NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me under section 21 (1) (b) of the Hyderabad City Police Act, I, ANJANI KUMAR, I.P.S, Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad City do hereby notify, for information of the general public that in order to facilitate proper regulation of traffic and ensure public safety in connection with the Construction of White Topping (Cement Concrete Road) from Balkampet Temple Junction to SR Nagar 'T' Junction. The following traffic restrictions and diversions will be imposed for a period of (20) days w.e.f. 15-11-2018 to 04-12-2018.

:- TRAFFIC DIVERSION :-

1. Traffic coming from Fathe Nagar towards Satyam Theater will not be allowed and it will be diverted at Holly 'x' road towards Bhogha residence - left turn - AP Cars - SR Nagar Community Hall.
2. Traffic coming from the Satyam Theatre towards Fathernagar will allowed as usual towards Fathernagar Bridge via R&B Office.
3. The traffic comming from Daram Karam raod towards Fathe nagar will not be allowed towards Fathe nagar vai R & B office. It will be allowed from Food world left turn , Sonabai Temple and Satyamm U turn towards Fathe Nagar Bridge via Balkampet Teple Bridge.

All citizens are requested to take alternate routes and avoid the above routes and cooperate with the Traffic Police during the period of traffic diversion.

PRESS NOTE

The Cyber Crime Police, CCS, DD, Hyderabad City arrested one person named **Nallapati Jeevan Kumar S/o Venkateswarlu age 23yrs Occ House Hold R/o H.No 2-146, Nallamadugula Village, Chandrashekarapuram Mandol, Prakasham Dist of Andhra Pradesh State in Cr.No.328/2018, U/s. 66 C, D, I.T.A. Act, 2008 and Sec.419, 420, IPC** who is cheating the innocent ladies in matrimonial sites in the pretext of getting marriage and extracting money from them by acting that his mother is bed ridden and undergoing Cancer treatment.

Brief facts of the case are that 04-10-2018 received a complaint from a lady R/o Secunderabad. in which she stated that in the month of June-2018 she created her profile with Jeevansathi.com with a view to search for a suitable groom. After that she searched for the suitable alliances over the website and found one profile with in the name of Rishi Kumar Nallapati. She sent her interest to him and he reciprocated her with his interest and they exchanged many photos and calls. She insisted him to come for a video chat but he avoided to show his face giving some flimsy reasons. After exchange of their views, they both decided to marry. According to his profile he is from Nellore working in Indian Institute of Science, as a professor. His qualification is Ph.D. The phone number which he kept in the matrimonial site is 6281327455. He gave her other numbers during their conversation are 9381176028, 8790099552. After that he requested her to furnish the credit card details facilitating him to use her credit cards as his mother was sick and suffering with cancer. Believing his words she have sent the photos of her credit cards to him through whatsapp.No. 6281327455. He used her credit cards No.4386280034679831 of Citi Bank and Card No.4726426895521583 of SBI. She informed the OTPs to him and he used both cards up to an amount of Rs.2 lakhs approximately. Later he asked her to send her debit card. She have given the details of her debit card No.5129670102950123 of HDFC bank. He used the card for an amount of approximately Rs.40,000/-. Later he blocked her profile and stopped responding to her., Basing on the complaint a case in **Cr.No.328/2018, U/s. U/s. 66 C, D, I.T.A. Act, 2008 and Sec.419, 420, IPC** was registered at Cyber Crime P.S.

Modus operandi :-

Accused Nallapati Jeevan Kumar created a fake profile in matrimonial sites like Jeevansathi.com and Shadi.com in the name of Rishi Kumar by keeping the photos of a person named Prithvish Shetty and introduced himself as a Professor in Indian Institute of Science, Bangalore, and sent messages to many earning women informing them that he liked their profiles and asked them to go through his profile.

In the month of February 2018, he sent acceptance for a lady of Secunderabad through JeevanSathi.com. She liked his profile and promised her to marry and convinced her to stay together and **transacted about Rs 2,40,000/-** from her cards by purchasing one I phone X, worth 1 lakh, one LG TV worth Rs 40,000/-, Apple Air PODS worth Rs 13,000/-, and one Valentine watch worth Rs 11,000/- and remaining money I spent for my lavishness.

Later in the month of March 2018, he trapped another girl, who is a software employee from Bangalore in same matrimonial site Jeevansathi.com and made her believed that my mother is suffering with cancer and managed to get approximately Rs 10,00,000/- through online transfer in to his account. With that money he purchased BAJAJ Dominar 400CC vehicle, worth 2 lakh rupees, Iphone 6 worth Rs 30,000/- Apple watch worth Rs 30,000/- and enjoyed in parties at Goa remaining money is now available in my bank account.

During April 2018 he came into contact with one girl of Banglore who is unemployed. He squeezed money from her on same false pretexts. She deposited money Rs 1,80,000/- in to his account.

Approximately he **cheated an amount of Rs 20,00,000/-** from different girls on different matrimonial sites.

In this case Ch. Gangadhar, Inspector of Police, SI Madhusudhan Rao, PCs- Sathish Kumar and Murali participated in this raid under supervision Addl.DCP Sri.Raghuvir.
