

NABBED DACOITY GANG 05 – HELD & RECOVERED Rs.3,000/- & 15-SHEEPS

On 13.04.2018, the sleuths of Commissioner's Task force, East Zone Team, Hyderabad, apprehended most wanted Dacoity gang consisting five accused persons namely **1) B.Srikanth Goud, 2) S.Pruthvi Raju, 3) G.Raj Kumar, 4) K.Ramu and 5) M.Sai Kumar** who are involved in Cr.No.68/2018 U/s 395, 419 IPC of Chaitanyapuri PS and Cr.No.278/2018 U/s 379 IPC of Meerpet PS of Rachakonda Commissionerate. Recovered **net cash of Rs.3,000/- and 15-Sheep** from their possession.

MODUS OPERANDI: -

- All the five accused persons namely 1) B.Srikanth Goud, 2) S.Pruthvi Raju, 3) G.Raj Kumar, 4) K.Ramu and 5) M.Sai Kumar are close friends. They are addicted to social vices, and roam in the late nights on the roads etc. As they have no sufficient means of earnings to meet their vices, they decided to commit property offences and lead a lavish life.
- **In the 2nd week of February'2018, in the midnight hours, the accused Srikanth along with Pruthvi Raju, Rajkumar were roaming in the area on Rajkumar's bike and Ramu, Sai kumar following on hired Auto, they came to near Kothapet area and found that, one person was sitting on bike near Omni hospital, then they went to him and caught him by saying that they are Task Force Police Department and made him to sit on the bike and took him Saroornagar Tank, Chaitanyapuri and they threatened the complainant and robbed net cash Rs.6,600/- and fled away from there. All the five accused persons shared the amount equally.**
- **In the 1st week of April-2018 in the afternoon hours all the five accused persons observed one old aged lonely person who was grazing the cattle (sheep) at open area of Dathu Nagar, Meerpet and they have planned to commit theft of sheep and hiring one four wheeler vehicle and committed theft of 15 sheep, while the old aged person was**

sleeping under a tree and this sheep were kept beside of Kabuthar building, Kaladera, Chadarghat, for disposal.

On 13-04-2018, on the tip off by Sri Mohd Mubeenuddin, PC 2544 of East Zone Task Force, the team apprehended five accused persons and **recovered net cash of Rs.3,000/- and 15-Sheeps**, from their possession.

The arrested accused persons along with seized property were handed over to SHO, Chaitanyapuri PS and remanded to judicial custody.

Note:- The general public are hereby requested to intimate the local Police about the roamers who roam late nights in the localities and create nuisance. By which the police can nab such persons and take necessary action against them according to law.

**ORGANIZED CRICKET BETTING GANG BUSTED -
APPREHENDED FOUR PERSONS - SEIZED (1) T.V, (1) LAPTOP,
(15) CELL PHONES AND NET CASH OF RS.2,05,000/-**

The sleuths of Commissioner's Task Force, West Zone Team, Hyderabad on 13-04-2018, generated actionable information after making sustained efforts and apprehended (4) cricket betting organizers by name 1) Ravinder Singh, 2) Ashish Singh, 3) Dinesh Singh and 4) Ram Singh, while they were accepting cricket betting amounts in the limits of Mangalhat Police Station directly and indirectly i.e., over cell phones for ongoing IPL-2018 Cricket match in between Royal Challengers Bangalore Vs Kings XI Punjab teams playing at Bangalore on 13-04-2018. **Seized 1) Net Cash of Rs.2,05,000/-, 2) One TV, 3) One Setup box, 4) One Laptop and 5) 15-Cell phones including 3 line phones** from the possession of accused persons.

Particulars of the Accused:-

1. Ravinder Singh S/o Late Babulal Singh, aged 35 yrs, Occ: Business, R/o H.No.14-10-126, Jali Hanuman, Mohandass mutt, Mangalhat, Hyderabad.
2. Ashish Singh @ Sonu S/o Karan Singh, aged 22 yrs, Occ: Un employee, R/o H.No.14-10-1170, Kaveli Masjid, Puranapool, Hyderabad.
3. Dinesh Singh S/o Late Ramesh Singh, aged 28 yrs, Occ: Auto Trolley driver, R/o H.No.14-10-47, Jinsi Chowrahi, Mangalhat, Hyderabad.
4. Ram Singh S/o Dasharath Singh, aged 27 yrs, Occ: P.O.P. Business, R/o H.No.13-1-931, Bada Banglaw, Upper Dhoolpet, Mangalhat, Hyderabad.
5. N.Lakhan S/o Late N.Subhash, aged 28 yrs, Occ: Bookie, R/o H.No.13-3-1107/40, Near 2J bus stop, Yellamma Temple, Jiyaguda, Kulsumpura, Hyderabad - **Absconding.**

Modus Operandi:-

The accused persons Ravinder Singh, Ashish Singh @ Sonu, Dinesh Singh and Ram Singh are friends from their childhood and they all hatched a plan to organize Cricket betting and to collect the betting amounts directly and indirectly i.e. through cell phones from the punters in Hyderabad and since two months they are running Cricket betting with the help of accused N.Lakhan who is a friend of Ravinder Singh and Ram Singh. As per the directions of accused N.Lakhan the accused remaining accused persons organizing cricket betting in the house of Ravinder Singh by watching the cricket matches in TV and Laptop. The accused Ramu Singh used to collect and distribute the cricket betting amounts from the punters in twin cities. After collecting the cricket betting amounts the accused persons used to give the betting amounts to the accused N.Lakhan by taking some amount as their commission. Sometimes the accused persons used to organize cricket betting directly and collecting the amounts with the punters without the knowledge of accused N.Lakhan.

