**NOTIFICATION**

Whereas, the area known as High Court of A.P and Telangana States, Hyderabad in the limits of Charminar Police Station, together with its surrounding roads and areas including the following roads, are busy places due to functioning of the High Court of A.P and Telangana States causing movements of litigants and Advocates to and from the premises of High Court of A.P Telangana States.

- 1) On the Northern side of the High Court Building : City College Junction to Nayapul Road.
- 2) On the Southern side of the High Court Building : Madina Circle to City College Road and its (3) by lanes leading to Ghansi Bazar and other (3) by lanes leading to Patel Market/Ricobgunj.
- 3) Nayapul – Madina Circle – High Court Road
- 4) Pathargatti – Madina Circle – High Court Road
- 5) Muslim Jung Bridge Circle to High Court Road
- 6) Puranapul – PTO – City College X- Road – High Court Road
- 7) Moosa Bowli – Mehandi – City College X- Road – High Court Road.

2. And whereas, reports have been received indicating that such conditions now exist that unrestricted holding of public meetings, processions/ demonstrations, etc. in the area is likely to cause obstruction, annoyance or injury to any person lawfully employed, or danger to human life, health or safety or disturbance of the public tranquility or a riot or an affray and inconvenience in the smooth functioning of the Hon'ble High Court of A.P and Telangana States and disturbance to the litigants and Advocates.

3. And whereas, it is considered necessary to take speedy measures in this behalf to prevent danger to human life, health or safety or for preventing a riot or any affray and disturbance of public tranquility.

4. Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me under Section 144 of Criminal Procedure Code, 1973 and under Sec. 22 of Hyderabad City Police Act, 1348 Fasli, I, M.Mahendar Reddy, Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad, do hereby make this written order and notify the same to the general public prohibiting the following matters :-

- i) the holding of any public meeting;
- ii) assembly of five or more persons;
- iii) carrying of fire-arms, banners, placards, lathis, spears, swords, sticks, bricksbats, etc.;
- iv) shouting of slogans;
- v) making of speeches, etc.;
- vi) processions and demonstrations; and
- vii) Picketing or dharnas in any public place within the area specified in the schedule and sketch map appended to this order without a written permission.

5. As the order cannot be served practicably to each individual on all concerned, the order is hereby passed ex-parte and the same is published for the information of public through Press and by affixing copies of this order on the notice boards of the offices of all the D.Cs.P., Addl.DCsP., A.Cs.P., all Police Stations concerned and other places for conveying the information to the general public.

6. Religious functions/ rallies/ public meeting, etc. in the above specified areas can be held with prior written permission from the Dy.Commissioner of Police, South Zone, Hyderabad well in advance and this order shall not apply to processions which have the requisite permission of the concerned Zonal Dy.Commissioner of Police/Divisional Asst.Commissioner of Police.

7. This order shall come into force with effect from 0600 hours on 14.08.2017 and shall remain in force for a period of two months i.e. upto 0600 hours on 13.11.2017 (both days inclusive) unless withdrawn earlier.

8. Any person violating this order shall be liable for punishment under Section 188 of the Indian Penal Code and as per the provisions of Hyderabad City Police Act, 1348 Fasli.

## **PRESS NOTE**

### **LAKE POLICE RESCUED TWO PERSONS FROM COMMITTING SUICIDE**

On 02 of August 2017, P S Lake officials has rescued **two persons** i.e., two female, their particulars are 1) Smt. G. Manga and 2) Smt. M. Lalitha @ Manjula were all rescued, while they were about to commit suicide by jumping into the Hussain Sagar Lake. The Details of the victims are as follows:-

**First incident:** Occurred on 10/09/2017 at 21.10 hours tried to Jump into water at upper tank bund near Peacock statue.

**Details of Victim:** Smt. G. Manga w/o Sri. G. Yadagiri, age:- 26 years, Occ:- Pvt employee, r/o:- 10-7-904, hamal basti, chilkalguda, sec-bad, hyd.

**Reason:** On causing enquiry it came to know that the victim is a married person. She was harassed by her in-laws for every petty issue. She unable the torture and decided to end her life by jumping into the Hussain sagar lake water and came to upper tankbund near Peacock statue and tried. Immediately our patrolling Lake police noticed victim and saved her life. SHO Lake police station, Sri. P. Murali krishna counselled both the wife and husband. After counselling send them to Barosa counselling centre for further counselling.

**Second incident:** Occurred on 11/09/2017 at 12.10 hours tried to Jump into water at upper tank bund near Lepakshi.

**Details of Victim:** Smt. M. Lalitha @ Manjulla w/o Sri. M. Narsingh, age:- 38 years, Occ:- housewife, r/o:- 5-4-45, suineri galli, near yapral, yapral, Secunderabad.

**Reason:** On causing enquiry it came to know that the victim is a married persn and blessed with two children. Victim is a psychiatric patient. Today in the morning she escaped from her residence and came to tankbund to commit suicide. Our patrolling Lake police noticed victim moving under suspicious manner and brought her to Lake police station. SHO Lake police station, Sri. P. Murali Krishna counselled victim, after counselling handed over to her family.

As such Lake Police played a vital role in saving them spontaneously without giving any scope for untoward incidents for which they could saved the lives of people viz.,. 1) Smt. G. Manga and 2) Smt. M. Lalitha @ Manjulla these two incidents were occurred on 10/11-09-2017 SHO Lake police station, Sri. P. Murali krishna, had counselled them promptly and they were safely handed over to their concerned by taking assurance that they will not repeat such thing in nearby future.

