**NOTIFICATION**

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me under section 21 (1) (b) of Hyderabad City Police Act, I, M.Mahendar Reddy, IPS., Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad, do hereby notify, for information of the general public, that, in order to relieve traffic congestion, to maintain smooth flow of traffic and to ensure public safety in connection with Dr.B.R.Ambedkar Birthday celebrations on 14-04-2017, at the Tankbund Circle, the following traffic diversions / restrictions are imposed: -

Traffic will be stopped or diverted at the following places from 2200 hrs on 13-04-2017 to 2000 hrs on 14-04-2017.

**Diversion Points :**

1. Traffic coming from Kattamaisamma towards Ambedkar Statue via Lower Tank bund will be diverted on to the Telugutalli flyover towards Iqbal Minor, Ravindra Bharathi.
2. Traffic coming from Childrens Park will not be allowed towards Ambedkar statue and will be diverted at Childrens Park towards DBR Mills, Kattamaisamma – Telugutalli flyover.
3. Traffic coming from Liberty will not be allowed towards Ambedkar Statue and will be diverted towards BRK Bhavan, I.T.Office, Telugutalli towards Ambedkar statue-Upper tankbund.
4. Traffic coming from NTR Marg and Iqbal Minor towards Liberty will not be allowed and will be diverted from Telugutalli Junction towards I.T.Office, Crystal Hotel left turn Balaji Grand Bazar, while traffic towards Uppar Tank bund will be allowed.

**Diversions for RTC Buses:**

1. RTC buses coming from Nirankari Bhavan, Old P.S.Saifabad to go towards Liberty will be diverted at Iqbal Minar towards Ravindra Bharathi, PCR- Basheerbagh .
2. RTC buses coming from Ranigunj, Karbala Maidan to go towards Liberty, Basheerbagh will be diverted at Childrens Park towards DBR Mills, Dhobi Ghat, Kattamaisamma to the Telugutalli flyover and Indirapark.

**Parking Arrangements :**

1. Lorries and trucks coming for the function to be parked behind Buddha Bhavan.
2. Other 2 & 4 Wheelers to be parked at Nizam College Grounds, Mee-Kosam (NTR Marg), Lumbini Park.

General public are requested to start early and take alternate routes to reach their destination in time.

**1 Person - Tipper driver; 2 Persons - 2<sup>nd</sup> time offenders;**

On 11<sup>th</sup> April a total number of ( 46 ) charge sheets were filed against the Drunken Drivers and produced in the Hon'ble 4<sup>th</sup> Metropolitan Magistrate Court, Erramanzil, Hyderabad. In this regard 4<sup>th</sup> Metropolitan Magistrate Court has awarded the following imprisonments to (31) respondents apart from imposing fine up to **Rs.61, 000/-** to the violators of Drunken Driving.

## PRESS NOTE

### NOTORIOUS INTER STATE DACOIT (TATLU BAAJI) GANG BUSTED - TWO HELD

The Hyderabad City Police formed a **Special Team** from CCS, PS Musheerabad, PS Kushaiguda and S.O.T Police of Rachakonda Commissionerate for detection of decoities which was reported in the above limits. The Special Team consisting of (11) members went to **Uttar Pradesh, Haryana and Rajasthan**, collected valuable evidence against the accused i.e. CCTV footages, Bank account details, cards swiping details and technical data, identified the gang members indulged in these cases. Later the team apprehended the following accused persons with the assistance of local police from the limits of Kishangarh Bas PS, Alwar District, Rajasthan state. Seized one country made Tapancha with two live cartridges and other documentary proofs etc.

#### Details of Accused:

1. **Arshad @ Aarthi @ Rahul @ Rahul Sharma @ Sona Raju**, S/o Nabba, age: 27 years r/o Devseras, Goverdhan, Mathura District, U.P.
  2. **Hassan Mohammad @ Bangad**, S/o late Deen Mohammed, age: 23 years, r/o Dongdi (V), Govindgarh, Alwar Dist, Rajasthan.
  3. Mousam, S/o Nabba, 21 yrs, r/o Devseras (V), Goverdhan Thana, Mathura Dist, U.P.
  4. Salman @ Sulli, S/o Lallu, age: 23 years, occ: truck driver, caste: Mewa muslim, r/o Nai (V), Punhana, Mewath Dist, Haryana.
  5. Amruddin, S/o Imran, age: 18 years, occ: labourer, r/o Bajot (V), Kishangarh, Alwar Dist, Rajasthan.
  6. Sakeer, S/o Safi Mohammed, age: 23 years, r/o Bajot (V), Kishangarh, Alwar Dist, Rajasthan.
- (Sl.No.s 3 to 6 are being brought on Production Warrant from Gujrath where they have been taken)

#### Cases Involved:

1. Cr.No.68/2017 U/s 364(A), 341, 387, 398, 120(B) IPC, Sec. 66(A) I.T Act, Sec. 25(1) (b) Arms Act, 1959 of PS Musheerabad.

