NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me under section 21 (1) (b) of the Hyderabad City Police Act, I, M.Mahendar Reddy, IPS., Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad and Secunderabad, do hereby notify, for the information of general public, that, in order to facilitate proper control and regulation of traffic in connection with the **Bonalu Procession of LAL DARWAZA**, the following restrictions are imposed on **17.07.2017 in Charminar, Mirchowk, Falaknuma and Bahadurpura areas of the Old City of Hyderabad from 12 noon to 10 p.m. :-**

1. Traffic coming from Kandikalgate will not be allowed towards Lal Darwaza and will be diverted at Chatrinaka PS "T" junction towards Gowlipura.
2. Traffic coming from Phoolbagh towards Lal Darwaza will be diverted at Pather-ki-Darga towards the old office of A.C.P., Chatrinaka.
3. Traffic coming from Balagunj will not be allowed towards Lal Darwaza and will be diverted at Balagunj towards Gowlipura X -Road.
4. Traffic coming from Gowlipura Market towards Sudha Talkies will be diverted at the Library towards the Ashoka Pillar X -Roads.
5. Traffic coming from Meer-ka-Daira and Moghalpura will not be allowed towards Shalibanda and will be diverted at Hari-Bowli X -Roads.
6. Traffic coming from Uppuguda and Chatrinaka side will be diverted towards Moghalpura PS at Gowlipura X Roads.
7. Traffic coming from Chandrayangutta towards Aliyabad will be diverted at new Shamsheergunj "T" junction towards -Tadban via Almas Hotel (Jahanuma).
8. Traffic coming from Bhavani Nagar and Mirjumla Talab will not be allowed towards Charminar and will be diverted at Bibi Bazar X Roads towards Alijah Kotla (Miralam Mandi road).
9. Traffic coming from Moghalpura towards Charminar will be diverted towards Alijah Kotla via Chowk Maidan Khan at Fire Station, Moghalpura.
10. Traffic coming from Yakutpura towards Gulzar House will be diverted towards Mir Alam Mandi road at Eitebar Chowk mosque.
11. Traffic coming from Purani Haveli and Mandi Road towards Chatta Bazar will be diverted at Lakkad Kote X -Roads towards Dar-ul-shifa.
12. Traffic coming from Fateh Darwaza will not be allowed towards Himmatpura X Roads and will be diverted at Volga Hotel towards Khilwat or Moti Galli.
13. Traffic coming from Puranapul towards Laad Bazar will be diverted at Motigalli towards Shahgunj or Chelapura.

14. Traffic coming from Khilwat towards Laad Bazar will be diverted at Motigalli "T" junction towards Chowk Mosque.
15. Traffic coming from Shakkar Kote will be diverted at Mitti ka Sher towards Ghansi Bazar and Chelapura.
16. Traffic coming from Puranapul and Mehboob ki Mehendi towards Nayapool will be diverted at Muslimjung Bridge towards Begum Bazar.
17. Traffic coming from Chaderghat, Noor Khan Bazar and Darul shifa will not be allowed towards Nayapool and will be diverted at Dar-ul-shifa, towards Gowliguda and Afzalgunj via Salarjung Bridge.
18. Traffic coming from Gowliguda and Siddiamber Bazar towards Nayapool will be diverted at Afzalgunj X -Roads towards Muslimjung bridge via Osmania General Hospital road along the Musi river.
19. The road between Madina X -Roads and Engine Bowli, Jahanuma, will be closed to all vehicular traffic.

The TS & APSRTC buses will terminate at old CBS hanger, Darulshifa X Roads and Engine Bowli and will take alternate routes open to them.

