NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me under section 21 (1) (b) of the Hyderabad city Police Act, I, Anjani Kumar, IPS, Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad, do hereby notify, for the information of the general public, that, in order to relieve traffic congestion, to maintain smooth flow of traffic and ensure public safety in connection with **Milad un Nabi** Procession in Hyderabad, the following traffic restrictions/diversions will be made on 21-11-2018 from 08.00 AM to 6.00 PM.

1. The Vehicular traffic will not be allowed to proceed towards Charminar at Shah ali banda X roads and will be diverted towards Khilwath or Nagula chintha or Moghlpura.
2. The Vehicular traffic will not be allowed to proceed towards Charminar at Motigalli and will be diverted towards Moosa bowli or Volga hotel.
3. The Vehicular traffic will not be allowed to proceed towards Charminar at Gulzar houz and will be diverted towards Mitti ka sher or Panjesha.
4. The Vehicular traffic will not be allowed to proceed towards Gulzar houz at Mitti ka sher and will be diverted towards Khilwath or Ghansi bazaar.
5. When procession reaches Gulzar houz, the traffic coming from Madina will not be allowed to proceed towards Charminar and will be diverted towards City College Jn.
6. When procession reaches Madina, the traffic coming from City College will not be allowed to proceed towards Delhi gate and will be diverted towards Begum Bazaar and Moosabowli.
7. When procession reaches Madina, the traffic coming from Afzal gunj will not be allowed to proceed towards Nayapool and will be diverted towards SA bazaar, Shivaji bridge and MJ bride.
8. When procession reaches Delhi gate, the traffic coming from SJ Rotary will not be allowed to proceed towards Nayapool and will be diverted towards Shivaji Bridge and Mir alam mandi.
9. When procession reaches Darul shifa, the traffic coming from Dabeerpura will not be allowed to proceed towards APAT and will be diverted towards Matha kidiki or so on.
10. When procession reaches APAT, the traffic coming from Dabeerpura OR Matha kidiki will not be allowed to proceed towards Purani haveli / Peeli gate and will be diverted towards Dabeerpura or Matha kidiki .
11. When procession reaches APAT, the traffic coming from Tippu khana Jn VIA Chatta bazaar will not be allowed to proceed towards Purani haveli / Peeli gate and will be diverted towards Madina at Tippu khana Jn.
12. When procession reaches APAT, the traffic coming from Etebar chowk will not be allowed to proceed towards Purani haveli / Peeli gate and will be diverted towards Panjesha or Yakutpura.
13. When procession reaches Etebar chowk, the traffic coming from Bibi bazaar will not be allowed to proceed towards Miralam mandi and will be diverted towards Talab katta or Hafeez danka masque at Bibi bazaar.

14. When procession reaches Kotla aliza, the traffic coming from Volta hotel will not be allowed to proceed towards Kotla aliza and will be diverted towards Talab katta or Moghlpura at Volta hotel.
15. When procession reaches Volta hotel, Moghlpura, the traffic coming from Hari bowli will not be allowed to proceed towards Volta hotel and will be diverted towards Shah ali banda X roads or Sultan shahi side.
16. APSRTC district buses will be diverted towards Chadarghat from there towards Nalgonda Chowrasta and Ranga mahal, MJ Market sides for entry and exit from 08.00 AM to 6.00 PM on 21-11-2018 and they should not come towards SJ Rotary and Miralam mandi road till the procession terminates.
17. The persons who are participating in the procession can park their vehicle at Charminar Bus Terminal.

PRESS NOTE

Cyber Crime Police of CCS, Detective Department, Hyderabad, apprehended (3) three offenders namely 1) Md. Salamt Islam Sardar, 2) Samir Hazra and 3) Shankar Haldar, all R/o South 24 Parganas district, West Bengal, who are assisting inter-state fraudsters indulging in obtaining debit/credit card details including OTP numbers from bank customers posing themselves as bank officials by providing them their address details and bank accounts on commission basis. Police seized (3) mobile phones, debit cards and bank pass books used in the offence from them.

FACTS OF THE CASE:

Basing on the complaints, regarding receiving of phone calls from unknown persons posing as Bank Officials who obtained SBI debit card details and OTP numbers fraudulently and made on line transactions for Rs.75,000/- and Rs.1,00,000/- respectively, two separate cases were registered vide Cr.Nos.274/2018 and 343/2018 at Cyber Crime PS, CCS, Detective Department, Hyderabad and investigated into.

During the course of investigation, basing on the information provided by banks and e-commerce wallets and clues on hand, a police team proceeded to West Bengal and apprehended the accused persons. The accused persons were brought to Hyderabad on transit warrant and they were remanded to Judicial custody.

- 1) Md. Salamat Islam Sardar R/o South 24 Parganas district, West Bengal.
- 2) Samir Hazra both from South 24 Parganas district, West. Bengal.

M.O. OF THE OFFENDER:-

The Accused persons along with their associates are assisting inter-state fraudsters indulging in obtaining debit/credit card details including OTP numbers from bank customers posing themselves as bank officials by providing them their address details and bank accounts on commission basis.

The team is headed by Sri D. Prashanth, Inspector of Police, Sri G. Thimmappa, Sub-Inspector of Police, under the supervision of KCS Raghu Vir, Addl. Dy. Commissioner of Police, Cyber Crime PS, Hyderabad, apprehended the accused persons.

LAKE POLICE RESCUED 2 PERSONS FROM COMMITTING SUICIDE

In the inverting nights of 08th November 2018, P S Lake officials have rescued **two man** in two different timing and situation. Were all rescued, while they were about to commit suicide by jumping into the Hussain Sagar Lake. The Details of the victims are as follows:-

First incident: On 19/11/2018 at 1530 hours tried to jump into water near Pooja stal, immediately our patrolling Lake Police noticed him and brought to Lake P.S.

Details of Victim: One lady, age:- 23 yrs, occ:- pvt employee, r/o:- ameerpet, Hyderabad.
Reason: On enquiry with the victim it came to know that she is in Love since three years. Yesterday in the evening hours victim and her boy friend quarrelled with each other, due to which she went into depression and came to tankbund and tried to jump into water. I counselled both victim and her boy friend promptly, after that handed over to Panjagutta P.S. for further legal action.

Second incident: It occurred on 19/11/2018 at around 1530 hour's tankbund children's park.

Details of Victim:- One woman, age:- 33 yrs, occ:- daily labour, r/o:- Attapur, Hyderabad.

Reason: On enquiry victim revealed that she revealed that she is facing with some personal family problems. Due to which she went into depression and came. I counselled her promptly, after that handed over to her husband.

Third incident: On 19/11/2018 at 1530 hours tried to jump into water near Pooja stal, immediately our patrolling Lake Police noticed him and brought to Lake P.S.

Details of Victim: One man, age:- 24 yrs, occ:- daily labour, r/o:- thukaramgate, Hyderabad.

Reason: On enquiry victim revealed that he is a psychiatric depression patient and undergoing treatment at Gandhi hospital. He fed up on his problematic life, today in the evening hours he escaped from his house and planned to end his life by committing suicide and came to tankbund with the intension to commit suicide by jumping into water.

As such Lake Police played a vital role in saving them spontaneously without giving any scope for untoward incidents for which they could save the lives of people. These three incidents were occurred on 19-11-2018. I counselled them promptly and they were safely handed over to their relatives and concerned by taking their assurances that they will not repeat such things in near & future.

Thus, the patrolling Blue Colts of Lake PS viz., HG 5348, P.V. Subba reddy, HG 6849, Jaganath bhai have tactfully identified the above persons in a suspicious manner and rescued them from committing suicide.
