**(18 ) Driving Licenses suspended in Drunken Drive**

During this week i.e., from 06-11-2017 to 10-11-2017, ( 539 ) charge sheets were filed against the Drunken Drivers and produced in the Hon'ble 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Metropolitan Magistrate Court, Erramanzil, Hyderabad. In this regard 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Metropolitan Magistrate Court has awarded imprisonment to the ( 49 ) respondents, (01) Driving License have been permanently cancelled and suspended driving license of ( 18 ) Persons for a period as mentioned below, apart from imposing fine up to Rs. 11,48,400. All the candidates sentenced for imprisonment are sent to Chanchalguda Jail.

**FAKE GOVT JOB RACKET BUSTED - 04 HELD  
FOR CHEATING UNEMPLOYE YOUTH WITH FALS PROMISES TO PROVIDE GOVT JOB IN GROUP-II,  
Jr.ASST, ATTENDER JOB OFFERS.**

The sleuths of Commissioner's Task Force, North Zone Team on a tip off information on 11-11-2017 **busted fake government job racket & nabbed (04) Job fraudsters** namely 1). Mohammed Yousuf Shareef @Yousuf 2). Nossam Raj Kumar along with their agents 3). Nimal Praveen Kumar @ Praveen & 4). Prabhu Chinnadurai who were indulged in cheating the innocent unemployed youth by false promises of providing Government jobs in **Group-II** (TSPSC), Jr.Assistant, Group-IV & Attender jobs in TS Secretariat, MCH Dept, Cole mining Department, Kothagudem & other Govt.Sectors by collecting huge amounts from job aspirants. **Seized Rs. 4,30,000/-, (04) Cell phones** and other incriminating material from their possession.

On 3-11-2017 the victim **Ambala Srikanth**, Post Graduate lodged a complaint at Tukaramgate PS stating that the accused persons on the pretext of provide **Govt job in Singareni, Cole Mining Department, Kothagudem, cheated Rs. 2,50,000/-**

2. **Cr.No.504/2017, U/S. 420, 506 IPC of Saifabad PS :-**

On 29-11-2017 the victim A.Sanjeev Kumar lodged a complaint at Saifabad PS stating that the accused persons cheated his family members as follows:-

### **MODUS OPERANDI:-**

The prime accused 1). Mohammed Yousuf Shareef @Yousuf is kingpin of the Government job frauds. The accused 2). Nossam Raj Kumar is accompanying with the prime accused. The accused persons by name 3) Nimal Praveen Kumar @ Praveen & 4). Prabhuchinnadurai are agents in the Government job racket work them on commission basis. To gain easy money illegally the accused persons have formed a gang and planned to lure the innocent job aspirants through known sources, who are interested in securing Govt. Jobs of Group-II, Jr. Assistant, Attender, Group-IV employee in Secretariat, MCH, Singareni Coal mines Department etc.

Initially the accused persons used to identify the candidates, who are intend to get job in Public Sector, trap them and the prime accused informed that he have good contacts with higher officials in Secretariat, MCH, Hyderabad, R&B and Coal Mines Department, TSPSC board, on the false promises of providing jobs to them through his influence. When the innocent candidates attract his version and shows interest in procuring a job, he demands them to pay an amount of Rs.3 lakhs for the post of Group-II job, Rs. 2 Lakhs for the post of Jr.Asst and Rs.1 Lakh for the post of attender, for processing their applications and ask them to pay an advance an amount of Rs.50,000/- to 1 Lakh, basing on the job requirement as well as economic statuses of the candidates.

In this process to gain money in easy manner the accused Nossam Raj kumar had joined with Mohammed Yousuf Shareef they both have lure the gullible public on pretext of provide Govt jobs, cheating huge amounts and sharing the amount which is collected from candidates. In this process they have engaged two agents by name Nimal Praveen Kumar @ Praveen & Prabhuchinnadurai. The agents have been arranged customers and produce before the fraudsters on commission basis. The fraudsters are pay commission Rs. 20,000/- per candidate to the agents.

Whenever the victims approach the accused persons, they inform that the allotment order copies are ready to deliver from Commissionerate of GHMC, Secretariat & other Departments to believe them, the accused persons call the victims at Secretariat and arrange Visitor pass, took them into the secretariat premises, filling the bio-data form, collecting Photostat copies, Address proof, etc by making them believe to be genuine and demanded to pay money to get appointment order copy.

By adopted the above modus operandi, to gain easy money since 2015 the fraudsters had amassed about 40 lakhs through fraud. After cheating they change their phone number as well as shift their shelter to another area to avoid their identity to victims.

Based on the complaint of a victims the SHO, Tukaramgate PS registered a case in Cr. No. 206/17 U/s 420, 406 IPC & SHO, Saifabad PS registered a case in Cr.No. 504/2017, U/s. 420, 506 IPC against the fraudsters.

### **ARREST:-**

To day i.e on 11/11/2017 On tip off the Commissioner's Task Force, North Zone team laid a trap and apprehended (04) accused persons. **Seized Rs. 4,30,000/- ( Four lakhs thirty thousand rupees), (04) Cell phones** from the instance of accused persons in which Rs. 80,000/- pertains to Cr.No. Cr. No. 206/17 U/s 420, 406 IPC of Thukaramgate PS & Rs. 3,50,000/- pertains to Cr.No. Cr.No.504/2017, U/S. 420, 506 IPC of Saifabad PS. The accused persons along with seized material are being handed over to SHO, Tukaramgate PS for further investigation in Cr. No. 206/17 U/s 420, 406 IPC and also intimated to SHO, Saifabad PS about the fraudsters for further necessary action in their case.

### **APPEALED TO THE CITIZENS:-**

In this connection it is to appeal the citizens that " any Govt job will get through examination and purely on merit basis, do not believe any brokers and do not get loss of money and valuable time. If anyone comes across such instances, you may inform us to enable us to take stringent action against those deceivers".