**HELD ONE PERSON WHO ATTEMPTED TO CHEAT INNOCENT PEOPLE BY
SELLING OUTDATED TURKEY CURRENCY - SEIZED (100) NOTES OF Rs. 05
LAKH DENOMINATED EACH TOTAL WORTH OF Rs. 05 CRORES OF OLD
LIRAS.**

On 14-07-2017, the sleuths of Commissioner's Task Force, **Central Zone Team along with Chilkalguda Police**, apprehended One person near White House Bar and Restaurant, Chilkalguda, Secunderabad who is trying to exchange outdated Turkey Currency to the customers. **Seized (100) Notes of Rs.05 Lakh denomination each Turkey Currency (LIRASI) and One Cell phone** from his possession.

DETAILS OF THE PERSONS:

- 1) M. srimannarayana Prasad S/o Laxmi Narsaiah, aged 53 yrs, Occ:-
Ex Railway Police Inspector, R/o Flat no 401, Kakatiya
Appartment, Stree no 2, Habsiguda, Hyderabad.
- 2) Sheshu (Absconding Native of Guntur District)

BRIEF FACTS:

The accused M. srimannarayana Prasad native of Guntur District was appointed in Railway Police Force as a Sub Inspector, Three Years back he was trapped by ACB and he was suspended and removed from services after that he was facing a lot of financial problems mean while his friend Sheshu r/o; karampodi informed that he is having Turkey Currency if he can exchange it in to Indian Currency he will give some commission in that amount. Due to financial problems, he agreed to exchange the currency and taken the 100 notes of Turkey currency (LIRAS) denomination of 5 lakh each and few days later he came to know that the Turkey currency (LIRAS) which he is possessed is demonetized and invalid. Even though he planned to sell the unused Turkey currency in Hyderabad to innocent interested persons for getting huge profits. In the meantime while searching in this regard he contacted one person in Hyderabad to sell unused Turkey currency.

According to their plan today i.e. on 14-07-2017 in the morning he came to White House Bar and Restaurant, Chilkalguda. Secunderabad

and trying to exchange outdated Turkey currency (LIRAS). Meantime the staff of Central Zone Task Force team along with Chilkalguda Police Station Staff laid a trap and apprehended the accused M. srimannarayana Prasad and seized (100) Notes of outdated Turkey Currency (LIRAS) and (01) cell phone from his possession.

The accused along with seized material handed over to the SHO, Chilkalguda PS for further investigation.

The above apprehension made under the supervision of **Sri. B. Limba Reddy, Deputy Commissioner of Police, Commissioner's Task Force** by Sri S Srinivasa Rao, Inspector of Police, Central Zone Task Force team, SIs Sri B. Kantha Reddy, G. Thimmappa, and K. The Marketing Intelligence Team of Cyber Crimes PS, CCS, DD, Hyderabad City have arrested an accused by name Bandreddy Vasantha Rao @ Vasanth who had cheated many persons on the pretext of selling Racks in online by posting advertisement in Quikr.com website in Cr. No. 151/2017, U/s 420,406,419 IPC & Sec 66(D) of ITA Act of PS Cyber Crimes and seized the hard disk, Wifi Router, 2 Mobile phones, Debit Cards, Bank Pass book etc.

FACTS OF THE CASE:

Facts of the case are that on 20-06-2017 received a complaint from Sri Akhil Kumar Jain, Age: 31 yrs, Occ: Business, R/o Yakuthpura, Hyderabad in which he stated that "he noticed an advertisement in Quikr on 17/05/2017 for purchasing Racks in online. He contacted over mobile phone and discussed about the size, quantity & gauze. He received the quotation for the Racks through email csk6106@gmail.com on 17/05/17 for 85,000/-. After negotiations, the accused agreed to supply the Racks for sum of Rs.75,000/- with payment coalition as 30,000/- as advance. Accordingly, he made payment of Rs. 15,000/- to the A/c of B. Vasantha Rao, Axis Bank A/c No. 916010023289328. Again the accused called up for 15,000/-. But he has transferred Rs.10,000/- on same day. They confirmed the receipt of the amount in their accounts. They assured him to send the copy of dispatched goods (LR) immediately when he didn't receive LR copy, he again contacted him, then he again demanded Rs. 5,000/- as advance for payment for transportation. The complainant doubted the assurance given by him. He did not make any further transaction. Since then, they are not answering his calls and have blocked his number. Hence, he requested to take necessary action.

