LAKE POLICE RESCUED FOUR PERSONS FROM COMMITTING SUICIDE

On 14 of April 2017, P S Lake officials has rescued **FOUR persons** i.e., one male and three female and their particulars are 1) Sri. K. Shankar, 2) Smt. C. Mangamma, 3) Smt. C. Mangamma and 4) Smt. Syed Sabha were all rescued, while they were about to commit suicide by jumping into the Hussain Sagar Lake. The Details of the victims are as follows:-

First incident: Occurred on 14/04/2017 at 03.00 hours tried to jump into Hussain Sagar Lake at upper tank bund near lepakshi.

Details of Victim: Sri. K. Shankar s/o Sri.K. Rathanji, age:- 46 years, Occ:- daily labour, r/o:- 8-3-169-82, ganga nagar, yousfguda, borabanda, hyderabad.

Reason: On causing enquiry it came to know that the victim is a married person and blessed with two children and leading conjugal life happily. Victim works as a painter; he is a alcoholic and suspects his wife's character. Last night he went to home in a fully drunken condition and started quarrelling with his wife. Due to which he went into depression and decided to end her life. After counselling the victim was sent to Barosa counselling centre for further action.

Second incident: Occurred on 14/04/2017 at 08.30 hours tried to Jump into water at upper tank bund near Pooja stal.

Details of Victim: Smt. C. Mangamma w/o C. Bikshapathi, age:- 50 years, Occ:- Housewife, r/o:- 23-4-248, sulthan shah, hyderabad.

Reason: On causing enquiry it came to know that the victim is a married person and blessed with three children. today in the morning the victim quarrelled with her husband in a petty family issue due to which she went into depression and came to upper tankbund near pooja stal and tried to jump into water. Immediately our patrolling Lake police noticed him and saved his life. Inspector lake Smt. K. Sreedevi counselled him. After counselling handed over to her son.

Third INCIDENT: It occurred on 14.04.2017 at around 09.30 hour's upper tankbund near Lepakshi.

Details of Victim:- Smt. C. Sudha rani s/o Sri. C. Prasad, age:- 50 years, occ:- housewife, r/o:-plot no:- 17, maruthi nagar, road no:-5, alwal, secunderabad.

Reason: On causing enquiry we got to know that the victim is a married person. The victim took hand loans of rupees 10 lakhs from her known for her personal works. But she unable to return the amount. Due to which she went into depression and came to upper tankbund and tried to jump into the Hussain Sagar Lake water immediately available Lake Police noticed her and stopped her jumping into water. Inspector Lake Smt. K. Sreedevi counselled the victim handed over to her husbandsssss.

FOURTH INCIDENT: It occurred on 14.04.2017 at around 13.45 hours upper tankbund near Lepakshi.

Details of Victim:- Smt. Syed Sabha w/o Sri. Shafee, age:- 39 years, occ:- Housewife, r/o:- 5-4-36/1, maqdoon nagar, nalsab gadda, jalal bagh, sangareddy, medak dist, telangana.

Reason: On causing enquiry we got to know that the victim is suffering with Psychiatric problem since seven years. She was undergone treatment at erragadda mental hospital for two years, but after few months she is suffering with same problem. One week back the victim's mother got expired due to some health problem. Due to her mother's death she went into depression and came to upper tankbund and tried to jump into the Hussain Sagar Lake water immediately available Lake Police noticed her and stopped her. Inspector Lake Smt. K. Sreedevi counselled the victim and send to Barosa for further action.

As such Lake Police played a vital role in saving them spontaneously without giving any scope for untoward incidents for which they could saved the

lives of people viz., 1) Sri. K. Shankar, 2) Smt. C. Mangamma, 3) Smt. C. Mangamma and 4) Smt. Syed Sabha these four incidents were occurred on 14-04-2017. Smt. K. Sreedevi, Inspector of Police, Lake Police Station had counselled them promptly and they were safely handed over to their relatives and concerned by taking their assurances that they will not repeat such things in near & future.

Thus, the patrolling Blue Colts of Lake PS viz., Sri. A. Rajkumar , PC 3358, Sri. C. Sai kiran, PC 4295, Sri. B. Krishna, PC 7384, Sri. K. Ramesh, HG 8484, Sri. SK. Ghouse pasha, HG 7785 have tactfully identified the above persons in a suspicious manner and rescued them from committing suicide which was done under the supervision of Smt. Sreedevi Inspector lake P.S.


HISTORY

All the accused persons are friends and residents of Malakajgiri area. Though they are doing different jobs, their earnings are insufficient to fulfil their lavish desires of all bad vices. Hence, they decided to commit property offences to earn money by adopting easy means and hatched a plan to rob the gullible people during odd hours in the night.

