NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me under section 21 (1) (b) of the Hyderabad City Police Act, I, Anjani Kumar, I.P.S., Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad, hereby notify, for information of the citizens, that, in order to relieve congestion, to maintain smooth flow of traffic and to ensure public safety and order, in connection with the visit of large number of devotees to Khairtabad Ganesh from **13-09-2018 to 23-09-2018** the following traffic restrictions will be imposed from 1500 hours on every day during the dates given above:-

1. Traffic coming from Mint Compound lane and Necklace Rotary will not be allowed towards Khairtabad Library and Ganesh Idol and will be diverted at Govt. Printing Press, Khairtabad.
2. Traffic coming from Rajiv Gandhi Statue will not be allowed towards Khairtabad library and will be diverted towards Nirankari at Rajiv Gandhi Statue.
3. Traffic coming from Rajdoot Hotel Lane, Khairtabad market by lane will not be allowed towards Khairtabad Library beyond MCH Sanitary ward Office No.6. And will be diverted towards Printing Press and Market Route.

Citizens are requested to take alternate routes to reach their destinations and cooperate with the Traffic Police.

**BUSTED SENSATIONAL BURGLARY AT H.E.H NIZAM MUSEUM-
RECOVERED STOLEN ANTIQUE GOLDEN ITEMS STUDED WITH
PRECIOUS DIAMONDS AND RUBIES**

On **11-09-2018**, the sleuths of **Commissioner's Task Force, South Zone Team**, Hyderabad apprehended two persons who are involved in the sensational night burglary at H.E.H Nizam Museum and recovered stolen antique golden items studded with precious diamonds and rubies.

Details of accused person:-

1) Mohd. Ghouse Pasha @ Khooni Ghouse S/o Mohd. Mahmood Pasha, age 23 yrs, Occ: centring work R/o Near Dairy farm, Chinthalmet, Rajendra Nagar, Ranga Reddy Dist.

2) Mohd. Mubeen S/o Mohd. Aziz, age 24 yrs, Occ: welding work, R/o Wadi-E-Mahmood, Rajendra Nagar, R.R. Dist.

Details of Property stolen/recovered:

1. Three tier gold tiffin box studded with precious diamonds and rubies (wg. about 1950 grams)
2. Gold cup and saucer with precious stones (wg. about 172 grams)
3. Gold tea spoon (wg. about 14 grams)

Brief History of Museum & stolen property:-

The building which comprises of the Nizam's Museum is locally called as Purani Haveli. It is an 18th century structure, constructed by Mir Mahbub Ali Khan, the sixth Nizam, as an extension of Masarat Mahal. The museum was opened in this building to public on February 18, 2000, by the trust headed by Prince Muffakham Jah, the younger grandson of the last Nizam. The museum showcases the fascinating collection of gifts that the last Nizam, Mir Osman Ali Khan, received on his silver jubilee celebrations. They were presented to Mir Osman Ali Khan, Bayafandi Asaf Jah VII, on the occasion of the silver jubilee of his rule in 1937. Though he completed 25 years of his rule in 1936, it was celebrated in 1937. The seventh and the last Nizam himself registered these articles in 1957 with an intention to display them for general public. There are over 1,000 objects in the museum, of which only over 400 are showcased to the general public.

Brief History of Accused:-

The accused Mohd. Ghouse Pasha and Mohd. Mubeen are distant relatives as well as childhood friends. Both are brought up from the same locality of Dairy Farm, Rajendra Nagar.

Ghouse Pasha is a 7th class (urdu medium) dropout. He first committed an offence in the year 2011. He is so far involved in about (15) House theft, House breaking and Automobile thefts. Lastly he was arrested in the month of

August, 2017 by Rajendra Nagar P.S and released on bail in the month of July, 2018.

Another accused Mohd. Mubeen is a 2nd class (urdu medium) dropout. In the year 2015 he went to Saudi Arabia for livelihood. While in Saudi Arabia, he was imprisoned for about 2 ½ months as he beat one Pakistani national. About four months back, he was deported to India from Saudi Arabia.

Modus Operandi:

Mohd. Mubeen after returning from Saudi Arabia happened to visit Nizam museum and was amused by seeing the precious artefacts-Gold Tiffin box, Gold Cup & Saucer, Gold spoon and Holy Quran gold casing. He discussed about committing theft of above artefacts with Ghouse as they are antique pieces and worth crores of rupees in domestic as well as international market. He planned to use his international relations in disposing them. As per their plan, initially Ghouse went to Museum and observed the location of gold tiffin box in the museum. As the museum spreads over a long corridor, in order to avoid confusion, he fixed the landmark by identifying a dried up tree which is quite opposite to the location of tiffin box. After three days, both came in the night and did recce of the entire premises and took note of the surroundings and the location of CCTV cameras. On the same day, they put up “arrow” mark over the ventilator through which they have to enter into the museum and over the parapet wall corresponding to the ventilator. They also analysed which tools are useful to them in the commission of offence.

On the day of offence, they carried with them three screw drivers of various sizes, cutting plier, nail puller, ten hack-saw blades and rope for removing ventilator and getting into the museum from the top. They prepared about thirty (30) knots all over the rope for grip. They also purchased hand gloves to avoid finger prints and masks to avoid identification. They also avoided carrying mobile phone to the place of offence. They planned to enter into Museum through the routes devoid of CCTV cameras, but failed to get into the museum. Finally they reached the museum through Mata-ki-khidki side over the Bajaj Pulsar motorcycle of Mobeen and got captured in CCTV footages.