Badreddy Vasantha Rao @ Vasanth S/o Prabhakar Rao, age: 31 years, Occ: Unemployed, R/o Flat No. 202, Sri Sai Residency, New Ashok Nagar, Street No. 4, Eluru, West Godavari Dist., Andhra Pradesh.

MO. OF THE OFFENCER

The accused had posted advertisement in Quikr.com saying he would sell the Racks in online under M/s CSR Traders along with his mobile number & email ID. The accused posted the photos of attractive racks. When the customers contact him, he would promise them that he would deliver the Racks after paying advance and asks them to transfer the amount into his bank. After transferring the money to his Bank account, he would again persist them to transfer some more amount for transport charge. After getting transfer the same, he would never give response to them. In the same manner, the complainant had contacted the accused in the month of May, 2017 for buying Racks. The accused dishonestly got the money transfer to this account and thereafter, never responded to his calls. The accused email IDs: csk6106@gmail.com, pratap095@gmail.com, vasanth4112@gmail.com, dannyfr29@gmail.com and SIM Cards 9052328883, 9985529123, 8499988629, 9133626127, 9133688577, 9553629998 etc. In the same manner, the accused had cheated many persons in Telangana, A.P., Tamilnadu and other states.

The Marketing Intelligence Team of Cyber Crimes PS, CCS, DD, Hyderabad City have arrested an accused by name Chadaram Chakradar who had cheated many persons along with one Ravinder Reddy on the pretext of providing VISAs to Cyprus & Turkey countries by running a website called www.sirios.in in Cr. No. 147/2017, U/s 420,406,419 IPC & Sec 66(D) of ITA Act of PS Cyber Crimes and seized Laptop, Mobile Phone, Bank Passbook, Debit Card etc.

FACTS OF THE CASE:

Facts of the case are that on 15-06-2017, received a complaint from Sri Ganji Ravi, Age: 38 yrs, Occ: Electrician, R/o Hyderguda, Hyd in which he stated that he had contacted with Mr. Chekradhar and Mr. Ravinder Reddy through a website www.sirios.in having it's email ID sirigulf@gmail.com who are running a consultancy namely Siri Overseas Solutions, Hyd for visa process to go to European country (Cypurs) on electrical work. As per their instructions, he had filled the application form & other documents, they told him that they would charge total Rs. 60,000/- for visa process and other service charges and asked him to deposit amount Rs. 30,000/- in advance in A/c No. 20177665089 of SBI. As such he has deposited Rs. 30,000/-. Before depositing amount in the account, they took him to Delhi for interview along with other 300 members and the complainant spent amount about Rs. 5000/- for expenditure for 2 days. Later he had been in touch with them over their phone numbers 8712300037 of Chekradhar, 8712300038 of Sagar and 8712300034 of Ravinder Reddy regularly. But till the date they did not provided any visa, moreover they are not responding to his calls and postponing the visa process day by day. When he had visited their office, he found that it is locked. Therefore, He requested to take necessary action.

MO. OF THE OFFENCEDER

The accused A-1 had established a company by name Siri Overseas Consultancy at Nagole, Hyd and were running a website called www.sirios.in & email ID: sirigulf@gmail.com. The accused A-1 with the help of A-2 used to collect the money from the unemployed persons by saying they would provide the VISAs to them for going to Cyprus, Turkey etc. The accused would collect the money through online transfer and after that, they would not respond to their calls and SMSs. In the same manner, the complainant had contacted the accused A-1 & A-2 after noticing their information on www.sirios.in for providing VISA to him to go to Cyprus on electrical work. The accused had got transfer an amount of Rs. 30,000/- from him through online to A-2's Bank Account No. 20177665089 of SBI. Later, they never responded to his calls & SMSs. In the manner, the accused had cheated many persons. The accused A-1: Ravinder Reddy is absconding.