In furtherance of their plan on the night of 22/23.03.2017 around 0130 hrs. they spotted the complainant Sri. Augustine William, (29), Steward at Social Monkey Restaurant, Hi-tech City r/o Shanti Nagar, Lalaguda, Secunderabad at Parade Grounds, Secunderabad while he was waiting for a sharing Auto to go to his residence. Having spotted they went there on their motor cycles (Pulsar and Honda Activa). A-3 grabbed the legs of the complainant under the vehicle tyre, A-2 hit him vigorously while A-2 snatched his cell phone and cash and decamped with the booty.

On 14.04.2017 in a joint operation by Sri. B. Ramesh, Inspector, Mahankali Police Station and his team assisted by the North Zone Field Team arrested the accused persons and recovered the stolen cell phone and the two wheelers used for the commission of offence at their instance and possession and all the accused persons are being produced in the Court for judicial remand.

The good work done by Sri. B. Ramesh, Inspector of Police with the assistance of Sri. E. Narasimha Naik, Sub-Inspector of Police, Mahankali P.S. and Sri. G. Rajasekhar Reddy, Sub-Inspector of Police, North Zone Analysis Team under the supervision of Sri. S. Gangadhar, ACP, Mahankali Division and able guidance of DCP, North Zone.

**RAID ON CRICKET BETTING - 02 HELD,
SEIZED NET CASH OF RS.3,84,000/-**

On 13-04-2017, the sleuths of Commissioner's Task Force, East Zone Team, Hyderabad, busted a cricket betting racket and apprehended 02-persons namely viz., 1) **Gajanand Upadhya**, and 2) **Sandeep Tak** at H.No.15-4-164/2, Osmanshah, Afzalgunj, Hyderabad and **seized net cash of Rs.3,84,000/-, 08-Cell phones and 02-Note books**, from their possession.

Modus Operandi:

On 13.04.2017, on a tip off Sri A.Sudhakar, Sub-Inspector of Police and the East Zone Task force Team conducted a raid at H.No.15-4-164/2, Osmanshah, Afzalgunj, Hyderabad, and apprehended two accused, who were accepting cricket betting in an organized manner and collecting amounts for their personal gains, for ongoing cricket match in between KKR vs KXIP at Kolkata, India, on 13-04-2017.

The accused Gajanand Upadhya is resident of Afzalgunj, Hyd, and his friend Sandeep Tak belongs to Begum Bazar, Hyderabad, hatched a plan to earn easy money by accepting cricket betting's during cricket matches in Hyderabad City over cell phones for ongoing IPL Cricket matches from the known punters and their close friends in an organized manner in Hyderabad, and earning easy money illegally. They received betting rates information from one Bunti Bai R/o Delhi, through cell phone and used to pay Rs.4,000/- to him per month and forwarded the same to their friends and known punters over cell phone and accepting betting directly and indirectly. The accused Gajanand Upadhya confessed that, if any punters played more than one lakh rupees of betting amount and he used to forward the same to one **Laddu Kachava, R/o King Koti, Hyderabad**, and collecting his commission amounts from Laddu Kachava and they used to make entry of betting amount details in their note books.

The apprehended accused persons along with seized property were handed over to S.H.O., Afzalgunj PS, for taking further action.

The above arrest was made under the supervision of **SRI N. KOTI REDDY, Addl. Dy. FOUR PERSONS HELD – SEIZED CALCIUM CARBIDE, CHINA POWDER AND OTHER CHEMICALS.

On 13 & 14.04.2017, on credible information the Commissioner's Task Force, South Zone Team, Hyderabad conducted simultaneous raids at various places in the limits of Moghalpura, Bhavaninagar, Falaknuma and Hussainialam Police Stations of South Zone, Hyderabad city and apprehended the following accused persons who were found ripening the mango fruits artificially by using **Calcium Carbide, China chemical powder and other chemicals** and selling the same in the market for their illegal gains and causing severe damage to the Public Health.

4. Shaik Jabbar S/o. SK Babar, aged: 27 yrs, occ: Fruit business R/o. Farooqnagar, Falaknuma, Hyderabad.

Seized Property:-

Calcium Carbide, Ethylene powder and other chemicals in huge quantity.

The brief facts of the case are that, the above mentioned accused persons were found ripening the fruits especially mangoes artificially by using **Calcium Carbide, China chemical powder and other chemicals** and selling the same in markets and gaining illegally. The above process of ripening of fruits using chemicals have severe side effects on the health of Public.

The apprehended accused persons and seized chemicals were handed over to the concerned Police Stations for taking necessary action.

The above apprehensions and seizure were made under the supervision of **Sri. N. Koti Reddy, Addl. Dy. Commissioner of Police, Commissioner's Task Force, Hyderabad City, by Sri. K. Madhu Mohan Reddy, Inspector of Police, South Zone Task Force, Hyderabad and SIs S/Sri. N.Srishylam, SK Jakeer Hussain and G. Venkata Rami Reddy along with the staff.**