On 13-04-2018 the said accused persons are running Cricket betting in an organized manner at premises No.14-10-126, Jali Hanuman, Mohandass mutt, Mangalhat, Hyderabad and accepting Cricket betting amount directly and indirectly i.e. over cell phones by watching T.V. on ongoing **IPL-2018 Cricket match in between Royal Challengers Bangalore Vs Kings XI Punjab teams playing at Bangalore.** In this case the accused N.Lakhan is at large.

The apprehended accused persons along with seized property were handed over to the SHO, Mangalhat PS, Hyderabad for further action.

**SLEUTHS OF SULTAN BAZAAR POLICE BLASTED RACKET OF EMPLOYMENT BY
ISSUING FAKE AND FABRICATED APPOINTMENT LETTER – RECOVERED CASH OF RS.
2,30,000/- AND FAKE APPOINTMENT LETTER OF SOUTH CENTRAL RAILWAY IN CRIME
NO. 57/2018 OF P.S SULTAN BAZAR.**

Name of the complainant :- Sri B. Shyam Lal, s/o B. Venkoba Rao, aged 47 yrs, occ: Marketing Executive, r/o H. No. 4-6-220/222, Esamiya Bazar, Koti, Sultan Bazar, Hyderabad

Name of the accused :- 1) **Nagulapalli Abhilash**, s/o N. Murali, aged 23 yrs, occ: Pvt. Service, r/o H. No. 3-3-470/1, Chappal Bazar, Kachiguda, Hyderabad., 2) **Mohammed Saleem**, s/o Mohammed Tohied, aged 43 yrs, occ: Business (Printing/Xerox shop situated at Amrutha Arcade, beside Snatosh Dhaba, Kachiguda, Hyderabad), r/o H. Nature of Crime: Deceived gullible and innocent job aspirants by collecting huge amount in the guise of providing employment in Central Government (South Central Railway) and issued fake and fabricated appointment letter.

Property Lost/Recovered: Amount of Rs. 6,10,000/- **(Lost)**., Amount of Rs. 2,30,000/-., Fake and Fabricated Appointment Letter., One Cell Phone., One CPU & Monitor and Fake Identity Card of accused **(Recovered)**.

The complainant reported that, the accused along with others cheated him and many others by collecting huge amount for job recruitment on the pretext of providing job in South Central Railway as Junior Clerk / Asst. Clerk through Railway Recruitment Board.

During the course of investigation, under the supervision of ACP Sultan Bazar, the SHO Sultan Bazar, Sri E. Naresh, S.I and Sri N. Bhaskar, S.I apprehended the accused person and recovered the above mentioned property along with equipments used in the commission of offence.

Nature of crime: House breaking by Night.

Property Lost/recovered i.e., 1) 15 nos of water self priming pump motors., 2) 2 nos. submersible pumps and 3) 7 bundles cable wires total worth about 95000/-. The entire stolen property was recovered.

On 08-04-2018 the complainant reported that his go-down was burgled and the above mentioned property was committed theft of by unknown offenders and requested to take necessary action and recover the stolen property.

Today the detective team lead by Sri G.V. Narsinga Rao, SI of PS Sultan Bazar and his team under the supervision of ACP Sultan Bazar and SHO Sultan Bazar arrested the accused and recovered the entire stolen property intact. The arrested accused persons are being produced before the Hon' ble court to-day. Efforts are being made to arrest the third accused person.

HELD ONE – SEIZED ONE COUNTRY MADE FIRE ARM AND ONE SWORD

On 14-04-2018, on credible information the sleuths of Commissioner's Task Force, West Zone Team, Hyderabad apprehended one person Ritesh Sharma at Jagannath Dwara, Begum Bazar, Hyderabad who found in possession of one Country made Pistol (Tapancha) along with two rounds (one live round and one empty round) and one Sword.

Details of the accused:-

Ritesh Sharma S/o Ramkishan Sharma, aged 30yrs, Occ: Chat bandar business at Public Garden, Nampally, Hyderabad, R/o H.No.14-7-159, Jaganathdwara, Begumbazar, Hyderabad N/o Tundla, Agra.

During interrogation it is revealed that the accused Ritesh Sharma is native of Tundla of Agra. He was born and brought up at Begumbazar, Hyderabad. From the year 2005 he is working in chat bhandar along with his father. Previously one Shiv Kumar Sharma who is uncle (Father's brother) of accused along with his wife also resided along with the accused family members at Begum Bazar, Hyderabad. He gave one country made fire arm along with two rounds and one sword to the accused. Later the accused Ritesh Sharma is moving in the locality with weapons to create panic among the public. Meanwhile, on credible information the West Zone Task Force team apprehended the accused and seized one Country made Pistol (Tapancha) along with two rounds (one live round and one empty round) and one Sword from his possession.

The accused along with seized property was handed over to SHO, Shahinayathgunj PS, Hyderabad, for taking further action.

The arrest was made under the supervision of Sri P.Radha Kishan Rao, Dy.Commissioner of Police, Commissioner's Task Force, by Sri B.Gattu Mallu, Inspector of Police, West Zone team, SI's Sri P.Mallikarjun, Sri M.Prabhakar Reddy, Sri V.Kishore, Sri L.Bhaskar Reddy and the staff of West Zone Team, Commissioner's Task Force.
