NOTIFICATION

With a view to maintain public order, peace and tranquility in the twin cities of Hyderabad and Secunderabad, I, M. Mahendar Reddy, IPS Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad City, in exercise of the powers vested in me under section 22(1) (a) to (f) and 22 (2) (a) and (b) of Hyderabad City Police Act, 1348 Fasli (No.IX), do hereby issue the following prohibitory orders.

- I Prohibit to hold any kind of public meetings, and processions within the Hyderabad City, without obtaining prior permission of Zonal Dy. Commissioners of Police, Law and Order concerned, Addl. Commissioner of Police, Law and Order or Jt. Commissioner of Police, Co-ordination & Security or Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad.
- a) Prohibit carrying of arms such as swords, spears, knives, sticks with or without flags bludgeons, guns, explosives, and other offensive weapons in the above mentioned areas.
- b) Prohibit gathering of persons on the public roads or public places disturbing peace and order or causing inconvenience, annoyance or danger to public.
- c) Prohibit collection, carrying of stones or other means of casting missiles.
- II Prohibit use of mikes/public address system by different Organisations around the Secretariat premises, including Burgula Rama Krishna Rao Building, Greater Hyderabad Municipal Corporation Building, Commissioner of Fisheries building, Mint Compound, Nizam College and its surroundings, Telangana / A.P. Legislative Assembly premises and surrounding roads, Public Garden Nampally, Upper Tankbund, I-MAX, Rotary and NTR Marg roads also fly-over road leading from Secretariat to Visweswarayya statue, Khairatabad.
- a) Prohibit music, singing or speeches or broadcasting through loud speakers in the above mentioned areas.
- b) Prohibit use of mikes/public address systems, use of horn through vehicles by any organisation, members of public etc., in the above mentioned areas.
- III The public are here by informed that any person violating the above orders shall be liable for prosecution under the Hyderabad City Police Act, 1348, Fasli (No. IX).
- IV **The following are exempted from the operation of this order**
- (i) Police Officers on duty,
(ii) Military personnel on duty,
(iii) Home Guards on duty,
(iv) Bonafide funeral processions.

This order shall be in force with effect from 0600 hours on 17-03-2017 to 0600 hours on 23-03-2017.

NOTIFICATION

WHEREAS, reports have been received indicating that consumption of liquor in public places has become rampant and unhindered in several areas of the City of Hyderabad, resulting in to a menace to the common members of the public, especially women and children in particular.

AND WHEREAS, such reports have been indicating that, persons consuming liquor in public places have been exhibiting abusive unruly and indecent behavior on the streets of Hyderabad City towards law abiding citizens especially women and children in particular endangering their modesty and safety in addition to causing disturbance to public tranquility resulting in annoyance and obstruction to road users in general and women and children in particular.

WHEREAS, such unruly and indecent behavior has been instilling a sense of fear psychosis in law abiding citizens, especially women and children resulting in restriction of their free movement on the streets of Hyderabad, thereby affecting public safety at large and safety and security of women and children in particular.

AND WHEREAS, it is considered necessary to take speedy measures in this regard to prevent danger to human life and safety and security of women and children or for preventing any affray and disturbance of public tranquility.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me under Section 144 of Criminal Procedure Code 1973, I, M. Mahendar Reddy, IPS, Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad City, do hereby make this written order and notify the same to the General Public **prohibiting Consumption of liquor in public places in the City of Hyderabad.**

This order is published for the information of public through the media and through the public address system in the areas affected with drunkenness in public places.

This order shall come into force from 0600 hours on 16-03-2017 and shall remain in force for a period of one week i.e. upto 0600 hours on 22-03-2017 (both days inclusive) unless withdrawn earlier.

Any person violating this order shall be liable for punishment under Section 188 of the Indian Penal code and as per the provisions of Hyderabad City Police Act, 1348 Fasli.

NOTIFICATION

Fresh / Re-poll elections to the Telangana Legislative Council in respect of Teacher's Constituencies are scheduled to be held in the Twin Cities of Hyderabad and Secunderabad on 19-03-2017 i.e., on Sunday.