On 24-03-2017 the above gang trapped the victim Sri D. Anjaiah, Prop. of Siri Technology, Ramnagar, Hyderabad doing CCTV cameras business in the guise of providing 850 CCTV Cameras installing in Gyan Vigyan Institute of Education, at Alwar, Rajasthan. After calling him to Kishangarh, Alwar, Rajasthan for demo they kidnapped him on point of gun, looted Rs.30,000/-, one mobile phone from his possession and confined him in the jungle. Later they have taken his photograph on aiming the weapon to the victim and posted the photographs to his family members and demanded Rs.5 lakhs for his release. On negotiation, an amount of Rs.1.5 lakhs transferred on the account of accused persons by the family members of victim. Later they released and warned him not to give complaint in the police station as they are highly dangerous and influenced.

2. Cr.No.225/2017 U/s 363, 384, 120(B) IPC of PS Kushaiguda, Rachakonda

On 14-03-2017 in the similar way the above accused persons trapped the victims Naveen Kumar and Samuel Wilson (employees of M/s. K.S. Safety & Security Systems, A.S. Rao Nagar, Hyderabad) at the same place. They took him to a secluded place in the nearby hillock and threatened them on point of gun, looted their mobiles and ATM & Credit cards. Later they have taken the PIN numbers of the cards by confining him at the same place. Some of the gang members went to Alwar and swiped the cards for the purchase of shopping in Reebok and Adidas show rooms for Rs.40,000/- and swiped in the ATM for an amount of Rs.30,000/-. They also threatened their owner Srinivas on phone and forced him to transfer an amount of Rs.2 lakhs in their accounts. After confirming the transfer of amount into their account, they released them.

3. Cr.No.349/2016 U/s 420 IPC of PS Golconda.

In the month of May, 2016 the victim Syed Zainullahbuddin and his friend Amjad Khan were trapped by the above gang in the guise of gold bricks at cheaper rate which were found in their fields while digging with plough. On reaching to Goverdhan of Mathura Dist the accused persons taken them to a secluded place and looted an amount of Rs.4 lakhs by giving fake gold bricks.

**4. Cr.No.401/2016 U/s 420, 406 r/w 34 IPC of PS Afzalgunj.**

On 28-08-2016 the above gang cheated the victim Smt. Ayesha Kareema for a tune of Rs.2 lakhs by giving fake gold bricks, in the guise of gold bricks of ancient era at a cheaper price lower than the market value, which they found while digging their fields.

Apart from the above reported cases in Hyderabad, they confessed to have committed number of offences in Telangana, Andhra Pradesh, Karnataka, Uttar Pradesh, Gujrat and Punjab etc. states.

**Previous Criminal History:**

**The accused Arshad @ Aarthi is a proclaimed offender and notorious gangster and absconding since (5) years.** He was involved in (11) cases of Attempt to Murder, Kidnapping, Cheating, Extortion, Arms Act etc. in the limits of PS Goverdhan, Mathura Dist, U.P.

The Special Team collected lot of information about the offenders who were cheating the innocent gullible people throughout India. These gangs are famous as "**Tatlu Baaji Gang**". The Special Team identified total **25 gangs, about 100 offenders** spread over 35 villages in Rajasthan, Uttar Pradesh and Haryana states. All Most all the offenders are possessing country made fire arms and live cartridges. They are indulging these types of crimes since 2010.

The arrest was made by Special Team Sri V. Syam Babu, Inspector, SIs Sri J. Ashok, PS Kushaiguda, Sri R. Balraju of PS Musheerabad along with the Team members HCs N.Venkateswar Rao, V. Sivananda Rao, PCs Y.Viswanath, B. Balaiah of CCS, PCs V. Abhilash, Shaik Thousif, D. Sudershan and S. Naender.

**Plea to the Public:**

- 1. Do not believe the calls from the unknown persons saying that they found antique gold bricks/gold coins of ancient era while ploughing in their lands and will sell at a very cheaper price than the market value as any treasure has to be declared to the Government.**
- 2. Do not go to the unknown places as told by the cheaters believing innocently.**
- 3. Do not believe the persons who asked for bulk purchase of CCTV Cameras for installing in their Educational Institutions, Corporate Offices, Business Establishments etc.**
- 4. Do not believe the persons telling as they will sell the "Basmathi Rice" at cheaper rate than the market price and asking to come to their place.**
- 5. If any member of Public comes across such persons who may try to cheat them, they are requested to contact Police immediately.**