They reached the roof of the museum from the terrace of the residential house whose wall is abutting to the wall of the museum. This route was selected by them at the time of recce. They reached the place of offence easily by identifying the “arrow” marks on the parapet wall. Ghouse and Mobeen carefully removed the ventilator with the instruments they carried with them. As Mobeen is physically weak compared to Ghouse, and is easy to be glided up or down the rope, Mobeen volunteered to go inside the museum. Ghouse tied

one end of the rope to the parapet wall and other end to the waist of Mobeen and released him slowly inside the museum through the ventilator. Before that they damaged the camera inside the museum which is erected right beneath that ventilator. Mobeen who entered into the museum, took out the Gold Tiffin box, Gold Cup & Saucer and Gold spoon from the showcase and put them in a bag and climbed up using the rope, which was pulled by Ghouse from other end. Later both of them exited from the museum through the same route used for entry.

To avoid being tracked by police in CCTV cameras, they avoided main roads and moved through by-lanes haphazardly and reached Muthangi of Sangareddy District located on the Mumbai Highway. At Muthangi ORR, they changed their route and took to service road along the ORR and travelled towards Hyderabad. As they felt insecure to carry the stolen property and feared of being caught by Police, they dug a pit in an open area near Dairy farm area of Rajendra Nagar and kept the entire stolen property in it. Later they again took the same route and reached Zaheerabad. At Zaheerabad their motorcycle brokedown. So they abandoned their motorcycle nearby the bustand and reached Mumbai through public transport system. At Mumbai they tried for possible buyers in the domestic market. Mobeen through his international realations also tried to find possible buyers abroad, but invain. Finally they returned to Hyderabad on 10.09.18 after all their attempts to dispose of the stolen property got exhausted.

On a tip off, on 11-09-2018 the sleuths of South Zone Task Force and Mirchowk Police apprehended both the accused persons in the hillocks nearby Himayathsagar and recovered the entire stolen property. The accused persons Mohd. Ghouse Pasha and Mohd. Mubeen along with recovered property is handed over to the SHO Mirchowk Police Station for taking further action against him.

TURUPU JAYAPRAKASH REDDY @ JAGGA REDDY EX MLA OF SANGA REDDY ARRESTED FOR INVOLMENT IN HUMAN TRAFFICKING.

On 10-09-2018 , the sleuths of Market Police arrested one accused Turupu Jaya Prakash Reddy @ Jagga Reddy, Ex-MLA of Sanga Reddy Constituency N/o.Sanga Reddy Telangana State who obtained Indian Passports & USA VISAs by submitting fabricated documents in the name of his family members 1.T.Nirmala (wife), 2.T.Jayalaxmi (daughter), 3.T.Bharath Sai Reddy (son) by affixing Photos of others from Regional Passport office, Secunderabad & US Consulate which was used for human trafficking to gain huge money illegally.

DETAILS OF THE ACCUSED PERSON:

Turupu Jaya Prakash Reddy @Jagga Reddy S/o. Jagga Reddy, age. 52 yrs, Ex-MLA of Sanga Reddy Constituency R/o. H.No. 2-6-131, Ram Nagar, Sanga Reddy, Telangana State.

BRIEF FACTS OF THE FIR :

The facts in brief are that Sri. M.Anjaiah, S.I of Police, Market Police Station, has registered a suo-moto case on 10-09-2018 at 0830 hrs stating that while he was in the Market Police Station, received a reliable information that, one Jayaprakash Reddy @ Jagga Reddy, Ex MLA of Sanga Reddy constituency obtained passports in the year 2004 for himself and for three others in the name of his wife Smt Nirmala, Daughter Jayalaxmi and son Bharath Sai Reddy by affixing the photos of others from Regional Passport office, Secunderabad. After obtaining the Passports followed by USA VISAs, the said Jayaprakash Reddy @ Jagga Reddy illegally transported them by accompanying himself to USA as his family members for making monetary benefits out of it.

In this regard, a case was registered in Cr.No.114/2018 U/Sec. 419, 420, 467, 468, 471, 409 & 370 IPC, Sec.12 of the Passport Act 1967 and Sec 24 of Immigration Act 1983.

MODUS OPERANDI:-

The accused Turupu Jaya Prakash Reddy @Jagga Reddy is native of Sanga Reddy. He is an active Political leader and Ex MLA of Sanga Reddy, Telangana State.

While he was MLA from Sanga Reddy Constituency in the year 2004, he obtained Passports for himself and 3 others in the name of his family members i.e 1)T.Nirmala (wife), 2)T.Jayalaxmi(daughter), 3)T.Bharath Sai Reddy (son) by affixing photographs of three un-known persons (two female & one male) and obtained Passports by submitting fabricated documents at Regional Passport office, Secunderabad. Then the accused obtained USA VISAs from US Consulate, Chennai through said Passports. The accused took an amount of Rs. 15 Lakhs from the agent Madhu @ Rs. 5 Lakhs each besides expenditure incurred for accomplishing the task. Later the accused along with his friend Jetti Kusum Kumar trafficked the said three un-known persons to USA by accompanying them as his family members and dropped them at New York, USA and later the accused and his friend Jetti Kusum Kumar returned back to Hyderabad after spending few days at New York. The accused has cheated the authorities of Regional Passport office as well as US Consulate by using his official position as MLA by submitting forged documents.

ARREST:-

On 10-09-2018 the accused Turupu Jayaprakash Reddy was arrested and being produced before the Hon'ble XXII ACMM Court, Secunderabad.

The above arrest was made by Sri. M.Mattaiah, Inspector of Police, Market PS and his team with the help of North Zone Task Force under the supervision of Sri. A.Vinod Kumar, Asst.Commissioner of Police, Mahankali Division and under the able leadership of **Smt. B.Sumathi, IPS, Dy.Commissioner of Police, North Zone, Hyderabad.**