After reviewing the situation carefully and with a view to maintain public order, peace and tranquility in the Twin Cities of Hyderabad and Secunderabad on 19-03-2017, I, M. Mahendar Reddy, IPS, Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad in exercise of the powers conferred on me Under Section 22 (1) (d) to (f) and 22 (2) (a) to (e) and 22 (3) of Hyderabad City Police, Act do hereby issue the following prohibitory orders:-

1. Prohibit Assembly of persons and any kind of processions
2. Prohibit carrying of sticks either with or without flags, lathies, fire arms, or any other weapons which can be used as weapons for offence or defence by persons in processions, big gathering or meetings within a radius of one K.M. from the Polling Stations
3. Prohibit erection of temporary structures like Shamianas, Pandals, Khannath etc., on thoroughfares, public places and all other places where public throng
4. Prohibit use of mikes/public address system by anybody or parties in the entire Twin Cities of Hyderabad and Secunderabad
5. Prohibit music, singing or speeches or broadcasting through or speakers of any other instruments
6. Prohibit making a speech, gesture or mimetic representation, exhibition or dissemination of pictures, symbols, placards or any other thing which is likely to create religious animosity or hatred between different communities or individuals or is likely to bring about commission of an offence or disturbance or contempt of the law or of a lawful authority

The following are exempted from the operation of this order

- a. Police Officers on duty
- b. Military/Para Military personnel on duty
- c. Home Guards on duty
- d. Election Officers on duty

The public are hereby informed that any person violating the above order shall be liable for prosecution.

This order shall be in force with effect from 1700 hours on 18-03-2017 to 0600 hours on 20-03-2017.

The sleuths of PS Chandrayangutta have arrested the following accused person who was involved in cheating and using un-known drugs and black Magic

Accused:- Syed Abbas Peer Quadri, S/o Hakim Syed Hashim Peer Quadri Al Hashmi, age 65 yrs, R/o H. No. 18-13-132/A/82 /1, Ahmed nager, Bandlaguda, Chndrayangutta, Hyd.

History of the case :-

The victim is Sabeena Begum D/O Mohd Afsar, age: 18 yrs, Occ: house hold, R/o Plot No:674 & 675, Ghousenagar, Bandlaguda, Hyd left the house on 06-03-2017 at about 2.30 PM without informing anybody in the family, a missing case has been registered and investigated in to. During investigation the victim woman traced on 13-03-2017 at H. No. 18-13-132/A/82/1, Ahmed Nager, Bandlaguda, Chndrayangutta, Hyd brought her to police station with the help of women staff, and recorded her detailed statement.

During enquiry with the victim woman, she informed that, she is suffering with thyroid problem and approached the Hakim Syed Abbas Peer Quadri for treatment, while the treatment going on the above said accused Syed Abbas Peer Quadri collected the information from the victim that, her marriage was fixed with one of her relation, but he is avoiding her due to thyroid problem. The accused take an advantage of the weakness of the victim woman and diverted her attention on him by giving some unknown medicine to her under cover of the treatment of thyroid problem, the accused know the black magic, he impressed with his activities. Due to which the victim women left from her parent's house without informing anybody. The accused succeeded to diverting her and married her as his third wife. The accused cheated the victim woman by giving unknown medicine under the treatment of thyroid problem and diverted her mind through black magic married her by putting under cover of fear. The accused Syed Abbas Peer Quadri, S/o Hakim Syed Hashim Peer Quadri Al Hashmi arrested in Cr.No.61/2017 U/s 420 IPC and Sec. 4(a) (b) & 7 of Drugs and Magic remedies Act 1954 of Chandrayangutta PS and being produced before the Hon'ble court for remand.

The case is investigated by Sri. M. Srinivasa Rao, Sub-Inspector of police under the supervision of Sri. Y. Prakash Reddy, Inspector of police, Sri Mohd. Tajuddin, ACP of Falaknuma Division , Sri K. Babu Rao, Addl. DCP, South Zone and Sri. V. Satyanarayana, IPS, DCP South Zone.
