skill women affected by violence to help make them economically self-sufficient, so that they, their families and future generations have better opportunities in life.

The Disha project, a partnership between India Development Foundation (IDF) and the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP), supported by IKEA Foundation, will assist the Hyderabad Police Commissionerate with its "Bharosa" initiative. Bharosa is a support center where women and children affected by all kinds of violence are provided medical, legal and psychological assistance. The agreement extends support to enable these women to learn marketable skills and connect with income opportunities.

The agreement was signed by Mr. M Mahendar Reddy, IPS, Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad City Police, and Mr. Clement Chauvet, Chief, Skills and Business Development, UNDP. The Commissioner of Police said "We are fully committed towards empowerment of women and this partnership will enable vulnerable and marginalized women to get skilled and join the workforce in the state".

Women can be the most important agents of change in the development process. Empowering marginalized girls and women through education, skills trainings, improved healthcare and initial financial support, enables them to build better futures for their children and communities. This leads to breaking the cycle of poverty and creating circles of prosperity.

Wanting to strengthen the Bharosa initiative, the Hyderabad City Police is taking on an inclusive approach which ensures vulnerable and marginalized women are given another shot at life. With the Disha skill building and training programmes, women can equip themselves and re-enter the workforce and improve the lives of their children and families as well as their livelihoods.

The Disha skill building initiative will be taken up in collaboration with government departments connected to the skilling ecosystem such as the Department for Women & Child Development, Mission for Elimination of Poverty in Municipal Areas (MEPMA), Greater Hyderabad Municipal Corporation (GHMC) etc. The implementation of skills training will be undertaken by the government empaneled training providers. The overall capacity building programme will be channelled through the Commissionerate's Bharosa initiative.

**CORDON AND SEARCH OPERATION IN OLD CITY OF HYDERABAD UNDER
THE LIMITS OF FALAKNUMA, CHANDRAYANGUTTA AND CHATRINAKA
POLICE STATIONS**

South Zone Police altogether Police Officers Addl. DCP, ACP Falaknuma, CIs-12, SIs-39 & Men – 300 including women force and conducted Cordon and Search Operation at Farooq Nagar, Fathima nagar, Bibi ka Chasma under the limits of Falaknuma, Hashemabad, Al-Zubail Colony under the limits of Chandrayangutta PS and Jangamet under the limits of Chatrinaka PS between 05:00 hrs to 08:30 hrs on 10/11/2017 which are bordering colonies to Falaknuma to curtail the criminal activities of gangs and to create sense of security in the minds of the locality people.

“E- FINGER PRINTS RECOGNITION DEVICE” & “HYDCOPS”

E-Finger Prints Recognition Device and “HYDCOPS APP” were used in this search operation. With the help of this device police verified the finger prints of the persons moving in suspicious circumstance in the cordoned locality without causing the disturbance to the locality people.

During the search operation 67 persons were taken into custody and verified their finger prints with E- Finger prints recognition device. On verification of their finger prints 27 Rowdy Sheets, 8 old property offenders and 32 suspect persons were identified. All the 67 persons were taken into custody and verifying their complicity.

Geo-Tagging

In the course of this Cordon & Search operation we used Geo-tagging in keeping view of the innocent public and not to disturb or create any inconvenience to the common public.

CAUGHT NOTORIOUS ROWDY SHEETERS GANG –

During the search operation 27 rowdy Sheeters were moving separately under suspicious circumstances in the localities of Farooq Nagar, Fathima nagar, Bibi ka Chasma under the limits of Falaknuma, Hashemabad, Al-Zubail Colony under the limits of Chandrayangutta PS and Jangamet under the limits of Chatrinaka PS were caught by the search teams, taken into custody and verifying their complicity.

CAUGHT OLD PROPERTY OFFENDER THROUGH E-FINGER PRINT –

During the search operation 8 old property offenders were identified through E-Finger Print equipment. Out of 8 two persons were caught in the limits of Charinaka and remaining 6 persons were caught in the limits of Chandrayangutta. They were also taken into custody and verifying their complicity.

CAUGHT CRIME SUSPECTS :

Total 32 suspects were caught in the search operation. During the verification of their complicity, 4 criminals wanted in Chatrinaka PS Cases were identified on whom 4 old NBWs are pending.

EXECUTED NBWS:

4 Old NBWs pending against 4 different criminals wanted in Chatrinaka PS Criminal Cases were executed on the following persons.

34 TWO WHEELERS & 03 THREE WHEELER:

Police have also verified the documents of vehicles in which 34 two wheelers & 03 Autos and 1 four wheeler were taken into custody to verify the documents which were found in suspicious condition without Number Plates and documents.

CENSUS OF COLONIES START TODAY ONWARDS:-

South Zone Police Starts census of Farooq Nagar, Fatima Nagar, Al-Jubail Colony and Jangammet who are in around of Falaknuma Palace are very how many members are there in a particular house. Police is urging them not to entertain or give shelter to relatives & friends or any stranger during these 20 days. Strict vigilance & surveillance been made in their colonies.

Speaking to the media, Sri V. Satyanarayana, IPS, DCP South Zone said that South Zone Police over all 300 Police men today i.e. 10-11-2017 early hours conducted cordon & search operation in limits of PS Falaknuma, PS Chatrinaka & PS Chandrayangutta. Around 67 new suspects have been taken into custody and 29 Rowdy sheeters and 38 suspects from which 4 suspects were found for whom Non-bailable warrants were issued by the court. Anwar House Break Offender wanted in so many cases of Chandrayangutta PS was caught and held in this operation. Telangana State Government is organizing the Global Entrepreneurship summit at Falaknuma Palace for three days in which business entrepreneurship representatives from 180 countries will attend this event. Keeping in view of Global security for the representatives Special Protection group, Telangana state ISW & City Police CSW will be inspecting the total areas to make no suspicious persons found or any other country citizens (foreigners) will not be allowed to stay.

Main aspire of this search was Jangamamet, forooqi nagar, Fatima nagar, bibi ka chasma, Hashimabad, Aljubel colony.

In future we are going to conduct more Cordon searches to create the sense of security in the minds of public and stop the unsocial and bad elements in the society.