Thus, the patrolling Blue Colts of Lake PS viz., Sri. K. Prabhakar, PC 5121, Sri. Md. Shareef, PC 7867, Sri. Jeevan rao, HG 3521, Sri. Kishan rathod, HG 5036 and Sri. B. Ravi, HG 7844 have tactfully identified the above persons in a suspicious manner and rescued them from committing suicide which was done under the supervision of SHO Lake police station, Sri. P. Murali krishna..

With a view to maintain public order, peace and tranquility in the area known as Andhra Pradesh and Telangana Secretariats, Hyderabad in the limits of Saifabad Police Station, together with the offices located within the premises of the A.P. and Telangana Secretariats including the gates leading to the offices and also areas falling upto a distance of 3 KM s from secretariat building perimeter, I, M.Mahendar Reddy, IPS, Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad City, in exercise of the powers vested in me under Sec 22 of Hyderabad City Police Act, 1348 Fasli, do hereby make this written order and notify the same to the general public prohibiting the following matters :-

- i) holding of any public meeting;
- ii) Assembly of five or more persons;
- iii) Carrying the fire arms, banners, placards, lathis, spears, swords, sticks, brickbats, etc;
- iv) Shouting of slogans;
- v) Making of speeches, etc;
- vi) Processions and demonstration; and
- vii) Picketing or dharnas within the area specified in the schedule to this order without a written permission.

As the order cannot be served practicably on each individual and all concerned, the order is hereby passed ex-parte and the same is published for the information of general public through press and by affixing copies of this order on the notice boards of the offices of all the DCsP, ACsP and all Police Stations concerned and other places for conveying the information to the general public.

This order shall be in force with effect from 0600 hours on 19-09.2017 and shall remain in force for a period of two months i.e. upto 0600 hours on 18-11-2017 (both days inclusive), unless withdrawn earlier.

Any person violating the order shall be liable for punishment under section 188 of the Indian Penal code and as per the provisions of Hyderabad City Police Act, 1348 Fasli.

### ARREST OF PSEUDO POLICE OFFICER AND SEIZURE OF PROPERTY BY CHILKALGUDA POLICE

#### FACTS OF THE CASE

On 09.09.2017 at 1300 hrs. On 9.9.2017 at 1300 hrs. one Sri. C. Kiran Kumar (46) Private employee, r/o H. No. 1-75/1, MCH Colony, Parsigutta, Secunderabad lodged a complaint stating that one Mrs. Nandini (29) used to visit his house frequently for the purchase of clothes from his wife Mrs. Sandhya Rani and during this process she informed his wife Mrs. Sandhya Rani that her husband works in Police Department in a higher position and he having good contacts with higher officers in the Department. On that, Smt. Sandhya Rani informed her that her son-in-law who appeared Police constable exams and waiting for results. Nandini by taking advantage of this, she said that her husband would help her to pass the Exams or jobs. In this regard, Mrs. Nandini introduced her husband A. Sridhar Goud with complainant in the month of August, 2016 and told the issue of complainant as his son-in-law got less marks in the PC exams. Upon which he demanded Rs. 5 Lakhs for job, on believing by his words and accused Sridhar Goud as he was residing since 7 years in the same locality and used to roaming in Police uniform and also used to carry revolver they had deposited Rs. 50,000/- in his Bank account. On believing him, they given all original certificates along with remaining amount Rs. 4,50,000/- by cash. Later, he collected Rs. 26,000/- by wearing police uniform as a officer. After 2 months they forcing about their jobs, but, he told that the TS Govt. has stopped to recruitments of 300 members due to court case is pending and Saivilas is one of them (victim). After that he called to the complainant and told that there is a vacant post in DGP office and the recruitment will be commenced in the end of August, 2017. He invited to his house and shown some papers of signed by Hon'ble Chief Minister, TS. On seeing it the complainant believed and gave some of Rs. 5

Lacks in two times. Upon which, he shown an appointment letter with mentioned date which was effected from 01.2.2018 signed and stamped by DGP office. When the complainant asked for the reasons to delay, he gave a reply that a police enquiry will be taken till 01.2.2018. Further the complainant came to know that he was cheated by Sridhar Goud and her wife Smt. Nandini. Hence, he requested to take action against them according to law.

Registered a case in **Cr. No. 538/2017 U/Sec. 170, 171, 468, 471, 419, 420 IPC r/w 34 IPC and investigation taken up by Sri. J. Veerababu, SI of Police, PS Chilkalguda.**

On 11.9.2017 on credible information, the Chilkalguda Police apprehended one person at Friday Market lane, Srinivas Nagar, Padmarao Nagar, Secunderabad and seized cash, vehicle, cell phone and fake documents and police uniform from the possession of the accused. The accused as per his plan, tried to contact prospective customers in Hyderabad, Secunderabad and lure them that he is having good contacts as Police Officer with Police and they would arranging jobs in Police Department. And being verified of the roll of accused wife Smt. Nandini in these crimes.

On interrogation, the accused Sridhar Goud revealed that he his wife are cheated the gullible public by offering Police constable and clerk jobs in Telangana. Earlier they also involved in Cr. No. 337/2016 u/sec 170, 419, 420, & 386 IPC of PS Godavarikhani I-Town P.S. in which he created nuisance in a Bar and Restaurant, posing himself as Dy. S.P. and refused to pay the bill. They made believe the innocent public as police officer and ultimately cheated. He has
