

**SHE TEAMS HYDERABAD ARRESTS CAB DRIVER FOR HARASSING A LADY  
TOURIST**

A tourist lady from Kerala, working in Bangalore, came to Hyderabad along with her family, on a 3 day trip to see Hyderabad and its surrounding places last week. She engaged a cab from a travel agency. They toured the city, went for shopping, took pictures, had food and spent the time moving around important tourist spots in the city. On the third day at the end of their tour when they were going to catch the train, the lady was sitting as the seat adjacent to the driver while her parents and relatives were at the back seat. When they were on the way and reached Ramanthapur area, the driver unzipped his pants and started showing his private parts to the lady. She was shocked and screamed asking him to stop the car. But the driver did not listen and repeated the same act. When the lady was shouting and screaming repeatedly, he stopped the car. She got down immediately and narrated the incident to her father and uncle. While they started questioning him, the driver started to drive away the car with her mother and aunt in it. Both her father and uncle grabbed the car keys from him. The driver threw their luggages on the road. The lady called up the travel agency and complained against the driver. As they were to board the train, she could not complain to the Police station. However, she sent the details to the whatsapp number of Hyderabad City Police requesting to take necessary action. On 18-04-2017, the Crime Team of Panjagutta Police apprehended one notorious accused person and detected (04) cases and recovered Gold Ornaments Total wg. about 14 tulas, all W/Rs. 4 Lakhs.

**Details of Arrested Accused person:**

**Reddy Pogu Venkateswarlu @ Venkatesh, S/o. Late. Chinna Venkat Swamy, age: 37 yrs, Occ: Auto Driver, R/o. H. No. 15-101, Indra Gandhi Nagar, Veldurthi, Kurnool Dist..**

**(The accused person was arrested on 18.04.2017 and being produced before the Hon'ble Court for judicial remand)**

**Modus Operandi:**

He is a notorious HB offender doing house lock breakings since 2007 and went to jail nearly about (10) times, last arrested by Pakala PS of Chittoor District and released on bail in the month of July 2016 from Chittoor district Jail.

The accused use to *move in the areas in the early hours and select the Apartments* and climb the Apartments from back side through Pipes and windows and reach to the Flats back side balconies and break open the backside balcony doors with the help of small iron rod and enter into the Flat and found Almirahs, cupboards and broke open the almirah locks and cupboard locks and commit theft of Gold and silver ornaments and escape from the spot along with the booty. Later he sold the Gold ornaments at various Jewellery shops and spent the amount lavishly for his bad habits i.e., Consuming Alcohol etc. The accused was addicted bad habits and he started the commission of thefts for fulfill his needs with the stolen ornaments money.

**Modus Operandi:**

The apprehended three juvenile boys, in which two boy juveniles were having past criminal record. They commit theft of two wheelers, by using false keys and commit night house burglaries by break open the locks of the doors with a small iron rod. Earlier they were involved in more than five cases of HB & two wheelers in the limits of Chilalguda PS, SR Nagar PS, Jubilee Hills PS, Jagathgirigutta PS, Chandanagar PS and Kukatpally PS.

## PRESS NOTE

### NOTORIOUS INTER STATE PASONDA GOODMORNING GANG (NAMASTHE GANG) BUSTED - TWO HELD

The **Special Team** of CCS identified "**GOODMORNING GANG**" (Namasthe gang) belongs to Pasonda village, Gaziabad Dist, Uttar Pradesh who are indulging in robberies/snatchings on the point of gun in Hyderabad, Pune, Bangalore, Delhi, Gurugram etc. Two accused namely Babbu Malik and Imran Malik were arrested. Seized (2) dummy pistols, (5) laptop bags, one Bajaj Chetak Scooter, gold chain weighing 3  $\frac{1}{2}$  tulas etc.

#### Details of Accused:

1. **Babbu Malik @ Babbu**, S/o Ikram Malik, age:28 years, occ: scrap business, r/o C-60, Gali No.4, Chamman Park, Ghoripur, Mustafabad, Delhi.
2. **Imran Malik @ Imran**, S/o Ite Ehasan Malik, age: 32 years, occ: scrap/clothes business, r/o Pasonda (V), near Badi Majeed, PS Saidabad, Gaziabad Dist, Uttar Pradesh.

#### Brief Facts:

#### Cr.No.44/2017 U/s 382 IPC of PS Ramgopalpet.

On 12-02-2017 morning hours the victim Sri Popuri Venkata Ratnam aged about 59 years, r/o Chikoti Gardens, Mayuri Marg, Begumpet, Secunderabad, after having darshan of Lord Saibaba at Nallagutta Saibaba Temple, Minister Road, he is on the way to his house, meantime near Mysamma Temple two unknown persons standing on footpath by stopping their two wheeler, came near to him and all of a sudden snatched his gold chain weighing about 3 tulas from his neck on point of gun and fled away towards Prendergast Road on their two wheeler.

#### Criminal History of the Gang:

A-1 Babbu Malik is a notorious gangster and History Sheeter of P.S North District and indulged in 32 criminal cases i.e. (1) Fire Arms cases, (12) Robbery cases, (1) Extortion, (17) Snatching cases, (1) Cheating etc. in Gurugram, Haryana state, Pune, Hyderabad.

A-2 Imran Malik is indulged in 11 criminal cases i.e. (5) Robbery cases, (5) Snatching, (1) Extortion etc. in Gurugram, Haryana state, Pune, Hyderabad.

#### Modus Operandi:

The above gang is belongs to Pasonda village, Shahibabad Thana, Gaziabad in Uttar Pradesh. Before 2010, they used to do 'Kabada Bangaru" business (buying/selling of old electronic parts). Initially they involved in number of cheating cases i.e. selling duplicate iphones, laptops etc. At the time of selling, after taking money they replace the originals

with duplicates or empty bags. Later they started involving snatchings, robberies etc. They extended their operations to the metro cities like, Hyderabad, Delhi, Bangalore etc. At present they are purchasing old scooters from the scrap and send them to the targeted cities through cargo with fake registration number. Later they go by air to the City and indulging in robberies particularly from the old people who came for morning walk. They will move on scooter and after identifying the target, stop their vehicle at a distance and on reaching the victim, they wish them as Good Morning or Namasthe and diverting their attention by showing a piece of paper and ask direction for the address. At that time they observe the valuables wear by them, after identifying the valuables, they snatch the valuables by threatening and manhandling them on point of gun and fled away in high speed. At the time of committing offence they wear masks to avoid identification.

The Special Team of CCS, after investigation went to Pasonda village and came to know that they were arrested by Gurugram Police where they committed (17) similar offences by using country made fire arms. Later they were brought to Hyderabad on Production Warrant along with Ramgopalpet Police and interrogated them. On interrogation it is came to light that within (3) months they indulged in total 21 such type of cases in Hyderabad, Delhi, Pune, etc.