CENTRAL ZONE TASK FORCE TEAM NABBED THREE MEMBER GANG INDULGING IN CIRCULATING FAKE INDIAN CURRENCY NOTES AND SEIZED WORTH OF RS. 1,90,000/-.

Today i.e. on 14-07-2017, on the Information and input by the DRI worked out by the Commissioner's Task Force, Central Zone Team with Gopalapuram Police, apprehended three member gang who procured fake Indian Currency Notes from West Bengal for circulating in Hyderabad. Seized Rs. 1,90,000/- fake Indian Currency Notes in Rs. 2,000/- denomination from their possession.

Details of the arrested accused:

01. Shaik Arshad Ali @ Arshad S/o Shaik Basith Ali, aged 28 yrs, Occ: auto Driver, R/o Narapally Colony, Ghatkesar Mandal, RR Dist.
02. Abdul Razzak @ Zintu Miya S/o Late Moslem Shaik, aged 31 yrs, Occ: Agriculture R/o Khoribona (Village), Shashani (Post), Kaliachak (Police station) Malda District, West Bengal State
03. Shaik Arif Ali S/o Shaik Basith Ali, aged 29 yrs, Occ: Driver, R/o Narapally Colony, Ghatkesar Mandal, RR Dist.
04. Mohd. Ghouse R/o Yakuthpura (**Absconding**)
05. Khaimul haq S/o Marffat, age: 23 years, Occ: Agriculture, N/o Subedar para (V), Kaliachak (Police station) Malda District, West Bengal. (**Absconding**)

Facts of the Case:

The accused Mohd.Ghouse R/o Yakuthpura was involved in procuring Fake Indian Currency Notes from West Bengal and circulating in Hyderabad city. He was arrested by Hyderabad police in various Police Stations several times. While he was in jail, he met Khaimul haq N/o West Bengal who was arrested in Fake Indian Currency Notes case of Bhavani Nagar PS and also met Shaik Arshad Ali who was arrested in Chain Snatching cases. When they were in jail they exchanged their contact numbers. Khaimul haq was released from jail in the month of January-2017 and went to Malda of West Bengal. Shaik Arshad Ali was released from jail in the month of March-2017 whereas Mohd Ghouse was released from jail on 14-06-2017 after releasing from jail Ghouse contacted and met Arshad and they both contacted Khaimul haq native of Bengal for circulating Fake Indian Currency Notes (FICN). As per their plan Khaimul haq sent Abdul Razzak to Nagpur, Maharashtra along with Rs. 2 lakhs FICN (Rs. 2000 Notes) to meet Arshad Ali. On 11-07-2017 Arshad and Razzak met at Nagpur Railway Station and came to Hyderabad along with the FICN on the same day. Next day Arshad Ali and his brother Arif Ali and Razzak met Mohd Ghouse at LB Nagar and handed over Rs.10,000/- FICN to him. As to check the quality of the note whether it is circulate in the market or not Today i.e., on 14-07-

2017 in the Afternoon Arshad Ali, Arif Ali and Razzak came near Secunderabad Railway Station along with the remaining Rs. 1,90,000/- FICNs to circulate them, on DRI Information Central Zone Task Force team along with Gopalapuram Police apprehended them and seized Rs. 1,90,000/- fake Indian Currency (95 notes) with denominations of Rs.2,000/- from their possession and the accused were handed over to Gopalapuram Police for taking further action.

The arrests were made under the supervision of **Sri B.Limba Reddy, Dy.Commissioner of Police, Commissioner's Task Force,Hyd.City** by Sri S. Srinivas Rao, Inspector of Police, Commissioner's Task Force, Central Zone, and Sri. Sridhar Inspector of Police, Gopalapuram PS with the assistance of SIs Sri K. Vinod Kumar, Sri. B. Kantha Reddy, Sri. G. Thimmappa and staff of Commissioner's Task Force, Central Zone team.
